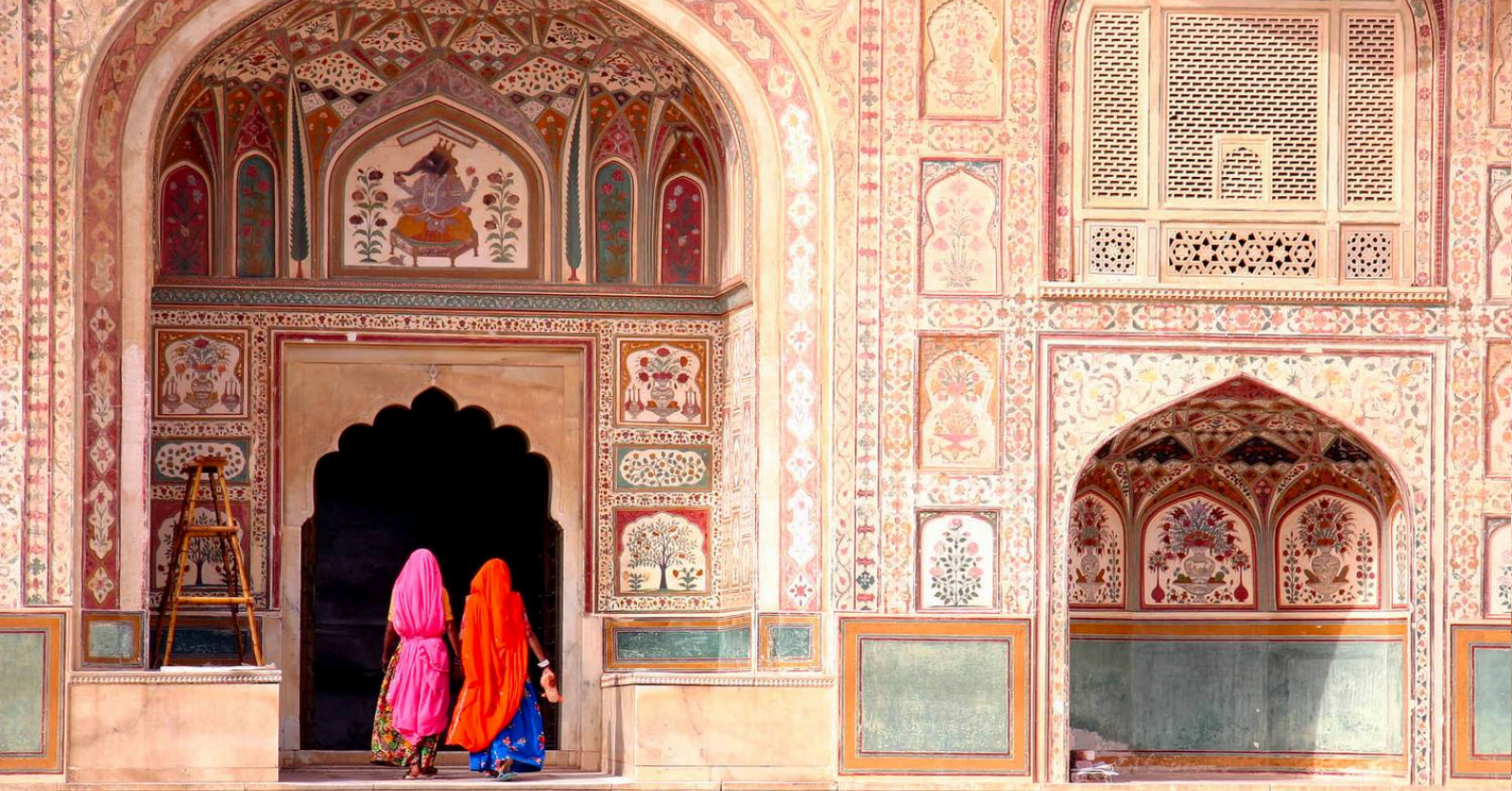

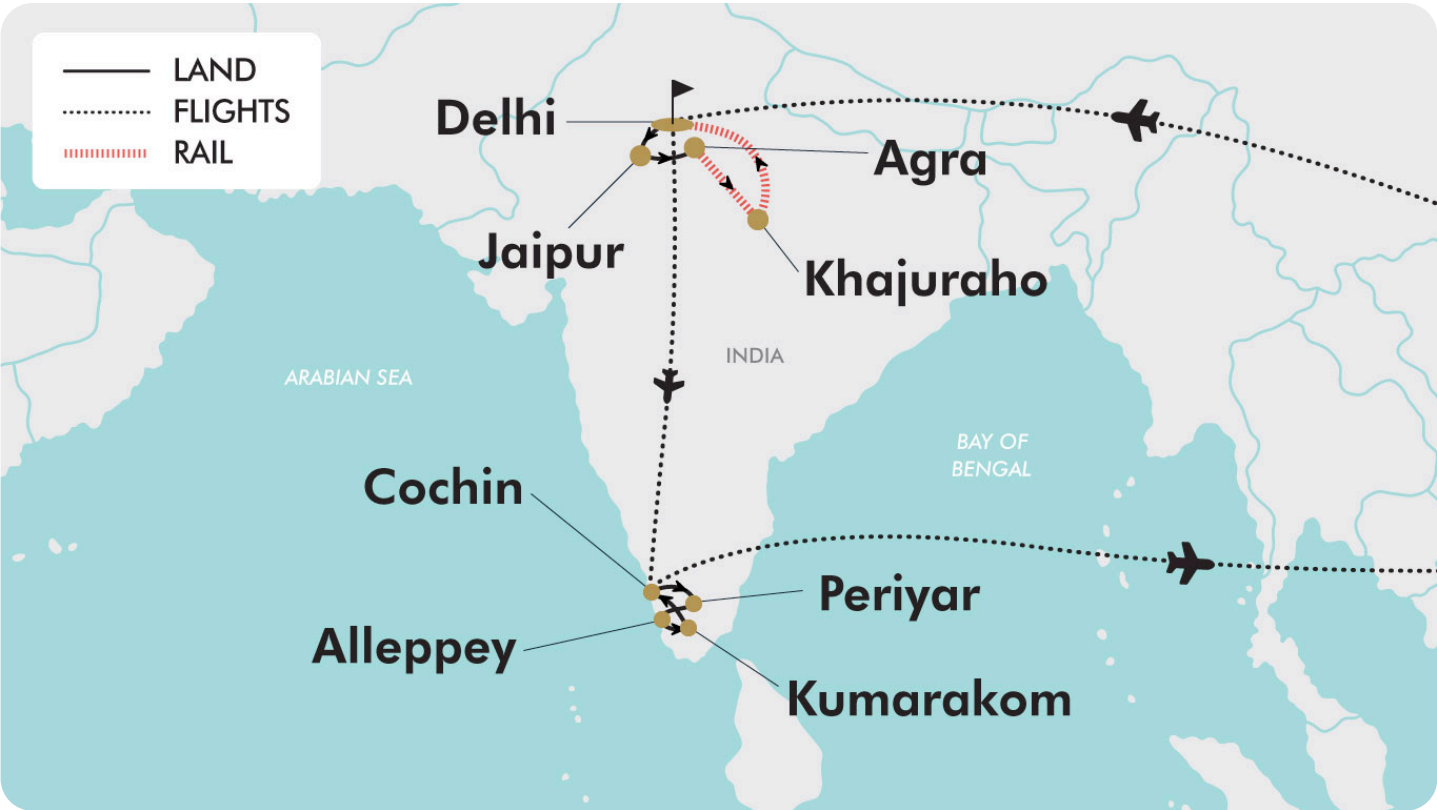

Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Delhi, India

Today, you'll fly from Australia or New Zealand to Delhi, India. Upon arrival, you'll be met by a representative at the airport who will transfer you to your hotel, where you may enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Please note: Due to flight scheduling and availability, some departures may occur on Day 0. Affected customers must be at the airport the day before. Flight times will be indicated on your final documents at least 6 weeks prior to departure.

