Next, visit the Ngwenya Glass Works, where talented artisans craft exquisite sculptures from molten glass. After exploring local craft markets, arrive at your hotel nestled in the picturesque Ezulwini Valley.

**Overnight:** Foresters Arms or similar, Mhlambanyatsi, Eswatini  
**Meals included:** Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner

#### Day 6 Mhlambanyatsi, Eswatini - Mkuze, South Africa - Zulu Homestead Visit

This morning, depart for a visit to the Swazi Candle Factory, where each unique candle is crafted by hand using the traditional "millefiore" technique. No two candles are alike, showcasing a mesmerising array of patterns and designs.

Continue your journey via Big Bend into KwaZulu Natal, arriving at your hotel in the afternoon.

Take an exhilarating scenic drive up the Ubombo Mountains, where breathtaking views of Lake Jozini await. As the sun sets, stop for sundowners and enjoy a visit to an authentic Zulu homestead for a glimpse into contemporary Zulu life before returning to the hotel for dinner.

#### Day 7 Mkuze Game Reserve - Safari Game Drive

Enjoy a game drive in the Mkuze Game Reserve. Mkuze harbours an astonishing diversity of habitats ranging from the eastern slopes of the Lebombo Mountains to stretches of rolling acacia savannah, swamps, woodlands and riverine forest. Wildlife in this game reserve include black and white rhino, lion, elephant, giraffe, leopard, cheetah, buffalo and a multitude of plains game. The birding is exceptional – 420 species recorded.

Return to your hotel in the late afternoon and savour a delightful dinner to conclude your day.

**Overnight:** Ghost Mountain Inn or similar, Mkuze  
**Meals included:** Breakfast; Dinner

#### Day 8 Mkuze - St Lucia - Umhlanga

Following an early breakfast, depart along the stunning Elephant Coast of KwaZulu Natal toward St Lucia, located at the southern tip of the iSimangaliso Wetland Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Embark on an estuarine boat trip, offering a unique chance to spot crocodiles, hippos and a plethora of bird species, including the elusive African Fish Eagle.

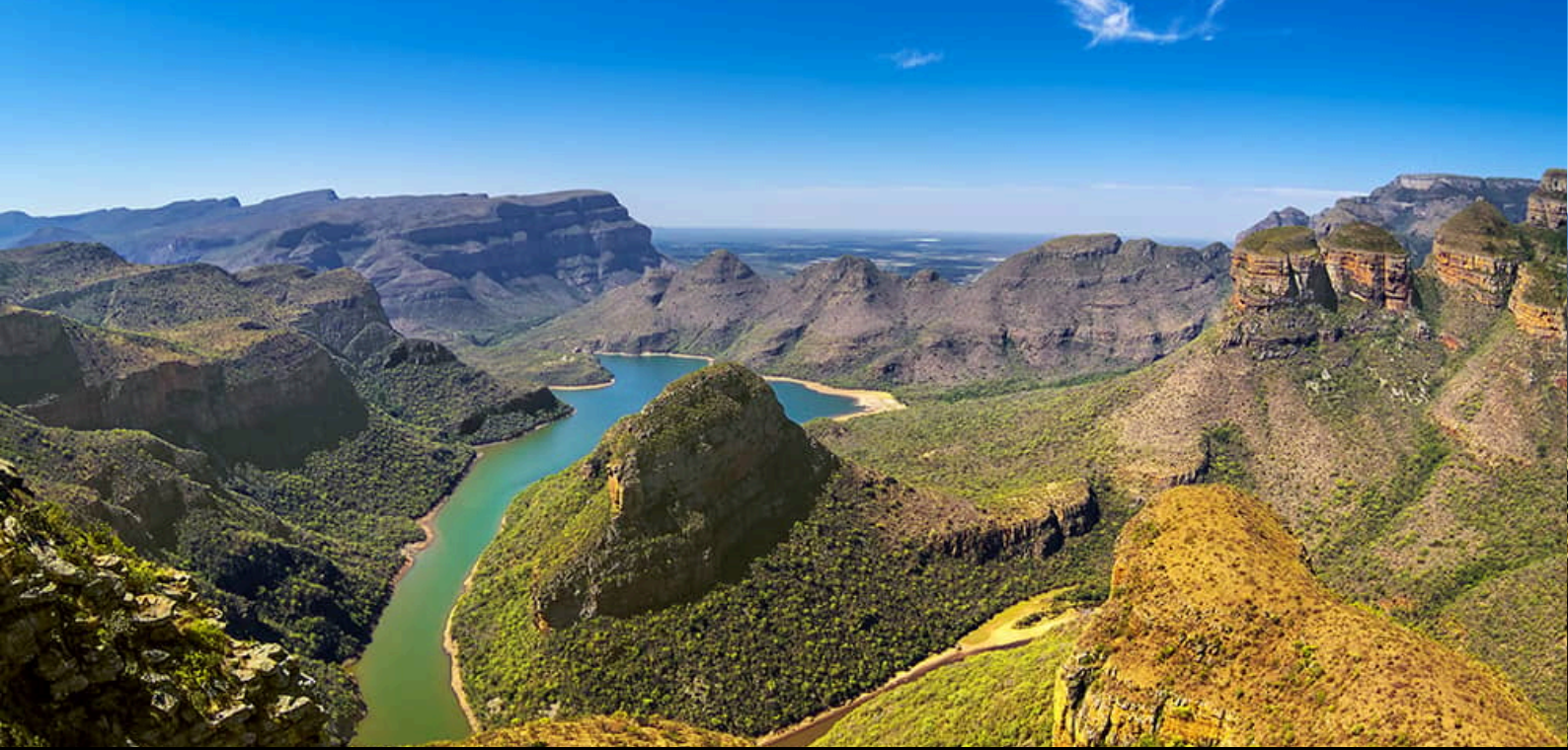

### TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

#### Tour Guide

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the

city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

#### Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

*Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.*

### CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

#### Johannesburg Area

Johannesburg is situated on the highveld plateau and has a subtropical highland climate. The city enjoys a sunny climate, with the summer months (October to April) characterised by hot days followed by afternoon thundershowers and cool evenings, and the winter months (May to September) by dry, sunny days followed by cold nights. Temperatures in Johannesburg are usually fairly mild due to the city's high elevation, with an average maximum daytime temperature in January of 25.6°C, dropping to an average maximum of around 16°C in June. The UV index for Johannesburg in summers is extreme, often reaching 14-16 due to the high elevation and proximity to the equator.

#### Eswatini

13°C in the morning and 27°C in the afternoon. June, July & August – Morning game drives in open vehicles will be cold, so it's advisable to pack warm winter clothing. The average morning temperature is 10°C.

## Cape Town

Cape Town has a Mediterranean-style climate: wet and cool winters, and dry and warm summers. The annual average temperature in Cape Town is a delightful 17°C.

### Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points
