Visas

United States of America

Australian passport holders must obtain an ESTA visa waiver in order to enter or transit in the United States.

Please note: You may be required to obtain a visa if you do not meet the eligibility requirements of the ESTA program. Please see https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov for full eligibility requirements and applications.

Canada

If transiting via Canada on the way to the USA, Australian and New Zealand passport holders must apply for an electronic travel authorisation (eTA) before travelling to Canada by air. An Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) is an entry requirement for visa-exempt foreign nationals travelling to Canada by air. An eTA is electronically linked to a traveller's passport. It is valid for up to five years or until the passport expires, whichever comes first. If you get a new passport, you need to get a new eTA. If you arrive in Canada by train, bus, or boat, you don't need a visa or eTA, but you do need to bring the right travel documents.

Dominican Republic

For Australian passport holders, A visa is not required for this destination for up to 30 days. Please keep in mind that while a visa is not required, you must complete an Electronic Ticket at

https://eticket.migracion.gob.do/ before entering and exiting the country and hold a passport valid for at least six months with at least one blank visa page

Puerto Rico

Australian passport holders must obtain an ESTA visa waiver in order to enter or transit in the United States.

St Kitts & Nevis

Australian passport holders are Visa exempt for a stay of up to 90 days. The traveller must hold a passport valid at least six months beyond the period of intended stay with one blank visa page

Aruba

Australian passport holders are Visa exempt for a stay of up to 90 days. The

traveller must hold a passport valid at least six months on entry with one blank visa page

Colombia

Australian passport holders are A visa is not required for this destination for a stay of up to 90 days. Please keep in mind that while a visa is not required, you must hold a passport valid at least six months beyond your date of country exit and with one blank visa page

Jamaica

Australian passport holders are Visa exempt for the duration of the passport validity. The traveller must hold a passport valid at least six months beyond the period of intended stay with one blank visa page

Grand Cayman

Visa exempt for a stay of up to six months. The traveller must hold a passport valid at least six months beyond the period of intended stay with one blank visa page
