Much of this drier region resembles a desert but the shapes of the hills and the way rain snags on ridges means Kona holds hundreds of microclimates. Coffee growers have flourished here as variations of only a few feet in altitude can result in very different brews. Some farms cover barely an acre while others sprawl enough to encompass two or three varietals.

Thankfully, plenty of places exist to play and burn off a little caffeine around Kona. History lies thick on the ground, from Kamehameha's heiau (temple) to the sacred buildings of Puuhonua O Honaunau ("The Place of Refuge"). Whales love Kona, spinner dolphins live up to their names and giant mantas slowly barrel roll up from the depths.

Day 15 Cruising Equator

The equator is an essential component of our planet's geography, even though it's just an imaginary line drawn on a map. In addition to being the widest spot on the planet, a full 43 kilometres wider than at the poles, this is also the planetary dividing line for the Coriolis effect. This explains why cyclones rotate clockwise north of the equator and counterclockwise south of it. It's also the place best suited for launching spacecraft because the gravitational pull gives rocket ships an extra boost out of the stratosphere.

For a bit of light-hearted fun, if you're onboard a craft where any of the crew are crossing this imaginary line for the first time, you'll likely witness a King Neptune (or Crossing the Line) ceremony. This ancient naval tradition puts newbies, or "Pollywogs," through a series of pranks and tests to prove themselves worthy of being a son or daughter of Neptune, the Roman god of the sea.

Day 18 Pago Pago, American Samoa Arrive: 08:00 - Depart: 17:00

Pago Pago's small size belies its historic stature and epic setting. The city lies along the shore of Pago Pago Harbour, which was carved from thousands of years of volcanic-crater erosion on Tutuila Island. The fjord-like harbour, one of the most stunning in the South Pacific, is bordered by steep and lush hills and dominated by Rainmaker Mountain.

The protected harbour site was selected in 1872 by Commander R.W. Meade as a fuelling station for the U.S. Navy. Meade negotiated the real estate deal with a Samoan high chief and the resulting naval base at Pago Pago was in use from 1900 to 1951.

Pago Pago itself is tranquil as far as capital cities go, though there is commerce and activity in the areas of Fagatogo and Utulei. The hills near the seafront are dotted with houses, while a variety of shops line the street that runs in front of the dock itself. The best views of the harbour and downtown can be had from the summit of Mount Alava in the National Park of American Samoa.

Day 19 Cruising International Date Line

Travellers flying or cruising across the Pacific Ocean get to experience the only-one-place-in-the-world feeling of adding or losing a day within the span of a second. The International Date Line is the longitudinal boundary between where one day starts (to the west) and another day ends (to the east). It runs roughly along the 180th meridian of longitude in the middle of the ocean with some exceptions in the southern Pacific, where sovereign islands opted for one side over the other for commercial reasons.

Please note: As you travel west, your clocks will be wound forward 24 hours and you'll effectively jump forward a calendar day as you cruise towards Apia.

Day 20 Apia, Samoa

Arrive: 08:00 - Depart: 17:00

The remote Polynesian nation of Samoa boasts a dramatic volcanic landscape with vibrant green jungles. Samoa's capital, Apia, sits midway along Upolu's north coast. This sprawling metropolitan area features a waterfront promenade and Beach Road, an avenue curving along the harbour where the Royal Samoa Police Band marches and hoists the national flag at Government House on weekday mornings. Check out their sharp ensembles, which feature navy lavalava (kilts) and blue dress shirts. Adventurers will want to make a splash at Palolo Deep National Marine Reserve near Apia harbour, while bookworms should make a beeline to the home and grave of Robert Louis Stevenson. Perhaps the best way to experience fa'a Samoa is by visiting the small villages scattered throughout the two islands. Here, you'll see locals still living in traditional fales which feature round thatched homes with no walls. All the better to enjoy the ocean breeze and cook on umus (ovens) of hot stones placed in shallow holes in the ground.

Day 22 Savusavu, Fiji

Known as the hidden paradise of Fiji, the striking harbour town of Savusavu is located on the south coast of Vanua Levu Island. Backed by green hills and featuring a bustling marina and attractive waterfront, the town was originally established as a trading centre for products like sandalwood, bêche-de-mer and copra. Today, the town is known for its burgeoning eco-tourism infrastructure which has spawned several luxury resorts.

The surrounding waters mean an abundance of scuba diving and yachting. On land you'll find historic hot springs, waterfall hikes, wildlife at Waisali Rainforest Reserve and traditional villages. There are several key landmarks too, including the 19th-century Copra Shed Marina which now serves as the local yacht club. Head to the Savarekareka Mission, a chapel built around 1870 by the first Roman Catholic mission on Vanua Levu. Relax and enjoy the palm-lined pristine beaches and the town's assortment of restaurants, cafés and bars.

