Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Delhi, India

Today, depart for Delhi, India!

It proudly bears the names of 85,000 Indian Army soldiers who bravely lost their lives during the campaigns of World War I. Finally, drive past Rashtrapati Bhawan, the opulent official residence of the President of India. This majestic palace-like building is a fascinating fusion of Mughal and Western architectural styles, reflecting India's rich cultural tapestry.

Optional Activity: UNESCO World Heritage Sites Exploration

Spend an afternoon delving into two of the city's incredible UNESCO World Heritage sites. India boasts an astounding 40 UNESCO sites, and this optional activity discovers two of Delhi's most significant. First, visit Humayun's Tomb, often regarded as the precursor to the Taj Mahal. This magnificent complex of buildings, set amidst perfectly manicured lawns and serene fountains, was the first grand example of Mughal architecture in India, built to house the body of Emperor Humayun.

Next, marvel at the towering Qutub Minar, a spectacular 72.5-metre victory tower with five distinct storeys. Built by Qutb ud-din Aibak in 1193, it stands as the world's tallest brick minaret. Adorned with intricate engravings from the Quran in red sandstone, its impressive scale and detailed craftsmanship are truly breathtaking.

Commissioned by Shah Jahan in 1631 in memory of his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal, construction of this architectural masterpiece began in 1632, with the principal mausoleum completed by 1643 and the surrounding buildings and gardens finished approximately five years later. Prepare to be utterly mesmerised by this symbol of eternal love.

Khajuraho, a place of profound beauty and artistic expression, is renowned worldwide for its extraordinary temples. Dedicated to various gods and goddesses like Shiva, Jagdamba, and Vishnu, these ancient temples are magnificent examples of exemplary sculptural art and architecture. Though famous for their intricate and sometimes erotic sculptures, these temples are over a thousand years old and stand as a testament to enduring craftsmanship. Of the original 85 temples, 20 have survived centuries of history and nature's fury and are now carefully preserved as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Khajuraho has historically been one of India's most visited sites after the Taj Mahal, also famed for its annual dance festival.

In the afternoon, embark on a captivating city tour, beginning with the Western Group of Temples. This impressive cluster comprises 14 magnificent temples, including the prominent Chaunsath Yogini, Lalguan Mahadev, Parvati, Varaha, Matangesvara, Lakshmana, Vishvanath and Nandi, Chitr Gupta, Devi Jagdamba, and the grand Kandariya Mahadeo temples. Each one tells a story through its exquisite carvings and intricate details.

Explore the serene Parsvanath, Adinath, Shantinath, and Ghantai temples belonging to the Jain faith, alongside the beautiful Vamana, Javari, and Brahma Hindu temples.

Day 15 Kanchanaburi

Today, delve deeper into Kanchanaburi's captivating blend of poignant history and breathtaking natural beauty. Your day begins with a sobering and important look into the region's past at the JEATH War Museum (or a similar WWII museum in the area). This museum provides a detailed insight into the harsh realities faced by prisoners of war who were forced to build the infamous Burma Railway during World War II, often featuring reconstructed bamboo huts and poignant exhibits that pay tribute to their sacrifice.

In stark contrast, your journey continues further into the province to reveal the serene and stunning Erawan National Park, a true jewel of Thailand's natural landscape. This park is home to the magnificent seven-tiered Erawan Waterfall, named for its resemblance to the three-headed elephant from Hindu mythology. Renowned for its beautiful, accessible levels, you'll have the opportunity to swim in crystal-clear emerald-green pools, enjoy the lush jungle surroundings, and spot diverse wildlife. It offers a refreshing and picturesque escape after reflecting on the historical significance of the area, allowing you to connect with Thailand's unspoiled natural wonders.

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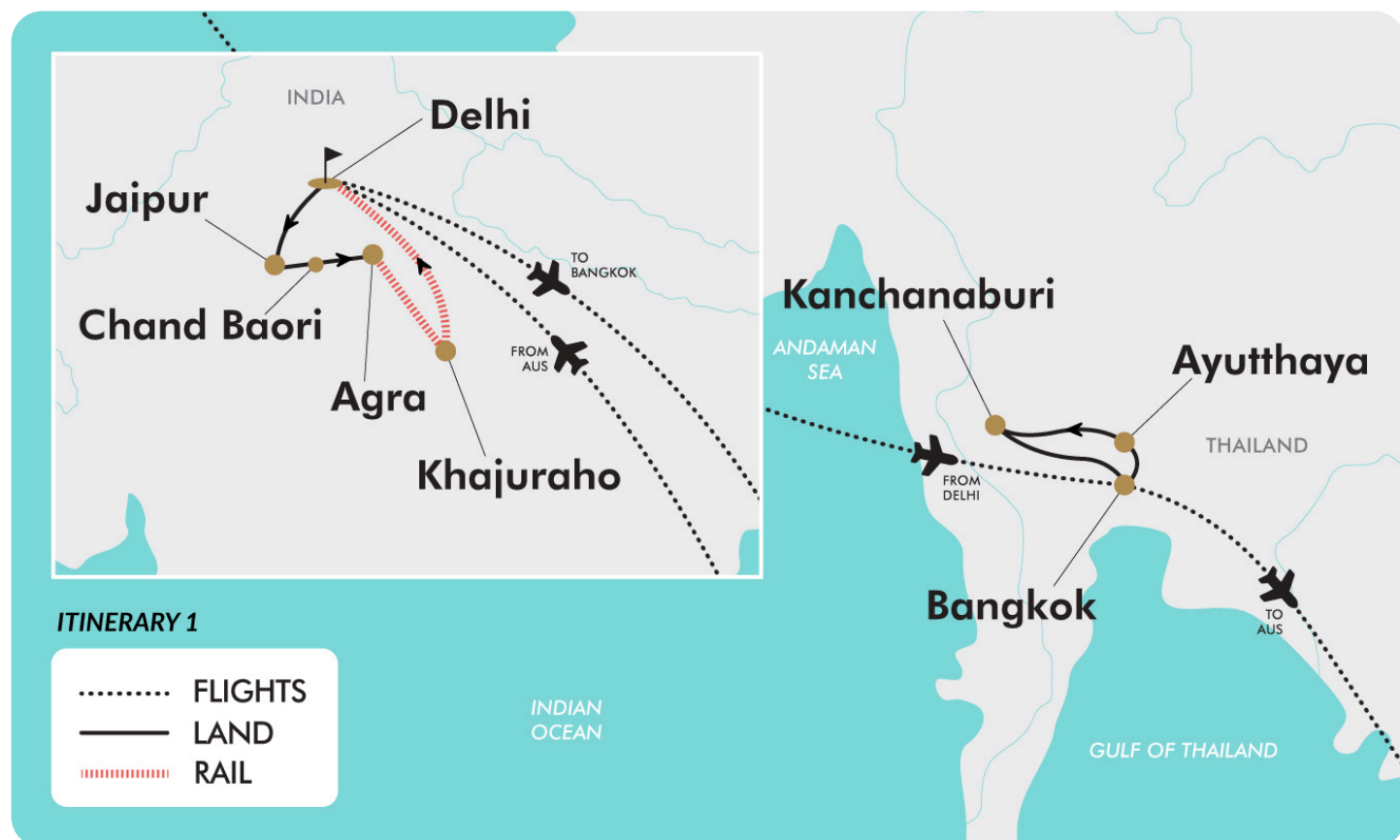