Day 2 Delhi City Tour

As the capital of India, Delhi is a major gateway city for international visitors. The area is a fascinating metropolis offering an intriguing mix of ancient sites and modern wonders while also serving as the headquarters of Indian politics. Many of the heads of the Indian government and other political parties reside in the city, including the Prime Minister and President of India.

After breakfast this morning, you'll take a late-morning city tour of Old and New Delhi. Your tour begins in Chandni Chowk, the main street of Old Delhi, which boasts the famous colourful shopping bazaar. Here, you'll enjoy a rickshaw ride through the marketplace. You'll then drive past Jama Masjid, the largest mosque in India, and the Red Fort, which the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan built.

Visit New Delhi to see the Laxmi Narayan Temple, dedicated to Lakshmi, the goddess of prosperity and good fortune.

Afterwards, you'll travel to India Gate, a 42-metre-high stone of

triumph and war memorial. It bears the names of 85,000 Indian army soldiers who died in the campaigns of WWI. You'll then drive past Rashtrapati Bhawan which is the official residence of the President of India and has an interesting blend of Mughal and Western architectural styles.

Afterwards, you'll return to the hotel, where the rest of the day is free for independent activities, or you can choose to take part in the optional afternoon tour.

Optional Activity: UNESCO World Heritage Site Tour

India has an astounding 40 UNESCO World Heritage sites, one of the largest concentrations in the world. On this tour, you'll discover two of Delhi's UNESCO-listed sites, starting at Humayun's Tomb. This is a notable example of Mughal architecture in India and was built to house the Emperor's body. You'll then stop off at the Qutub Minar, a 72.5-meter victory tower with five distinct storeys. Built by Qutb ud-din Aibak in 1193, it is the world's tallest brick minaret. The red sandstone structure has words from the Quran intricately engraved into it. This optional tour includes transfer by air-conditioned vehicle, an English-speaking guide and entrance fees. Check the current pricing on the Important Info section.

As the picturesque capital of Rajasthan, Jaipur is washed in pink, the colour associated with hospitality in Rajput culture. This beautiful city, along with Agra and Delhi, forms what is known as the Golden Triangle of the Indian tourist circuit. Jaipur is a city where royalty still lives in the grandeur of its palaces. Fighting for the honour of one's clan has never been a necessity, but a way of life, and treating guests as gods has been a tradition for centuries. There is a timeless appeal to Jaipur's colourful bazaars where one can shop for Rajasthani handlooms and trinkets. You'll also find beautifully laid-out gardens and parks, attractive monuments, and marvellous heritage buildings. Not to mention the ambling camels and cheerful people in multi-hued costumes that make your trip to the pink city a memorable one.

Upon arrival in Jaipur, you'll check into the hotel and then enjoy a short orientation tour of the city, which includes a demonstration of sari and traditional Indian costumes. Afterwards, if you wish, you can participate in an optional cooking demonstration with dinner.

Day 4 Jaipur

It was the old fort of the Kachwaha clan of Amber and is a beautiful sight to behold, as the fort is built with white marble and red sandstone. It looks even more attractive because of the Maota Lake in the foreground.

Optional Activity: City Tour To Hawa Mahal, City Palace & Jantar Mantar

Take part in an afternoon city tour that visits the Hawa Mahal, also known as the 'Palace of the Winds', which was constructed for the royal ladies to watch royal processions without being seen. You'll also have the chance to discover Jantar Mantar, the largest of the five astronomical observatories built by Sawai Jai Singh, and visit the City Palace. Day 5 Jaipur - Agra

After breakfast this morning, you'll depart for Agra on an approximately 250-kilometre journey. You'll stop en route to visit the Chand Baori Step Well, located opposite the Harshat Mata Temple. It's believed that the Chand Baori Step Well has a religious connection, which is why it was built in front of the temple. Upon arrival in Agra, you can check in at your hotel.