It was once thought that Fijians were shaped by wet earth, pulled from the sea on a giant fishhook and given more than 300 islands to live on.

Fiji, especially the southeast coast of Viti Levu, is geographically beautiful with a string of golden sand islands decorating the warm oceans. It's the kind of spot that made mariners of old leave their ships and settle on land. The city of Suva, holds threequarters of the nation's population. It's also shielded by shimmering green mountains opening to a calm sea, a land lush with afternoon rains.

Lautoka, known as the Sugar City, is nestled between the sparkling Pacific Ocean to the west and lush sugar cane fields and rolling pine forests to the east.

With a day at leisure in Lautoka, you could visit nearby Denarau, a popular holiday destination for visitors to Fiji. On an optional shore excursion you could join a day trip to Tivua Island, a tropical island surrounded by 500 acres of coral reef where you will experience a traditional Fijian kava ceremony, kayaking and snorkelling.

Easo is the capital of Lifou, the largest and most populated of the Loyalty Islands which is home to around 10,000 Kanak people. It's a simple, relatively undeveloped and largely unspoiled place, famed for a sandy palm-fringed beach that fans out on either side of the main dock and a very friendly atmosphere. Cruise

ships are often welcomed to this island paradise with traditional tribal dances as well as a colourful local market that pops up to sell food, drinks and crafts.

The island itself offers a diverse landscape that ranges from the steep cliffs of the northern coast to the pristine white-sand beaches and stunning turquoise waters along the southern coast. On the island's many walking paths you might see the famous Chapelle Notre Dame de Lourdes, a wide variety of wildflowers and more. Visitors can also tour vanilla plantations to learn about this venerable spice and its production, or make day trips to the nearby island of Tiga.

Nouméa is a French city with Polynesian accents, cooled by ocean breezes and set among tropical flowers the size of dinner plates. With one of the healthiest reef systems left on earth, the island's UNESCO-listed lagoons hold more than 9,000 species of fish and marine life. The Kanaks, the native people to whom French colonialist first gave cooking lessons, already lived lives rich with fish, taro and coconuts fresh from the tree.

Host to Vanuatu's largest harbour and airport, the city is popular with cruise ship visitors and serves as a great base for all kinds of activities and tours across Efate. In addition to enjoying the many pristine beaches, sandy bays and clear waters that lie along the rugged coastline, it's possible to hike through rainforest jungle and verdant countryside plus admire the island's many cascading waterfalls and fast-flowing rivers. The port also offers opportunities to learn about the local culture and customs at institutions like the Vanuatu Cultural Centre, the Ekasup Cultural Village and the island's many markets and restaurants.

Day 31 Honiara, Solomon Islands Arrive: 08:00 - Depart: 17:00

The unspoiled beauty of the Solomon Islands is a sight to behold. Mountain spires, rugged rocky coastlines, dense rainforest and spectacular waterfalls are only a few the natural jewels adorning this necklace of islands in the South Pacific. Honiara is the capital of the most populous island, Guadalcanal.

Visit one of the island's traditional villages or drop into a local market to sample fresh produce, admire local goods and shop for crafts. Don't miss the stunning Mataniko Falls or the petroglyphs of the Vauluma Posori Cave, dating from 1,000 BC. The Vilu War Museum contains US and Japanese war relics so you can view memorials for each country in different areas of the island. The Japanese Peace Memorial in particular offers panoramic views.

The East New Britain province of Papua New Guinea is lush and tropical. Mountain peaks and active volcanoes surround the town of Rabaul and Simpson Harbor. Built on an ancient volcanic crater, the harbour is one of the deepest in the region. For the same reason, some of most spectacular diving and snorkelling in the world can be found here. At Sub-Base, a shallow reef extends dramatically out from shore before dropping off into a crevasse rich with fish and other marine life.

Day 35 Alotau, Papua New Guinea Tender Arrive: 08:00

The sprawling town of Alotau, spectacularly located on Papua New Guinea's southeastern tip, is an ideal introduction to the relaxed charms of the region. The capital of Milne Bay Province, Alotau is also the main port for the 600 islands that encompass the area.

The town was a major Allied base and the site of the 1942 Battle of Milne Bay, resulting in Japan's first defeat in the Pacific during World War II. A fascinating Battle of Milne Bay tour combines historic war stories with locals' tales of how modern warfare changed their world.

