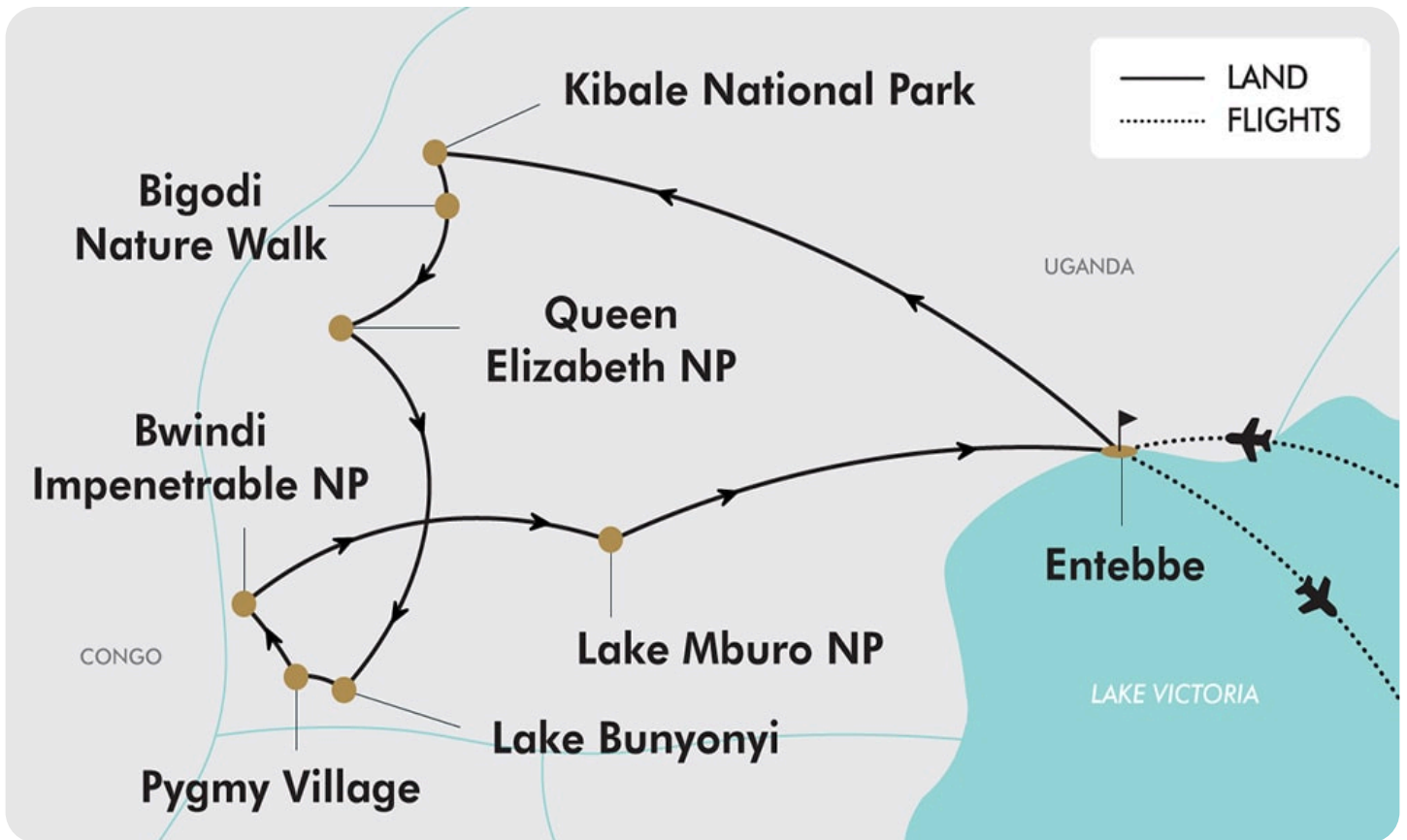

Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Entebbe, Uganda

Today depart for Entebbe, Uganda!

Please note: Some customers may depart on Day 0.

Meals included: In-Flight

Day 2 Welcome to Entebbe, Uganda!

Upon arrival at Entebbe International Airport, a representative will meet, greet and transfer you to the hotel.

Overnight: Admas Grand Hotel, Entebbe or similar

Meals included: None

Day 3 Entebbe - Fort Portal - Kibale National Park

This morning, drive south past big tea plantations and arrive in Fort Portal in time for lunch (not included).

