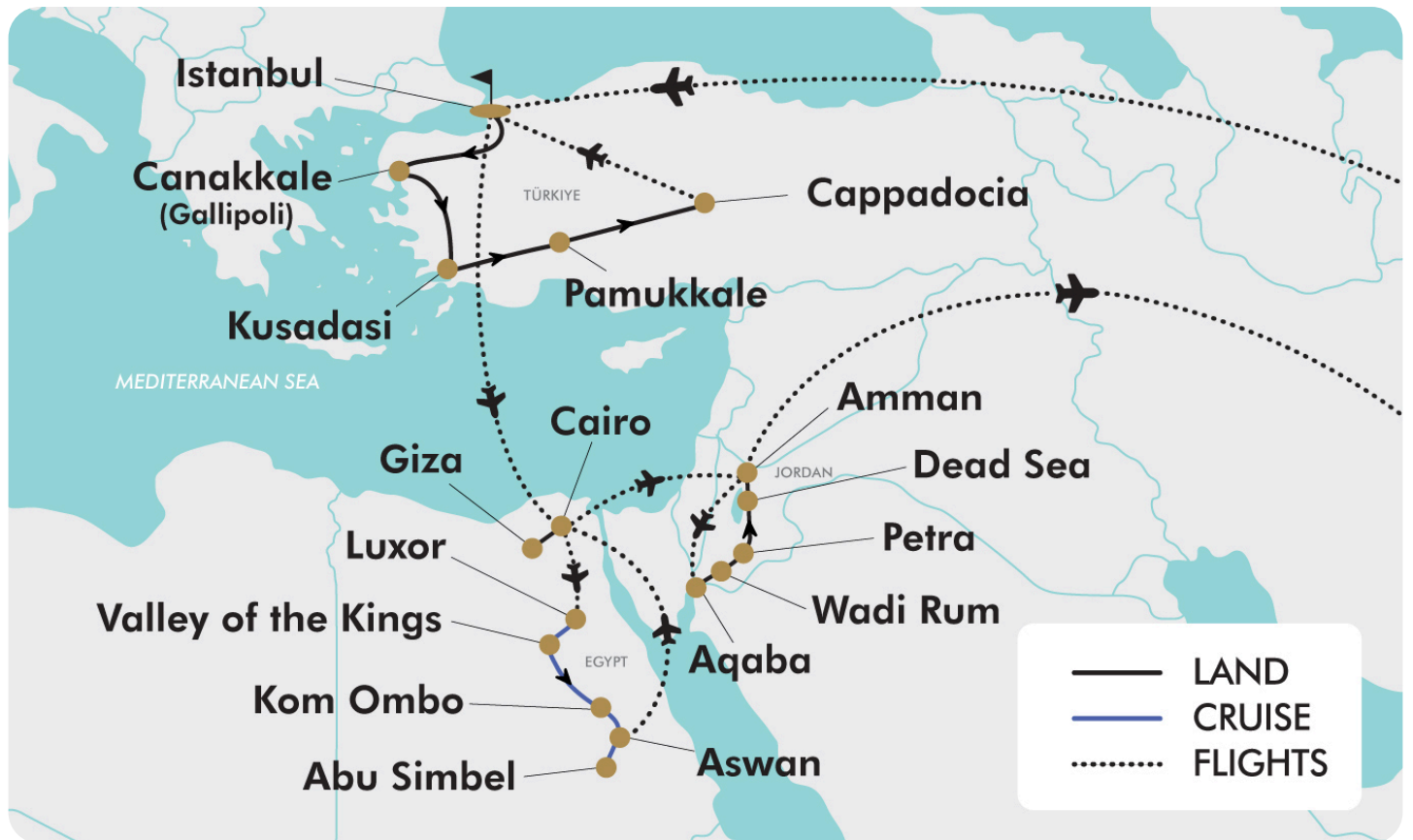

### The Itinerary

#### Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Istanbul, Türkiye

Today, you'll depart for Istanbul, Türkiye!

*Please note: Due to flight schedules and availability, some customers may be required to depart on Day 2. Affected customers will still arrive on Day 2. Other customers may depart on Day 0. Flight times will be indicated on your final documentation, which you will receive 4 to 6 weeks prior to departure.*

**Meals included: In-Flight**

#### Day 2 Welcome to Istanbul

Upon arrival at Istanbul International Airport, exit at Gate 13 where you'll be met by a tour representative and transfer to the hotel.

