Optional trips to the salt terraces of Maras or a trek to Rainbow Mountain are also available. Head into the Sacred Valley of the Incas along the Urubamba River, into the village of Pisac and the cultural site of Ollantaytambo. Witness breathtaking views of the Andes onboard the Peru Expedition Train to the thermal oasis of Aguas Calientes, to then reach the iconic citadel of Machu Picchu. Experience the House of the Guardian, Intihuatana, the Temple of the Sun, the Sacred Plaza and other key locations. Reach Lake

Titicaca, up in the Andean Altiplano, and step into the fantastic Uros Floating Islands, man-created atolls where entire villages reside, made for centuries by hand using only totora reeds.

Fly from Lima to Buenos Aires, Argentina, where you get acquainted with 'Evita' Peron and the beloved First Lady's dramatic story in the government palace, La Casa Rosada (The Pink House). Later, enjoy a dinner and tango show before moving on to Iguazu Falls. Located on the border between Brazil and Argentina, this stunning site includes 275 cascades fed by the Iguazu River. The most popular is Garganta del Diablo (Devil's Throat), the biggest fall of the complex at 80 metres high.

Tour both sides of the falls to find yourself in Brazil, and soon in your next destination: Rio de Janeiro. In Rio, say 'bom dia' (Portuguese for "G'day") to Christ The Redeemer atop the iconic Corcovado Hill. Some time at leisure means you can laze at Ipanema Beach while listening to some samba before flying back home.



Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Lima, Peru

Today depart from Australia (or New Zealand) to Lima, Peru. Upon arrival in Lima, be welcomed and transferred to the hotel.

Lima is a huge and fascinating city, a melting pot of all things Peruvian, where world-famous restaurants sit alongside ancient archaeological sites. Known as The City of Kings, the Peruvian capital is packed with stunning colonial architecture, huge religious buildings, government seat, and other important structures.

Please note:

- Due to flight scheduling and availability, some departures may occur on day 0. Affected customers must be at the airport the day before. Flight times will be indicated on your final documentation which you will receive prior to departure.
- For those departing from Perth, you may depart on day -1 (two days earlier). Flight times will be indicated on your final documentation, which you will receive prior to departure.
- Some customers may experience an extended layover. Lounge passes may be purchased at your own expense

Day 2 Lima City Tour

Today, embark on a half-day city tour of Lima, where you will be guided to some of the most important locations in the city, including Huaca Pucllana, the Plaza de Armas, Lima Cathedral and the Santo Domingo Convent.

Huaca Pucllana is a huge archaeological site in Miraflores, one of Lima's most popular districts. Huaca Pucllana was an important ceremonial and administrative centre of the Lima culture, which developed along this part of the Peruvian coast between 200 AD and 700 AD. After exploring Huaca Pucllana with your guide, travel to Lima's historic centre, a designated UNESCO World Heritage site. Go to the beautiful Plaza de Armas (Lima's main square), surrounded by impressive colonial and Republican-era buildings, many of which have ornate wooden balconies. Visit the Cathedral of Lima, which was completed in 1649. It's a massive structure with a large central nave and 14 side chapels. Inside, we'll see the sculptures and paintings that decorate the interior. Next, we'll walk one block to the Convent of Santo Domingo. Founded in the 1530s and completed in 1766, it is one of the most important religious buildings in Peru, and its large bell tower is a landmark in the historic centre of Lima. Afterwards, you'll be returned to the hotel, where you can enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. We recommend enjoying a stunning sunset over the South Pacific Ocean at the Miraflores Viewpoint.

Day 3 Lima - Puerto Maldonado - Amazon Jungle

Today, at the appropriate time, you will be transferred to the airport in Lima in preparation for your flight to Puerto Maldonado. Once you arrive, you will be met by your specialised Amazon tour leader and transferred to your accommodation for the next two nights.

Please note that you will only be allowed to bring a small bag with your essentials due to luggage and space limitations on the boats during your stay in the Amazon. It is highly recommended that you pre-pack a smaller bag with just the essentials needed for this portion of your trip to Amazon. The remainder of your luggage can be kept at the lodge's office in Puerto Maldonado at no cost.

Puerto Maldonado is Peru's capital of biodiversity and gateway to the Amazon. You will be transported to Puerto Capitanía, the port where our riverboat will be waiting for us. We will sail across Rio Bajo Madre de Dios (Winding River) until arriving at our lodge, 30 km away from Puerto Maldonado City. On the way to the lodge, you can observe diverse animals such as the capybaras, caimans, water turtles, herons, cormorants, carrion birds and birds of prey.

Upon arrival, you will be welcomed with delicious Amazon tropical fruit nectars and a hearty lunch will be served in the rustically designed dining room.

In the afternoon, the specialised guide will take you through an interpretive trail, conveniently signposted, to Caiman Cocha, a little lagoon where you will have the chance to observe the black caiman and the common caiman, as well as efficient predators located at the top of the food chain. They feed on a rich water fauna—mainly represented by fish—that inhabits the pond. In the evening you can enjoy a delicious dinner and time to share unforgettable moments at the bar, equipped with an excellent game room.

Day 4 Amazon Jungle

After breakfast, embark on a hike deep into the forest on well-looked-after trails. On the way, cross the riverside to reach high-elevation forests, and then you will descend to floodable forests. During the journey, you will see the widest range of flora and fauna in the wild. Arrive at the majestic Lake Apu Victor, surrounded by immense swamps and gigantic trees. Then, you'll go up to an Amazonian observation deck, from which you'll get to enjoy a panoramic view of the lake, and observe parrots, macaws, toucans, horned screamers, hoatzins, herons and other animals like caimans, turtles, etc. A wide variety of fish enter Lake Apu Victor with flooding in the rainy season. In addition, there are other species of fauna associated with the lake, like the yellow-footed tortoise, the mata mata, the twist-necked turtle, the freshwater blenny, the kinkajou, the white-tailed deer, the Central American agoutis and the giant otter of the Amazon rainforest.

