Start with the city highlights of Türkiye's capital, Istanbul, from the stunning Blue Mosque and Topkapi Palace to the buzzing Spice Bazaar. Then, journey to the Gallipoli Peninsula's solemn battlefields and Kabatepe War Museum, with time to reflect among the memorials of Lone Pine cemetery. Itinerary 2 extends the adventure to explore UNESCO World Heritage sites and ancient wonders of Cappadocia. Take the chance to join an optional hot air balloon ride (not included) to watch the sun rise and float above fairy chimneys and Cappadocia's unique landscapes.

Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Istanbul, Türkiye

Today depart for Istanbul, Türkiye!

Meals included: In-Flight

Day 2 Welcome to Istanbul!

Upon arrival in Istanbul, make your way to Exit 14 where you'll be met by your English-speaking tour leader and transferred to your hotel. If it is too early to check-in, your luggage can be stored at the hotel while you explore this magnificent city (charges may apply).

Please note: If your international flight arrives at Sabiha Gokcen Airport, the tour representative will meet you at Column 9.

Day 3 Istanbul City Tour

Today, embark on a guided tour of Istanbul, a city that has witnessed the rise and fall of empires for centuries.

See iconic landmarks such as the Topkapi Palace, the Sultan Ahmed Mosque (Blue Mosque), and the Hippodrome, along with the vibrant and fragrant Spice Bazaar. Once the grand residence of Ottoman sultans from the 15th to 19th centuries, Topkapi Palace boasts a stunning collection of crystal, silver, and Chinese porcelain. Explore the opulent robes worn by the sultans and their families, admire the dazzling jewels of the Imperial Treasury, and view sacred relics, including the Holy Mantle of the Prophet Mohammed.

Nearby, the Sultan Ahmed Mosque, built between 1609 and 1616, is famously known as the Blue Mosque due to its mesmerizing blue Iznik tiles. A masterpiece of Ottoman architecture, it remains one of Istanbul's most awe-inspiring landmarks.

Step into history at the Hippodrome, now known as Sultan Ahmed Square. Once the heart of Byzantine Constantinople's social and sporting life, this ancient chariot-racing arena still holds remnants of its grand past. Marvel at the surviving monuments of the Spina, including the Serpentine Column and two towering obelisks, now set within a beautifully landscaped garden.

A sensory delight awaits at the Spice Bazaar, one of Istanbul's oldest and most atmospheric markets. Located in Eminönü, this historic bazaar is second only to the Grand Bazaar in size. Immerse yourself in the intoxicating aromas of cinnamon, saffron, caraway, mint, and countless other exotic spices.

In the evening, attend a special conference on the ANZAC Dawn Service and Türkiye (approximately 1 hour). Enjoy a welcome cocktail with coffee, tea, and snacks while meeting your fellow ANZAC Day Gallipoli tour members and the tour staff.

Set off early this morning for Gallipoli, watching the latest documentaries about the Gallipoli campaign along the way. En route, take a break on the scenic Kabatepe coast, where you'll have some free time to enjoy lunch by the sea.

Continue your exploration of the Gallipoli Peninsula, visiting key historical sites that played a significant role in the campaign. Stops include the Kabatepe War Museum, ANZAC Cove, Lone Pine Memorial and Cemetery, Quinn's Post, Turkish 57th Regiment Cemetery, The Nek, Chunuk Bair, and the New Zealand Memorial and Cemetery—each offering poignant reminders of the sacrifices made during the conflict.

After the tour, embark on a scenic journey to Çanakkale. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and enjoy the rest of the evening at your leisure.

Day 5 Troy Tour & ANZAC Cove

Today, embark on a journey to the legendary ancient city of Troy, located on the opposite side of the Dardanelles. After a scenic 1.5-hour ferry ride or bridge crossing, step into one of the most famous archaeological sites of antiquity. Your guide will bring the mythology of Troy to life, sharing tales of the Trojan War, the iconic Trojan Horse (a replica of which stands at the site), and the story of Helen of Troy, said to be the most beautiful woman in the world.

In the evening, gather at the hotel for dinner before departing late at night for ANZAC Cove, where you will spend the night in preparation for the ANZAC Day Dawn Service. Be sure to bring warm clothing, a sleeping bag, wet weather gear, a torch, a hat, sunscreen, and comfortable walking shoes. If needed, sleeping bags are available for hire at \$75 AUD per person (pre-booking required). Please add this to your order at checkout if you'd like to reserve one.