The fort may be gone, but the town offers sublime scenery, abundant nature and genuine adventure. Fort Portal is the heartland of a verdant tea-growing area and an important commercial centre. After lunch, visit the Toro King's palace to learn about the Batooro culture and also explore the burial grounds of their kings to gain a deeper understanding of traditional leadership in Uganda. This afternoon, drive onwards to Kibale National Park and check into the lodge accommodation. Today's travel time is approximately 6 hours.

Overnight: Chimpanzee Forest Guest House or Nyaika Hotel, Kibale National Park or similar

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

Day 4 Chimpanzee Tracking in Kibale National Park

After breakfast, transfer to the park headquarters for a briefing and then begin your amazing chimpanzee trekking.

Chimpanzee tracking is generally not too demanding, but it does involve 3-4 hours of trekking. Chimps stay in groups of 10 – 100 members and can babysit each other's young, kiss, groom one another and even hold hands. After the morning searching for these beautiful primates, head back to the lodge for lunch and some time at leisure.

This evening, you'll visit Amabere Ga Nyina Mwiru Cave, an amazing result of the formation of stalagmites and stalactites. There is also a beautiful waterfall that forms below the scenic caves. Afterwards, transfer back to the hotel for dinner.

Day 5 Kibale National Park - Queen Elizabeth National Park

This morning, after breakfast, head to the Bigodi Wetland Sanctuary where you will enjoy a nature walk. The walk is about 3-4 hours guided through 4-5 km of trail; however, customers can always choose a shorter trail if preferred. The Bigodi Wetland Sanctuary is located in Magombe Swamp. This area is recognised for its extensive array of biodiversity, among which are several primate species, including the Red Colobus Monkey, Baboon, Black-and-White Colobus Monkey, Blue Monkey, Grey-cheeked Monkey, Mangabey Monkey, Vervet Monkey, Red-tailed Monkey, and the L'Hoest Monkey. The swamp supports about 200 bird species, and among the major bird species, one can spot the grand Blue Turaco.

Afterwards, travel to the nearby crater lakes. There are over 30 lakes, believed to be the densest concentration of crater lakes in the world, over a short 10 km stretch. Walk along the "Top of the World" trail, where you can view most of the lakes whilst passing through local villages and tea plantations. On a clear day, you can also view the Rwenzori Mountain Ranges, Africa's tallest mountain range, in the distance.

In the afternoon, drive onwards to Queen Elizabeth National Park and check into the lodge for the night. Today's travel time is approximately 3 hours.

Overnight: Buffalo Safari Lodge, Queen Elizabeth National Park or similar

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

Day 6 Katwe Salt Lake - Kasoga Community

Today, enjoy a relaxed morning at the lodge before travelling to Katwe Salt Lake. The lake is salty due to the many inlets from streams that bring in the water. Salt mining is a major activity here in the dry months. At the lake enjoy the beautiful scenery and learn about the salt mining process.

This afternoon, travel to the Kasoga community. The Kasoga community experience offers first hand encounters about the life and culture of native communities on this landing site. Here you will enjoy a walk through the community and learn about the fishing practices of the local community, see the fish preservation stoves, witness traditional canoe making demonstrations and see the crafts being made. Walk through the historical swamps in the community and the vacation palace of the former king of Tooro. Along the way, keep your eyes peeled for the abundant birdlife, up to 26 different species, and a magnificent opportunity to spot hippos.

Return to the lodge and enjoy an evening at leisure.

This afternoon, you will be rewarded with a river cruise on the Kazinga Channel, a 32 km-long natural channel connecting Lakes George and Edward. The shores of this channel attract a large number of wild animals, birds, and reptiles throughout the year, with one of the largest populations of hippos in the world, as well as plentiful Nile crocodiles. While returning to the lodge, enjoy a short game drive.

Overnight: Buffalo Safari Lodge, Queen Elizabeth National Park or similar

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

Day 8 Queen Elizabeth National Park - Lake Bunyonyi

Today, after breakfast, transfer to the Ishasha sector of Queen Elizabeth National Park and enjoy a game drive, where you can seek the famous tree-climbing lions, which this area is known for. While driving through the savannah plains, you will seek other wildlife, such as elephants and a diverse range of bird species. Afterwards, travel onwards to Lake Bunyonyi.

Lake Bunyonyi is located in southwestern Uganda, between Kisoro and Kabale, and is close to the border with Rwanda. It's known as the second-deepest lake in Africa, after Lake Tanganyika.