Return to the lodge for a refreshing lunch before heading on a guided tour in the afternoon to Monkey Island. This island shows an enormous variety of exuberant flora and hosts numerous primate specimens like the black spider monkey, the black-cap capuchin monkey, the squirrel monkey and the lion monkey. Also other species of little mammals like the ring-tailed coati (*nasua nasua*), the squirrel and an enormous variety of coloured birds.

Finally, we will complete our visit to the island, enjoying a sunset with the most impressive dusk in the jungle. Back in the lodge, you will taste an exquisite dinner.

Day 5 Amazon Jungle - Puerto Maldonado - Cusco

This morning wake to the sounds of the amazon, enjoy breakfast before departing the lodge and transferring to Puerto Maldonado Airport in preparation for your flight to Cusco. Once you arrive, you will be met by a tour representative and transferred to the hotel, where you can enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Day 6 Cusco, City Tour

Wake up in Cusco, the Inca Empire's former capital, one of South America's most fascinating cities. Walking through the city centre, you can see the incredible mix of Inca and colonial architecture, watch the merging of indigenous and Spanish influences, and feel the history flowing through every cobblestone street. Cusco is located in the Peruvian Andes at 3,399 metres above sea level. Today, you will embark on a half-day tour, visiting Cusco Cathedral, the Koricancha (Qorikancha), Sacsayhuaman and Tambomachay, giving you a deep insight into the city and its history. First, go to the wonderful Koricancha, next to the Church of Santo Domingo. According to chroniclers, the Koricancha was the most sacred and important temple of the Inca Empire during the period immediately after the Spanish conquest. Its walls were covered in gold, and life-size statues of plants and animals, all pure gold and silver, decorated its rooms and corridors. Unfortunately, this wealth was stripped away by the Spanish conquistadors. Afterwards, visit the Cathedral of Cusco in the Plaza de Armas (Main Square). Built between 1560 and 1654 on the foundations of an existing Inca temple, this spectacular cathedral houses many works of art from the Cusco school of painters, and its high altar and pulpit are covered in gold and silver reliefs. The next stop is the imposing Inca fortress of Sacsayhuaman, which stands on a hill above Cusco. Here, you will see some of the best examples of Inca stonework and construction, including huge rocks carefully cut and fitted perfectly to form the walls. Then, visit the Qenqo Archaeological Complex, considered an Inca labyrinth with an altar with ritual motifs. Then head to Tambomachay. The exact purpose of this

site is unknown, but it may have functioned, at least in part, as an Inca spa. After a morning of exploring, you'll have the remainder of the day at your own leisure.

Overnight: Hotel Jose Antonio Cusco or similar
Meals included: Breakfast

Day 7 Cusco Free Day

After breakfast, enjoy a free day to explore Cusco at your own leisure. The capital city of the Inca Empire is the archaeological capital of the Americas, as well as the continent's oldest continuously inhabited city. Alternatively, you can choose to participate in an optional activity,

Optional Activity: Maras & Moray

Embark on a captivating half-day tour of Maras and Moray, beginning with a pickup from your Cusco hotel at approximately 09:00. The journey to Moray takes about 1.5 hours, offering breathtaking views of the Andean landscape along the way. Pass golden wheat fields, charming traditional villages, and majestic snow-capped mountains. Upon arrival at Moray, explore its fascinating amphitheatre-like terraced structures. These circular terraces, believed to have been an agricultural laboratory for the Incas, showcase their innovative techniques for optimising crop growth. It's a truly awe-inspiring site that highlights the ingenuity of the Inca Empire. Next, you'll visit Maras, located just 3km from Moray. Here, you'll marvel at the ancient salt evaporation ponds carved into the mountainside. More than 3,000 pools collect salty spring water that evaporates to leave behind the renowned sal de Maras, a prized pink salt still harvested today. The view of

these glistening ponds, resembling a blanket of snow or ice, is unforgettable. After exploring Maras, you'll return to Cusco, with drop-off at your hotel included. Please see the current pricing in the Important Information section.

Optional Activity: Rainbow Mountain Trek

Set off before sunrise on an unforgettable full-day adventure to Rainbow Mountain (Vinicunca), one of Peru's most spectacular natural wonders. Your day begins with a 05:00 hotel pick-up from Cusco, followed by an approximately 3-hour scenic drive through the South Valley, where you'll enjoy breathtaking Andean landscapes and a delicious breakfast en route.

Starting your hike in the small town of Pitumarca (3,310 metres), you'll follow a gentle path beside a tranquil stream with views of Mount Ausangate, one of the region's most sacred peaks. Along the way, spot grazing alpacas and llamas, and pass through remote villages where traditional Andean life still thrives. After about 1.5 hours of hiking, you'll reach Rainbow Mountain, standing at an impressive 5,100 metres. Marvel at the vibrant mineral layers that create the mountain's iconic striped appearance and enjoy approximately 30 minutes at the summit to take in the panoramic views, snap photos, and absorb the majestic setting.

The return hike is approximately 1-hour, followed by a hearty buffet lunch at a local restaurant. Afterwards, sit back and relax during the 3-hour drive back to Cusco, arriving around 16:00. Please see current pricing in Important Information.

Please note: The Rainbow Mountain Trek tour requires a moderate to high level of fitness. Participants will encounter uneven surfaces, steep inclines, numerous steps and trekking at high altitudes. Prior to undertaking this optional excursion, we recommend consulting with your GP to assess your suitability for the tour.

