### The Itinerary

#### Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Zagreb, Croatia

Today, depart for Zagreb, Croatia.

*Please note: Some customers may depart on Day 2 and arrive on Day 2.*

**Meals included: In-Flight**

#### Day 2 Zagreb, Croatia

Upon arrival at Zagreb Airport, make your way to the hotel. As the city approaches, a blend of historic architecture, lush parks and lively squares comes into view. If it's too early for check-in, luggage can be stored at the hotel.

Enjoy the rest of the afternoon to explore at leisure. The charming nearby streets offer opportunities to discover quaint shops and hidden corners, or a visit to one of the cosy cafés provides a taste of local culture.

**Overnight: Hotel Central or similar, Zagreb**

#### Day 3 Zagreb - Plitvice National Park - Bihać

After breakfast, depart from Zagreb and enjoy a scenic drive through the Croatian countryside to the famous Plitvice Lakes National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Upon arrival, there will be time for a leisurely lunch at a local restaurant near the park (not included). Afterwards, embark on a guided tour of the breathtaking Plitvice Lakes. The area is renowned for its cascading waterfalls, crystal-clear lakes and lush forests. Wander along wooden pathways and bridges, marvelling at the park's stunning natural beauty and diverse wildlife.

In the late afternoon, continue across the border to the charming town of Bihać in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Upon arrival, check into the hotel and relax. The evening is free to explore Bihać at your own pace after an approximately 153-kilometre travel day.

**Overnight: Hotel Kostelski Buk, Safir Hotel or similar, Bihać**

**Meals included: Breakfast**

#### Day 4 Bihać - Jajce - Sarajevo

After breakfast, depart from Bihać and continue through the scenic Bosnian landscape towards the historic town of Jajce. Upon arrival, explore this charming town known for its iconic 17-metre-high waterfall at the confluence of the Pliva and Vrbas rivers. Stroll through the cobble streets and take a break for lunch at a local restaurant to savour traditional Bosnian dishes (not included).

In the afternoon, drive to Sarajevo, the vibrant capital of Bosnia and Herzegovina. After checking into the hotel, the evening is available to relax after an approximately 314 kilometre travel day.

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### The Itinerary

#### Day 5 Sarajevo City Tour

Begin the day with a guided walking tour of Sarajevo, a city celebrated for its rich history and unique blend of cultures. Walk through the vibrant streets of the old town, Baščaršija, where Ottoman-era architecture meets Austro-Hungarian influences. Visit notable landmarks including the Gazi Husrev-beg Mosque, Latin Bridge and the historic Sarajevo City Hall. Afterwards, explore Sarajevo's recent history with a visit to the War Tunnel Museum. Known as the "Tunnel of Hope", this underground passage was vital during the siege of Sarajevo, acting as a lifeline for the city.

The afternoon is free for further exploration of Sarajevo so why not browse local markets or discover more of the city's attractions?

**Overnight: Hotel Colors Inn or similar, Sarajevo**

**Meals included: Breakfast**

#### Day 6 Sarajevo - Mostar

Following breakfast, take an approximately 130 kilometre scenic drive through the beautiful landscapes of Herzegovina en route to Mostar.

Upon arrival, join a guided walking tour by a local expert who will share insights into the city's rich history and cultural heritage. Visit the iconic Stari Most (Old Bridge), a symbol of unity and resilience, and explore the charming old town with its blend of Ottoman and Mediterranean architecture.

Afterwards, enjoy free time to wander through the lively bazaar, browse local crafts, or relax in a riverside café with views of the Neretva River. The rest of the afternoon is open for further exploration before checking into the hotel for the night.

**Overnight: Hotel Bristol or similar, Mostar**

**Meals included: Breakfast**

#### Day 7 Mostar - Blagaj - Dubrovnik

Start the day with a drive to Blagaj, a peaceful village at the Buna River's source. Visit the renowned Blagaj Tekija, a 16th-century Dervish monastery set dramatically against a cliffside.

