The Itinerary

Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) – Istanbul, Türkiye

Today, depart for Istanbul, Türkiye!

Please note: Some customers may depart on Day 2 and arrive on Day 2.

Meals included: In-Flight

Day 2 Istanbul, Türkiye!

Upon arrival into Istanbul, make your way to Exit 14 (IST Airport) and be met by the tour leader and transferred to the hotel. If you are too early for check-in, your luggage can be stored at the hotel until the room is ready. The rest of the day is yours to explore this vibrant city at leisure.

Istanbul was the capital city of Byzantium, Roman Empires and Ottoman State. It is a fascinating city, which crosses two continents: Europe and Asia. Istanbul is full of museums, bazaars, minarets, mosques, churches, palaces, and restaurants catering to everyone's taste.

Overnight: La Quinta Hotel or similar, Istanbul

Meals included: None

Day 3 Istanbul City Tour

After breakfast, enjoy a tour of Istanbul City. Visit the Hippodrome, the ancient structure was the scene of chariot races, featuring the three monuments: the Obelisk of Theodosius, the bronze Serpentine Column, and the Column of Constantine. Continue to the Sultan Ahmet Imperial Mosque, near the Hagia Sophia Grand Mosque, built in the 16th Century by the architect Mehmet, and known as the Blue Mosque because of its magnificent interior decoration of blue Iznik Tiles. The next stop is Topkapi Palace, the great palace of the Ottoman sultans from the 15th to the 19th centuries, housing an exquisite collection of crystal, silver, and Chinese porcelain robes worn by the sultans and their families. Later in the afternoon, after lunch at leisure (not included), head to the famous Spice Bazaar, where the air is filled with the enticing aromas of cinnamon, caraway, saffron, mint, thyme and every other conceivable herb and spice. Browse the authentic gifts, Turkish coffee, herbs, spices and handicrafts. Please note that Topkapi Palace is closed on Tuesdays and will be replaced with the Turkish Islamic Art Museum.

Overnight: La Quinta Hotel or similar, Istanbul

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 4 Istanbul - Bursa

After breakfast today you will travel to Bursa, Türkiye's fourth largest city, located in Anatolia at the foot of Mount Uludag, which is shrouded by mystery and legends. Bursa was the first capital of the Ottoman Empire. Here, visit the Green Mosque, the Grand Mosque and the Mausoleum complex. There will be time in the afternoon to explore the city's bazaars, silk markets and historic monuments.

Thereafter, you will be transferred to visit the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Cumalikizik, an important village settlement showcasing Ottoman architecture, 12 kilometres east of Bursa, one of Türkiye's main cities. Traditional lifestyles are still maintained in Cumalikizik, and most of the houses continue to be used as residences. In this manner, the village offers visitors an atmosphere that bears traces of ancient times.

After the tour, you'll be transferred to the hotel after an approximately 152-kilometre day.

Overnight: Hilton Hotel or similar, Bursa

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 5 Bursa - Sirince Village Tour - Kusadasi

Today, travel to Ephesus and enjoy a lunch break, before embarking on a tour to the Turkish village of Sirince, known for its pretty white-painted houses. Sirince also has a fantastic reputation for making some of the best wines in Türkiye, especially fruit wines. On the way back to the hotel, visit one of the famous leather production centres of the region. On completion of the tour, continue to travel to Kusadasi after an approximately 440-kilometre day.

Overnight: Ramada Kusadasi Hotel, Kusadasi

Day 6 Kusadasi Free Day

Today, enjoy a free day at leisure to explore this magnificent beachside city.

Day 7 Kusadasi - Pergamon Tour- Troy Tour- Canakkale

Today, depart Kusadasi for your next adventure. En-route to Canakkale, commence a tour of Pergamon, where you will enjoy some free time before departing for a tour of its magnificent Acropolis. Pergamon's impressive temples and library once made it a renowned cultural and political centre. Today, the town is famous for its jewellery, stones and silver, so a stop at a jewellery centre is a must. Then, continue to the ancient site of Troy, see the remnants of the ancient city walls and the famed wooden horse as you learn about the groundbreaking archaeological digs and how the site has baffled historians, approximately 444 km/day.

