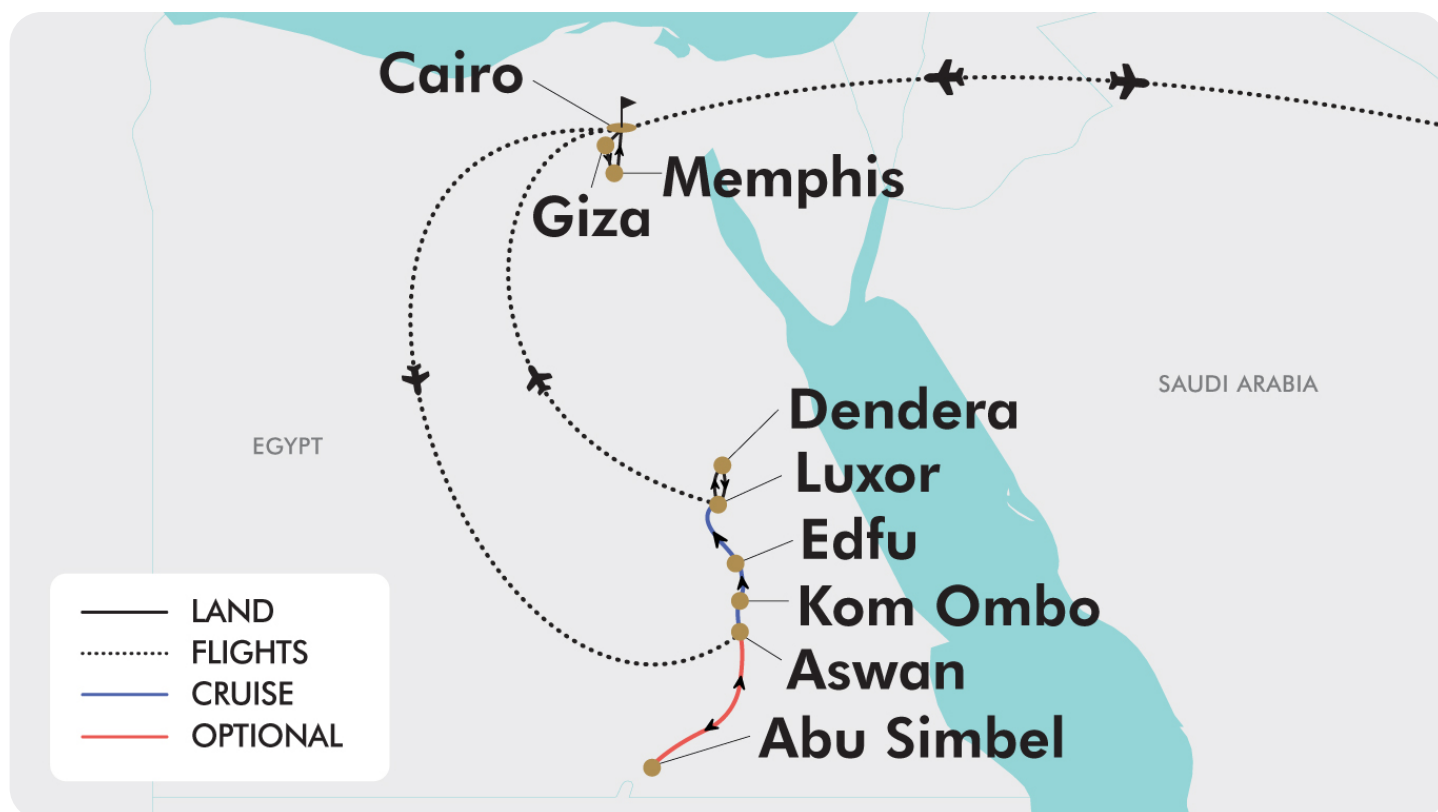

The Itinerary

Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Cairo, Egypt

Today, you will begin your journey to Cairo, Egypt.

Please note: Some departures may occur on Day 0 due to flight scheduling and availability. Affected customers must be available to depart the day before. Flight times will be indicated on your final documents, issued 4-6 weeks before departure.

Day 2 Welcome to Cairo

Salām 'alaykum! Your tour awaits! Once you've arrived in Cairo, you will meet a representative at the airport and be transferred to your hotel.