Istanbul is a fascinating city that crosses the 2 continents of Europe and Asia. It's an amalgamation of bazaars, minarets, mosques, churches, palaces and restaurants catering to every taste.

*Please note: If your international flight arrives at Sabiha Gokcen Airport, the tour representative will meet you at Column 9.*

**Overnight: Elite World Comfy Hotel or similar, Istanbul**

**Meals included: Dinner**

#### Day 3 Istanbul City Tour

Following breakfast this morning, you'll be picked up from the hotel for a day tour of old Istanbul.

Visit Topkapi Palace, the great palace of Ottoman sultans from the 15th to the 19th centuries, home to an exquisite collection of crystal, silver and Chinese porcelain. Robes worn by the sultans

and their families, the famous jewels of the Imperial Treasury, miniatures, the Holy Mantle and enshrining relics of the Prophet Mohammed are also featured.

See the Sultan Ahmet Imperial Mosque, built in the 16th century by the architect Mehmet. It is more commonly known as the Blue Mosque due to its magnificent interior decoration of blue Iznik tiles. Afterwards, view the ancient Hippodrome, the scene of chariot races. It also features 3 famous monuments including the Obelisk of Theodosius, the bronze Serpentine Column and the Column of Constantine.

After lunch, visit the Spice Bazaar where the air is filled with the enticing aromas of cinnamon, caraway, saffron, mint, thyme and every other conceivable herb and spice.

*Please note: Topkapi Palace is closed on Tuesdays and will be replaced with a visit to the Turkish Islamic Art Museum.*

**Overnight: Elite World Comfy Hotel or similar, Istanbul**

**Meals included: Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner**

#### Day 4 Istanbul - Day at Leisure

Today, enjoy a full day at leisure to explore this magnificent city! Istanbul is a treasure trove of historical, cultural and culinary experiences.

A shuttle bus will be organised from the hotel to the city centre, departing at 10:00 in the morning and returning in the late afternoon at 16:30. If you would like to explore the city at leisure for longer, taxis are easily accessible from the city back to the hotel.

### The Itinerary

#### Day 5 Gallipoli Tour - Canakkale

Today, depart for Gallipoli on an approximately 315-kilometre journey. Along the way, there will be a rest stop in a restaurant area.

Arrive in Gallipoli around midday and enjoy lunch before departing for the battlefields. Visit Ari Burnu Cemetery, Anzac Cove, Beach Cemetery, Shrapnel Valley and Plugge's Plateau.

Afterwards, head to Canakkale for the night.

**Overnight:** Iris Hotel or similar, Canakkale

**Meals included:** Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner

#### Day 6 Canakkale - Troy Tour - Pergamon Tour - Kusadasi

Visit the famous archaeological site of Troy, known for the Trojan Horse and story of Helen of Troy.

After the tour, drive to Pergamon, and on arrival enjoy lunch before a tour of the acropolis of Pergamon. Its impressive temples and library made it a cultural and political centre at the time.

In the evening, arrive in Kusadasi for dinner after an approximately 400-kilometre journey.

**Overnight:** Proxima Hotel or similar, Kusadasi

**Meals included:** Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner

#### Day 7 Ephesus Tour & Sirince Vineyards Tour

Enjoy a guided tour of Ephesus, one of the best preserved ancient sites in the world. Visiting the Temple of Artemis, Curetes Street, the Roman baths, the Celsus Library, the Grand Theatre and the House of the Virgin Mary. After lunch, visit a place that continues to perform one of the oldest arts of Türkiye, a carpet weaving centre.

Afterward, enjoy a tour of the Turkish village of Sirince, a pretty village that mostly dates back to the 19th century with original white-painted houses. Before returning to the hotel, visit one of the most famous leather production centres of the region.

**Overnight:** Proxima Hotel or similar, Kusadasi

**Meals included:** Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner

#### Day 8 Kusadasi - Pamukkale Tour

After breakfast, depart on an approximately 200-kilometre journey to Pamukkale. Upon arrival, check into the hotel and enjoy lunch.