Overnight: Troia Tusan Hotel or similar, Canakkale

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 8 Canakkale - Gallipoli Tour

This morning, depart for Gallipoli to visit the battlefields, upon arrival in Gallipoli around midday, enjoy some free time for lunch before departing for the battlefields. Visit Kabatepe Museum, Ari Burnu Cemetery, Anzac Cove, Beach Cemetery, Shrapnel Valley and Plugge's Plateau. After the tour, head back to Canakkale and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Troia Tusan Hotel or similar, Canakkale

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 9 Canakkale - Edirne

After breakfast around midday, depart for Edirne, a 231 km/day. Upon arrival to Edirne check in to your hotel and the rest of the day is at your leisure.

Overnight: Hilly Hotel or similar, Edirne

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 10 Edirne – Sofia, Bulgaria

After breakfast, depart for Sofia in Bulgaria. Arrive in Sofia around noon. Sofia is surrounded by soul-stirring mountains, golden beaches and sprawling parkland. Sofia is the capital and largest city of the Republic of Bulgaria. With a history that stretches over seven millennia, ruin-rich Sofia is one of Europe's oldest cities.

In the afternoon, commence a city tour of Sofia, visit the Alexander Nevsky Cathedral - one of the largest Eastern Orthodox cathedrals in Europe, as well as one of Sofia's symbols and a primary tourist attraction. Continue to St George Rotunda, St Sophia Church, National Theatre, and the former Royal Palace, which now houses the National Revival Art Gallery and the Ethnographic Museum, in an approximately 311-kilometre day. After the tour, enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to explore this magnificent city.

Overnight: Hotel Ramada Princess or similar, Sofia

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 11 Sofia Free Day

Enjoy a free day to explore this magical destination. Sofia is the capital and largest city of Bulgaria, located in the western part of the country. The city of Sofia has a long and diverse history, with traces of settlements dating back to at least 7000 BC.

Throughout its history, Sofia has been influenced by various civilizations, including Thracians, Romans, Byzantines, Ottomans and Soviets. Sofia is known for its cultural scene, with numerous theaters, art galleries, museums, and music venues. The city has a bustling nightlife and a wide range of dining options, offering both traditional Bulgarian cuisine and international flavours.