More broadly, Alotau is an excellent place to gain insight into Papua New Guinea's cultures and traditions - don't miss the Cultural Festival excursion in which you'll see everything from warrior dances to gospel choirs and traditional drumming. For even more local flavour, wander through Alotau Market with its mounds of betel nuts, which many islanders chew.

Day 36 Kiriwana Island, Papua New Guinea Tender Arrive: 08:00

Located in Papua New Guinea's Milne Bay Province, Kiriwina is the largest of the Trobriand Islands and home to the majority of their 12,000-strong indigenous population. The picturesque island is steeped in history and is famous to many as a site of U.S. occupation during World War II. Various relics of the war, including the remains of an American plane, can still be seen on the island.

You'll also find an idyllic traditional lifestyle, incredibly friendly locals and a fascinating social structure that's based on matrilineal clans, with unique marriage and courtship rituals. Many aspects of life revolve around the cultivation and exchange of yams. There's also mesmerising scenery, from crystal-clear waters to jungle-covered cliffs. Make time to hire a dugout canoe, hike to the burial caves, peruse exquisite carvings and explore the coral-filled offshore islands. Be sure to stop and watch a game of Trobriand cricket, an innovative spin on the game. Whatever you choose to do, it's bound to be an eye-opening experience.

Day 37 Conflict Islands, Papua New Guinea Tender Arrive: 08:00

Although the name might not sound inviting, they were named after a British naval ship and the 21 islands are like paradise on earth. Tropical islets encircle an enormous turquoise lagoon formed by the rim of a sunken volcano, with vibrant coral reefs and rainbow schools of fish below the water. Located about 160 kilometres east of Papua New Guinea in the Coral Sea, the island group is owned by Australian businessman and conservationist lan Gowrie-Smith.

Just as Papua New Guinea is one of the wildest and most diverse places on the planet, the seas here offer some of the world's most extensive biodiversity and coral reefs, making for unparalleled kayaking, diving and snorkelling. There are hundreds of coral species and thousands of species of fish and invertebrates such as the sea cucumber. Why not watch manta rays float past, lie back on the white sand, look up at the palm trees blowing in warm trade winds or watch the sun set over the lagoon?

This laidback city is popular with travellers who depart for days of sailing, diving, snorkelling and trekking through nearby parks. It's also a celebrated launching pad for those who want to explore the reef, the Daintree Rain Forest and more. The residents of Cairns are welcoming, the beach life idyllic and the climate consistently sunny and warm.

Queensland's Cape York Peninsula stretches northward like a long arm, with the Great Barrier Reef running parallel to the east. Cape York, at the end of the peninsula, is the northernmost point of the Australian mainland. Past the cape, the Torres Strait Islands continue onward toward Papua New Guinea, creating a maze of tropical islands and reefs that divide the Coral Sea from the Arafura Sea.

Only 14 of the strait's 274 islands are inhabited. The languages and customs vary from island to island, the people have largely maintained their indigenous cultures which is a mix of Australian Aboriginal, Melanesian and others from Papua New Guinea.

This cosmopolitan city has fewer than 140,000 residents, but they include some 50 nationalities. In the downtown area you'll find everything from great shopping to a crocodile park. You can trace the region's dramatic history at innovative museums and gallery-hop to see indigenous art. After your sightseeing stroll, why not treat yourself to a plethora of fresh seafood from mud crab, barramundi and more.

The nearby 477-square-kilometre Cape Range National Park, along the western coast of the cape, draws visitors with its spectacular Charles Knife Canyon and Yardie Creek Gorge, carved over millennia by rivers that run through the park.

Day 50 Fremantle (Perth), Australia (Overnight) Arrive: 08:00 - Overnight

Despite being one of the most isolated capital cities in the world, Perth often paves its own way when it comes to food, fashion and art.

Fremantle was first settled in 1829 by Swan River colonists as free colonies. Historical relics abound, from the Fremantle Prison and the Round House to the Fremantle Market Hall, where shoppers once arrived by horse and carriage. These sights now share the spotlight with art galleries, breweries and designer boutiques.

In the city centre, the modern towers of mining and financial firms also contain inventive restaurants and rooftop bars. Nearby are Perth institutions like the Art Gallery of Western Australia, Kings Park and Botanic Garden. Don't miss the creative neighbourhoods of Subiaco, Leederville and Mount Lawley.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

San Diego

In January, San Diego experiences mild and pleasant winter weather. Daytime temperatures typically range between 18°C and 20°C, while nights are cooler, averaging around 9°C to 11°C. Rain is possible but infrequent, with January being one of the wetter months, averaging about 50-60 mm of rainfall. Overall, it's a



comfortable time to visit, with plenty of sunny days.