For those who prefer not to sleep outdoors at the ANZAC Commemorative Site, optional hotel accommodation in Çanakkale is available at an additional cost of \$110 AUD per person (twin share) or \$220 AUD (solo traveller). Pre-booking is required, and transfers to and from the ANZAC Commemorative Site will be provided for guests who opt for this

Please note: During your time at the commemorations walking on steep terrain and along unpaved dirt roads may be required.

Day 6 ANZAC Dawn Service at Commemorative Site Gallipoli

Today you will attend the dawn service at ANZAC Cove.

- 05:30 - 06:15 Dawn Service, ANZAC Commemorative Site, North Beach

- 11:30 - 12:15 New Zealand Memorial Service, Chunuk Bair

Please note: After attending the official Dawn Service, you can choose to attend either the Australian Memorial Service at Lone Pine, or the New Zealand Memorial Service at Chunuk Bair. Due to timing, you will not be able to attend both of these services.

This afternoon, after attending the ANZAC services, you will travel back to the hotel in Çanakkale. The night is then yours to relax before dinner is served at the hotel.

Day 7 Bergama/Pergamon Tour - Kusadasi

Today, journey to Pergamon, an ancient Hellenistic and Roman city near Bergama, once ruled by a powerful local dynasty. Explore Pergamon's fascinating ruins, including the Asklepion healing temple, and Bergama's Red Basilica.

The Asklepion, an ancient medical centre dedicated to Asklepios, the god of healing, was one of the most renowned healing sanctuaries of the ancient world. Meanwhile, the Red Basilica was originally built as a temple to the Egyptian god Osiris before being transformed into a Christian basilica in later centuries.

After a guided tour of Bergama and Pergamon, continue your journey toward Kuşadası, a charming coastal town. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and enjoy a relaxing evening with dinner.

Day 8 Ephesus & Şirince

A highlight of any visit to Türkiye, Ephesus was a city of immense wealth and influence, its grandeur reflected in its remarkable architecture. Dedicated to the goddess Artemis, the city was home to her magnificent temple, considered one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, with its final form dating back to the third century B.C.

During your guided tour, stroll along Curetes Street, marvel at the famous Roman baths, stand before the grand Celsus Library, and explore the impressive Grand Theatre, which once hosted audiences of up to 25,000 spectators. You'll also visit the House of the Virgin Mary, a revered pilgrimage site believed to be where Mary spent her final years.

After exploring Ephesus, continue your journey to Şirince, a charming hillside village known for its well-preserved Greek architecture and picturesque vineyards. Along the way, stop at a traditional carpet-weaving centre, where you can witness the artistry behind one of Türkiye's most ancient crafts.

Day 11 Cappadocia Tour

Today, immerse yourself in the wonders of Cappadocia, a truly awe-inspiring volcanic region famous for its unique geological formations, as well as its rich history of ceramics and carpet weaving. Known as Katpatuka (the “land of beautiful horses”) by the Persians, this mysterious and enchanting land offers a landscape like no other.

Your day begins with a visit to Özkonaç Underground City, where you’ll explore ancient subterranean tunnels and galleries carved into the volcanic rock of Idis Mountain. This fascinating city was built into dense layers of volcanic tuff and served as a safe haven for early inhabitants.

Next, head to the Göreme Open Air Museum, a UNESCO World Heritage site at the heart of Cappadocia. Here, you’ll discover frescoes depicting the life of Jesus Christ and early Christian monks, set against the backdrop of the region’s iconic rock formations.