Agra is the quintessential Mughal City where the world marvels at the epitome of love, beauty and sacrifice. It's also home to the Taj Mahal, one of the 7 Wonders of the World. So overwhelming is the magic of the Taj that Agra has been immortalised as the City of the Taj. As visitors walk down the narrow, bustling streets, they cannot help but wonder if the man contentedly smoking a hookah is a direct descendant of some bygone Mughal.

Afterwards, visit the Agra Fort, also known as the Red Fort, a historical monument built in the 16th century. Near the gardens of the Taj Mahal, it was built by Akbar and covers a total area of 380,000 square metres. More than 4,000 workers and 8 years of hard work culminated in the construction of Agra Fort. You'll find that many impressive structures, such as Moti Masjid, Jahangir Mahal, Machchhi Bhawan, Diwan-i-Am, Diwan-i-Khas, and Khas Mahal, are located within the Agra Fort.

Return to your hotel for the day to relax or take an optional tour of the Baby Taj.

Optional Activity: Visit Baby Taj & Mehtab Bagh

Head to the landmark mausoleum of Itmad Ud Daulah, known as "the Baby Taj". Marvel at the intricately carved marble monument conceived before the Taj Mahal and considered the blueprint for its design. You'll then continue to Mehtab Bagh, Moonlight

Garden and admire the Taj Mahal from the beautiful gardens. This optional tour includes transfers in an air-conditioned vehicle, an English-speaking guide and fees. The current pricing is available from the Important Info section.

Overnight: Agra (Standard or Premium Option)

Day 6 Agra

Today, just after sunrise, you'll visit the Taj Mahal at approximately 06:00 before returning to the hotel for breakfast. Alternatively, you can choose to visit the mausoleum just after breakfast at 09:00. The world-famous Taj Mahal is where you'll see the undeniable beauty of Persian and earlier Mughal architecture. The Taj Mahal was commissioned by Shah Jahan in 1631 to be built in memory of his wife Mumtaz Mahal. Construction of the Taj Mahal began in 1632, and the principal mausoleum was completed in 1643; the surrounding buildings and garden were finished about five years later.

Afterwards, enjoy the city of Agra at leisure or take part in the optional activity below.

Optional Activity: Food Trail Tour

Embark on a heritage walk through hidden lanes and bustling markets to visit an array of local eateries. Meet the people behind some of the city's most famous snacks, sample traditional foods such as paratha and savour chai served in a traditional clay cup. You'll also have the chance to taste Agra's famous sweet petha, originally prepared more than 350 years ago in the royal kitchens of Shah Jahan. This sugary white pumpkin sweet comes in a variety of flavours, having adapted to consumers' changing

tastes. This optional tour includes transfer in an air-conditioned vehicle, an English-speaking guide, and a selection of snacks and chai. The current pricing is available from the Important Info section.

Overnight: Agra (Standard or Premium Option)

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 7 Agra - Khajuraho

This morning, you'll be transferred to the railway station to board your train for Khajuraho on an approximately 6.5-hour journey. On arrival, you will be met and assisted by a representative who will escort you to the hotel and help with check-in.

The temples of Khajuraho are dedicated to Gods and Goddesses like Shiva, Jagadamba and Vishnu. These temples, reputed to be over a thousand years old, are exemplars of exceptional sculptural art and architecture. During the thousand-year period that these temples stood, they witnessed carnage and faced the test of time. Out of the 85 temples initially built, only 20 have survived and been designated as a UNESCO World Heritage site. This afternoon, you'll take part in a city tour visiting the Western and Eastern Group Temples. Gaze in amazement at the rich historical architecture of these buildings and learn about the heritage of ancient empires.

