Continue to Ross Island, near McMurdo Sound, and the remote islands of the Ross Sea, key locations for Antarctic heritage conservation and natural nesting sites for seabirds like skuas and penguins. Sailing into New Zealand waters, the UNESCO-listed Campbell Island and Auckland Islands offer unique wildlife and native birds hiding among rugged landscapes and lush tundra. Before disembarking in New Zealand's Dunedin, experience the raw wild beauty of Snares Island to perhaps snatch a glimpse of the rare Snares crested penguin.



Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Buenos Aires, Argentina

Day 5 Elephant Island, South Shetland Islands & Telefon Bay, Deception Island

Elephant Island

Arrive: 07:00 - Depart: 11:00

Elephant Island is a remote, ice-covered island located in the South Shetland Islands near the tip of the Antarctic Peninsula. Known for its rugged terrain and harsh weather, it gained historical significance as the refuge of Ernest Shackleton's crew during the ill-fated Endurance expedition in 1916. The island is

largely uninhabitable, with no permanent human presence, but supports wildlife such as penguins and seals. Its name is believed to derive from either its elephant-like shape or the presence of elephant seals.

Telefon Bay

Arrive: 14:00 - Depart: 19:00

Telefon Bay is a coastal area located on Deception Island, part of the South Shetland Islands in Antarctica. It lies within the island's flooded volcanic caldera, offering a dramatic landscape shaped by past eruptions. The bay is known for its striking black sand beaches, steaming fumaroles, and colourful volcanic deposits. Named after the whaling ship Telefon, the area is a popular site for scientific research and tourist visits due to its unique geology and accessible volcanic features.

Day 6 Neko Harbour & Goudier Island

Arrive: 07:00 - Depart: 11:00

Surrounded by towering glaciers and snow-covered peaks, it is one of the few places on the continent where visitors can set foot on the mainland. Named after the Scottish whaling ship Neko, which operated in the area in the early 20th century, the harbour is home to gentoo penguin colonies and offers stunning views of calving glaciers and floating icebergs. Its calm waters and dramatic scenery make it a popular stop for Antarctic expeditions.

Goudier Island

Arrive: 14:00 - Depart: 20:00

Goudier Island is a small rocky island located off the coast of Wiencke Island in the Palmer Archipelago, Antarctica. It is best known as the site of Port Lockroy, a former British research station that now operates as a museum and post office during the Antarctic summer. The island is surrounded by stunning icy landscapes and is home to a colony of gentoo penguins. Goudier Island plays a key role in both Antarctic history and tourism, offering insight into early scientific exploration in the region.

Day 7 Orne Harbour & Damoy Point

Orne Harbour

Arrive: 07:00 - Depart: 11:00

Sheltered by surrounding landforms, it provides a relatively calm anchorage in an otherwise harsh and icy environment. The harbour has been used historically by explorers and researchers, including members of early 20th-century expeditions.

Damoy Point

Arrive: 14:00 - Depart: 19:00

Damoy Point is a scenic headland located on Wiencke Island in the Palmer Archipelago, Antarctica. It is known for its historic significance as the site of a former British summer airstrip and transit station used from the 1970s to the 1990s to support

research operations. The Damoy Hut, now preserved as a historic site, remains on the point and offers insight into the logistics of past Antarctic exploration. Surrounded by icy waters and frequented by penguins, Damoy Point is a popular stop for expedition cruises exploring the region.

Peter I Island is a remote volcanic island located in the Bellingshausen Sea, off the coast of Antarctica. It is one of the most isolated islands in the world and is claimed by Norway as a dependent territory. The island is mostly ice-covered, with steep cliffs and a rugged coastline, and is rarely visited due to difficult sea conditions and heavy pack ice. Discovered in 1821 by a Russian expedition, it was first landed on in 1929 by a Norwegian team. Peter I Island remains uninhabited and is primarily of interest to scientists and polar explorers.

Shepard Island is a small, ice-covered island located off the coast of Marie Byrd Land in West Antarctica, near the Getz Ice Shelf. It lies mostly buried under ice, making its rocky features difficult to distinguish. The island was discovered in 1962 by the United States Geological Survey using aerial photography. Due to its remote location and harsh conditions, Shepard Island is uninhabited and rarely visited, serving primarily as a point of interest for scientific mapping and Antarctic research.

The Bay of Whales is a natural ice harbour located along the edge of the Ross Ice Shelf in Antarctica. It was historically significant as the site where several early Antarctic expeditions, including those led by Roald Amundsen and Richard E. Byrd, established bases in the early 20th century. Formed by periodic calving of the ice shelf, the bay's shape and size can change over time. Despite its name, it is not a true bay, but rather an indentation in the ice shelf. The Bay of Whales has largely disappeared due to ice shelf movement and collapse in recent decades.