Overnight: Hotel Ramada Princess or similar, Sofia

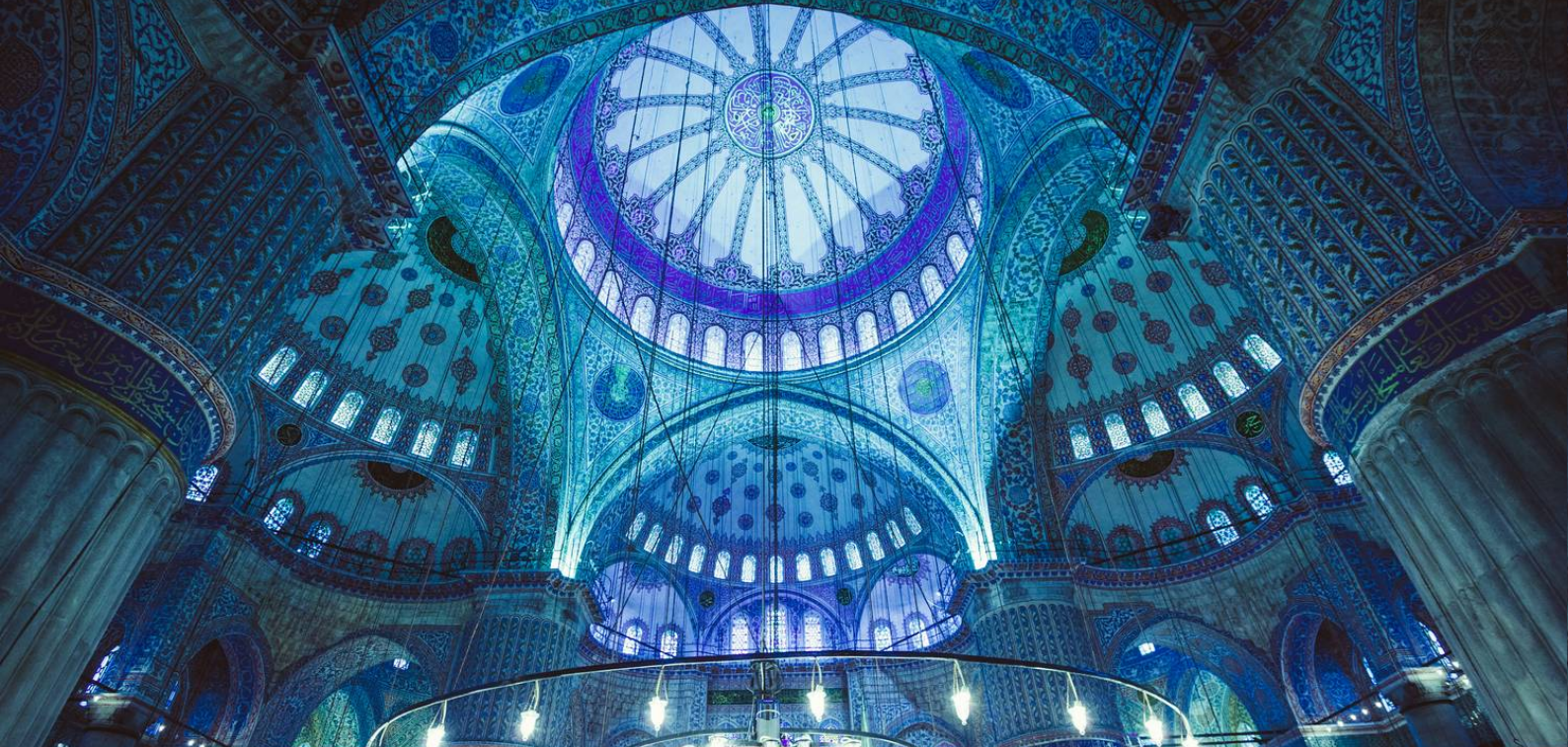

Day 12 Sofia - Skopje - Ohrid, North Macedonia

After breakfast, depart to Ohrid. On route, stop in Skopje, Macedonia, where you will arrive in the mid afternoon. The city is famous for being the birthplace of Mother Teresa. Here, enjoy a panoramic city tour with free time for a late lunch (not included). Afterwards depart for Ohrid, upon arrival check into the hotel, in an approximately 443-Km day.

Day 13 Ohrid City Tour

Following breakfast, visit a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where you will enjoy a walking tour of the old city situated along a hill at the edge of Lake Ohrid. Lake Ohrid is famous as it's Europe's oldest lake, having formed over three million years ago. The tour will include Hadzi Turgut Mosque/ Krst Dazmija. The mosque was built in 1466 by the Turkish Empire and is believed to be the oldest mosque in town. It was built on the former site of the St Kyriaki church. The legend says that the minaret of the mosque had collapsed several times until the Turks left the original Tekke.

Overnight: Hotel Su or similar, Ohrid

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 14 Ohrid, North Macedonia – Durres - Tirana, Albania

After breakfast, depart on a half-day city tour in Durres, visit the newly rebuilt National Archaeological Museum, the Roman Amphitheatre, Venetian Tower and walls, Town Hall Square and the Promenade. Then, continue to Tirana. The remainder of the day will be at leisure for you to explore one of the most fascinating capitals in Eastern Europe, in an approximately 134-Km day.

Overnight: Hotel Tirana International or similar, Tirana

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 15 Tirana – Kruje, Albania – Budva, Montenegro

After breakfast, travel to Budva, the metropolis of Montenegrin tourism due to its sandy beaches, stunning landscapes, nightlife and its historical monuments are just as exciting! Here, enjoy a walk in the city centre and see the most famous tourist attractions: Ballerina and Mogren Beach, Old Town, Ancient Necropolis, Slovenska Plaza, in an approximately 181-Km day.

Overnight: Hotel Bracera or similar, Budva

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 16 Budva, Montenegro – Dubrovnik, Croatia

After breakfast, you'll head to Dubrovnik, Croatia, known as 'The Pearl of the Adriatic'. The mediaeval Old Town is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Enjoy a city tour to discover Rector's Palace, Franciscan Monastery, Clock Tower and Orlando's Columns. Afterwards, check into the hotel and enjoy an evening at leisure in this magical destination.