Then, visit the famous calcium terraces of Pamukkale and the ruins of Hierapolis. Walk around this natural phenomenon and enjoy the option to lay in the mineral-rich waters of the natural springs.

**Overnight:** Pam Thermal Hotel or similar, Pamukkale

**Meals included:** Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner

#### Day 9 Pamukkale - Konya - Cappadocia

After an early breakfast, depart to Konya at approximately 08:00. Enjoy a break for coffee (not included) before getting back on the road, aiming to arrive in Konya for lunch around 13:00.

### The Itinerary

After lunch, visit the imposing green-tiled Mausoleum of Mevlana, the mystic founder of the Sufi sect (Whirling Dervishes).

Depart for Cappadocia, arriving at around 18:30 to check into your hotel after an approximately 640-kilometre journey.

*Please note: If you wish to join the optional hot air balloon activity tomorrow, please speak with your guide and register as it will take place early the next morning (paid on tour).*

**Overnight: Gamirasu Cave Hotel or similar, Cappadocia**  
**Meals included: Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner**

#### Day 10 Cappadocia Tour

Today, experience a tour of Cappadocia. Drive to Ozkonak Underground City, one of the area's best-preserved underground cities, before visiting Uchisar Castle, the highest point of Cappadocia. Visit Goreme Open Air Museum which is famous for its frescoes that depict the life of Jesus Christ and monks.

After lunch, discover how pottery is made at a local workshop, visit Pasabagi to see three-headed fairy chimneys, then visit another workshop to be immersed in handwoven carpets and kilims. The next stop is Devrent Valley, also called Imagination Valley, filled with natural rock formations. Enjoy time at leisure for shopping at a handicrafts centre before stopping at the Three Beauties, the symbol of Cappadocia.

Optional Activity: Hot Air Ballooning in Cappadocia (book on tour, not included)

Early this morning, why not take the opportunity to join an amazing optional experience? Take a hot air balloon over the spectacular landscape of Cappadocia. Book on tour, not included.

#### *Please note:*

- *As you can appreciate, Hot Air Ballooning is a highly sought after bucket list adventure and is dependent on good weather conditions. As a result, prices can fluctuate quite dramatically and we recommend researching before you travel so that you can manage your travel budget.*
- *If you wish to embark on the balloon journey then please inform the tour leader the day prior.*

#### Day 11 Cappadocia - Istanbul

Today, head to Kayseri Airport for an internal flight to Istanbul. Upon arrival, enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

#### Day 12 Istanbul, Türkiye - Cairo, Egypt

This morning, check out of your hotel and be transferred to the airport for your international flight to Cairo, Egypt.

Upon arrival, be met by your tour guide and transferred to your hotel.

### The Itinerary

#### Day 13 Pyramids of Giza & Sphinx

Your Egyptian odyssey begins at the incredible Great Pyramids of Giza and the nearby Sphinx. Initially standing at 147 metres high and 230 metres wide at its base, the Great Pyramid of Khufu (Cheops) is a breathtaking man-made structure, built from enormous stone blocks with a white limestone covering. Together with the smaller pyramids, the sight of these huge structures is unforgettable.

Afterwards, visit the ancient capital of Memphis and the famous Step Pyramid of Saqqara.

**Overnight: Oasis Pyramids Hotel or similar, Cairo**

**Meals included: Breakfast; Lunch**

#### Day 14 Giza - Luxor - Depart 5-Star Nile River Cruise

This morning, transfer to Cairo Airport for an internal flight to Luxor in Upper Egypt. Upon arrival, explore the fascinating Karnak Temple, dedicated to the Pharaoh Amun and once linked to the Luxor Temple by the 3-kilometre-long Avenue of Sphinxes.

In the afternoon, be transferred to the Luxor cruise port to embark on a 4-night Nile River cruise.

*Please note: Some cruises depart 1 day later, when this is the case, the Day 19 Cairo excursion activities will be moved to Day 14 instead.*

**Overnight: Royal Ruby OR MS Sarah or similar**

**Meals included: Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner**

#### Day 15 Valley of the Kings & River Cruise

This morning, the ship will cross to the West Bank of the Nile to explore the Valley of the Kings, known as the "Gateway to the Afterlife". Many of the tombs within the valley were once filled with an abundance of antiquities. While many have suffered at the hands of grave robbers, others thankfully have remained unscathed.

