CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Las Vegas

From September to May, Las Vegas experiences a wide range of temperatures, transitioning from hot late-summer days to mild winter months and warming springtime weather. In September. temperatures are still high, ranging from 22°C to 37°C, but by October and November, they cool to a more comfortable 14°C to 29°C. December through February brings the coolest weather, with daytime temperatures ranging from 4°C to 19°C, and chilly nights. March to May sees a steady warmup, with temperatures rising from 10°C to 32°C by late spring. Overall, this period offers mostly dry, sunny weather ideal for exploring the city and surrounding desert.

Eastern Caribbean

From September to May, the weather in





the Eastern Caribbean is generally warm, tropical, and inviting, though there are some variations across the months. In September to November, temperatures are typically between 24°C and 31°C, with higher humidity and occasional rain showers due to the hurricane season, which peaks in September. From December to February, the region enjoys its dry season, with cooler and more comfortable temperatures ranging from 22°C to 29°C, and less humidity, making it ideal for outdoor activities. In March to May, temperatures begin to warm again, ranging from 24°C to 31°C, with sunny skies and pleasant conditions perfect for beachgoers and adventurers.

Western Caribbean

From September to May, the weather in the Western Caribbean is typically warm and tropical, with some seasonal variation. September to November sees temperatures ranging from 24°C to 32°C, with high humidity and occasional rain showers due to the hurricane season, which peaks in September. The region experiences drier and cooler conditions from December to February, with temperatures ranging from 21°C to 29°C, making it a great time to visit for comfortable outdoor activities and less humidity. In March to May, temperatures rise again to 24°C to 32°C, with sunny skies and pleasant weather, ideal for exploring the islands and relaxing on the beaches.

Miami

From September to May, Miami enjoys a warm tropical climate with distinct seasonal changes. September to November is still part of the hot, humid summer season, with temperatures ranging from 24°C to 31°C and occasional rain showers, especially during the hurricane season. December through February brings cooler, more comfortable weather, with temperatures ranging from 18°C to 26°C and lower humidity, making it the perfect time to enjoy outdoor activities and beaches. March to May sees temperatures warming up again, ranging from 21°C to

29°C, with sunny skies and pleasant conditions, making it an ideal time for visitors to explore the city and its coastal attractions.

Canada

An Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) is an entry requirement for visa-exempt foreign nationals travelling to Canada by air. An eTA is electronically linked to a traveller's passport. It is valid for up to five years or until the passport expires, whichever comes first. If you get a new passport, you need to get a new eTA. If you are not travelling via Canada by air, and are only visiting by boat, you will not require an eTA if you are an Australian or New Zealand citizen.

St Maarten (Dutch Caribbean)

Australian passport holders are visa exempt for an accumulative total stay of 90 days per 180 calendar days. The traveller must hold a passport valid at least six months on entry with two blank visa pages

St Thomas (U.S. Virgin Islands)

If travelling on an Australian Passport, an ESTA (Visa Waiver) for the USA is a strict

requirement when travelling to or flying through the USA. Once a USA ESTA Visa Waiver is issued it is valid for 2 years or until your passport expires (whichever is sooner) and will allow multiple entries into the USA. Bahamas