Day 19 Cape Royds & Cape Evans, Ross Sea Cape Royds

Arrive: 07:00 - Depart: 12:00

Cape Royds is a rocky headland on the western coast of Ross Island in Antarctica, near the McMurdo Sound. It is best known as the site of Ernest Shackleton's historic 1908 Nimrod Expedition hut, which still stands today as a well-preserved monument to early Antarctic exploration. The area is also home to one of the southernmost Adélie penguin colonies. With its combination of historical significance and ecological interest, Cape Royds is a key location for both scientific research and heritage conservation in Antarctica.

Cape Evans

Arrive: 13:00 - Depart: 19:00

Cape Evans is a prominent headland on Ross Island in Antarctica, famous for housing the historic British Antarctic Expedition hut built by Robert Falcon Scott during his Terra Nova Expedition (1910–1913). The well-preserved wooden hut served as the expedition's base camp and is now a protected historic site. Surrounded by icy terrain and close to McMurdo Sound, Cape

Evans offers insight into early 20th-century Antarctic exploration and remains a popular destination for researchers and visitors interested in polar history.

Day 20 Franklin Island, Ross Sea Arrive: 07:00 - Depart: 19:00

Discovered in the early 19th century, Franklin Island remains uninhabited and is primarily visited by scientists studying the region's unique wildlife and geology. Its remote location makes it a key spot for understanding Antarctic ecosystems in the Ross Sea area.

Day 21 Inexpressible Island, Ross Sea

Arrive: 07:00 - Depart: 19:00

Inexpressible Island is a rugged, ice-covered island located in the Ross Sea, Antarctica, near the coast of Victoria Land. It is historically notable for being the site where members of the British Terra Nova Expedition (1910–1913) endured a harsh winter after being stranded during their return from the South Pole. The island's name reflects the extreme conditions faced by the explorers. Today, Inexpressible Island remains uninhabited and is important for scientific research and wildlife, including seabird colonies.

Day 22 Kay Islands, Ross Sea

It is historically significant as the site of the first confirmed landing on the Antarctic continent, made by the Norwegian explorer Carsten Borchgrevink in 1895. The cape is home to one of the largest and oldest Adélie penguin colonies in Antarctica and features well-preserved historic huts from early expeditions. Cape Adare remains an important location for both wildlife and the history of Antarctic exploration.

PACKING LIST GUIDE

As Antarctica is one of the most remote, rarely visited, parts of the world, knowing what to pack for your voyage isn't always easy. So, in case you're unsure what clothes to pack for a cruise to Antarctica, below is a simple cruise outfit planner.

Plan ahead

It's best to pack thoughtfully for Antarctica's climate. Unless you travel there frequently, there's no reason you'd know what clothes to bring on a cruise to Antarctica. Everyone experiences the cold (and warmth) differently, but it pays to bear in mind daily temperatures in the Antarctic Peninsula can range from well below freezing to the upper 40°F/4°C. Plus, windchill can make things feel much colder, especially as you'll be spending a lot of your time outdoors in places that are subject to strong winds.

Stay warm

When you're thinking about what clothes to take on a cruise, it's worth remembering that the outside temperature in Antarctica can feel much colder than the reading on a thermometer. So it's recommended you wrap up extra warm. Layering is a great way to do this. Wearing several lightweight, loose-fitting layers is better than opting for one heavier layer. This is because the different layers allow for pockets of air between each item of clothing, which provides extra insulation, and it means you can remove or add layers when your body temperature changes.

Choosing clothes

A lot of the action on an expedition cruise happens outside, so dress codes are very relaxed on these voyages. Pack clothes that are comfortable and easy to wash. And it pays to consider how you're going to pack everything. For instance, do you know how to pack a cocktail dress in a suitcase? Is a cocktail dress something you'll definitely need? Some guests find it helpful to choose their clothes, then go back and edit their choices after an hour or so.

What to pack

For the polar regions you'll need casual trousers, jeans, long-sleeved t-shirts and a thin jumper or bodywarmer. You'll be cosy and comfortable when you're inside the ship, but it's always good to have warm clothes handy for when something out on deck takes your interest. Waterproof trousers, to wear over your pants or

thermal underwear, are essential for Zodiac trips and land excursions. You'll need to bring a warm, windproof hat that covers your head and ears, and a collar scarf to protect your neck and chin from the elements. Polarised sunglasses will help reduce the glare from the snow and ice, protect your eyes from UV rays, and help you see the details of the Antarctic scenery better. It's also worth packing mittens, ski gloves and insulated glove liners to keep your hands warm and dry. Also, you might want to pack swimming and fitness gear if you plan to visit the spa, pool or fitness centre. Evenings are informal, but maybe pack a couple of casual shirts, and skirts or dresses for dinner, and something stylish for special occasions, such as cocktails with the Captain. When it comes to footwear, keep it light and easy to pack. Swan Hellenic will provide a pair of rubber Muck boots for Zodiac excursions and onshore landings, so a pair of lightweight trainers will be fine. Steer clear of bringing high-heels, especially stilettos, as the seas can get rough at times, and you'll need to keep your balance.