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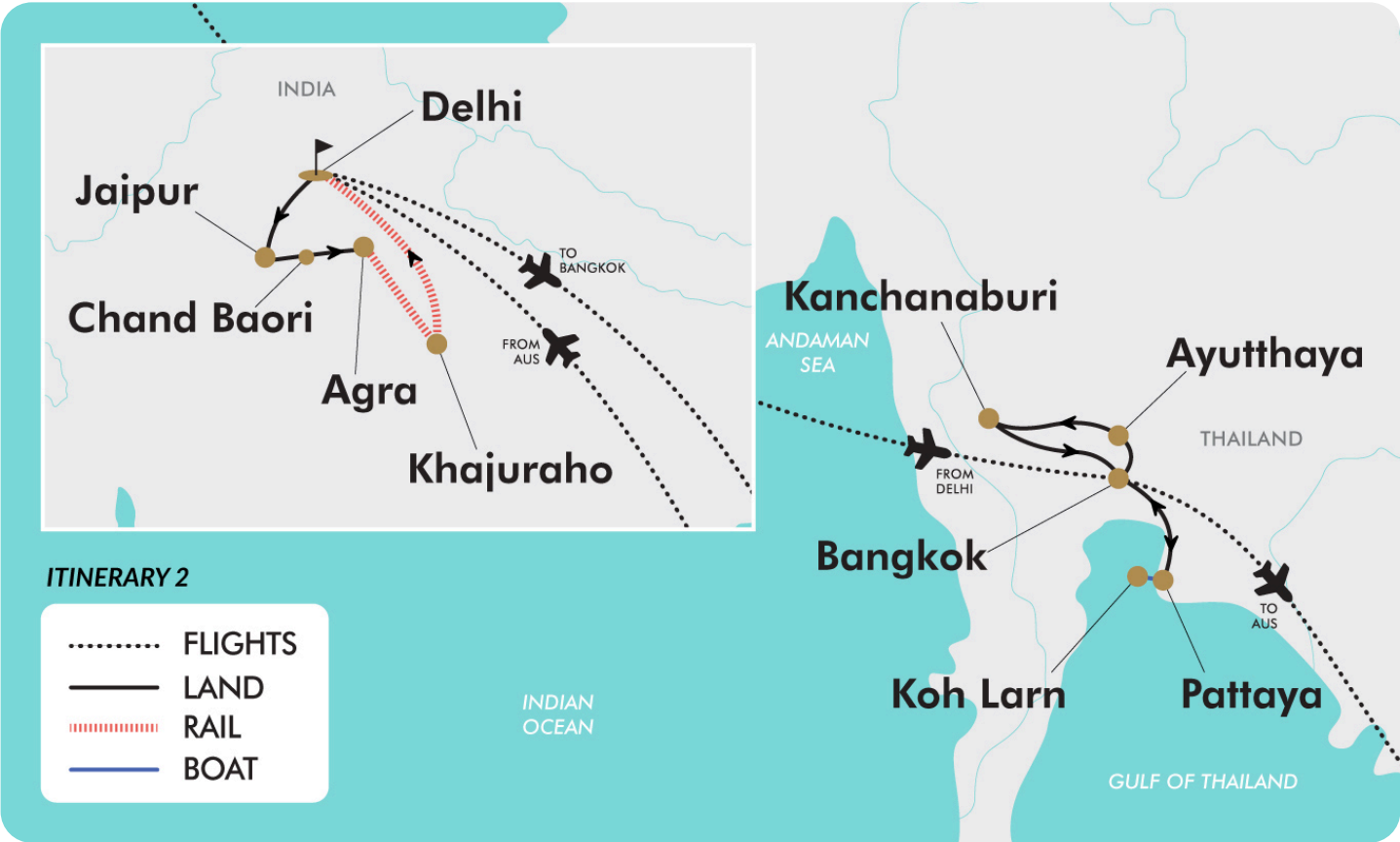

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES
