Getting To The Event

- Rideshare options are available at Allegiant Stadium. Rideshare pick-up and drop-off is located in Lot N, just north of the stadium.

Important Information

- Once you are on the Strip, the RTC's Deuce bus runs 24/7 every 15 minutes from 57 stops along Las Vegas Blvd with the closest stop near Hacienda Bridge at Mandalay Bay. A 24-hour pass, priced at \$8 USD, allows you to ride the Deuce to the game, back and anywhere else on the Strip you would like to go. Passes can be purchased on the RTC app.
- A dedicated area west of the Stadium near Diablo and Procyon is available for taxis, shuttles, and general drop-off and pick-up before and after games.
- Single-event or game-day parking passes are available via the SpotHero app and must be purchased in advance.
- If you are driving your own car, allow plenty of time to get to the Stadium, many of the streets in the area will be converted to one-way on game or event days. Vehicles are not permitted to park overnight prior to game day.

Las Vegas

In February, Las Vegas experiences mild winter weather with daytime temperatures typically ranging from 15°C to 20°C and cooler nights dropping to around 4°C to 8°C. It's generally dry with low humidity and only a small chance of rain, making it a pleasant time to explore the city without the intense heat of summer. While snow is rare in the city itself, the surrounding mountains may have snow, offering scenic views.

Miami

In March, Miami enjoys warm and inviting weather, making it an ideal destination for beachgoers and outdoor enthusiasts. Daytime temperatures typically range from 21°C to 27°C, with average highs around 26°C and lows near 18°C. The city experiences about 7 days of rainfall, totaling approximately 64mm, so brief showers may occur but are usually short-lived. Humidity levels are moderate, averaging around 70%, and the sea temperature hovers at a comfortable 24°C, perfect for swimming and water activities. With around 8 hours of sunshine per day, March offers pleasant conditions for exploring Miami's vibrant neighborhoods, enjoying the beaches, and participating in various outdoor events.

Turks & Caicos

In March, the Turks and Caicos Islands offer warm and pleasant weather, making it an ideal time for a tropical getaway. Daytime temperatures typically range from 26°C to 29°C, while nighttime temperatures hover around 24°C, providing comfortable conditions for both daytime activities and restful nights. March is part of the islands' dry season, with average rainfall between 35mm and 41mm, spread over approximately 8 to 10 days. Showers, when they occur, are usually brief and followed by sunshine. The sea temperature is inviting, averaging around 25°C, perfect for swimming, snorkeling, and other water activities. With about 8 hours of sunshine per day, visitors

can enjoy ample daylight for beach outings and exploration. Overall, March presents an excellent opportunity to experience the natural beauty and outdoor offerings of the Turks and Caicos Islands in comfortable and favorable weather conditions.

Jamaica

Canada

If transiting via Canada on the way to the USA, Australian and New Zealand passport holders must apply for an electronic travel authorisation (eTA) before travelling to Canada by air. An Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) is an entry requirement for visa-exempt foreign nationals travelling to Canada by air. An eTA is electronically linked to a traveller's passport. It is valid for up to five years or until the passport expires, whichever comes first. If you get a new passport, you need to get a new eTA.

Jamaica

Australian passport holders are visa exempt for a stay of up to six months. Travellers must hold a passport valid for at least six months beyond the period of

Mexico

Australian passport holders are visa exempt for a stay of up to 180 days. Travellers must hold a passport valid for at least six months beyond the period of intended stay with one blank visa page.

Belize

Australian passport holders are visa exempt for a stay of up to 30 days. Travellers must hold a passport valid for at least six months beyond the period of intended stay with one blank visa page.

Turks & Caicos

Australian passport holders are visa exempt for a stay of up to 90 days. Travellers must hold a Machine Readable passport valid for the period of intended stay with two blank visa pages.
