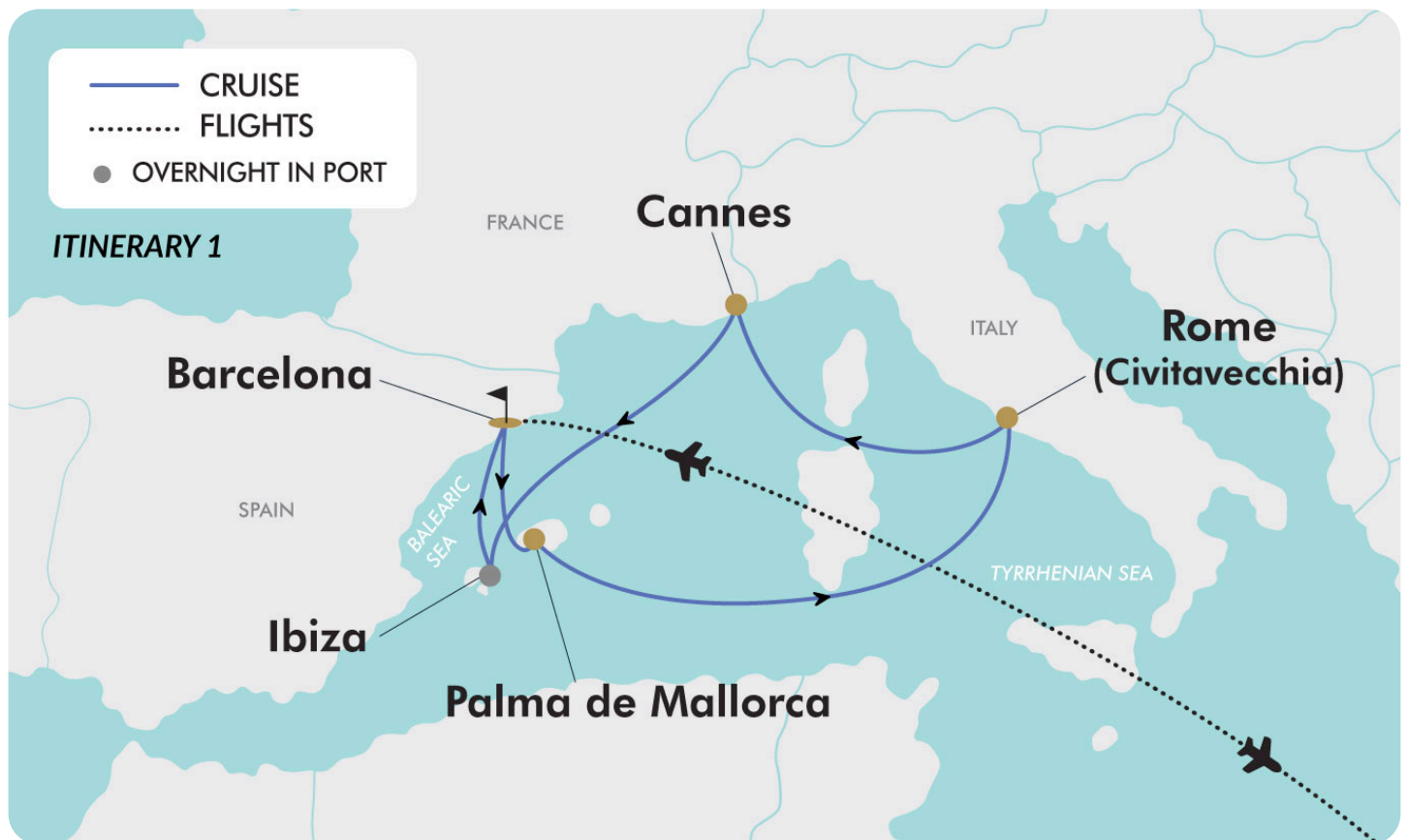

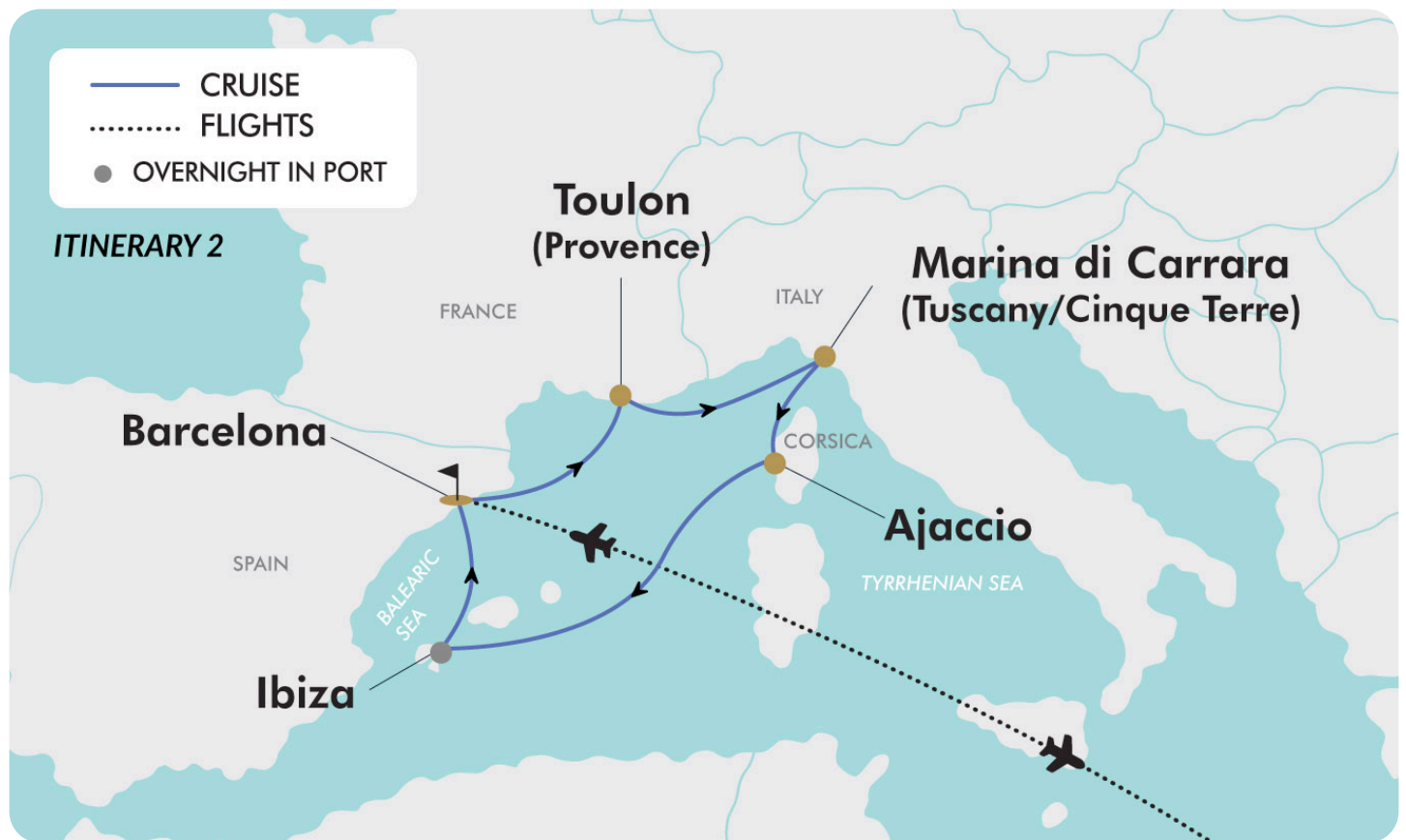

Palma de Mallorca experiences similar conditions, with May temperatures ranging from 17°C to 25°C, and June warming to 20°C to 29°C, accompanied by long sunny days and calm seas. Ibiza is slightly milder but still warm, with May temperatures between 17°C and 24°C, increasing to 20°C to 28°C in June. Overall, the weather is sunny, dry, and perfect for Mediterranean cruising.

Italy

In May and June, Rome and Tuscany enjoy beautiful late spring to early summer weather, making it one of the best times to visit. In Rome, May temperatures range from 14°C to 24°C, warming to 18°C to 30°C in June, with plenty of sunshine and low rainfall. Tuscany experiences similar
