Keep your camera ready for a wealth of wildlife sightings, including elephants, giraffes, hippo, antelope and a whole host of birdlife. Top it all off with an optional sunrise hot air balloon experience (charges apply) high above these wildlife-rich plains, before your flight back home.



Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Nairobi, Kenya

Today depart from Australia (or New Zealand) to Nairobi, Kenya

Meals included: In-Flight

Day 2 Welcome to Nairobi, Kenya!

Welcome to Nairobi! Upon arrival, be met at the airport by a representative and transferred to the hotel. If it is too early for check-in, the luggage can be stored at the hotel while you enjoy time at leisure to explore Nairobi.

Nairobi, the capital of Kenya, is a vibrant and dynamic city that blends modern urban life with rich history, diverse cultures, and natural beauty. Often called the "Green City in the Sun," Nairobi is the economic, political, and cultural heart of East Africa.

Overnight: Hilton Gardens Hotel JKIA or similar, Nairobi

Meals included: None

Day 3 Nairobi - Amboseli National Park - Afternoon Game Drive

Following an early breakfast, depart from Nairobi and drive south towards Amboseli National Park (approximately 200 kilometres).

Arrive at the camp in time for lunch before embarking on your first afternoon game drive in the park. Search for lions, elephants, leopards, rhinos, buffalos, as well as wildebeest, zebras, giraffes, impalas and Thomson's gazelle.

Amboseli National Park is one of Kenya's most famous safari destinations, renowned for its large elephant herds and breathtaking views of Mount Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest peak.

Covering approximately 392 square kilometers, the park offers a diverse landscape of savannahs, wetlands, woodlands, and dry lake beds, creating a rich habitat for wildlife.

Overnight: Kibo Camp or similar, Amboseli

Meals included: Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner

Day 4 Amboseli National Park - Morning & Afternoon Game Drive

Following an early breakfast, depart for an early morning game drive to search for the magnificent wildlife. Amboseli is best known for its huge elephant population, with over 1,600 individuals, including some of the largest tuskers in Africa. Don't forget to bring your camera!

Afterwards, enjoy some time at leisure at the camp, before setting off for another game drive in the afternoon. As the sun sets, return to the camp and settle back for an evening at leisure.

Overnight: Kibo Camp or similar, Amboseli

Meals included: Breakfast; Lunch; Dinner

Day 5 Amboseli, Kenya - Arusha, Tanzania - Karatu

After an early breakfast, savor your final glimpses of the majestic Mount Kilimanjaro as you bid farewell to Amboseli.

Journey towards the Namanga Border, where, following customs formalities, you will be warmly welcomed into Tanzania by your English-speaking tour guide. From here, embark on a scenic transfer to Arusha, nestled at the foot of the striking Mount Meru. Arriving just in time for a delightful lunch.

Day 6 Ngorongoro Crater

A truly unforgettable experience awaits you this morning as you set out to explore what is often hailed as the world's largest natural wildlife sanctuary.

After a hearty breakfast, descend 2,000 feet through the ethereal morning mist into the breathtaking Ngorongoro Crater, a UNESCO-listed marvel and the world's largest intact volcanic caldera. Within this vast and diverse ecosystem, the crater floor unveils a mesmerising tapestry of landscapes, from dense forests and tranquil swamps to shimmering lakes, bubbling springs, sweeping grasslands, and golden sand dunes. Ngorongoro Crater boasts one of the highest concentrations of wildlife in Africa, making it an exceptional safari destination. The crater floor supports around 25,000 to 30,000 animals, including all members of the 'Big Five'. As the afternoon light begins to fade, ascend from the crater and return to your lodge in time for dinner.

Day 7 Karatu - Serengeti National Park - Afternoon Game Drive

Keep your eyes peeled, as wildlife sightings may begin well before you even reach the park's borders.

After covering approximately 190 kilometers, arrive at your camp for lunch. Later, set out on an exhilarating afternoon game drive, immersing yourself in the untamed beauty of the Serengeti. Serengeti National Park is one of the most iconic safari destinations in the world, renowned for its vast plains, diverse wildlife, and the breathtaking Great Migration.

Serengeti is best known for hosting the Great Migration, where it's estimated that over 1.5 million wildebeest, 200,000 zebras, and 400,000 gazelles move in search of fresh grazing lands, making it the largest land migration on Earth. This dramatic journey is full of peril, as predators such as lions, cheetahs, leopards, and crocodiles wait for an opportunity to strike.

The park is home to the Big Five; lions, leopards, elephants, buffaloes, and rhinos, as well as giraffes, hippos, hyenas, and countless bird species. As the sun dips below the horizon, return to camp in time for dinner, reflecting on the day's incredible encounters.

Tour Guide

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

GREAT MIGRATION - IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Great Migration in East Africa is one of the world's most spectacular wildlife events but unlike many migrations that happen seasonally in a short burst, this one is a continuous, year-round cycle. Over 1.5-2 million wildebeest, along with hundreds of thousands of zebras and gazelles, are constantly on the move through Tanzania's Serengeti and Kenya's Maasai Mara in search of fresh grazing and water.

Here's how the continuous event works through the year:

- December - March: Calving season in

the southern Serengeti/Ndutu area.

- April – May: Herds start moving northwest through the central Serengeti as the plains dry out.
- June – July: The western corridor and Grumeti River crossings.
- July – September: The famous Mara River crossings into Kenya's Maasai Mara.
- October – November: Herds move back south through the Serengeti as rains return, restarting the cycle.

Please note: Wildlife movements are influenced by rainfall and seasonal conditions. While this cycle provides a general guide, sightings can vary and specific experiences cannot be guaranteed.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Kenya: Inland & Highland Areas (Nairobi, Amboseli & more)

Milder and Less Humid: These areas, including Nairobi, are generally cooler and less humid than the coast, with temperatures typically ranging from 12°C to 25°C. Cooler Nights: Nights can be quite cold, especially in the highlands, where temperatures can occasionally drop close to freezing.

Tanzania

From July to August, Tanzania's weather is generally the coolest, the sunniest and the driest. June is a good month almost everywhere, but in the north-east the long rains can linger on until this month.

September is also a good month, but at lower elevations the days can be hot. In October, the season of the short rains begins in the north, though in the first half of the month, there is usually little rain, however, it can get hot at low altitudes. In November, rain tends to fall overnight, this is an ideal month for nature lovers as the land blooms.