Expedition extras

When you travel to the polar regions, a Swan Hellenic expedition parka will be waiting for you in your stateroom on the first day of the cruise. This is yours to keep after your voyage. Your parka is water and windproof, and features an adjustable hood with fleece lining for added warmth, a visor for optimal visibility in all conditions, and a high collar and elongated cuffs to give you extra protection. You'll also receive a branded waterproof backpack, which will be useful for protecting your camera and any other electronic gear that you want to bring for shore landings.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Buenos Aires

In February, Buenos Aires experiences warm and humid summer weather. Daytime temperatures typically range between 25°C and 32°C, while nights remain mild, averaging around 20°C to 22°C. It's one of the wetter months, with occasional thunderstorms and humidity levels often above 60%. Despite the chance of rain, there's still plenty of sunshine, making it a lively and vibrant time to visit the city.

Antarctica

In February and March, Antarctica is transitioning from late summer into early autumn, with temperatures beginning to cool. Along the Antarctic Peninsula—where most cruises visit—daytime temperatures in February generally range from -2°C to

4°C, while March sees a drop, averaging between -5°C and 0°C. February still offers relatively stable weather, with long daylight hours and good visibility for wildlife spotting, particularly whales and penguin chicks. By March, daylight begins to shorten and conditions become colder and windier, especially inland. While snow becomes more frequent later in the season, both months remain within the window for expedition cruising, with February marking the end of peak season and March offering a quieter, more atmospheric experience.

Dunedin

In March, Dunedin experiences mild and pleasant early autumn weather. Daytime temperatures typically range from 14°C to 18°C, while nights can be cooler, averaging around 8°C to 10°C. March tends to be relatively settled, with moderate rainfall and a mix of sunny and overcast days. It's a comfortable time to explore the city and its surrounding coastal landscapes, as the summer crowds ease and the autumn colours begin to appear.

You will be responsible for all your personal belongings whilst on tour. You must carry your own luggage to and from the transfers, hotel and cruise ship.

Mobility

If you require wheelchair access please contact our friendly sales and service team to inquire on your behalf.

Fitness Level Required

Adventure (and spontaneity) create some of the best travel memories. Bear in mind, your home schedules and timings might not be adhered to on tour - it's all part of the fun!

A moderate level of fitness will be required. Expect a moderate pace of touring with a focus on guided tours that may include full days with extended activity, guided city tours or nature walks. You will require a general level of fitness for unassisted navigation of stairs and inclines, longer distances with possible periods of standing when visiting sites, walking on sloping, uneven ground or elevations. You will be responsible for your own luggage and have the ability to board all modes of transport without assistance.

Please note:

- Many areas may be inaccessible to wheelchairs or mobility scooters, where the unassisted use of personal walking sticks and other aids may be required. Although some assistance may be available, every traveller should be self-reliant during all aspects of their travel.*
- It is expected that every traveller must be self-reliant and able to undertake all aspects of their own travel. Please speak to your booking agent about your personal circumstances and any assistance requirements to ensure this tour is right for you.*
- If you have any concerns, please consult your healthcare provider prior to purchase/travel.*

Yellow Fever

A valid international certificate of

vaccination against Yellow Fever is required in many countries. You may need to present this on arrival at the airport or border crossing. Some countries will refuse entry if you are unable to present your certificate. It's also common for your home country to request a Yellow Fever certificate upon arrival. You must check with your doctor well before leaving home about the Yellow Fever requirements for the countries you'll be visiting.

Sightseeing

Please note: If entry to a site is affected by changes in operating hours or public holiday closures, your itinerary, where possible, may be adjusted, or a similar activity will be offered in its place (subject to availability).

Wildlife

Shopping

Shopping overseas can be a daunting and confusing experience, especially when there is a language barrier. Please be very cautious when foreign currencies and prices are involved. Visas

New Zealand

All travellers to New Zealand are required to complete a traveller declaration 24 hours prior to arrival in New Zealand. Most Australian citizens don't need a visa to enter unless you have a criminal record or if you've been deported from any country. Australian permanent residents

need to apply online for a New Zealand Electronic Travel Authority (NZeTA) to enter New Zealand. Australian citizens are exempt from this rule. New Zealand Immigration requires you to have 3 months of validity on your passport after the date you plan to leave.

Argentina

A tourist visa for Argentina is no longer required if travelling on an Australian Passport. Passengers must hold a passport valid at least six months on entry with one blank visa page.

Please Note: Effective immediately, all international travellers to Argentina must hold valid travel insurance with medical coverage. This insurance may be requested and verified upon arrival in the country. Argentina's public healthcare system will no longer provide free medical services to foreign nationals. It is therefore essential that you obtain appropriate insurance before your departure.

Chile (For optional Santiago, Chile pre tour stopovers)

As of 17th September 2025 tourist visas for Chile are not required if travelling on an Australian Passport. You can stay in Chile for up to 90 days without a visa. If you're unsure whether you need a visa, contact the nearest embassy or consulate of Chile.

Important:

- Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
- It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*

Important Information

- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
- *It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.*

Travel Insurance

Embarking on your next trip is exciting, and while you hope the unexpected does not happen, it is best to be prepared. We strongly recommend you take out travel insurance when making your booking.