Overnight: Concorde El Salam or similar, Cairo

Meals included: None

Day 3 Pyramids of Giza - Sphinx - Sakkara & Memphis Tour

After breakfast, get ready to meet your Egyptologist guide for a visit to the enigmatic Sphinx and Pyramids of Giza. At 500 feet high and 750 feet wide at its base, the Great Pyramid of Khufu (Cheops), the only survivor of the Seven Great Wonders of the ancient world, is a breathtaking structure built from enormous stone blocks with a white limestone covering.

After taking some token pictures, it's time to visit the Pyramid of Chephren. The top part retains the original facing of smoothly finished stone, showing how the pyramids would have appeared back in ancient Egyptian times. Besides the pyramid, you will see the Great Sphinx stretching out over 45 metres, carved out of a

natural rocky outcrop. Afterwards, marvel at the pink granite slabs on the pyramid of Mycerinus, the smallest of the three pyramids.

Your tour continues with a visit to Memphis, one of the most important cities in Egypt. From the 3rd millennium BC, this 'City of the Dead' was the capital of ancient Egypt when King Menes unified upper and lower Egypt. At the end of today's tour, you will see the first real pyramid in ancient Egypt, the Pyramids of King Zoser in Saqqara. Look back on all the fantastic snaps from the day while you are transferred to your hotel.

Optional Upgrade: 5-Star Dahabiya Sailboat Upgrade

Upgrade to a 5-star Dahabiya Sailboat with only 17 cabins for a classic and traditional cruising experience on the Nile River. Enjoy the chance to walk around riverside villages, visit local markets and explore ancient monuments along the Nile. Day 4 Cairo - Aswan - Temple of Philae - Begin 3-Night 5-Star Nile Cruise

This morning, it's time to check out and be transferred to Cairo Airport for your domestic flight to Aswan. Upon your arrival, enjoy a guided tour of the "Aswan High Dam", an embankment dam built across the Nile in Aswan between 1960 and 1970.

Afterwards, you will visit the beautiful Temple of Philae, dedicated to worshipping the Goddess of Love, Isis. Take a short motorboat ride to the majestic Philae Temple on Philae Island. Philae Island is a rocky island in the middle of the River Nile, and the Temple was an ancient pilgrimage centre for the cult of Isis. This sacred site was revered from the Pharaonic era to the Greek, Roman, and Byzantine periods.

Later in the day, you will board the 'MS Royal Esadora' ship to begin your three-night 5-star cruise along the beautiful Nile River. Settle in and enjoy lunch as you watch the day go by. In the afternoon (if weather permits), enjoy a sailing cruise around Elephantine Island aboard a traditional wooden Felucca sailing boat. Once back on board, enjoy a traditional dinner.

Please note:

- Due to flight scheduling and availability, customers may be required to depart to Aswan on the evening of Day 3. Flight times will be indicated on your arrival in Egypt.
- If you have chosen to upgrade your cruising experience, you'll board the Iris Dahabiya Sailboat for your 5-star experience along the Nile.

Day 5 Aswan - Kom Ombo - Edfu

Relax on board or join an optional tour to Abu Simbel, the two famous massive rock temples on the western bank of Lake Nasser.

Optional Tour: Abu Simbel Tour

Early this morning, travel by coach from Aswan to the impressive Abu Simbel temples. Here, travellers may recognise the four colossus statues of Ramses guarding the Great Temple. This outstanding archaeological area contains monuments such as the Temples of Ramses II at Abu Simbel and the Sanctuary of Isis at Philae, which were saved from the rising waters of the Nile thanks to an international campaign launched by UNESCO. Once back onboard enjoy lunch while your ship sails to Kom Ombo. Visit the Temples of the Gods Sobek and Haroeris dedicated to both the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon-headed god Horus. Back to the cruise, and sail to Edfu. Please see current pricing in Important Information.

Overnight: MS Royal Esadora ship or similar

Meals included: Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner

Day 6 Edfu - Temple of Horus - Luxor - Karnak Temple

This morning join your tour guide and travel by horse carriage to visit the extraordinary Temple of Horus at Edfu. The Temple of Horus was the 'home' and cultural centre of the falcon god Horus of Behdet (the ancient name for Edfu).

Return onboard sail pass by Esna city and sail to Luxor. Lunch on board. Transfer to East bank of Luxor to visit the amazing Abu Hagag Mosque, Luxor Temple, and the biggest temple in the world Karnak Temple, dedicated to the worship of Almighty God of the New Empire "god Amun."