Continue on to Çavuşin, an abandoned village with ancient cave dwellings and old Greek houses, offering a glimpse into the area’s historical architecture. 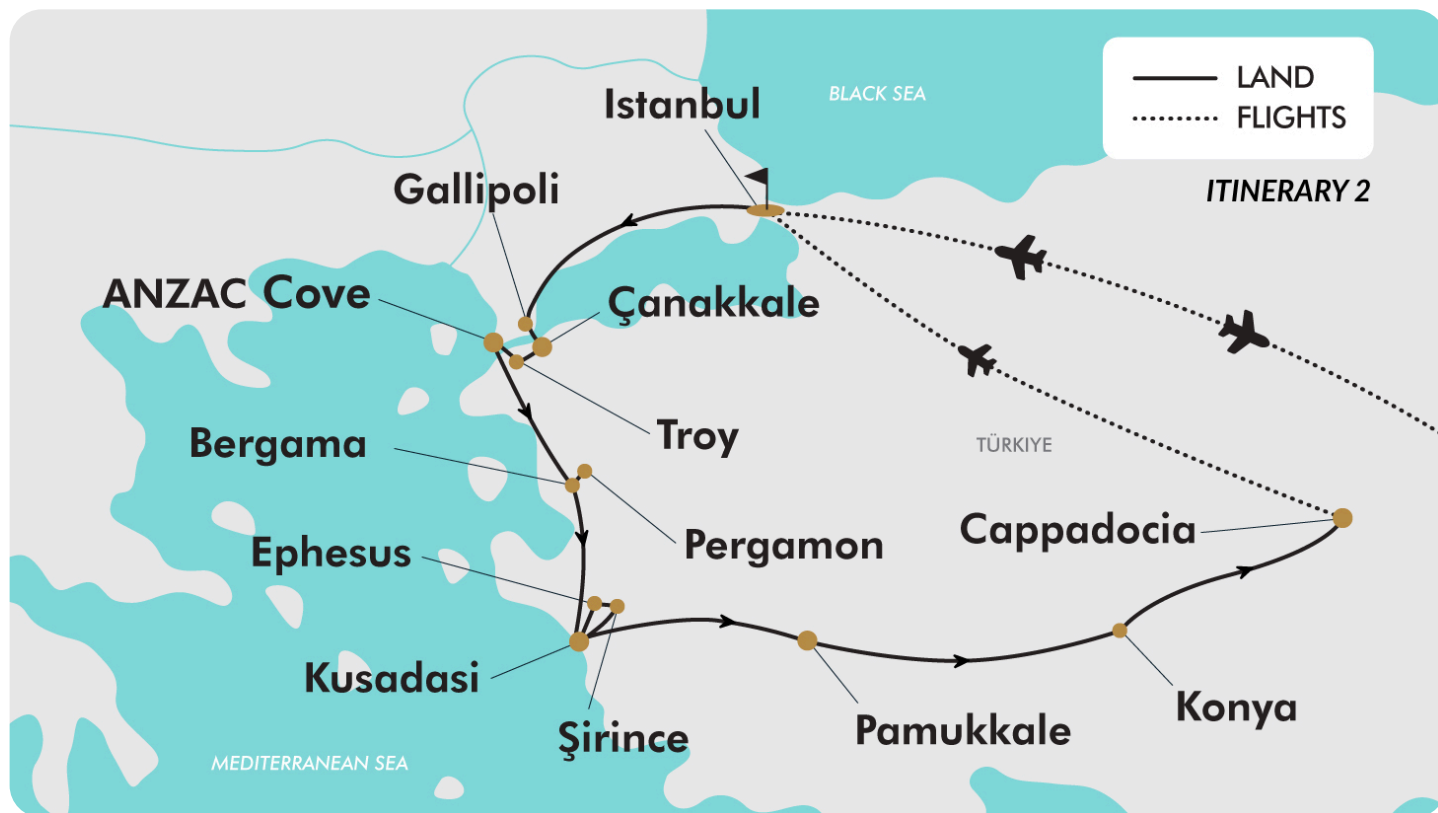

As a result, cemeteries and memorials will not be accessible on this day. The reopening time will be determined at a later date and confirmed prior to your arrival in Türkiye. Additionally, all guests must be registered for attendance passes before arrival. Further instructions regarding these passes will be provided closer to departure.

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Istanbul

For Istanbul in April, you can expect spring weather that is relatively mild and pleasant, but with some variability. Average daytime temperatures typically range from 12°C to 18°C, although it can occasionally be cooler or warmer. Nights

are cooler, and temperatures can drop to around 7°C to 12°C.

Kusadasi

There are two main seasons in Kusadasi: the cold season and the hot season, which basically correlate with winter and summer in other parts of Europe. The shoulder seasons, autumn and spring, experience weather patterns that are a mix of both the cold and warm seasons.

Gallipoli Peninsula (ANZAC Service):

Weather conditions on the Gallipoli Peninsula are highly variable. During the day, the temperature can be very hot. Strong winds and heavy rain have been experienced in previous years. Attendees should ensure they come prepared for these conditions. The commemorative sites are exposed, and there is no permanent shelter available.

Cappadocia (Extension Package)

Cappadocia has a continental climate characterised by dry summers and sometimes snowy winters. Rainfall is sparse and the region is largely semi-arid to arid. There is a sharp difference in the temperature between day and night and it is not uncommon to have cold nights interspersed with hot days.

Weather

We always suggest referring to an online source for the most up-to-date weather information for your destination/s.
