#### **CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES**

#### Assam

Assam has a subtropical climate influenced by the Brahmaputra River and surrounding hills. The best time to visit is between November and April, when temperatures range from 15-25°C, and rainfall is minimal. From May to October, the region experiences monsoon rains, with temperatures ranging from 22-32°C. Humidity is high during this time, but the landscape is lush and vibrant.

#### Meghalaya

Known for its high rainfall, Meghalaya experiences a cooler, misty climate. The best months to visit are October to April, when temperatures range from 10-20°C. From June to September, temperatures range from 15-25°C, but heavy rainfall occurs, especially in Cherrapunjee and Mawsynram. Despite the rain, the scenery is breathtaking during the monsoon, with waterfalls and greenery at their peak.

#### Golden Triangle (Delhi, Agra & Jaipur)

This region experiences a hot semi-arid climate. The best time to visit is from October to March, when temperatures range from 10-25°C, making sightseeing more comfortable. Summer months, from April to June, see temperatures rising to 35-45°C. The monsoon arrives in July, bringing cooler temperatures but also humidity and occasional heavy rains.

#### Cherrapunjee

Cherrapunjee, famous for its heavy rainfall, has a temperate climate. The best time to visit is from October to March, with temperatures ranging from 13-23°C. The monsoon season from June to September sees the heaviest rains, with temperatures from 18-25°C. The lush landscape and numerous waterfalls are most striking during this period.

#### Mobility

If you require wheelchair access please contact our friendly sales and service team to inquire on your behalf.

#### **Fitness Level Required**

A moderate level of fitness will be required. Moderate is described as expecting a moderate pace of touring with a focus on guided tours that may include full days with extended activity, guided city tours or nature walks. You will require a general level of fitness for unassisted navigation of stairs and inclines, longer distances with possible periods of standing when visiting sites, walking on sloping, uneven ground or elevations. You will be responsible for your own luggage and have the ability to board all modes of transport without assistance.

# Visas

#### India

A tourist visa for India is a strict requirement if travelling on an Australian or New Zealand passport. You will be able to start your visa application process once you receive your final travel documentation approximately 6 weeks prior to departure.

#### Important:

- Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.
- Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.
- It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.
- Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.
- It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.