Hawaii

In January, Hawaii enjoys warm and pleasant weather, making it an appealing winter destination. Daytime temperatures typically range between 24°C and 27°C, while nighttime temperatures cool slightly to around 18°C to 21°C. Rain is more frequent during this time, particularly on the windward (eastern) sides of the islands, but showers are often brief. The ocean remains warm, with water temperatures averaging around 24°C, ideal for swimming and snorkelling. January is also a great time for whale watching as humpback whales migrate through Hawaiian waters.

Samoa

In January, Samoa experiences warm and humid weather as it is part of the wet season. Daytime temperatures typically range between 28°C and 31°C, while nighttime temperatures remain warm, averaging around 24°C to 26°C. January sees significant rainfall, often in the form of tropical downpours, as it coincides with the cyclone season. However, rain is usually brief, with plenty of sunshine in between. The ocean temperatures are warm, averaging around 28°C, making it great for swimming and snorkelling despite the wetter conditions.

Fiji

In January, Fiji experiences warm and humid weather as it falls within the wet season. Daytime temperatures typically range between 30°C and 32°C, while nighttime temperatures are around 24°C to 26°C. This is one of the wetter months, with heavy rainfall and occasional tropical storms or cyclones, especially in the afternoons and evenings. Despite the rain, there are often sunny periods during the day. The sea remains warm, averaging around 28°C, making it ideal for water activities when the weather permits.

New Caledonia

During January, New Caledonia experiences warm and humid summer

weather, as it is part of the wet season. Daytime temperatures typically range between 28°C and 30°C, while nighttime temperatures average around 22°C to 24°C. Rainfall is common, with occasional tropical downpours and the possibility of cyclones, as January is within the cyclone season. Despite the rain, there are often sunny intervals, and the lagoon waters remain warm, around 26°C to 28°C, making it suitable for swimming and snorkelling when conditions are calm.

Vanuatu

Throughout January, Port Vila, Vanuatu, experiences warm and humid summer weather as part of the wet season. Daytime temperatures typically range from 28°C to 31°C, while nighttime temperatures remain warm, averaging around 23°C to 25°C. Rainfall is frequent, with tropical downpours and high humidity, and January is also within the cyclone season, so tropical storms are possible. Despite the wet conditions, there are often sunny breaks, and the ocean remains warm at around 28°C, ideal for swimming and water activities when the weather allows.

Solomon Islands

In February, the Solomon Islands experience warm and humid weather as part of the wet season. Daytime temperatures typically range between 29°C and 31°C, while nighttime temperatures stay around 24°C to 26°C. This is one of the wetter months, with heavy rainfall and high humidity, as well as the possibility of tropical storms or cyclones since February falls within the cyclone season. Despite the rain, there are often sunny intervals, and the sea remains warm, averaging around 28°C, making it suitable for swimming and snorkelling when weather conditions permit.

Papua New Guinea

During February, Papua New Guinea experiences hot and humid weather, as it falls within the wet season. Daytime temperatures typically range between 29°C and 32°C, while nighttime

temperatures remain warm, averaging around 23°C to 25°C. This is one of the wetter months, with frequent heavy rainfall, high humidity, and the possibility of tropical storms or cyclones, particularly in coastal and lowland areas. Despite the rain, there are often sunny periods, and the sea temperature stays warm, around 28°C, making it comfortable for water activities when the weather allows.

Northern Territory

During February, the Northern Territory of Australia experiences hot and humid conditions as it is part of the wet season (also known as the monsoon season). Daytime temperatures typically range between 30°C and 34°C, while nighttime temperatures remain warm, averaging around 24°C to 26°C. Heavy rainfall is common, with tropical downpours and thunderstorms occurring frequently, particularly in the afternoon and evening. Humidity levels are high, and the region may experience flooding in some areas due to the intense rains. Despite the wet conditions, there are occasional sunny periods, and the lush landscapes are vibrant during this time.

Western Australia

In February, Western Australia experiences hot and dry weather, particularly in the southern and inland regions, as it's the middle of summer. Daytime temperatures typically range between 30°C and 38°C in cities like Perth, with higher temperatures in the inland areas, where it can reach up to 40°C or more. Nights are warm, with temperatures around 18°C to 22°C. Coastal areas like Perth enjoy more moderate temperatures due to the sea breeze, while the northern parts of the state, including areas near Broome, can be much hotter. This period generally sees little rainfall, though some tropical storms may affect the northern regions, where the wet season occurs. The weather is generally sunny, making it a great time for beach activities and outdoor exploration.