Visit Deir el-Bahari, the mortuary temple of 'Pharaoh Queen' Hatshepsut. Rising out of the desert sands in a series of terraces, it's an incredible sight to behold. On the way back to the river, the road passes by the famed Colossi of Memnon, 2 massive stone statues of the Pharaoh Amenhotep III.

**Overnight: Royal Ruby OR MS Sarah or similar**

**Meals included: Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner**

#### Day 16 Temple of Horus, Temple of Kom Ombo & River Cruise

This morning, visit the magnificent Temple of Horus. The temple was the 'home' and cultural centre of the falcon god Horus of Behdet (the ancient name for Edfu) and remains one of Egypt's best-preserved temples.

Once back onboard, continue sailing to the Temple of Kom Ombo. Dedicated to Sobek the crocodile god and Horus the falcon-headed god, the temple occupies a stunning location overlooking the Nile. In the afternoon, the cruise continues to Aswan.

Tonight, experience a galabeya (a traditional Egyptian garment) party on board.

#### Day 17 Abu Simbel & River Cruise

Enjoy an early start this morning to cross the desert to visit the incredible Abu Simbel. This was originally carved out of the mountainside during the reign of Pharaoh Ramses II in the 13th century BC, as a monument to himself and his queen, Nefertari. The complex was relocated to higher ground in 1968 to make way for the Aswan High Dam reservoir.

In the afternoon, relax onboard a traditional felucca (sailing boat) as you cruise down the Nile towards Aswan.

**Overnight:** Royal Ruby OR MS Sarah or similar  
**Meals included:** Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner

#### Day 18 Disembark River Cruise - Aswan City Tour - Cairo

After breakfast, disembark the cruise ship in Aswan before enjoying a sightseeing tour of the city. See highlights such as the impressive Aswan High Dam, the picturesque Temple of Isis on Philae Island and the Unfinished Obelisk.

Afterwards, transfer to the Aswan airport for your flight to Cairo.

**Overnight:** Oasis Pyramids Hotel or similar, Cairo  
**Meals included:** Breakfast; Dinner

#### Day 19 Cairo City Tour

Today, visit the 12th-century Saladin Citadel of Cairo and the Mohammed Ali Mosque. Afterwards, discover the 14th-century Khan el-Khalili Bazaar which is famous for its handmade crafts.

In the afternoon, explore the world-famous Egyptian Museum (2026 departures) or the Grand Egyptian Museum (2027 departures), home to a staggering number of ancient Egyptian artifacts.

#### Please note:

- *If travelling in 2026 the visit is to the Egyptian Museum in Cairo. The Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM) is only included when travelling in 2027, but a visit to the GEM can be arranged at your leisure for an additional cost.*
- *If travelling in 2027 the visit is to the Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM). The Egyptian Museum in Cairo is not included in this itinerary, but a visit can be arranged at your leisure for an additional cost.*

**Overnight:** Oasis Pyramids Hotel or similar, Cairo  
**Meals included:** Breakfast

#### Day 20 Cairo - Aqaba

Today, you will be transferred to the Cairo Airport for your flight to Aqaba, Jordan. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to the hotel.

#### Please note:

- *Due to flight schedules and availability, travellers may be subject to a longer transit time in Amman before flying onwards to Aqaba.*
- *If there are no suitable connecting flights available from Amman to Aqaba, you will be transferred approximately 330 kilometres from Amman to Aqaba by coach.*

**Meals included:** Breakfast

### The Itinerary

#### Day 21 Aqaba (Red Sea) - Wadi Rum

After breakfast, head to Wadi Rum, a protected desert wilderness in southern Jordan. It features dramatic sandstone mountains like the many-domed Jebel Um Ishrin and natural arches such as Burdah Rock Bridge.

Many prehistoric inscriptions and carvings line rocky caverns and steep chasms, such as Khazali Canyon. The natural watering hole of Lawrence's Spring is named after British lieutenant T.E. Lawrence (best known as Lawrence of Arabia), who allegedly washed there. Enjoy an exciting jeep tour through the dunes before riding a camel through the uniquely shaped landscape.

