Day 1 Australia - London, UK

Today depart for London, England.

Please note: Due to flight scheduling and availability, some customers may be required to depart on Day 2, to arrive on Day 2. Flight times will be indicated on your final documentation, which you will receive 4-6 weeks prior to departure.

Day 2 Welcome to London

Upon arrival make your own way to your hotel. Spend the rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Ibis London Earls Court Hotel or similar, London

Meals included: None

Day 3 London Free Day

Today, spend the day at your leisure in the amazing city of London.

Make the most of your day visiting famous sights such as Trafalgar Square, Piccadilly Circus, Covent Garden, Regent Street, Oxford Street and more.

See Albert Memorial, Royal Albert Hall, Parliament House and the London Eye Ferris wheel.

Overnight: Ibis London Earls Court Hotel or similar, London

Meals included: None

Day 4 London Free Day

Enjoy a free day in the historic city of London.

You could take in iconic sights such as Tower Bridge, Buckingham Palace, and Covent Garden, browse the Borough Market, take a photo with the Beefeaters at the Tower of London, or venture further afield.

Day 5 London, UK - Reykjavik, Iceland

Today make your way to the airport for your flight to Reykjavik. Upon arrival be transferred to the hotel by hotel shuttle.

Enjoy the rest of your day at leisure in Iceland's capital city.

Overnight: Hotel Klettur or similar, Reykjavik

Meals included: None

Day 6 Reykjavik City Tour and Borgarfjörður Saga Valley - Begin 6-Night Northern Lights Academy Program

After breakfast meet the tour guide who will show you the highlights of Iceland's exciting capital city.

Then head west, stop in Borgarnes and learn about Iceland's earliest days at the Settlement Center. Continue to Borgarfjörður, known as the Saga Valley, due to its many important historical events.

Get a chance to climb the Grábrók volcano crater and visit Deildartunguhver, Europe's most powerful hot spring: 180L of water per second which is nearly boiling at 97° Celsius. In the





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valley you will also visit Hraunfossar, a series of waterfalls pouring from beneath a wide lava field, and Barnafoss, the children's falls, with its own tragic tale.

The afternoon includes a lecture about the Northern Lights - this is the beginning of the six-night Northern Lights Academy (see Important Information below for additional details).

After dinner (not included) step into the hotel garden in search of the Northern Lights while sipping a hot cup of hot chocolate or tea.

Overnight: Hotel Hamar or similar, Borganes
Meals included: Breakfast

Day 7 Snæfellsnes Peninsula and Lava Cave

Today head to the Snæfellsnes Peninsula, 'the peninsula of the snowy mountain', located on Iceland's west coast, and, in many ways, a microcosm of the whole island. The region is characterised by a rugged mountain chain that runs its length. Travel to the charming fishing village of Grundarfjörður, a place with an impressive coastline and mountains, lakes and waterfalls behind the village. One of the most photographed and famous mountains in Iceland, Kirkjufell, can be seen jutting out into the bay.

Visit Arnarstapi and Hellnar before experiencing the area from below, inside Vatnshellir cave - you'll travel 35 meters underground and about 200 meters into the lava tube under the glacier Snæfellsjökull!

On the way back to Borgarnes, after an approximately 250km travel day, the guide will provide some practical tips on how to photograph the Auroras as part of the Northern Lights Academy

program. Naturally. Once darkness falls, venture out into the hotel garden to chase the Northern Lights and soak in the hotel's outdoor hot tubs.

Overnight: Hotel Hamar or similar, Borganes
Meals included: Breakfast; Lunch

Day 8 Golden Circle, Geothermal Taste & Icelandic Horse

Today, travel along the Hvalfjörður Fjord. Continue inland to Þingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Travel the Golden Circle route and see steam rising from the Geysir geothermal fields as you arrive. There are a variety of hot springs and bubbling pools to explore. The original geyser is now dormant but has been replaced by Strokkur, 'the Churn', which erupts at 5-10 minute intervals.