South Australia

experiences hot summer weather, with daytime temperatures typically ranging between 28°C and 35°C in cities like Adelaide. Inland areas, particularly in the outback, can see temperatures soar above 40°C during the day, while nights tend to be cooler, averaging around 16°C to 20°C. February is generally dry, with little rainfall, and the region enjoys plenty of sunshine. Coastal areas benefit from cooling sea breezes, especially in the afternoon, making the weather more bearable. It's a great time for outdoor activities, but it can get quite hot, particularly in the more inland and northern regions.

Tasmania

In March, Hobart, Tasmania, experiences mild and pleasant autumn weather. Daytime temperatures typically range between 14°C and 20°C, with cooler temperatures in the early mornings and evenings, which can drop to around 7°C to 10°C. March is generally a dry month, with occasional rain showers, but overall, it's a great time to explore the outdoors with more moderate temperatures and less humidity. The weather is still relatively mild, making it ideal for outdoor activities like hiking, sightseeing, and enjoying the beautiful landscapes, though the evenings can feel crisp as the season transitions into autumn.

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points

Fitness Level Required

- Some areas may be inaccessible to wheelchairs or mobility scooters, with personal walking sticks and other aids required should they be needed. Although some assistance may be available, every traveller should be self-reliant during all aspects of their travel.
- It is expected that every traveller must be self-reliant and able to undertake all aspects of their own travel. Please speak to your booking agent about your personal circumstances and any assistance requirements to ensure this tour is right for you.
- If you have any concerns, please consult your healthcare provider prior to purchase/ travel.

Yellow Fever

A valid international certificate of vaccination against Yellow Fever is required in many countries. You may need to present this on arrival at the airport or border crossing. Some countries will refuse entry if you are unable to present your certificate. It's also common for your home country to request a Yellow Fever



certificate upon arrival. You must check with your doctor well before leaving home about the Yellow Fever requirements for the countries you'll be visiting.

Sightseeing

Please note: If entry to a site is affected by changes in operating hours or public holiday closures, your itinerary, where possible, may be adjusted, or a similar activity will be offered in its place (subject to availability).

Shopping

Shopping overseas can be a daunting and confusing experience, especially when there is a language barrier. Please be very cautious when foreign currencies and prices are involved. If paying by credit card, please pay close attention to the amount you are being charged and keep all your receipts. Do not make any purchases you are not comfortable with or feel pressured into. If you are uncertain or need assistance with the language barrier, please seek assistance from your Tour Guide/Leader. Please refer to our Terms and Conditions regarding shopping for further information.

Visas

United States

If travelling on an Australian Passport, an ESTA (Visa Waiver) for the USA is a strict requirement when travelling to or flying through the USA. Once a USA ESTA Visa Waiver is issued it is valid for 2 years or until your passport expires (whichever is sooner) and will allow multiple entries into the USA. For information on ESTA eligibility or to apply, please visit https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/esta/.

Please note: Due to recent changes in the USA Immigration policies, TripADeal recommends all travellers visit US Customs & Border Protection.

Canada

If transiting via Canada on the way to the USA, Australian and New Zealand passport holders must apply for an electronic travel authorisation (eTA) before travelling to Canada by air. An Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) is an entry requirement for visa-exempt foreign nationals travelling to Canada by air. An eTA is electronically linked to a traveller's passport. It is valid for up to five years or until the passport expires, whichever comes first. If you get a new passport, you need to get a new eTA. If you are not travelling via Canada by air, and are only visiting by boat, you will not require an eTA if you are an Australian or New Zealand citizen.

Samoa

Australian passport holders are visa exempt for a stay of up to 30 days. The traveller must hold a passport valid at least six months beyond the period of intended stay with one blank visa page

Fiji

Australian passport holders are visa exempt for a stay of up to four months. The traveller must hold a passport valid at least six months beyond the period of intended stay with one blank visa page

New Caledonia

Australian passport holders are visa exempt for a stay of up to 90 days per 180 days. The traveller must hold a passport valid at least six months beyond the period of intended stay with one blank visa page

Vanuatu

Australian passport holders are visa exempt for a stay of up to 120 days. The traveller must hold a passport valid at least six months on entry with one blank visa page

Solomon Islands

Australian passport holders can obtain a visitor visa for a stay of up to 90 days may be issued upon arrival. The traveller must hold a passport valid at least six months on entry with two blank visa pages

Papua New Guinea

Travellers need a visa to visit Papua New Guinea for Business or Tourism.

Important:

- Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.
- Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.
- It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.
- Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.
- It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.

Travel Insurance