Optional Activity: Folklore Dinner & Show

At 19:00, make your way to a restaurant near Cusco's central Plaza de Armas for an unforgettable evening. Indulge in a fabulous buffet dinner featuring a wide selection of traditional dishes, including meats, fish, vegetables, and exquisite desserts. The culinary delights are sure to please every palate. As you dine, the evening comes alive with a vibrant traditional dance show. Immerse yourself in the rich culture of the Andes with folk and classical music performed on traditional instruments like the quena, charango, flute and zampoña. For an even more memorable experience, you're welcome to join the dancers on the floor and become part of the celebration. It's an enchanting way to connect with the region's culture and traditions. Day 8 Sacred Valley of the Incas

Start your journey with a scenic drive from your hotel to the breathtaking Sacred Valley of the Incas, stopping en route at the charming village of Chinchero. Nestled in the Peruvian Andes, this small, picturesque town is home to about 50 families who sustain themselves through agriculture and traditional weaving.

During your visit, you'll have the unique opportunity to engage with local artisans and learn about centuries-old textile-making techniques. Participate in a hands-on demonstration as a member of the community explains, in Quechua (with English translation), the cultural significance and intricate symbolism woven into their textiles. Experience every step of the process—from shearing and spinning wool to washing it with natural soap, dyeing it with plants and flowers, and weaving it into vibrant blankets, ponchos, or hats. Witness how ancient practices are passed down through generations, preserving a rich cultural heritage.

After this immersive experience, continue on to your hotel for the evening.

Day 9 Pisac - Ollantaytambo - Aguas Calientes

This morning, check out of your accommodation and prepare an overnight backpack for your journey to Aguas Calientes, as large suitcases cannot be transported on the train. Your main luggage will be securely transferred to your Cusco hotel, where it will be waiting for your return tomorrow. Begin your day with a pickup from your hotel in the Sacred Valley, nestled beside the sacred Urubamba River. The first stop is the charming village of Pisac, known for its vibrant traditional market. Spend time browsing the colourful stalls filled with artisan crafts, textiles, and souvenirs before continuing to the Pisac archaeological site, perched on a hill overlooking the valley. Explore these extensive ruins with a guided tour, uncovering remnants of Inca temples, homes, storage facilities, and the Intihuatana stone, known as the "hitching post of the sun." Soak in stunning views across the Sacred Valley while learning about the history and significance of this ancient site.

Afterwards, journey to Urubamba for a lunch break (not included) before continuing to Ollantaytambo, a historic Inca town and ceremonial centre. Marvel at its impressive archaeological site, including the Temple of the Sun, crafted from massive, intricately polished stones. Explore the terraces, water channels, and agricultural innovations that showcase Inca engineering expertise. Stroll through the town of Ollantaytambo, where Inca-built water channels are still in use. Take in the views of the surrounding ruins, granaries, and storehouses built into the mountains, and observe daily life in this Inca town, where many locals still wear traditional dress.

From Ollantaytambo, board the Peru Expedition train to Aguas Calientes (also known as Machu Picchu Pueblo), a colourful town at the foot of Machu Picchu. The two-hour train ride is a memorable experience, as you'll pass through river canyons and rolling hills. Aguas Calientes is the gateway to Machu Picchu, sitting in a deep gorge at the foot of the mountain on which Machu Picchu stands. It is a beautiful town that mixes traditional life with a massive tourist infrastructure, with many markets, souvenir shops, hotels and restaurants. It's also largely pedestrianised, making it a fun place to explore on foot. Jungle-covered mountains and cliffs surround Aguas Calientes, and the Urubamba River flows by the town. Aguas Calientes is also surrounded by hot springs, so you will have plenty of time to relax and dip in one of the steaming natural springs (not included). You will also have time to walk around the city and explore the colourful markets and the general bustle of this unique Peruvian settlement.

Alternatively, you can choose to supplement the activities on this day and participate in the Express Inca Trail Trek (additional expense).

Optional Tour Supplement - Express Inca Trail Trek

Physical ability: Active (please refer to the Other Important Information section for a description).

You will be picked up early (approximately 06:00). Board the train for a 1.5-hour scenic ride to a point known as Kilometre 104 to start your short Inca Trail trek. From here, you will hike for approximately four hours to the Inca site of Wiñay Wayna ("Forever Young"), approximately 2,680 metres above sea level.

Built on a steep hillside overlooking the Urubamba River, this archaeological site has ten baths and numerous Inca buildings displaying high levels of Inca masonry. Wiñay Wayna was discovered almost 30 years after the entire world knew about Machu Picchu and 40 years after Machu Picchu was first discovered. Little is known about what Wiñay Wayna was originally built for, however there are theories that it was built as a spiritual destination or resting place before reaching Machu Picchu, where elders and royalty would cleanse themselves in the baths. Others believe that the site functioned as a kind of administrative centre to keep track of the amount of produce stored on-site. After exploring Wiñay Wayna, you will continue your walk to Inti Punku (the Puerta del Sol, or The Sun's Gate). From here, you will have your first spectacular view of Machu Picchu. This site was believed to have once been the main entrance to Machu Picchu and was dedicated to Inti, the Inca Sun God. You'll then head to Aguas Calientes where your afternoon will be spent at leisure. Please note that due to the nature and duration of this tour, a moderate to active fitness level is required for participation in this supplementary trek. The route includes uneven surfaces, steep ascents and descents, a mix of stairs and dirt trails, and high-altitude conditions. The trek spans approximately 12 km (6–8 hours) of walking, including steps for photos, lunch (included) and exploring. If you have any concerns about your ability to complete this trek, we recommend consulting your GP for guidance. Current pricing details can be found on the Important Information section.

