



### **Tour Guide**

The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

### Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

### CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

### Singapore

In Singapore, November is typically hot, humid, and wet, as it falls within the Northeast Monsoon season. Daytime temperatures usually range from 30°C to 32°C, while nighttime lows hover around 24°C to 25°C. November sees frequent rainfall, often in the form of short but intense afternoon or evening thunderstorms. Despite the rain, there are still many warm and sunny periods throughout the day, and the lush greenery thrives in the tropical climate. Humidity

levels are high, often exceeding 80%, making it feel warmer than the actual temperature.

### Lombok, Indonesia

In Lombok, Indonesia, November is typically warm and marks the beginning of the rainy season. Daytime temperatures average around 30°C to 32°C, while nighttime lows are comfortably warm, around 23°C to 24°C. Humidity levels are high, and while much of the day can still be sunny, afternoon or evening showers become more frequent as the month progresses. The rain often comes in short, heavy bursts rather than prolonged downpours, so travellers can still enjoy beach time, hiking, and exploring, though it's wise to plan outdoor activities earlier in the day.

### Darwin

In Darwin, Australia, November is the beginning of the wet season, which brings hot and humid conditions. Daytime temperatures typically range from 28°C to 33°C, with nighttime lows around 24°C to 25°C. Humidity levels are high, often above 70%, which can make the heat feel more intense. Rain becomes more frequent toward the end of the month, with occasional thunderstorms and heavy showers, though the majority of the day remains dry and sunny. This warm and humid weather is typical for the tropical climate of Darwin, making it a great time to enjoy indoor activities or early morning and late afternoon outdoor adventures before the afternoon showers arrive.

#### Yorkey's Knob

In Yorkey's Knob, Queensland, November marks the transition from spring to summer, offering warm and increasingly humid conditions. Average daytime temperatures range from 28°C to 29°C, with nighttime lows around 22°C to 23°C. Humidity levels are moderate, averaging about 75%, which can make the air feel warmer than the actual temperature. Rainfall is relatively low for the month, with an average of 63 mm over approximately 5 days, making it a favourable time for outdoor activities. The sea temperature is also inviting, averaging around 26°C, ideal for swimming and water sports. With around 255 hours of sunshine, it's a great time to enjoy the tropical climate before the peak of the wet season arrives in December.

Australian passport holders can obtain a visa on arrival for entry into Indonesia.
