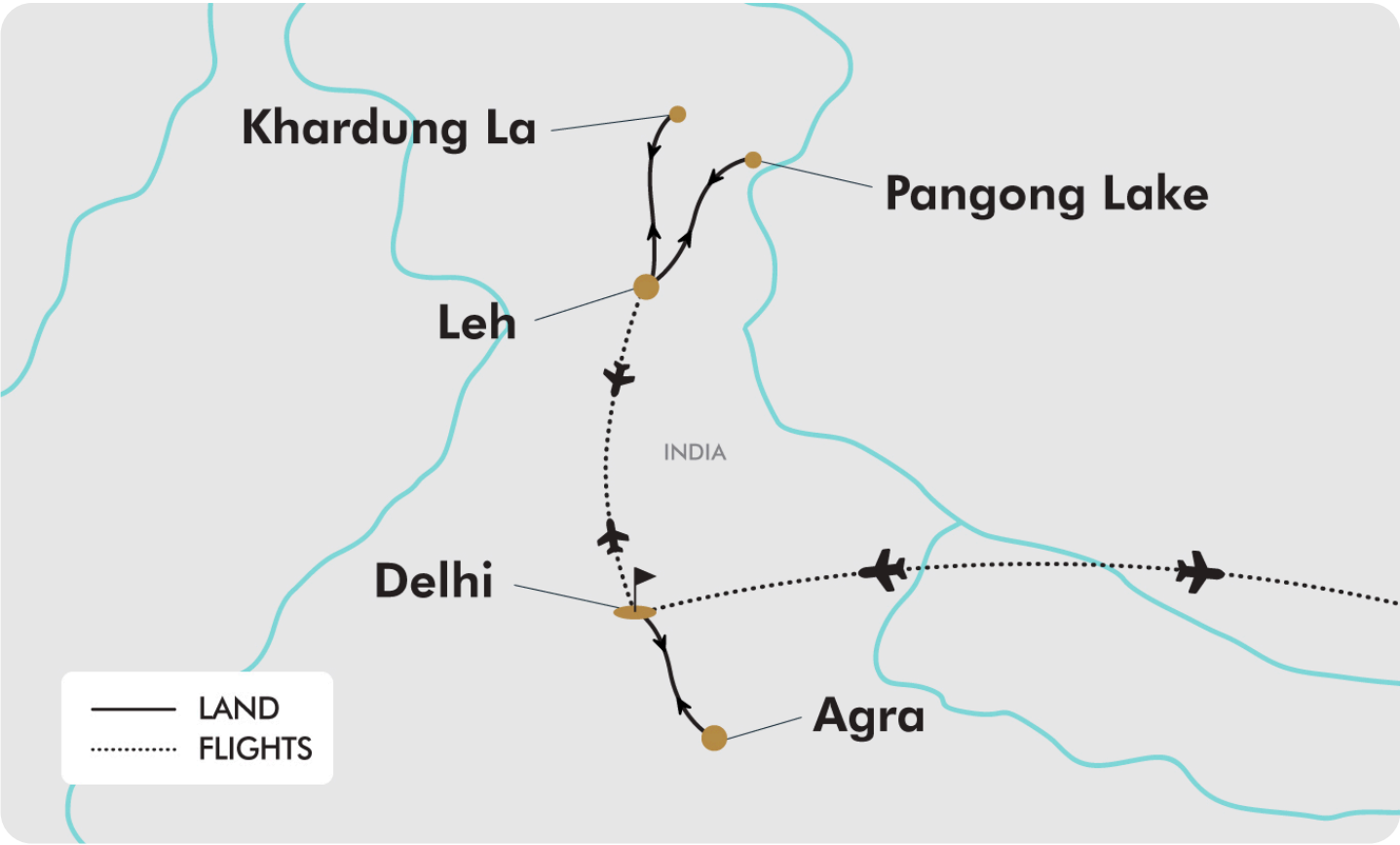

Day 2 Delhi City Tour

Enjoy breakfast before embarking on a fascinating full-day city tour exploring both Old and New Delhi.

Your journey begins at Raj Ghat, the serene memorial site where Mahatma Gandhi was cremated. You'll then continue to the magnificent Red Fort, an iconic masterpiece built by Mughal

Emperor Shah Jahan. Marvel at the imposing Jama Masjid before heading to the vibrant Chandni Chowk that's teeming with colours and aromas.