Day 10 Machu Picchu

Today has an early start. At approximately 05:40, you will be picked up and boarding the bus to the citadel of Machu Picchu. You will have time for breakfast before being picked up this morning. Pass through the gates into the Machu Picchu archaeological site. Here, you'll be guided on a two-hour tour of this archaeological complex's most famous and spectacular parts. These include the House of the Guardian, Intihuatana, Temple of the Sun, Sacred Plaza and other key locations. As you walk around, you'll enjoy spectacular views across the agricultural terraces of Machu Picchu and across the surrounding mountains and plunging gorges. Once you've finished the tour of Machu Picchu, take the bus back down to Aguas Calientes, where you can relax and have lunch (not included) before boarding the train back to Poroy and Cusco. Upon arrival at the station, a tour representative will wait for you to take you back to the hotel in Cusco, arriving around 19:00.

Day 11 Cusco - Puno

Rise early for breakfast and transfer to the bus station to travel to Puno onboard a modern bus, stopping along the way at several interesting sites, such as:

- *Andahuaylillas: "The Sistine Chapel of South America," one of the most beautiful examples of Andean popular religious art.*
- *Raqchi (Wiracocha God Temple): An Incan church of monumental dimensions.*

- *La Raya: The halfway point between Cusco and Puno, where you'll enjoy a rest stop and delicious buffet lunch in the town of Sicuani.*
- *Pukara: The most important and oldest ceremonial centre of the Altiplano. Upon arrival at the bus station in Puno around 17:00, you'll be met and transferred to the hotel, where you can enjoy the evening at leisure after an approximately 10-hour journey.*

Day 12 Lake Titicaca - Uros Islands

This morning, at around 07:00, you'll depart for a boat ride to the island of Taquile, one of the most beautiful islands in Peru, where their traditional way of life is still alive. You'll have the chance to meet some of the master weavers of this ancient Andean community, whose textiles are considered among the best in the country. According to legend, the Incas learned how to weave from the artisans of this island, with the men being the weavers and the women spinning the yarn.

Afterwards, your boat journey continues to the Chucuito Peninsula in the Aymara region of Lake Titicaca, representing the communal identity of the Peruvian-Bolivian Altiplano. Here, you will visit the small and rarely visited rural community of Luquina and enjoy lunch at a typical island restaurant. You'll then head back towards Puno, stopping to see the fantastic Islands of the Uros people, created entirely from the buoyant totora reeds that grow abundantly in the lake's shallows and are constantly replenished from the top as they rot from the bottom. You'll drop by the main island and enjoy a brief explanation of the history

and lifestyle of the people who have lived here for centuries, visit some of their homes to learn about their lifestyle and meet one of the local families to see how they live.

Day 13 Puno - Lima

This morning, at the appropriate time, you will be transferred to Juliaca Airport in preparation for your flight to Lima. Once arrived in Lima, you will be met by a tour representative and transferred to the hotel, where you can enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Hotel Jose Antonio Lima or similar
Meals included: Breakfast

Day 14 Lima, Peru - Buenos Aires, Argentina

Today, at the appropriate time, you'll be transferred to the airport in Lima, Peru, for your flight to Buenos Aires, Argentina. Once you arrive, you'll be met by a tour representative and transferred to your accommodation for the evening. The name "Buenos Aires" translates to "good airs" in Spanish, and the city is one of the most significant and culturally rich destinations in Latin America. Your centrally-located hotel provides easy access to nearby restaurants, entertainment, and local attractions, making it the perfect base to explore this vibrant city.

Day 15 Buenos Aires, City Tour

This morning, after breakfast, embark on a city tour of Buenos Aires and discover the charm and magic of this vibrant metropolis. Not only is the statue the most recognizable landmark of Rio, but it has also become a cultural icon of Brazil. Continue to visit the impressive Selarón Stairs: Jorge Selarón's unique and vivid mosaic steps. The Escadaria Selarón, 125 metres of steps covered in bright tile, is a product of sheer determination by Selarón, and it acts as a source of inspiration for the neighbourhood. After the tour, return to the hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

Huaca Pucllana is a huge archaeological site in Miraflores, one of Lima's most popular districts. Huaca Pucllana was an important ceremonial and administrative centre of the Lima culture, which developed along this part of the Peruvian coast between 200 AD and 700 AD. After exploring Huaca Pucllana with your guide, travel to Lima's historic centre, a designated UNESCO World Heritage site. Go to the beautiful Plaza de Armas (Lima's main square), surrounded by impressive colonial and Republican-era buildings, many of which have ornate wooden balconies. Visit the Cathedral of Lima, which was completed in 1649. It's a massive structure with a large central nave and 14 side chapels. Inside, we'll see the sculptures and paintings that decorate the interior. Next, we'll walk one block to the Convent of Santo Domingo. Founded in the 1530s and completed in 1766, it is one of the most important religious buildings in Peru, and its large bell tower is a landmark in the historic centre of Lima. Afterwards, you'll be returned to the hotel, where you can enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. We recommend enjoying a stunning sunset over the South Pacific Ocean at the Miraflores Viewpoint.

Day 10 Lima - Puerto Maldonado - Amazon Jungle

Today, at the appropriate time, you will be transferred to the airport in Lima in preparation for your flight to Puerto Maldonado. Once you arrive, you will be met by your specialised Amazon tour leader and transferred to your accommodation for the next two nights.

Please note that you will only be allowed to bring a small bag with your essentials due to luggage and space limitations on the boats during your stay in the Amazon. It is highly recommended that you pre-pack a smaller bag with just the essentials needed for this portion of your trip to Amazon. The remainder of your luggage can be kept at the lodge's office in Puerto Maldonado at no cost.

