Norfolk Island, located in the South Pacific Ocean, has a subtropical climate with mild temperatures throughout the year. The climate on Norfolk Island can be generally described as pleasant and moderate,

making it a popular destination.

Summer (December to February):

Summer on Norfolk Island is warm and humid

Average high temperatures range from 24°C to 28°C

It is the wettest season with occasional heavy rainfall and thunderstorms

Autumn (March to May):

Autumn is characterized by mild and pleasant weather

Average high temperatures range from 22°C to 25°C

Rainfall decreases as the season progresses, with March being relatively wetter than May

Winter (June to August):