Afterwards, travel to Dubrovnik on an approximately 126 kilometre journey. Upon arrival, check into the hotel and enjoy a relaxed afternoon with free time to unwind.

#### Day 8 Dubrovnik Free Day

Today, enjoy a full day at leisure in the beautiful city of Dubrovnik. Known for its well-preserved mediaeval architecture, stunning coastal views and rich cultural history. Located on the southern Dalmatian coast, it's a UNESCO World Heritage Site that attracts visitors from all over the world.

Optional Activity: Half-Day Dubrovnik Sightseeing Tour

A guide will lead a walk through the UNESCO World Heritage-listed Old Town to highlight iconic landmarks such as the imposing City Walls, the Stradun (main street) and the historic Rector's Palace. A special part of the tour includes visiting the

#### Day 9 Dubrovnik - Split - Šibenik - Vodice

This morning, embark on a scenic drive along the breathtaking Dalmatian coast to the historic city of Split. Croatia's second-largest city is renowned for its unique blend of ancient history and contemporary life. Upon arrival, a local guide will lead a tour through the city's centre featuring the ancient Diocletian's Palace, a masterpiece of Roman architecture and one of the best-preserved Roman monuments worldwide. Walking through the lively streets within the palace walls reveals how the ancient and modern worlds coexist seamlessly in Split. From the historic Peristyle Square to the Cathedral of Saint Domnius (originally Diocletian's mausoleum) each corner uncovers another layer of the city's rich heritage.

Afterwards, enjoy free time to explore Split at your own pace. Why not visit the lively Riva promenade, unwind with a coffee at a vibrant café or browsing the bustling markets. Continue onward to the charming town of Šibenik, enjoy some time at leisure for dinner (own account) before transferring to your accommodation in Vodice after an approximately 320 kilometre day.

#### Day 10 Vodice - Zadar - Opatija or Pula

After breakfast, depart from Vodice and take a scenic drive to the historic city of Zadar, situated along the picturesque Adriatic coast.

In the afternoon, continue north to the elegant coastal town of Opatija or Pula. Upon arrival, check into the hotel and spend the evening by the sea after an approximately 348-kilometre travel day.