Puerto Maldonado is Peru's capital of biodiversity and gateway to the Amazon. You will be transported to Puerto Capitanía, the port where our riverboat will be waiting for us. We will sail across Rio Bajo Madre de Dios (Winding River) until arriving at our lodge, 30 km away from Puerto Maldonado City. On the way to the lodge, you can observe diverse animals such as the capybaras, caimans, water turtles, herons, cormorants, carrion birds and birds of prey.

Upon arrival, you will be welcomed with delicious Amazon tropical fruit nectars and a hearty lunch will be served in the rustically designed dining room.

In the afternoon, the specialised guide will take you through an interpretive trail, conveniently signposted, to Caiman Cocha, a little lagoon where you will have the chance to observe the black caiman and the common caiman, as well as efficient predators located at the top of the food chain. They feed on a rich water fauna—mainly represented by fish— that inhabits the pond. In the evening you can enjoy a delicious dinner and time to share unforgettable moments at the bar, equipped with an excellent game room.

Day 11 Amazon Jungle

After breakfast, embark on a hike deep into the forest on well-looked-after trails. On the way, cross the riverside to reach high-elevation forests, and then you will descend to floodable forests. During the journey, you will see the widest range of flora and fauna in the wild. Arrive at the majestic Lake Apu Victor, surrounded by immense swamps and gigantic trees. Then, you'll go up to an Amazonian observation deck, from which you'll get to enjoy a panoramic view of the lake, and observe parrots, macaws, toucans, horned screamers, hoatzins, herons and other animals like caimans, turtles, etc. A wide variety of fish enter Lake Apu Victor with flooding in the rainy season. In addition, there are other species of fauna associated with the lake, like the yellow-footed tortoise, the mata mata, the twist-necked turtle, the freshwater blenny, the kinkajou, the white-tailed deer, the Central American agoutis and the giant otter of the Amazon rainforest.

Return to the lodge for a refreshing lunch before heading on a guided tour in the afternoon to Monkey Island. This island shows an enormous variety of exuberant flora and hosts numerous primate specimens like the black spider monkey, the black-cap capuchin monkey, the squirrel monkey and the lion monkey. Also other species of little mammals like the ring-tailed coati (nasua nasua), the squirrel and an enormous variety of coloured birds.

Finally, we will complete our visit to the island, enjoying a sunset with the most impressive dusk in the jungle. Back in the lodge, you will taste an exquisite dinner.

Day 13 Cusco City Tour

Wake up in Cusco, the Inca Empire's former capital, one of South America's most fascinating cities. Walking through the city centre, you can see the incredible mix of Inca and colonial architecture, watch the merging of indigenous and Spanish influences, and feel the history flowing through every cobblestone street. Cusco is located in the Peruvian Andes at 3,399 metres above sea level. Today, you will embark on a half-day tour, visiting Cusco Cathedral, the Koricancha (Qorikancha), Sacsayhuaman and Tambomachay, giving you a deep insight into the city and its history. First, go to the wonderful Koricancha, next to the Church of Santo Domingo. According to chroniclers, the Koricancha was the most sacred and important temple of the Inca Empire during the period immediately after the Spanish conquest. Its walls were covered in gold, and life-size statues of plants and animals, all pure gold and silver, decorated its rooms and corridors. Unfortunately, this wealth was stripped away by the Spanish conquistadors. Afterwards, visit the Cathedral of Cusco in the Plaza de Armas (Main Square). Built between 1560 and 1654 on the foundations of an existing Inca temple, this spectacular cathedral houses many works of art from the Cusco school of painters, and its high altar and pulpit are covered in gold and silver reliefs. The next stop is the imposing Inca fortress of Sacsayhuaman, which stands on a hill above Cusco. Here, you will see some of the best examples of Inca stonework and construction, including huge rocks carefully cut and fitted perfectly to form the walls. Then, visit the Qenqo Archaeological Complex, considered an Inca labyrinth with an altar with ritual motifs. Then head to Tambomachay. The exact purpose of this

site is unknown, but it may have functioned, at least in part, as an Inca spa. After a morning of exploring, you'll have the remainder of the day at your own leisure.

The journey to Moray takes about 1.5 hours, offering breathtaking views of the Andean landscape along the way. Pass golden wheat fields, charming traditional villages, and majestic snow-capped mountains. Upon arrival at Moray, explore its fascinating amphitheatre-like terraced structures. These circular terraces, believed to have been an agricultural laboratory for the Incas, showcase their innovative techniques for optimising crop growth. It's a truly awe-inspiring site that highlights the ingenuity of the Inca Empire. Next, you'll visit Maras, located just 3km from Moray. Here, you'll marvel at the ancient salt evaporation ponds carved into the mountainside. More than 3,000 pools collect salty spring water that evaporates to leave behind the renowned sal de Maras, a prized pink salt still harvested today. The view of

Optional Activity: Rainbow Mountain Trek

Set off before sunrise on an unforgettable full-day adventure to Rainbow Mountain (Vinicunca), one of Peru's most spectacular natural wonders. Your day begins with a 05:00 hotel pick-up from Cusco, followed by an approximately 3-hour scenic drive through the South Valley, where you'll enjoy breathtaking Andean landscapes and a delicious breakfast en route.

Starting your hike in the small town of Pitumarca (3,310 metres), you'll follow a gentle path beside a tranquil stream with views of Mount Ausangate, one of the region's most sacred peaks. Along the way, spot grazing alpacas and llamas, and pass through remote villages where traditional Andean life still thrives. After about 1.5 hours of hiking, you'll reach Rainbow Mountain, standing at an impressive 5,100 metres. Marvel at the vibrant mineral layers that create the mountain's iconic striped appearance and enjoy approximately 30 minutes at the summit to take in the panoramic views, snap photos, and absorb the majestic setting.

