

Day 3 Paris Walking City Tour

Following breakfast this morning, you'll enjoy a half-day guided city tour of Paris with a local guide. You will begin the tour outside the imposing Notre Dame in Île de la Cité, which many consider the most significant church in Paris. It's a masterpiece of French Gothic art, renowned for its stunning stained glass windows, flying buttresses and intricate statues. Not far from Notre Dame, you will see the Palace of the Conciergerie, formerly a prison but presently used for practicing law. The prison housed as many as 1,200 prisoners in its heyday, including the infamous Queen of France, Marie Antoinette. You'll then continue to the Latin Quarter, the literary and intellectual area and home to the former University of Sorbonne. Afterwards, admire the impressive Luxembourg Garden and Saint Germain des Pres (entrances not included). Head through the Les Halles shopping district (formerly a fresh food market in the 19th century) until you reach the George Pompidou Cultural Centre, built in 1977 by the famous architect Renzo Piano as the Museum of Contemporary Art. You'll then finish your tour on a high by seeing the centrepiece of Paris' cityscape, the Eiffel Tower (entrance not included), before enjoying the remainder of the day

Day 4 Paris - Cannes - Nice

This morning, travel aboard the TGV high-speed train (approximately 5 hours) to Cannes on the glittering French Riviera. Best known for its annual film festival, the coastal city is brimming with luxury hotels, sunny seaside restaurants, and gorgeous stretches of beach. From Cannes, travel along the scenic Riviera to Nice, arriving late afternoon.

Nestled between the south of France and the Tuscan border lies the region of Liguria, with verdant mountains to the north and east and the sapphire-blue Mediterranean to the south and west. In the late afternoon, arrive at your Hotel in the Genoa Area, a beautiful destination known for its beaches, colourfully painted towns and natural environment. Today's travel is approximately 230km.

Day 7 Lucca - Pisa - Florence Walking City Tour

Today, head to Pisa and marvel at the unique Leaning Tower. Continue on to Florence and enjoy a guided tour of this incredible city (approximately 3 hours). The tour will take you through some of the famous sights and attractions, including the Santa Maria del Fiore Cathedral, Piazza del Duomo, together with Piazza San Giovanni, represent the heart of the city. The most important religious monuments of Florence are here, linked by their geometric design and characterised by the typical white, green and pink marble coating. You will see the Baptistery (entrance not included) with its octagonal shape and three bronze doors; the Cathedral (entrance not included), built in Florentine Gothic style; and Giotto's Bell Tower, regarded as one of the most beautiful towers in Gothic architecture (entrance not included). The tour will continue through Piazza Signoria to the Palazzo Vecchio (entrance not included), the town hall of Florence. Admire the impressive statues that surround the piazza before continuing to the Straw Market, where the tour will end. Today, travel is approximately 110km.

After breakfast head north and arrive in Bologna for a lunch stop (not included) and free time to walk around this lively historic city, renowned for its culinary traditions. Bologna has given its name to the well-known Bolognese sauce, which in Italian is called ragù alla bolognese. Afterwards continue onto the majestic area of Venice. Upon arrival, check into the hotel and then enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. Today travel approximately 280km.

Day 10 Venice Walking City Tour

Today, you will be transferred to the Tronchetto Pier in Venice, where you will be able to admire the beautiful buildings and canals of Venice by water bus (ferry). Upon arrival, be met by a local guide at the Piazza San Marco to start a guided tour of Venice (approximately 2 hours). The tour starts at the iconic St Mark's Square, one of the most beautiful squares in the world and the hub of Venetian life. Around the square, you will see the famous St Mark's Basilica, the Doge's Palace, and the Bell Tower (entry fees not included). The church was built to house the body of St Mark, transported from Alexandria in 828 AD. Inside the basilica, you can admire glittering Byzantine Mosaics. The tour will continue onwards to Rialto Bridge, one of the most beautiful bridges in Venice and an icon of the city. Upon conclusion of the tour, enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

Venice, Italy

It is now mandatory for all tourists who are daytripping or staying less than one night in Venice to pay an entrance tax online prior to arrival. The cost of the tax will change based on the season and the turnout of tourists. Prices will range from €3 up to €10 per person, per day. Exemptions:

- Guests staying more than one night in Venice and Venice area (with proof of stay)
- Children 6 years and under
- Residents, Home owners, Students of Venice
- Tourist bus passengers

Gratuities / Tipping

Cruise Fee for Mykonos and Santorini

From the 21st July 2025, the Greek government – similarly to many other tourist destinations - will introduce a new fee defined "Cruise Fee". This fee,, is designed to support local infrastructure, promote sustainable tourism, and enhance visitors' experience. Such fee is mandatory and applies to all cruise guests regardless of age, for each day they will disembark in a Greek port.

The amount of the tax varies depending on the season and the port as follows: From June 1 to September 30: Mykonos and Santorini: €20 per person Other Greek ports: €5 per person From October 1 to October 31 and from April 1 to May 31:

Mykonos and Santorini: €12 per person Other Greek ports: €3 per person From November 1 to March 31: Mykonos and Santorini: €4 per person Other Greek ports: €1 per person

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Italy & Mediterranean

Italy is largely characterised by a typical Mediterranean climate made up of warm springs and hot and dry summers, the climate here is very pleasant. Along the coast of Southern Italy in July and August the average temperature is above 25°C. April to June and September to October are the best months to travel through southern Italy. You can expect temperatures of up to 26°C during the warmest part of the day. In the northern areas in October the average daily temperature is 14.5°C but temperatures can still reach highs of 19°C which can feel guite pleasant. Temperatures are starting to drop low during this month though, especially at night. The average minimum temperature in October is 10°C.