Overnight: Hotel Adria or similar, Dubrovnik

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 17 Dubrovnik Free Day

Today, enjoy a free day to explore this magical city. Dubrovnik is a captivating city that seamlessly combines history, culture, and natural beauty. Its stunning architecture, picturesque setting and warm Mediterranean climate makes it a must-visit destination for travellers.

Overnight: Hotel Adria or similar, Dubrovnik

Meals included: Breakfast





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Day 18 Dubrovnik, Croatia – Split, Croatia

Today, travel to Split, one of the most important cities along the Adriatic Sea. Here you can visit the city's historical centre (which is UNESCO World Heritage Listed), explore the history of Split, from Diocletian's Palace (built for the Roman Emperor in 305 CE), Cathedral of Saint Domnius with its 12th century bell tower, and visit the Peristyle courtyard of Diocletian's Palace, in an approximately 232-Km day. Admire the statue of Gregory of Nin by the 20th-century-sculptor Ivan Mestrovic. Also visit the Golden Gate, Riva Promenade, Old Town Hall, City Clock on People's Square. Visit the fish market, explore the old neighbourhood of Varos and much more.

Overnight: Hotel Corner or similar, Split

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 19 Split – Plitvice

After breakfast, proceed to Plitvice National Park, a well known UNESCO World Heritage Site with 16 crystal blue lakes cascading into 92 spectacular waterfalls. Plitvice is Croatia's oldest National Park. Walk on the wooden promenades with magnificent views on the waters where every turn leads to a breathtaking scenery and yet another waterfall. Surrounded by dense woods, Plitvice Lake is a natural phenomenon of rare and unique beauty, approximately 241-Km day.

Overnight: Hotel Lakeside or similar, Plitvice

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 20 Plitvice - Croatia – Ljubljana, Slovenia

After breakfast, travel to Ljubljana, Slovenia. On route, see Zagreb city, the capital of Croatia, enjoy a walking tour of Zagreb's Upper and Lower Town districts with amazing city views from the Strossmayer Promenade. Afterwards, cross the border into Ljubljana, Slovenia, and check into the hotel. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure, Ljubljana offers a blend of history, culture, and natural beauty. Its welcoming atmosphere, well-preserved architecture, and numerous attractions make it a delightful destination to explore in Slovenia, approximately a 269-Km day.

Overnight: Hotel Austria Trend or similar, Ljubljana

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 21 Ljubljana City Tour

This morning, enjoy a walking tour to see the main tourist attractions of Ljubljana's city centre. These include the National University Library, Congress Square, Cobbler's Bridge, the New Square, Franciscan Church, the main square with the Prešeren Monument, the Three Bridges, the river promenade, the Municipality Square, the Open-Air Market, Butcher's Bridge, the Old Square, St. Nicholas Cathedral and Dragon Bridge. Continue with a visit to Ljubljana Castle and treat yourself to beautiful views of the city from the castle's ramparts. Ljubljana Castle, standing on a hill above the city for about 900 years, is Ljubljana's main attraction. The castle's outlook tower and ramparts offer some of the most beautiful views of the city, while the castle houses a museum exhibition on Slovenian history, a puppet museum, and a number of historical rooms such as the Chapel of St George, the Prison, and a video presentation room called Virtual Castle.

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 22 Ljubljana, Slovenia - Venice, Italy

After breakfast, this morning you will be transferred to the magical city of Venice. En route, visit Noventa di Piave McArthur Glen, where you can enjoy some shopping and a lunch break. Upon arrival in Venice, enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. Venice's captivating beauty, rich history, and distinctive atmosphere make it a truly enchanting destination.

Overnight: Novotel Venezia Mestre Castellana Hotel or similar, Venice Area
Meals included: Breakfast

Day 23 Venice City Tour

After breakfast, you will be transferred to the Punta Sabbioni port, where you will board the water bus into the city. Take the time to admire the beautiful buildings and architecture as you cruise the waters of Venice. Upon arrival, be met by a local tour guide at the Piazza San Marco Square and begin your guided tour of Venice. The Piazza San Marco Square is the hub of Venetian life and a great place to start your tour. Surrounding the square you will see the famous St Mark's Basilica, the Doge Palace, and the Bell Tower (entrances not included). The tour will continue onwards to the Rialto Bridge, the oldest bridge over the Grand Canal, and an icon of the city. Upon the conclusion of the tour, enjoy some time to explore the city on your own. In the afternoon take the water bus back to the port of Punta Sabbioni and return to the hotel.