Day 7 Luxor - Valley of The Kings Tour

After breakfast, it's time to disembark your cruise and transfer to the West Bank of Luxor, where you will then enjoy a tour of the Valley of the Kings, known as the 'Gateway to the Afterlife'. The ancient Egyptians built impressive tombs for their pharaohs, the most famous of which can be found in the Valley of the Kings. Rising out of the desert plain in a series of terraces, you will also see the Temple of Hatshepsut - often referred to as the Pharaoh Queen. On the way back to the river Nile, the road passes by the famed Colossi of Memnon, two massive stone statues of the Pharaoh Amenhotep III.

Day 8 Luxor - Dendera - Temple of Hathor & Abydos

Today discover the ancient sites of the Dendera complex and visit the Temple of Hathor, goddess of love and joy. The temple is located in Dendera, north of Luxor. Afterwards, visit the Great Temple of Abydos, one of the main historical sites in Abydos. It was a cemetery for Egypt's earliest kings and later became a pilgrimage centre for worshipping the god Osiris. In the afternoon, transfer back to Luxor for your overnight stay.

Today is approximately a 200 kilometre travel day.

Day 9 Luxor - Cairo Free Day

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Luxor Airport for your flight back to Cairo. Upon arrival, be transferred to your hotel. Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure in the Egyptian capital on the Nile River, or choose the optional activity to visit the brand-new Grand Egyptian Museum.

Optional Activity: Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM)

Visit the new Grand Egyptian Museum, the largest archaeological museum complex in the world that hosts more than 100,000 artefacts. For the first time ever, King Tutankhamun's entire treasure collection is on display alongside artefacts from pre-historic times through Egypt's many thousands of years. Day 10 Egyptian Museum - Salah El Deen Citadel - Muhammad Ali Mosque & Old Cairo

Today is a big day filled with culture! In the morning, enjoy a guided tour of the famous Egyptian Museum in Cairo. It's the richest museum of Egyptian antiquities worldwide and contains pharaonic treasures from over 5,000 years ago. The rectangular building has a large dome on the ground floor containing massive exhibitions.

Afterwards, you will visit the medieval Salah El-din citadel, an Islamic-era fortification in Cairo against the Crusaders. Explore this ancient fortress and marvel at its brilliant domed ceilings, suspended lights, and commanding views of Cairo. The citadel houses the Alabaster mosque of Muhammad Ali.

You will then drive to Old Cairo and visit the Coptic Cairo, a part of Old Cairo that encompasses the Babylon Fortress, the Hanging Church, The Greek Church of St. George and many other Coptic churches and historical sites. It is believed in the Christian tradition that the Holy Family visited this area and stayed at the site of Saints Sergius Church (Abu Serga). In the evening, feel free to explore Cairo at your leisure.

Day 11 Cairo, Egypt - Australia (or New Zealand)

Today at the appropriate time, be transferred to the airport for the return flight back home.

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip.

Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

February

Is usually the second-coldest month of the year with only slightly higher temperatures than January, but it is generally warm by day, with an average daytime maximum temperature of 22°C, while on average the temperature falls to 14°C at night.

March

As spring gets underway the temperatures rise, but the day-to-day weather is rarely excessively hot. The daytime temperature typically reaches a high of 25°C around mid-March, though the average is a degree or two higher than that towards the end of the month.

May

The tourist season is in full swing in Cairo and the weather is already very warm. The average temperature reaches a high of 32°C during the day and at night only dips to a low of around 18°C.

June/July/August:

The hot summer weather intensifies further in June and July, with an average daytime maximum temperature of 37°C, and an average minimum temperature of 22°C. Temperatures rarely fluctuate by more than a few degrees either side of the long-term average. You can expect no rain

during this month and there are 13 hours of sunlight each day on average.

September/October

Temperatures begin to cool off a little during September though the daily weather is still hot. The daytime temperature reaches an average maximum of 35°C, and the temperature falls to an average minimum between 26 and 27°C overnight. October is slightly cooler than preceding months but remains hot. The average temperature still reaches a high of 30°C during the day and dips no lower than 18°C at night.

November/December

From November onwards, Egypt offers hot and sunny days which stay very dry. The average daily temperature during this month in Cairo is 20°C. This can reach highs of 25°C or drop to lows of 14°C. The average daily temperature during December in Cairo is 15°C. This can reach highs of 20°C or drop to lows of 10°C.

FLIGHTS

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points

At TripADeal we do not arrange seat selection. It is essential to highlight that some airlines do not allow pre-selected seats. We strongly suggest you contact the airline directly with seating allocation requirements and/or arrive at the airport earlier to arrange your seating.