Treat yourself to hot springs freshly baked bread served with Icelandic butter, geothermal boiled eggs and herring. The chef at Geysir Restaurant recommends enjoying the dish with a small glass of Geysir Schnapps, very cold - nearly freezing. Next head to Gullfoss, a double waterfall that tumbles 34m into the Hvítá River and attracts tourists and travellers all year round. In the afternoon, you will learn about Icelandic horses, their special qualities and history before visiting a geothermal greenhouse.

Afterwards, continue towards the accommodation in south Iceland after an approximately 220-km travel day. Tonight, step into the darkness and search for the elusive northern lights from a comfortable hot tub in the hotel's garden, amidst the peace and stillness of rural Iceland.

Overnight: Landhotel or similar, Hella
Meals included: Breakfast

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Day 9 Natural Wonders of South Iceland and Volcano Centre

Today, travel along the south coast of Iceland to the Lava and Volcano Exhibition Centre, where you will learn about the geology of active volcanoes. Further east, visit one of Iceland's finest folk museums. This museum contains an outstanding collection of farm and domestic artifacts from Iceland's past and several turf built houses. Nearby is Skógafoss Waterfall, which is 60m high and one of the most impressive waterfalls in the country.

In the afternoon take a stroll on the black lava beach and along bird cliffs at Reynisfjara in south Iceland after an approximately 220km travel day. Spend the next two nights near Kirkjubæjarklaustur in the Vatnajökull National Park region, located in darkness and ideal for Northern Lights searching.

Overnight: Fosshotel Núpar or similar, Kirkjubæjarklaustur

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 10 Vatnajökull National Park & Glacier - Glacial Lagoon and Diamond Beach

Today is all about glaciers, ice and icebergs on an approximately 200km travel day. Travel to Jökulsárlón, a glacial lagoon filled with floating icebergs, and explore this extraordinary site. If you are lucky, you might spot seals swimming in the arctic waters. You can also walk along the black sandy beach where large icebergs get stranded.

In the afternoon visit the tiny turf church at Hof and spend time at Europe's largest national park, which has Iceland's highest mountains, an alpine environment, and Europe's largest glacier. In the evening enjoy a film presentation about the Northern Lights.

Be careful not to go to bed too soon in this remote and quiet location or you may just miss out on one more chance of seeing the Northern Lights shimmering and dancing across the night sky.

Optional Activity: Ice Cave Tour (bookable on tour, weather permitting)

The tour takes about 2.5 hours in total – a 30-minute drive by 4x4 vehicle from the Jökulsárlón glacier lagoon, and a 5-15 minutes hike (one-way). You'll spend about an hour inside the ice cave. Please note you'll need good hiking boots and warm clothing that keeps you dry from the dripping water in the ice cave. Minimum age is 10 years old. The ice cave tour can be booked on day 2 of Northern Lights Exploration tour.

The ice cave explorers meet their local guide at the glacier lagoon and will be brought back to the hotel after the ice cave tour, while the rest of the group continues the official tour program. The ice cave explorers will miss out on some of the official tour programs, but the stop and visit at the Jökulsárlón glacier lagoon are included for all group members.

Price per person is ISK 23,000 (approx. \$250 AUD)

Day 11 South Shore, Reykjavik and The Blue Lagoon

From Kirkjubæjarklaustur head across the Eldhraun Lava Field to the village of Vík, where you will make a photo stop. The black lava beach with high bird cliffs and pounding waves is an impressive sight. Further west, reach the high but narrow Seljalandsfoss Waterfall which plunges from the mountain.

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In the afternoon enjoy a soak in the famous Blue Lagoon (entrance and towel included). An otherworldly wonder in the heart of a volcanic landscape, experience the radiant powers of geothermal seawater.

Arrive back in Reykjavík around dinner time for one night after an approximately 250km travel day.

Overnight: Hotel Klettur or similar, Reykjavík

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 12 Reykjavik, Iceland - Australia

Today you will be transferred to the airport by the hotel shuttle for the return flight back to Australia.

