Arrive: 12:00 - Depart: 15:00

The morning starts on a high note with the passage of the Lorelei in the Upper Middle Rhine Valley. At lunchtime, the vessel arrives in Rüdesheim, a picturesque wine-making town in the Rhine Gorge. Discover the region's rich history on a walking tour and admire the magical collection of instruments at the Music Cabinet Museum (optional excursion). Or choose to take a tram ride through the vineyards of Rüdesheim on the "Wine Express", enjoy some fine wine and stroll along the quaint "Drosselgasse" (optional excursion).

Day 7 Miltenberg, Germany – Wertheim, Germany

Miltenberg - Arrive: 14:00 - Depart: 14:30

Wertheim - Arrive: 18:30 - Depart: 19:00

Today you can choose to remain onboard for a relaxing day or take the opportunity to join an optional excursion to the historic townships of Miltenberg and Wertheim (not included).

See the historic town of Miltenberg on the Main River. Some of Germany's most beautiful timbered houses can be found in Miltenberg, considered a traditional village located in the Lower Franconia district of Bavaria.

Wertheim was founded between the 7th and 8th century, and is best known for its landmark castle and mediaeval town centre.

Arrive in Würzburg - a Bavarian city at the centre of Franconian wine country, renowned for lavish baroque and rococo (late baroque) architecture. It's home to numerous wine bars, cellars and wineries that are waiting to be discovered and sampled. Relax in the afternoon and enjoy a sumptuous dinner tonight.

This evening, transit the Main and Danube Canal, and learn about this important waterway with an onboard talk.

Day 10 Nuremberg, Germany

Arrive: 07:30 - Depart: 17:00

Following breakfast, enjoy your day in the romantic old town of Nuremberg. Though largely destroyed during WWII, it has been lovingly restored and is distinguished by its mediaeval architecture, including the fortifications and stone towers of its Altstadt (Old Town).

Day 11 Regensburg, Germany

Arrive: 13:00 - Depart: 22:00

This afternoon the ship docks at one of Germany's most well preserved mediaeval cities. Regensburg is located on the most northern point of the Danube River and is known for its UNESCO world heritage architecture from many different centuries. The 13th century Regensburg Cathedral, a twin-spired Gothic landmark, is home to the Regensburger Domspatzen choir, just one of the many highlights of this city.

This evening enjoy a special Bavarian themed evening celebrating the wonderful region you have been cruising.

Day 12 Passau, Germany

Arrive: 12:00 - Depart: 16:00

Passau, a German city on the Austrian border, lies at the confluence of the Danube, Inn and Ilz rivers, and is known as the 'Three Rivers City'. The town is overlooked by the Veste Oberhaus, a 13th century hilltop fortress housing a city museum and observation tower. The old town below is known for its baroque architecture, including St. Stephen's Cathedral, which features distinctive onion-domed towers and an organ with 17,974 pipes.

Enjoy dinner as the vessel sets off toward the romantic Wachau Valley.

Day 13 Emmersdorf/Melk, Austria – Dürnstein, Austria - Vienna, Austria

Emmersdorf/Melk, Austria – Arrive: 06:30 - Depart: 11:30

Dürnstein – Arrive: 13:00 - Depart: 15:00

Vienna – Arrive: 19:15

Early this morning, dock in Emmersdorf, in the heart of the UNESCO protected cultural heritage landscape of the Wachau Valley. Travel to Melk, known for the 11th century Melk Abbey - a vast monastery built high above the town. Gold statuary adorns its domed Abbey Church, and the huge library houses mediaeval manuscripts. The Marmorsaal is a baroque hall with a ceiling fresco and red marble walls. South of Melk, gardens surround the Renaissance Schallaburg Castle, which hosts cultural exhibitions.



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The Itinerary

Durnstein is a small town on the Danube River and it's one of the most visited tourist destinations in the Wachau region. Take the opportunity to join an optional walking tour and wine tasting in Dürnstein (not included).

The Wachau Valley is an Austrian region near the Danube River, west of Vienna. It's known for its rolling hills, vineyards and fortresses. Arrive in Vienna this evening at approximately 19:15. Tonight, don't miss the opportunity to enjoy the "Sound of Vienna" concert (optional excursion).

Day 14 Vienna, Austria
Depart: 23:59

There is much to see in Vienna, Austria's capital city. It lies in the country's east on the Danube River. Its artistic and intellectual legacy was shaped by residents including Mozart, Beethoven and Sigmund Freud. The city is also known for its imperial palaces, including Schonbrunn, the Habsburgs' summer residence. In the Museumsquartier district, historic and contemporary buildings display work by Egon Schiele, Gustav Klimt and other artists.

Day 15 Bratislava, Slovakia
Arrive: 07:00 - Depart: 20:00

Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia, is set along the Danube River by the border of Austria and Hungary. It's surrounded by vineyards and the Little Carpathian Mountains and is crisscrossed with forested hiking and cycling trails. The pedestrian only, 18th century old town is known for its lively bars and cafes. Perched atop a hill, the reconstructed Bratislava Castle overlooks old town and the Danube.

Tonight, you will enjoy the Captain's Gala Dinner.

Day 16 Budapest, Hungary
Arrive: 08:30

The beautiful Hungarian capital of Budapest is a perfect finale to your trip. One of the largest cities in the European Union, it's bisected by the Danube River. Its 19th century Chain Bridge connects the hilly Buda district with flat Pest. A funicular (cable railway) runs up Castle Hill to Buda's Old Town, where the Budapest History Museum traces city life from Roman times onward. Budapest offers many interesting sites, including the largest building in Hungary, the neo gothic Parliament building, Fisherman's Bastion.

This evening enjoy a Hungarian folklore show as the ship cruises the Danube to view the beautiful city by night.

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

Visas

A tourist visa is not required for Europe for stays up to 90 days if travelling on an Australian or New Zealand passport.

EU Entry/Exit System (EES)

From October 12, 2025, a new European Entry System (EES) replaces the current manual passport-stamping process for non-EU travellers. Upon arrival in the Schengen area, Australian and New Zealand passport holders will have their fingerprints recorded and a photograph taken. Their entry and exit dates will be electronically registered. No previous action is required, but please be aware of longer wait times at border entry. From 10

April 2026, the EES will be fully operational at all external border crossing points of all the European countries (Schengen area) using the system.

European Travel Information & Authorisation System (ETIAS)

As an extension of the EES implementation introduced from 2025, ETIAS travel authorisation is a mandatory entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals travelling to any of [these 30 European countries](#), including Australian and New Zealand citizens, that will be introduced in 2026. We advise you to monitor [smartraveller.com.au](#) closer to your departure to ensure you are up to date on the requirements at the time of entry.

Important:

- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