Following the tour, you'll return to the hotel to rest.

Overnight: Khajuraho (Standard or Premium Option)

Day 8 Khajuraho

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before spending a full day at leisure exploring this ancient city. Alternatively, choose one or both of the optional tours today.

Optional Activity: Raneh Falls Tour & Lunch

Join this morning's excursion to Raneh Falls, situated on the Ken River, approximately 20 kilometres from Khajuraho. The forest is surrounded by flowing waterfalls, making it an ideal place for nature lovers. Green, red, pink, grey and other different colours are seen on the crystalline granite. This is a must-visit place for both nature and adventure lovers. The current pricing is available from the Important Info section.

Optional Activity: Panna Tiger Reserve Safari Tour

This is an afternoon excursion to Panna Tiger Reserve. This national park is home to various animals, including Sambhar, sloth bears, Nilgai, tigers, leopards, Chital, Chinkara, and 200 species of birds. Safari through this sanctuary on a comfortable jeep and see how many animals can be spotted. The current pricing is available from the Important Info section.

Overnight: Delhi (Standard or Premium Option)

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 10 Delhi - Cochin

Begin the day with breakfast at the hotel, and then, at the appropriate time, be transferred to the airport to board your flight to Cochin. On arrival, you will be transferred to the hotel.

Cochin, also known as Kochi, is popularly referred to as the "Queen of the Arabian Sea" and is the oldest European settlement in India. Surrounded by backwaters, this city has consistently drawn voyagers to travel to the state of Kerala. Cochin is one of the finest natural harbours on the Arabian Sea coast. Kochi has been a port of call for foreign traders from early times.

One of the most interesting towns in South India, its cosmopolitan character is reflected in its low-rise, picturesque buildings and structures. The city of Kochi perfectly reflects Kerala's eclecticism and is a prime tourist destination and commercial hub.

Overnight: Cochin (Standard or Premium Option)

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 11 Cochin

After breakfast at the hotel this morning, you will take a city tour of Cochin. Your tour begins with a visit to the Dutch Palace, which, despite its name, was built by the Portuguese. It's known for its murals depicting scenes from the Ramayana and the Mahabharata epics, as well as dresses and palanquins used by Cochin's erstwhile rulers.

You'll then visit the Koonan Kurishu Shrine and a Jewish Synagogue, boasting several copper plates inscribed in Hebrew script. The tour continues to Fort Kochi and St Francis Church, the oldest European-built church in India. Not to be missed is the Santa Cruz Basilica with its beautifully painted ceiling.

After the city tour, spend the afternoon enjoying this heritage city at leisure or choose from optional activities.

Optional Activity: Heritage Walk Through Fort Kochi Old Quarter

This walking tour offers a glimpse into Cochin's rich history and heritage, showcasing the diverse influences of the Dutch, Portuguese, British, and Jewish communities that make the city unique. During the tour, you will visit the old quarter of Fort Kochi, exploring the quaint streets of this city on foot. You will also visit Fort Kochi's seaside promenade and get a glimpse of daily life in Kochi. The current pricing is available from the Important Info section.

Optional Activity: Fort Kochi, Broadway Bazaar & Mattancherry By Rickshaw

This tour is a walking exploration of two neighbourhoods, Fort Kochi and Mattancherry. You will use a local rickshaw to travel between these two areas. Fort Kochi is comprised of quaint streets, vibrant markets, beaches, and old, stately houses.

Mattancherry, once a significant trading centre, is home to a wide range of communities who have settled here over the years. At the heart of Mattancherry is 'Jew Town', where ancient Jewish traders first established a presence. If you are charmed by colourful bazaars and like discovering local food and culture, you will thoroughly enjoy this exploration of Ernakulam's Broadway area. Broadway is the traditional nerve centre of business in the city. The area rose to prominence when the British took over control of the Cochin area from the Dutch. Traders moved from Mattancherry to Broadway, setting up shops selling everything under the sun. Today, Broadway remains a bustling wholesale and retail hub with specialised markets for various products and services. The current pricing is available from the Important Info section.