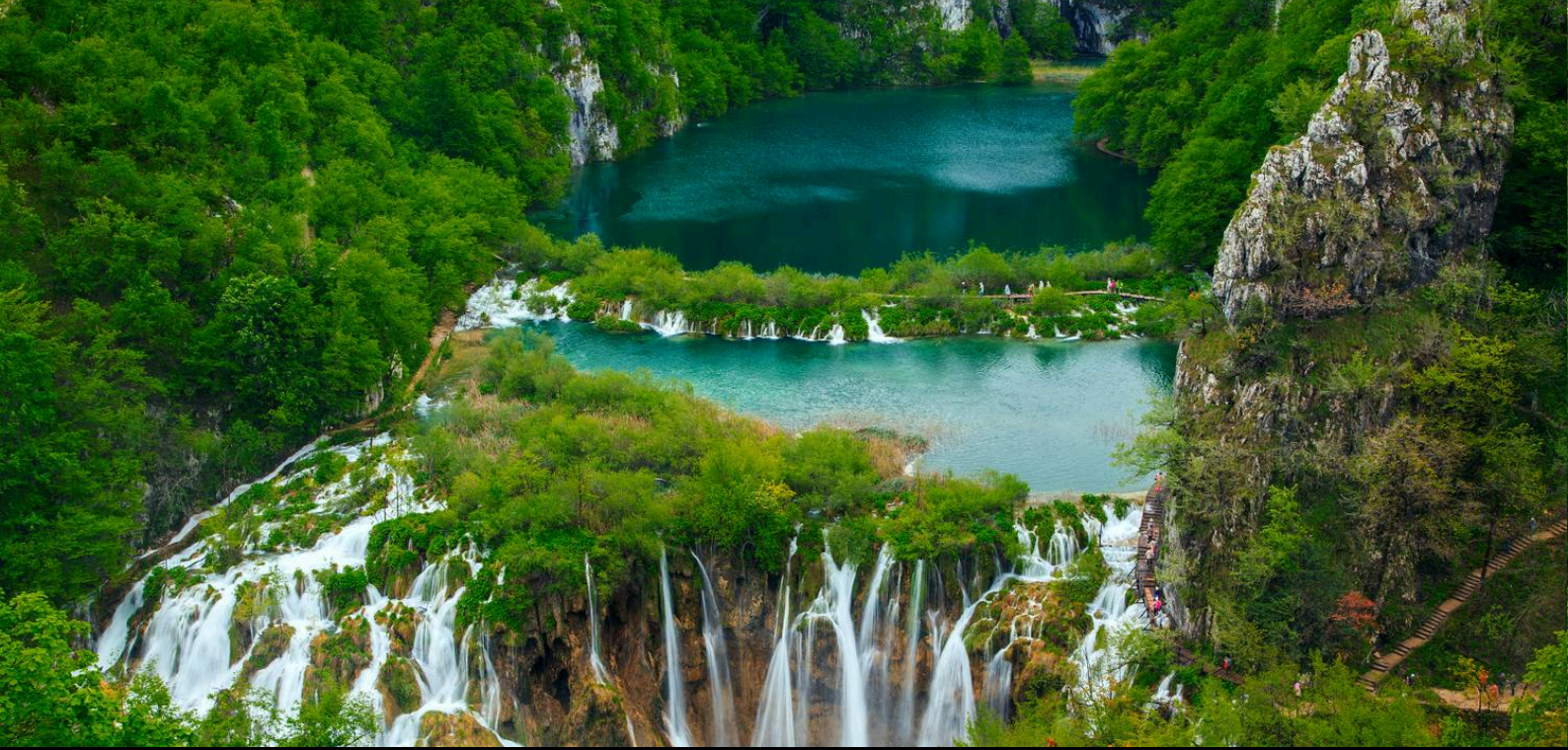

### TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

#### Tour Guide

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

#### Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

*Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.*

The Croatian coastline experiences a Mediterranean climate from April to October. In April and May, temperatures range from 15°C to 24°C, with pleasant spring weather. June to August is the peak summer season, featuring hot and dry weather, with temperatures averaging between 25°C to 35°C. September and

October bring milder temperatures of 18°C to 26°C and are characterised by pleasant autumn days, making it an ideal time for coastal activities and exploring the region.

## Slovenia

Winter temperatures rarely drop below 10 °C, but this mildness is sometimes interrupted by a cold northerly wind. Temperatures in Slovenia soar into the thirties in July and August

## Bosnia & Herzegovina

In Sarajevo, the summers are warm and mostly clear and the winters are very cold, snowy, and partly cloudy. Over the course of the year, the temperature typically varies from -5° to 27°

## FLIGHTS

### Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points

We do not arrange seat selection. It is essential to highlight that some airlines do not allow pre-selected seats. We strongly suggest you contact the airline directly with seating allocation requirements and/or arrive at the airport earlier to arrange your seating. ### EU Entry/Exit System (EES)

From October 12, 2025, a new European Entry System (EES) replaces the current manual passport-stamping process for non-EU travellers. Upon arrival in the

Schengen area, Australian and New Zealand passport holders will have their fingerprints recorded and a photograph taken. Their entry and exit dates will be electronically registered. No previous action is required, but please be aware of longer wait times at border entry. From 10 April 2026, the EES will be fully operational at all external border crossing points of all the European countries (Schengen area) using the system.

## European Travel Information & Authorisation System (ETIAS)

As an extension of the EES implementation introduced from 2025, ETIAS travel authorisation is a mandatory entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals travelling to any of [these 30 European countries](#), including Australian and New Zealand citizens, that will be introduced in 2026. We advise you to monitor [smartraveller.com.au](http://smartraveller.com.au) closer to your departure to ensure you are up to date on the requirements at the time of entry.

### **Important:**

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up-to-date information.*
- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*

- *It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.*