Day 15 Sacred Valley of the Incas

Start your journey with a scenic drive from your hotel to the breathtaking Sacred Valley of the Incas, stopping en route at the charming village of Chinchero. Nestled in the Peruvian Andes, this small, picturesque town is home to about 50 families who sustain themselves through agriculture and traditional weaving.

During your visit, you'll have the unique opportunity to engage with local artisans and learn about centuries-old textile-making techniques. Participate in a hands-on demonstration as a member of the community explains, in Quechua (with English translation), the cultural significance and intricate symbolism woven into their textiles. Experience every step of the process—from shearing and spinning wool to washing it with natural soap, dyeing it with plants and flowers, and weaving it into vibrant blankets, ponchos, or hats. Witness how ancient practices are passed down through generations, preserving a rich cultural heritage.

After this immersive experience, continue on to your hotel for the evening.

Day 16 Pisac - Ollantaytambo - Aguas Calientes

This morning, check out of your accommodation and prepare an overnight backpack for your journey to Aguas Calientes, as large suitcases cannot be transported on the train. Begin your day with a pickup from your hotel in the Sacred Valley, nestled beside the sacred Urubamba River. The first stop is the charming village of Pisac, known for its vibrant traditional market. Spend time browsing the colourful stalls filled with artisan crafts, textiles, and souvenirs before continuing to the Pisac archaeological site, perched on a hill overlooking the valley. Explore these extensive ruins with a guided tour, uncovering remnants of Inca temples, homes, storage facilities, and the Intihuatana stone, known as the "hitching post of the sun." Soak in stunning views across the Sacred Valley while learning about the history and significance of this ancient site.

Afterwards, journey to Urubamba for a lunch break (not included) before continuing to Ollantaytambo, a historic Inca town and ceremonial centre. Marvel at its impressive archaeological site, including the Temple of the Sun, crafted from massive, intricately polished stones. Explore the terraces, water channels, and agricultural innovations that showcase Inca engineering expertise. Stroll through the town of Ollantaytambo, where Inca-built water channels are still in use. Take in the views of the surrounding ruins, granaries, and storehouses built into the mountains, and observe daily life in this Inca town, where many locals still wear traditional dress.

From Ollantaytambo, board the Peru Expedition train to Aguas Calientes (also known as Machu Picchu Pueblo), a colourful town at the foot of Machu Picchu. The two-hour train ride is a memorable experience, as you'll pass through river canyons and rolling hills. Aguas Calientes is the gateway to Machu Picchu, sitting in a deep gorge at the foot of the mountain on which Machu Picchu stands. It is a beautiful town that mixes traditional life with a massive tourist infrastructure, with many markets, souvenir shops, hotels and restaurants. It's also largely pedestrianised, making it a fun place to explore on foot. Jungle-covered mountains and cliffs surround Aguas Calientes, and the Urubamba River flows by the town. Aguas Calientes is also surrounded by hot springs, so you will have plenty of time to relax and dip in one of the steaming natural springs (not included). You will also have time to walk around the city and explore the colourful markets and the general bustle of this unique Peruvian settlement.

Alternatively, you can choose to supplement the activities on this day and participate in the Express Inca Trail Trek (additional expense).

Optional Tour Supplement - Express Inca Trail Trek

Physical ability: Active (please refer to the Other Important Information section for a description).

You will be picked up early (approximately 06:00). Board the train for a 1.5-hour scenic ride to a point known as Kilometre 104 to start your short Inca Trail trek. From here, you will hike for approximately four hours to the Inca site of Wiñay Wayna ("Forever Young"), approximately 2,680 metres above sea level.

Built on a steep hillside overlooking the Urubamba River, this archaeological site has ten baths and numerous Inca buildings displaying high levels of Inca masonry. Wiñay Wayna was discovered almost 30 years after the entire world knew about Machu Picchu and 40 years after Machu Picchu was first discovered. Little is known about what Wiñay Wayna was originally built for, however there are theories that it was built as a spiritual destination or resting place before reaching Machu Picchu, where elders and royalty would cleanse themselves in the baths. Others believe that the site functioned as a kind of administrative centre to keep track of the amount of produce stored on-site. After exploring Wiñay Wayna, you will continue your walk to Inti Punku (the Puerta del Sol, or The Sun's Gate). From here, you will have your first spectacular view of Machu Picchu. This site was believed to have once been the main entrance to Machu Picchu and was dedicated to Inti, the Inca Sun God. You'll then head to Aguas Calientes where your afternoon will be spent at leisure. Please note that due to the nature and duration of this tour, a moderate to active fitness level is required for participation in this supplementary trek. The route includes uneven surfaces, steep ascents and descents, a mix of stairs and dirt trails, and high-altitude conditions. The trek spans approximately 12 km (6–8 hours) of walking, including steps for photos, lunch (included) and exploring. If you have any concerns about your ability to complete this trek, we recommend consulting your GP for guidance. Current pricing details can be found on the Important Information section.

Day 17 Machu Picchu

Today has an early start. At approximately 05:40, you will be picked up and boarding the bus to the citadel of Machu Picchu. You will have time for breakfast before being picked up this morning. Pass through the gates into the Machu Picchu archaeological site. Here, you'll be guided on a two-hour tour of this archaeological complex's most famous and spectacular parts. These include the House of the Guardian, Intihuatana, Temple of the Sun, Sacred Plaza and other key locations. As you walk around, you'll enjoy spectacular views across the agricultural terraces of Machu Picchu and across the surrounding mountains and plunging gorges. Once you've finished the tour of Machu Picchu, take the bus back down to Aguas Calientes, where you can relax and have lunch (not included) before boarding the train back to Poroy and Cusco. Afterwards, your boat journey continues to the Chucuito Peninsula in the Aymara region of Lake Titicaca, representing the communal identity of the Peruvian-Bolivian Altiplano. Here, you will visit the small and rarely visited rural community of Luquina and enjoy lunch at a typical island restaurant. You'll then head back towards Puno, stopping to see the fantastic Islands of the Uros people, created entirely from the buoyant totora reeds that grow abundantly in the lake's shallows and are constantly replenished from the top as they rot from the bottom. You'll drop by the main island and enjoy a brief explanation of the history

and lifestyle of the people who have lived here for centuries, visit some of their homes to learn about their lifestyle and meet one of the local families to see how they live.