Transition to the grandeur of New Delhi with stops at Laxmi Narayan Temple and the towering 42-metre India Gate war memorial. Pass by the stately President's official residence, also known as Rashtrapati Bhavan with its striking blend of Mughal and Western architectural styles. Your day then concludes at the serene Lotus Temple, a Bahá'í marvel set amidst tranquil gardens that's open to people of all faiths for prayer and meditation.

Following the city tour, you'll return to the hotel for an evening at leisure.

It's nestled between 2 of the world's mightiest mountain ranges, the Karakoram to the north and the Great Himalayas to the south. This high-altitude desert is defined by rugged peaks, dramatic valleys and pristine lakes such as Tso Moriri, Tso Kar and the famed Pangong Tso.

You'll then visit the iconic Hemis Monastery, the largest and most famous monastery in Ladakh which is renowned for its vibrant festivals and rich cultural heritage. Nestled in a picturesque valley, Hemis offers a glimpse into the region's deep spiritual roots.

Afterwards, you'll stop at the historic Shey Palace which was once the summer retreat of Ladakh's royal family. Marvel at its striking architecture and the magnificent Shakyamuni Buddha statue housed within.

This day promises a profound connection to Ladakh's spiritual and cultural essence.

Day 5 Khardung La

Featured in the Guinness Book of World Records, this engineering marvel offers unparalleled views of snow-capped peaks and rugged landscapes.

Located north of Leh, Khardung La serves as the gateway to the enchanting Shyok and Nubra Valleys. The pass is also a critical route for transporting supplies to the remote Siachen Glacier, the world's highest battlefield.

Opened to the public in 1988, Khardung La has become a bucket list destination for adventurers attracting automobile, motorbike and mountain biking enthusiasts from around the globe. At the summit, soak in the breathtaking beauty of the surrounding Himalayas with the crisp mountain air and serene views making it an experience to cherish.

Day 6 Pangong Lake

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before embarking on a full-day adventure to Pangong Lake, one of Ladakh's most iconic natural wonders. Your journey takes you through the Changla Pass, the world's third-highest motorable pass at an altitude of 17,586 feet. En route you'll pass through the charming villages of Durbuk and Tangtse, located in the picturesque Changthang region.

Pangong Lake, a breathtaking expanse of saline water, stretches 120 kilometres in length and spans approximately 7 kilometres at its widest point. The lake's vibrant blue hues and serene

surroundings make it a haven for nature lovers. It's bisected by the international border between India and China, adding to its mystique.

Begin at the Taj Mahal, the ultimate symbol of love and devotion. Its intricate white marble architecture and timeless beauty continue to captivate visitors from around the world.

Afterwards, you'll explore the historic Agra Fort, a grand UNESCO World Heritage site. This red sandstone fortress was once the royal residence of the Mughal emperors. It was here that Shah Jahan was imprisoned by his son Aurangzeb, spending his final years gazing at the Taj Mahal from a distance. Highlights within the fort include the Pearl Mosque and the Halls of Public and Private Audience where history comes alive in its intricate artistry.

Wrap up your day by wandering through Agra's bustling markets, renowned for their rich heritage of handicrafts including marble inlay work, jewellery and textiles.

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

India

- Summer: April, May & June - Expect hot temperatures, very low to moderate humidity and low precipitation.
- Autumn: October & November - A pleasant climate characterised by warm days, cool nights, low humidity and low precipitation.
- Winter: December & January - Typically cool to cold temperatures with moderate humidity and low precipitation.

- Spring: February & March - Expect a pleasant climate with warm days, cool nights, low to moderate humidity and moderate precipitation.

Ladakh experiences a pleasant and inviting climate from April to September, making it the ideal time to visit. During this period, temperatures range from mild to moderately warm, typically between 5°C and 25°C, depending on the altitude and time of day. The skies remain clear, offering breathtaking views of the surrounding mountains and landscapes. While April and May mark the end of winter with cool evenings, June to September sees warmer days, particularly in the lower valleys. Rainfall is minimal due to Ladakh's location in a rain-shadow region, ensuring dry and sunny weather.

Visas

India

A tourist visa for India is a strict requirement if travelling on an Australian or New Zealand passport. You will be able to start your visa application process once you receive your final travel documentation approximately 6 weeks prior to departure.

Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*

- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
- *It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.*
