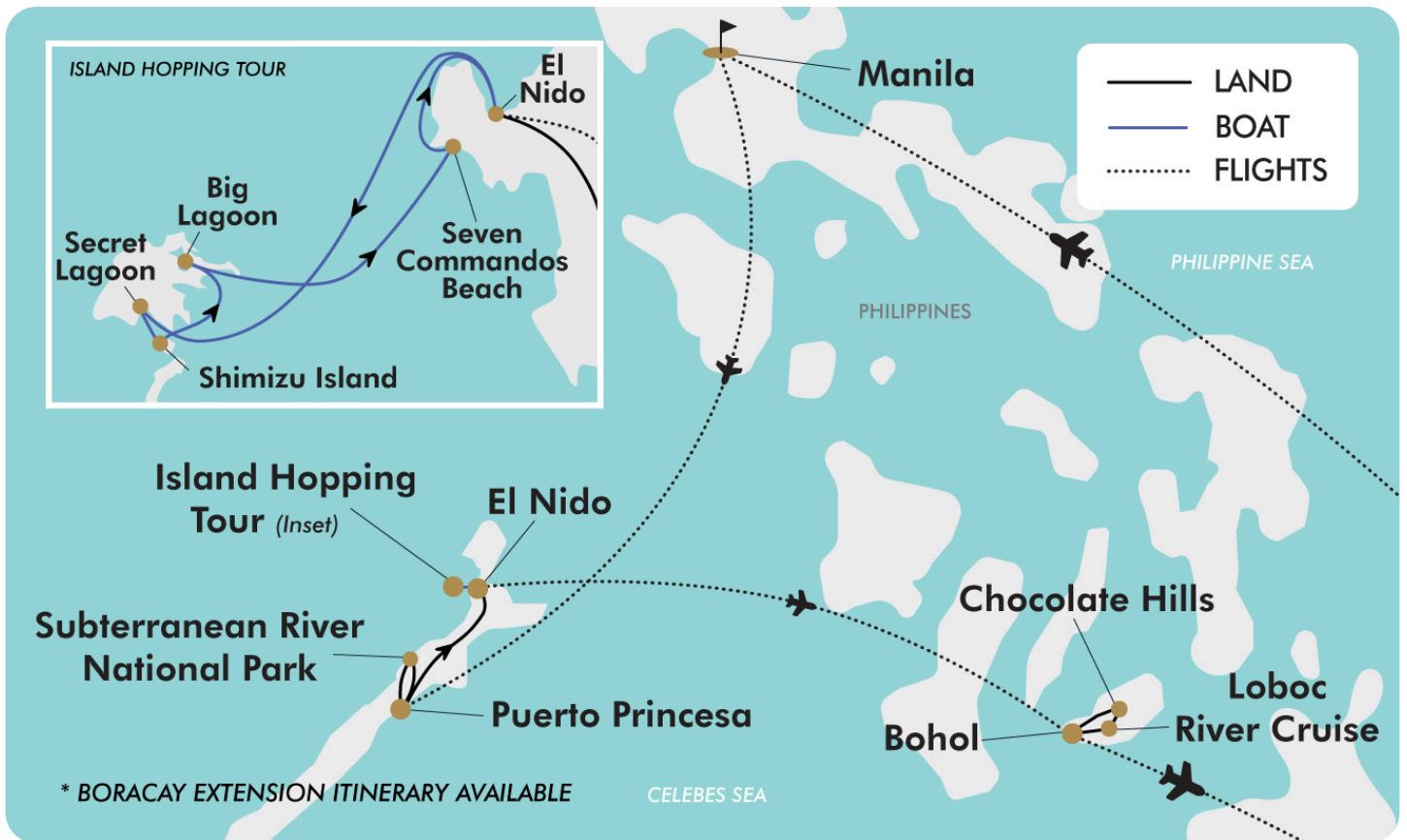

Begin your day with a tour through the bustling financial district of Makati, including a visit to Fort Bonifacio and the American Cemetery, a poignant tribute to fallen soldiers. Continue on to the heart of Manila, where you'll make a brief photo stop at Rizal Park, named in honour of the national hero, Dr. Jose Rizal.

Next, step back in time as you enter Intramuros, the historic Walled City. Wander the cobbled streets leading to San Agustin Church, the oldest stone church in the country, and admire its impressive collection of religious artifacts. Just across the street

is Casa Manila, a faithful reproduction of a 19th-century colonial home showcasing a mix of Oriental and European furnishings, along with authentic Filipino antiques.

Continue to Fort Santiago, a key stronghold during the Spanish colonial era, which played a significant role in Philippine history. Located at the mouth of the Pasig River, the fort stands as a solemn reminder of the country's tumultuous past.

Following the tour, transfer to the airport for your flight to Puerto Princesa, Palawan. Upon arrival, enjoy a welcome dinner at a local restaurant.

Explore the park's magnificent underground river aboard a self-paddled canoe. As you glide through the cave's cathedral-like chambers, marvel at the towering limestone formations, eerie stalagmites, and the dramatic play of light and shadow. The river stretches up to 8 kilometres beneath the cliffs, creating an otherworldly atmosphere amplified by the distant echoes of bats residing within the cavern walls.

Tour Guide

They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

Singapore (Transiting)

In most circumstances, such as tourism, travel for business meetings or conferences, Australian passport holders do not require a visa for stays up to 90 days. Other passport holders should check with the [Singapore Immigration and Checkpoint Authority](#) if they need a visa to enter Singapore.

At immigration, you may have to show:

- Passport with at least 6 months validity
- Evidence of enough funds for your intended stay
- Confirmed onward or return flight ticket
- Valid visa to enter your next destination
- Yellow fever vaccination certificate, if required ([ICA | Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate](#))

Malaysia (Transiting)

In most circumstances, Australian passport holders can get a 90-day tourism visa on arrival. Entry and exit conditions can change at short notice. Contact the nearest high commission, embassy or consulate of Malaysia for details about visas, currency, customs and quarantine rules.

Papua New Guinea (Transiting)

You need a visa to enter PNG and must apply for a visa before travel. Australian citizens cannot obtain a visa on arrival. You can apply for certain visas online, such as eVisas. eVisas are available through the PNG eVisa portal.

There have been reports of fraudulent websites targeting foreign nationals

applying for eVisas to PNG. If applying for an eVisa, use the official PNG Immigration and Citizenship Authority website. It's illegal to work in PNG on a tourist visa.

Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