Not only is the statue the most recognizable landmark of Rio, but it has also become a cultural icon of Brazil. Continue to visit the impressive Selarón Stairs: Jorge Selarón's unique and vivid mosaic steps. The Escadaria Selarón, 125 metres of steps covered in bright tile, is a product of sheer determination by Selarón, and it acts as a source of inspiration for the neighbourhood. After the tour, return to the hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the

city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Lima, Peru

Lima is usually described as mild and warm throughout the year without noteworthy rain making Lima one of the driest capitals in the world. The average temperatures range from 18°C to 28°C.

Amazon Jungle, Peru

The climate is tropical with a rainy period from October to April and a relatively dry period from June to August. The coolest month is July with an average minimum of 20°C degrees and an average maximum of 29°C.

Cusco, Peru

Cusco has a subtropical highland climate due to its elevation (3500m above sea level). It is generally dry and temperate, with two defined seasons. The dry season lasts from May to August, with abundant

sunshine and occasional nighttime freezes; July is the coldest month with an average of 9.7°C. The wet season lasts from December to March, with night frost less common; November averages 13.3°C. Although frost and hail are common, the only snowfall ever recorded was in June 1911. Temperatures usually range from 0.2°C to 20.9°C.

Puno, Peru

Puno experiences cool weather throughout the year due to its high altitude. During the dry season, from May to October, days are sunny with temperatures ranging from 15°C to 18°C, while nights can be quite cold, often dropping to -1°C to 2°C. The wet season, from November to April, brings warmer days with highs of 16°C to 20°C and frequent rain showers, while nights are milder, averaging around 4°C to 8°C. Layered clothing is recommended year-round to stay comfortable in Puno's variable climate.

Buenos Aires, Argentina

Buenos Aires, the capital of Argentina, has a temperate climate, which is classified as a humid subtropical climate under the Köppen climate classification with four distinct seasons. Summers are hot and humid with frequent thunderstorms while winters are cool and drier with frosts that occurs on average twice per year. Spring and fall are transition seasons characterised by changeable weather.

Puerto Iguazu, Argentina

Puerto Iguazú has a humid subtropical climate. Temperatures are warm in winter and hot in summer. There is no dry season and rainfall is abundant with every month receiving over 100mm of rain.

Rio de Janeiro, Brazil

Rio has a tropical savanna climate that closely borders a tropical monsoon climate according to the Köppen climate classification, and is often characterised by long periods of heavy rain between December and March. In inland areas of the city, temperatures above 40°C are

common during the summer, though rarely for long periods, while maximum temperatures above 27°C can occur on a monthly basis.

Quito, Ecuador (Itinerary 2 Only)

In Quito, the climate is warm and temperate. There is a great deal of rainfall in Quito, even in the driest month. The average annual temperature is 13.9°C. With an average of 14.1°C May is the warmest month. The lowest average temperature in the year occurs in June when it is around 13.6°C.

Santa Cruz, Galapagos, Ecuador (Itinerary 2 Only)

No time of year is too hot or too cold to enjoy the Galapagos, but the climate is not exactly the same throughout. June through December are considered the cooler months in terms of both the air and water. This is also the time of the dry season, where the highlands of the major islands are kept lush but the beaches and flatlands receive very little rain. Blue skies interrupted by sparse and sporadic afternoon showers are the norm.

FLIGHTS

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points

We do not arrange seat selection. It is essential to highlight that some airlines do not allow pre-selected seats. We strongly suggest you contact the airline directly with seating allocation requirements and/or arrive at the airport earlier to arrange your seating. While we do not add frequent flyer member details to bookings, you can do this directly with the airline once you have your flight information.

Passport Validity

Customers must provide valid passport details either at the time of purchase or no later than 45 days before the departure date. Failure to do so may result in the cancellation of the booking. Customers will be responsible for any costs and fees incurred in this instance.

Fitness Level Required

Adventure (and spontaneity) create some of the best travel memories. Bear in mind, your home schedules and timings might not be adhered to on tour - it's all part of the fun! A moderate level of fitness will be required. Expect a moderate pace of touring with a focus on guided tours that may include full days with extended activity, guided city tours or nature walks. You will require a general level of fitness for unassisted navigation of stairs and inclines, longer distances with possible periods of standing when visiting sites, walking on sloping, uneven ground or elevations. You will be responsible for your own luggage and have the ability to board all modes of transport without assistance.

Please note: Many areas may be inaccessible to wheelchairs or mobility scooters, where the unassisted use of personal walking sticks and other aids may be required. Although some assistance may be available, every traveller should be self-reliant during all aspects of their travel.

Rainbow Mountain Trek (Optional Activity): Active

The Rainbow Mountain Trek is a challenging yet rewarding adventure, suitable for those with a good fitness level who exercise regularly. This trek involves hiking at high altitudes, navigating uneven terrain for several hours. Participants should be prepared for steep ascents and the effects of altitude. Recommended for active travellers with prior trekking experience and a reasonable level of endurance, this trek offers breathtaking views of the vibrant Rainbow Mountain and its surrounding landscapes

Express Inca Trail Trek (Optional Activity): Active

Active/demanding are more strenuous activities, suitable for a good fitness level and for guests who exercise regularly. More fast-paced activities and walking on uneven surfaces. A high fitness level is required to undertake activities, which include high-altitude trekking for anywhere between four to seven hours per day for an extended number of days. Recommended for active travellers with some previous trekking experience.