Other Important Information

Northern Lights

This program includes a special six-night Northern Lights Academy – which means that during six evenings there is a combination of presentations, lectures, a film and guided searches for the Aurora Borealis – the Northern Lights. All countryside hotels in this program offer a Northern Lights wake-up call for guests that register for that special service at the hotel reception. The Northern Lights Exploration series are designed to spend 6 evenings in the countryside to maximise the chances of seeing the elusive Northern Lights, still the tour is dependent on weather and therefore sightings are not guaranteed. The Northern Lights are in the northern hemisphere from September through April but are only visible when the sky is clear and free of clouds. Like many natural wonders, the Northern Lights are ephemeral – they may be visible, they may appear for a bit and then be gone (it is not a TV show that you can just turn on and off). But it is worth the patience which is much required. Because they are a winter event, you need to be prepared to wait outside while looking for them. It is best to dress very warmly, in layers, with good footwear, gloves, hats and whatever else makes you comfortable while you wait patiently for this truly outstanding event. For the best photos, a tripod is recommended.

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the

tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however, they are not required to have specific knowledge of art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Thanks to the Gulf Stream, Iceland enjoys a moderate maritime climate: cool in summer and fairly mild in winter. It is an island in the North Atlantic, nestled against the Arctic Circle, so the weather is very changeable and visitors should be prepared for the unexpected. Normal winter temperatures, like October and November range between 0-5 °C. When it comes to Iceland's weather – the one thing you can count on is unpredictability. You never know what is going to happen next! A beautiful sunny day can suddenly turn windy and rainy – then it can all change again in a moment. You may experience every weather imaginable over the course of a few days, especially in late autumn and early spring. Important to

remember when packing: Iceland is a very windy place! The best plan is to be prepared for anything and everything AND always dress in layers. The Icelanders have a saying: "there's no such thing as bad weather, just bad clothing."

FLIGHTS

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points

At TripADeal we do not arrange seat selection. It is essential to highlight that some airlines do not allow pre-selected seats. We strongly suggest you contact the airline directly with seating allocation requirements and or arrive at the airport earlier to arrange your seating. While we do not add frequent flyer member details to bookings, you can do this directly with the airline once you have your flight information.

Passport Validity

COACH TOUR

Meals

8 meals in total are included in the package. For all other meals, the tour leader (when available) will offer assistance with reservations, suggestions and directions to local restaurants. It is your responsibility to notify TripADeal of any dietary requests/requirements.

Luggage

You will be responsible for all your personal belongings whilst on the tour. With regards to luggage, you must carry your own luggage from the coach to the hotel room and back to the coach. The driver will assist with the uploading and offloading of the luggage from the coach.

OTHER

Mobility

Our vehicles are not equipped with wheelchair access, so, unfortunately, our tours are currently not suitable for wheelchair users and those less mobile.

Please note: A general level of fitness will be required. If you have any concerns please consult your healthcare provider prior to purchase/travel.

Fitness Level Required

Adventure (and spontaneity) create some of the best travel memories. Bear in mind, your home schedules and timings might not be adhered to on tour - it's all part of the fun!

A moderate level of fitness will be required. Expect a moderate pace of touring with a focus on guided tours that may include full days with extended activity, guided city tours or nature walks. You will require a general level of fitness for unassisted navigation of stairs and inclines, longer distances with possible periods of standing when visiting sites, walking on sloping, uneven ground or elevations. You will be responsible for your own luggage and have the ability to board all modes of transport without assistance.

- *Many areas may be inaccessible to wheelchairs or mobility scooters, where the unassisted use of personal walking sticks and other aids may be required. Although some assistance may be available, every traveller should be self-reliant during all aspects of their travel.*

Gratuities/Tipping

Land

Visas

Europe

A tourist visa is not required if travelling for less than 90 days on an Australian passport.

UK

The UK government announced the next phase of the rollout of electronic travel authorizations (ETAs). As of 8th January 2025, all Australia and New Zealand passport holders will require an ETA to enter the UK. An ETA gives visitors permission to travel to the UK. Visitors who do not currently need a visa may need

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to apply an electronic travel authorisation (ETA) to travel to [the UK](#), please refer to [the UK Government website](#) for further information.

Important: Visa rules may have changed since COVID-19. Check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination you're entering.

Please note: Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required. It is also important to note, that some areas of employment such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may in turn affect the type of application required.

Travel Insurance