VENICE TOURIST ENTRANCE TAX

Venice, Italy

From January 2023, to enter Venice it will be mandatory for all tourists who are daytripping or staying less than one night in Venice to pay an entrance tax online prior to arrival. The cost of the tax will change based on the season and the turnout of tourists. Prices will range from €3 up to €10 per person, per day.

Exemptions

- Guests staying more than one night in Venice and Venice area (with proof of stay).
- Children 6 years and under.
- Residents, homeowners, students of Venice.
- Tourist bus passengers.

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not

required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Türkiye

- March - April have highs of 20°C and lows of 5°C.
- May - October have highs of 30°C and lows of 13°C.
- November has highs of 17°C and lows of 8°C.

Bulgaria/North Macedonia

Bulgaria and Macedonia have a temperate continental climate with moderate features which is characteristic for Central Europe. with hot summers, cold winters and very distinct seasons. Abundant snowfalls may occur throughout Bulgaria from December to mid-March, especially if you are in the mountainous areas.

Albania/Montenegro/Croatia/Slovenia

May

May is when temperatures really begin to climb and the summer season truly begins. The town and ports are filling up with tourists, restaurants and bars are alive, museums open and extend their hours and the weather triumphs it all by warming up considerably. Average temperatures reach a very pleasant high of around 21°C and reach a low of a very manageable 11°C.

June

The weather in June is one of the warmest you'll experience. Daily average temperatures in June are about 22°C, highs reaching up to 27°C and lows plummeting to about 16°C. Over the course of the month, the hours of sunshine remain pretty constant, with an average of

about 15 hours per day.

September

September is still very warm, with the average daily temperature ranging from 16-19°C, the highest still a lovely 24°C and the lowest temperature is only around 13°C.

October

Is still fairly warm during October, but the temperature is noticeably lower than in summertime. October's average daily temperature is about 18°C over the course of the month, with highs decreasing from 22°C to 18°C and lows from 15°C to 12°C. Of course with the temperature being lower at night, it would be wise to pack a few items such as a light jacket just in case.

Italy

- Spring (March to May): Spring in Venice is mild and pleasant, with temperatures gradually rising. Average temperatures during this season range from 10°C to 19°C (50°F to 66°F).
- Summer (June to August): Summer in Venice is warm and can get quite humid. Average temperatures range from 18°C to 28°C (64°F to 82°F), but it's not uncommon for temperatures to exceed 30°C (86°F) during heatwaves.
- July and August are the hottest months.
- Autumn (September to November): Autumn is another pleasant time to visit Venice. The temperatures start to cool down, with averages ranging from 12°C to 21°C (54°F to 70°F). September can still be warm, while November tends to be cooler and wetter.

Visas

Türkiye

A tourist visa is a strict requirement if travelling on an Australian Passport. You will be able to start your eVisa application process once you receive your final travel documentation 4-6 weeks prior to departure.

Europe

A tourist visa is not required for Europe for stays up to 90 days if travelling on an Australian passport.

EU Entry/Exit System (EES)

From October 12, 2025, a new European Entry System (EES) replaces the current manual passport-stamping process for non-EU travellers. Upon arrival in the Schengen area, Australian and New Zealand passport holders will have their fingerprints recorded and a photograph taken. Their entry and exit dates will be electronically registered. No previous action is required, but please be aware of longer wait times at border entry. From 10 April 2026, the EES will be fully operational at all external border crossing points of all the European countries (Schengen area) using the system.

European Travel Information & Authorisation System (ETIAS)

As an extension of the EES implementation introduced from 2025, ETIAS travel authorisation is a mandatory entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals travelling to any of [these 30 European countries](#), including Australian and New Zealand citizens, that will be introduced in 2026. We advise you to monitor smartraveller.com.au closer to your departure to ensure you are up to date on the requirements at the time of entry.

Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*

- *Visa rules may have changed since Covid-19. Some countries and airlines may require you to obtain an additional visa before arrival. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination you're entering.*

Please note:

- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