Please note: If you have any concerns, please consult your healthcare provider prior to purchase/travel.

High Altitude Illness

Altitude illness occurs when there is a lack of oxygen in the air at high altitudes. Altitude illness will affect some travellers, with no apparent regard to age, gender or physical condition. If you have any concerns please consult your healthcare provider prior to purchase/travel.

Please note: Inoculations may be required to enter the country visited, along with re-entry into Australia after your visit. It is your responsibility to consult with your travel doctor for up-to-date medical travel information well before departure.

Yellow Fever

A valid international certificate of vaccination against Yellow Fever is required in Ecuador and many other

countries. You will need to be vaccinated against Yellow Fever 10 days prior to arriving in Ecuador if you have visited Colombia, Peru, Brazil, or Bolivia and have spent more than 10 days in any of these countries. You may need to present this on arrival at the airport or border crossing. Some countries will refuse entry if you are unable to present your certificate. It's also common for your home country to request a Yellow Fever certificate upon arrival. You must check with your doctor well before leaving home about the Yellow Fever requirements for the countries you'll be visiting.

Sightseeing

Please note: If entry to a site is affected by changes in operating hours or public holiday closures, your itinerary, where possible, may be adjusted, or a similar activity will be offered in its place (subject to availability).

Shopping

Shopping overseas can be a daunting and confusing experience, especially when there is a language barrier. Please be very cautious when foreign currencies and prices are involved. If paying by credit card, please pay close attention to the amount you are being charged and keep all your receipts. Do not make any purchases you are not comfortable with or feel pressured into. If you are uncertain or need assistance with the language barrier, please seek assistance from your Tour Guide/Leader. Visas

New Zealand (Transiting)

If you do not hold an Australian passport you may be required to obtain a transit visa. Some flight routes make a stop in New Zealand and you may be required to obtain a transit visa to board your flight. It is the passengers' sole responsibility to seek advice on the correct visa and take appropriate action to ensure they have the correct visa prior to departure. Failure to do so may result in denied boarding and or

refusal of entry to the country by the local authorities and immigration department. We strongly advise you to carefully review your flight tickets and then contact your respective consulate or a visa agency to confirm the necessary visa regulations and acceptable forms of personal identification for your transit.

Peru

Tourists who hold an Australian passport don't need a visa. You can get a permit to stay for up to 3 months when you arrive. You may need a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate to enter Peru. Some airlines may want to see one when you leave. If you've visited Peru in the previous 6 days, you'll need a valid certificate to enter Australia. Find out about returning to Australia after exposure to yellow fever.

Argentina

As a tourist, you can stay for up to 90 days without a visa, but you'll need:

- A return or onward ticket.
- A valid passport.
- Travel/medical insurance.

Please Note: Effective immediately, all international travellers to Argentina must hold valid travel insurance with medical coverage.

This insurance may be requested and verified upon arrival in the country.

Argentina's public healthcare system will no longer provide free medical services to foreign nationals. It is therefore essential that you obtain appropriate insurance before your departure.

Brazil

A visa is required for Australian passport holders entering Brazil. Persons travelling after this date to Brazil will require a Visit Visa to enter the country. You can apply for a visa here: <https://www.gov.br/mre/pt-br/embaixada-camberra/English/consular-section/visas/short-term-visas-for-stays-up-to-90-days/e-visa>. Entry and exit conditions may change without warning. Follow the advice of border and health authorities and comply with local regulations. Contact your airline or the nearest embassy or consulate of Brazil for

more information.

United States (Transiting)

If travelling on an Australian passport, an ESTA (visa waiver) for the USA is a strict requirement when travelling to or flying through the USA. Once a USA ESTA visa waiver is issued it is valid for 2 years or until your passport expires (whichever is sooner) and will allow multiple entries into the USA. Chile

You must obtain your visa before you arrive in Chile. The application process can be lengthy, so allow yourself enough time before your planned travel. If you arrive in Chile without a valid visa, you won't be able to pass the immigration point, and you'll be sent back to your last port of departure. You won't be able to obtain a visa at the airport or border entry point. To enter Chile, Australian citizens must obtain a visa before arrival: [SAC Sistema Atención Consular - Ciudadanos](#). Please reach out to the Chilean consulate for any visa requirements.

Ecuador (Itinerary 2 Only)

Tourist visas for Ecuador are not required if travelling on an Australian Passport. You can stay in Ecuador for up to 90 days without a visa.

Please note: Passengers who are not Australian citizens must check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required. It is also important to note, some areas of employment such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations may have additional restrictions in applying for Visas. This may in turn affect the type of application required.

Yellow Fever

Important Information

A valid international certificate of vaccination against Yellow Fever is required in Ecuador and many other countries. You will need to be vaccinated against Yellow Fever 10 days prior to arriving in Ecuador if you have visited Colombia, Peru, Brazil, or Bolivia and have spent more than 10 days in any of these countries. You may need to present this on arrival at the airport or border crossing. Some countries will refuse entry if you are unable to present your certificate. It's also common for your home country to request a Yellow Fever certificate upon arrival. You must check with your doctor well before leaving home about the Yellow Fever requirements for the countries you'll be visiting.

Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- *Visa rules may have changed since Covid-19. Some countries and airlines may require you to obtain an additional visa before arrival. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination you're entering.*

- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