Overnight: Cochin (Standard or Premium Option)

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 12 Cochin - Periyar

After breakfast at the hotel, you'll depart for Periyar on an approximately 120-kilometre journey. Upon arrival, you can check into the hotel.

Located in the Idukki district, Periya is the pride of Kerala and a testimony to nature's splendour and human innovation. It's often known as the 'Spice City' of India, also referred to as Thekkady. Periyar Lake is a paradise for nature lovers and a birdwatcher's delight. The greatest attraction of Periyar Lake is also the herds of wild elephants that occasionally come down to play in the lake.

Overnight: Periyar (Standard or Premium Option)

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 13 Periyar

After breakfast this morning at the hotel, you'll visit a spice garden that's combined with a tea and coffee plantation. These plantations open up a world of information and offer an insight into the growing process. The climate here is perfect for growing these particular plants. You'll also stop by a local vegetable farm to learn how the locals cultivate their food using various techniques and experience the local culture here. You may have the opportunity to interact with people from nearby villages or farms to learn more about their lives.

This afternoon, enjoy this spice city at leisure or choose from optional activities.

Optional Activity: Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary Tour

The Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary is spread across 777 square kilometres, of which 360 square kilometres is thick evergreen forest. The lake formed by the Mullaperiyar Dam across the Periyar River adds to the charm of the park. The sanctuary is renowned for its diverse fauna, including elephants, tigers, gaurs, sambars, lion-tailed macaques, Nilgiri langurs, wild boars, spotted deer, barking deer, stripe-necked mongooses, wild dogs, sloth bears, Malabar giant squirrels, civets, Nilgiri tahr, and more. Optional Activity: Tribal Heritage Program

This optional activity includes a tribal dance performed by two of the six tribes in Thekkady, the Mannan and Paliyan tribes. You will be introduced to various tribal musical instruments and costumes. The tribal dance theme revolves around narrating and presenting the story of the tribes in the region from their inception. This translates to a world once ruled by the children of

Day 14 Periyar - Alleppey - Embark Houseboat

After breakfast this morning, you'll depart for Alleppey on an approximately 120-kilometre journey. Upon arrival, check in to your air-conditioned houseboat and enjoy a cruise on tranquil backwaters.

Enjoy lunch onboard as you take in the relaxing atmosphere, bask on the sun deck, and savour the experience on these majestic live-in boats, accompanied by delicious Kerala-style cuisine. With the Arabian Sea on the west and a vast network of lakes, lagoons and freshwater rivers crisscrossing the area, Alappuzha is a district of immense natural beauty. Referred to as the 'Venice of the East' by travellers from across the world, this backwater country is also home to diverse animal and bird life.

Due to its proximity to the sea, the town has always held a unique place in the maritime history of Kerala. Today, Alappuzha has grown in importance as a backwater tourist centre and is famous for its boat races, houseboat holidays, beaches, marine products and coir industry.

Overnight: AC Houseboat , Alleppey

Day 15 Disembark Houseboat - Kumarakom

Enjoy breakfast on board as you cruise the backwaters before disembarking the boat and departing to Kumarakom. This town is located on the shores of the enchanting Vembanad Lake. Upon arrival, check into the hotel and spend the rest of the day at leisure, or take an optional tour through a nearby bird sanctuary.

Optional Activity: Kumarakom Bird Sanctuary

Located on the banks of the Vembanad Lake and spanning 14 acres, the Kumarakom Bird Sanctuary is a favourite haunt of migratory birds, including the Siberian stork, egret, darter, heron, and teal. The current pricing is available from the Important Info section.

Tour Guide

Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.