Tonight, enjoy accommodation in a Bedouin-style glamping desert camp under a blanket of stars.

**Overnight: Magic Camp or similar, Wadi Rum**  
**Meals included: Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner**

#### Day 22 Wadi Rum - Petra

After breakfast, depart approximately 110 kilometres for Petra, home to the iconic Lost City of Petra.

On the way, enjoy stopping at 'Little Petra', which is believed to be a suburb of the Lost City. With a history dating back some 9,000 years, it's one of the oldest archaeological sites in the Middle East.

Afterwards, continue to Petra for the night.

**Overnight: Sella Hotel or similar, Petra**  
**Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner**

#### Day 23 The Lost City of Petra

Today, visit the famous Lost City of Petra. Inhabited since prehistoric times, this Nabataean caravan-city, situated between the Red and the Dead Sea, was an important crossroads between Arabia, Egypt and Syria-Phoenicia. Petra is half-built and half-carved into rock while being surrounded by mountains riddled with passages and gorges. It's one of the world's most famous archaeological sites where ancient Eastern traditions blend with Hellenistic architecture. Travel along the Siq, the main entrance which is a natural passage between 2 mountains, leading to the Treasury, the most elaborate temple in Petra.

**Overnight: Sella Hotel or similar, Petra**  
**Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner**

#### Day 24 Petra - Dead Sea

This morning, continue north to visit Shobak Castle and the Crusader fortress of Kerak.

Afterwards, travel approximately 200 kilometres to the Dead Sea which is the lowest point on Earth. The Dead Sea is a salt lake with banks more than 400 metres below sea level, the lowest point on dry land. Its famously hypersaline water makes floating easy while its mineral-rich black mud is used for therapeutic and cosmetic treatments.

**Overnight: Grand East Hotel or similar, The Dead Sea**  
**Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner**

#### Day 25 Jerash Excursion

Today, visit the beautifully preserved city of Jerash. This Roman city is known for its cardo arches, theatres and Roman churches.

Visit Umm Qais, another Roman city with stunning views of Mount Tabor. Afterwards, visit the impressive Ajloun Castle before departing to Amman for the night.

In the evening, join a cooking class with your fellow travellers and enjoy each others creations during a group dinner.

**Overnight: Amman Days Inn Hotel or similar, Amman**

**Meals included: Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner**

#### Day 26 Madaba Excursion

Today, travel to Madaba to see a beautiful mosaic map of the Holy Land in the Greek Orthodox church of St George. You'll then continue to the biblical site of Mount Nebo which overlooks the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea. Mount Nebo is where Moses was granted a view of the Promised Land.

**Overnight: Amman Days Inn Hotel or similar, Amman**

**Meals included: Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner**

#### Day 27 Amman, Jordan - Australia (or New Zealand)

Today, transfer to the airport for your return flight home.

Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

## CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

### Egypt

There is never a shortage of sunshine in Egypt, with averages of 11 hours a day during the summer and 8 hours a day in winter. From April to October the average temperature ranges from 21-28°C while between November and March, this drops to 13-20°C. This does vary along the Mediterranean coast which, while still warm, is more prone to periods of cloud and rain in winter. Generally, winters in Egypt are warm enough to allow pleasant and comfortable travelling all year long, though travellers should be prepared for cold nights.

### Jordan

For ideal sightseeing conditions, the best time to visit Jordan is during the spring (March-May) and autumn (September to November) months. At these times of the

year, the temperatures are cool enough to spend your days exploring Jordan's iconic sites.

## Türkiye

### Istanbul

Temperatures in May/June and September/October are between 22 and 30°C. January/December has an average temperature of around 15°C.

### Cappadocia

Cappadocia has a continental climate characterised by dry summers and sometimes snowy winters. Rainfall is sparse and the region is largely semi-arid to arid. There is a sharp difference in the temperature between day and night and it is not uncommon to have cold nights interspersed with hot days.

### Kusadasi

There are two main seasons in Kusadasi: the cold season and hot season, which basically correlate with winter and summer in other parts of Europe. The shoulder seasons, autumn and spring, experience weather patterns that are a mix of both the cold and warm seasons.

## Weather

We always suggest referring to an online source for the most up-to-date weather information for your destination/s.

## FLIGHTS

### Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points