Overnight: Birdnest Resort, Lake Bunyonyi or similar

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

Day 9 Lake Bunyonyi - Pygmy Village - Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

This morning, after breakfast, enjoy a boat cruise to the Pygmy Village on the other side of the lake. The Batwa, also known as the Pygmy, are an indigenous tribe in Uganda, characterised by their unusually short stature. Their forest culture is worth exploring to learn about their lifestyle and how they are used to surviving without modern-day amenities. Here you will enjoy traditional music and dance. Continue on the boat cruise, enjoying the scenic views of the Kigezi terraces (2,200m - 2,400m), which are tilled by the Bakiga tribe, the second tribe that lives by the lake. You will also enjoy beautiful views of birds, with over 200 species at Lake Bunyonyi, including weaver birds and herons.

This afternoon, return to shore and transfer to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park. "Bwindi" is derived from the Runyakitara language and means "impenetrable". This name comes from the extensive stands of bamboo interspersed amongst the larger forest hardwoods. The bamboo and thick ground cover of ferns, vines, and other plant growth severely hinder direct access on foot. Relax and enjoy the evening at leisure after a travel day of approximately 250 km.

With gorilla permits included in your package, set off to the thick forest in search of gorillas. The terrain can be difficult, with steep slopes covered in dense vegetation that gives the park its name. Additionally, the altitude of up to 1600m requires participants to be reasonably fit. The time taken to track the gorillas will vary enormously, from as little as half an hour to as much as 8-9 hours before one returns to camp, but coming face to face with these amazing primates is extremely rewarding! For those who do not wish to participate, you are welcome to relax at the lodge and enjoy the day at your leisure.

The network of game tracks in the east of the park passes a variety of landscape features: acacia woodland, wetlands, grassy hillsides, rock outcrops and seasonally flooded valley floors. The park is home to a diverse array of animals, including zebras, hippos, impalas, warthogs, common elands, African buffalos, jackals, African leopards, and over 300 bird species. You won't want to forget your camera! Enjoy an evening of rest after a day of approximately 270 km.

Overnight: Rwakobo Rock Lodge or Igongo Cultural Hotel, Lake Mburo National Park or similar

Chimpanzee tracking involves 3-4 hours of trekking, although generally not too demanding. Chimps stay in groups of 10 - 100 members and can babysit each other's young, kiss, groom one another and even hold hands. After the morning searching for these beautiful primates, head back to the lodge for lunch and some time at leisure.

In the evening, head to the Bigodi Wetland Sanctuary where you can enjoy a nature walk through this sanctuary. The walk is about 3-4 hours, guided through 4-5 kms of trail, with a shorter trail available, if preferred.

Bigodi Wetland Sanctuary lies within the Magombe Swamp, an area celebrated for its rich biodiversity. It is home to a variety of primate species, including colobus monkeys, baboons, mangabeys, vervet monkeys, red-tailed monkeys and L'Hoest's monkeys, among others. The swamp also provides habitat for around 200 bird species, featuring several notable varieties.

Day 5 Kibale National Park - Queen Elizabeth National Park

After breakfast, set out on a scenic trek to nearby crater lakes. This region is home to more than 30 crater lakes and is believed to have the highest concentration within a short 10 km stretch.

Follow the "Top of the World" trail to enjoy sweeping views of many of these lakes while passing through local villages and tea plantations. On a clear day, it's possible to catch a glimpse of the distant Rwenzori Mountain Range, Africa's highest mountain range.

In the afternoon, drive to Queen Elizabeth Park for an overnight stay (approximately a 3-hour journey).

Day 6 Katwe Salt Lake - Kasoga Community

Standard

Tour Guide

They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Uganda

Uganda is near the Equator. As a result, the climate does not change much and the country can be visited throughout the year. The rainy seasons tend to be from February to April and October to December, but this varies in different areas and it can rain any time of the year, especially in the forest and mountainous areas. Travel can be slower in the rainy season but the views are often better. Gorilla tracking can be muddier but it can certainly be done. In the mountainous areas it is much colder than on the plains and the rainfall is greater. The temperatures on the plains tend to be

between 21°C and 30°C and in the mountainous areas they can go down to 10°C in certain months, especially November.

FLIGHTS

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points

At TripADeal, we do not arrange seat selection. It is essential to highlight that some airlines do not allow pre-selected seats. We strongly suggest you contact the airline directly with seating allocation requirements and/or arrive at the airport earlier to arrange your seating.
