

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Barcelona

Barcelona enjoys a Mediterranean climate with warm and pleasant weather from April to October, making it an ideal destination for exploring its vibrant culture and stunning coastline. In April, temperatures range from 9–19°C, offering mild, spring-like conditions with occasional showers. May brings warmer and sunnier days, with highs of 21–23°C, leading into the summer months. June sees temperatures climb to 26–28°C, with dry and warm conditions perfect for outdoor activities. July and August are the hottest months, with highs of 29–31°C and warm evenings ranging from 21–24°C, ideal for beach visits and late-night strolls. As autumn approaches, September remains warm and pleasant, with temperatures between 19–28°C and fewer crowds. By October, the weather cools slightly, with

comfortable highs of 22–24°C and crisp evenings around 14–16°C, offering a perfect blend of sunny and refreshing days for sightseeing.

French Riviera

France, including Marseille and Villefranche, experiences a variety of weather from May to April, reflecting the charm of each season. In May, temperatures in these coastal cities range from 13–23°C, with warm days and cool evenings, perfect for exploring. Summer months, from June to August, bring sunny and hot weather, with highs of 27–30°C and lows around 18–22°C, ideal for enjoying the Mediterranean coastline. September remains warm and pleasant, with temperatures ranging from 17–26°C, gradually cooling into October, which sees highs of 19–22°C and lows of 11–14°C. The winter months, from November to February, bring cooler weather with highs of 11–15°C and lows of 4–9°C, often accompanied by crisp, clear skies. By March and April, spring emerges with temperatures climbing to 10–20°C, offering mild, fresh weather and blooming landscapes, perfect for outdoor adventures and cultural exploration.

Italy

From May to October, Italy—encompassing Livorno, Sicily, Salerno, and Rome—enjoys warm Mediterranean weather, ideal for exploring its rich history and stunning coastlines. In May, temperatures range from 13–23°C, offering mild, sunny days and cooler evenings as the tourist season begins. By June, the warmth sets in, with highs of 26–29°C and pleasant lows of 17–20°C, perfect for outdoor adventures. July and August bring peak summer heat, with temperatures soaring to 30–34°C and warm nights around 20–24°C, particularly in southern regions like Sicily and Salerno. September sees a slight cooling, with highs of 18–28°C, providing warm days and comfortable evenings. By October, autumn ushers in milder weather, with temperatures ranging from 12–24°C, creating a refreshing and pleasant atmosphere for sightseeing. This period is

ideal for immersing yourself in Italy's captivating culture, breathtaking landscapes, and vibrant coastal charm.

Weather patterns and forecasts are often not as reliable as they once were, so we always suggest referring to an online source for the most up-to-date information.

Visas

Europe (Schengen Visa Countries)

A tourist visa is not required for Europe for stays up to 90 days if travelling on an Australian passport.

EU Entry/Exit System (EES)

From October 12, 2025, a new European Entry System (EES) replaces the current manual passport-stamping process for non-EU travellers. Upon arrival in the Schengen area, Australian and New Zealand passport holders will have their fingerprints recorded and a photograph taken. Their entry and exit dates will be electronically registered. No previous action is required, but please be aware of longer wait times at border entry. From 10 April 2026, the EES will be fully operational at all external border crossing points of all the European countries (Schengen area) using the system.

European Travel Information & Authorisation System (ETIAS)

As an extension of the EES implementation introduced from 2025, ETIAS travel authorisation is a mandatory entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals travelling to any of [these 30 European countries](#), including Australian and New Zealand citizens, that will be introduced in 2026. We advise you to monitor smartraveller.com.au closer to your departure to ensure you are up to date on the requirements at the time of entry.

Important:

- Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
- It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
- Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
- It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.*
