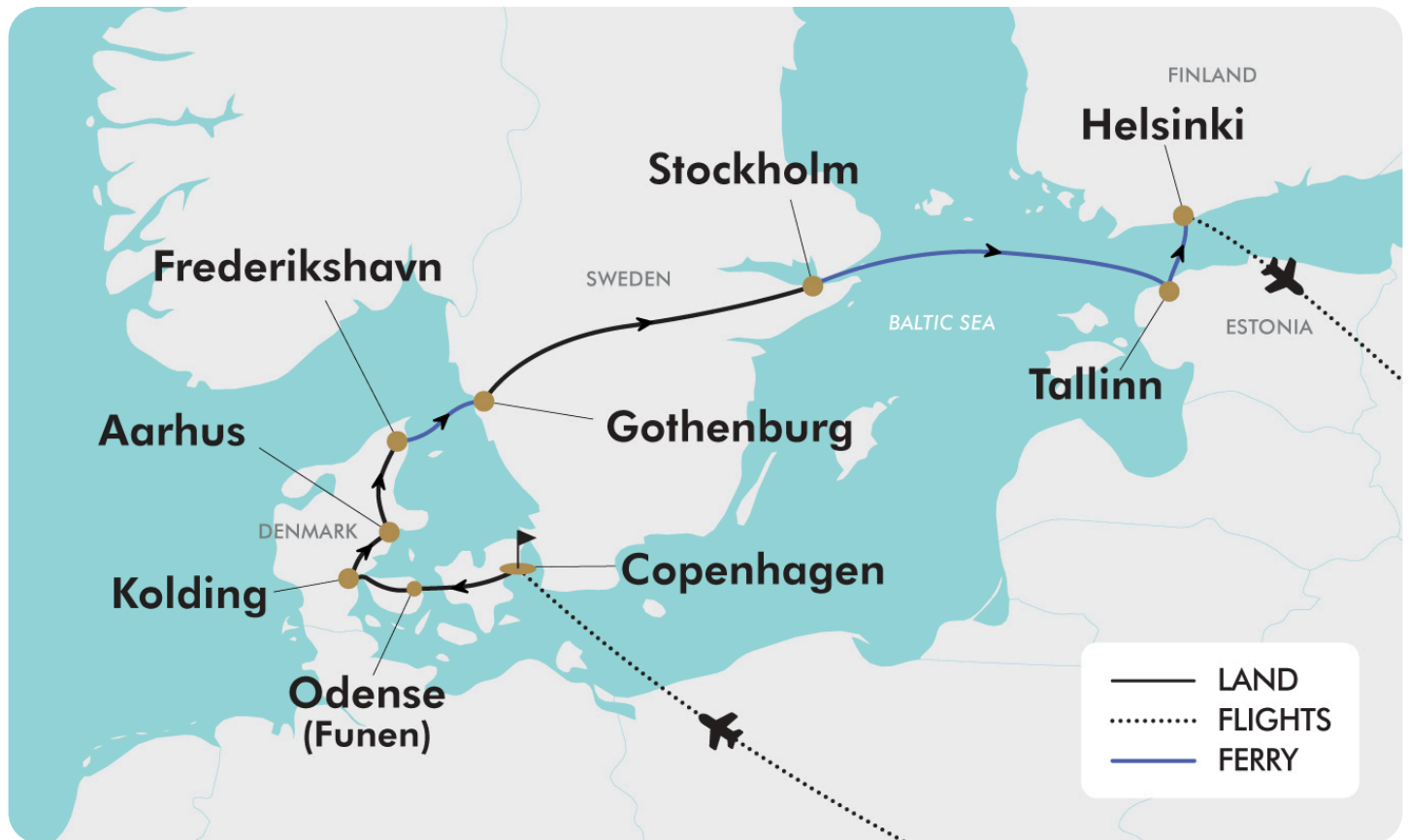

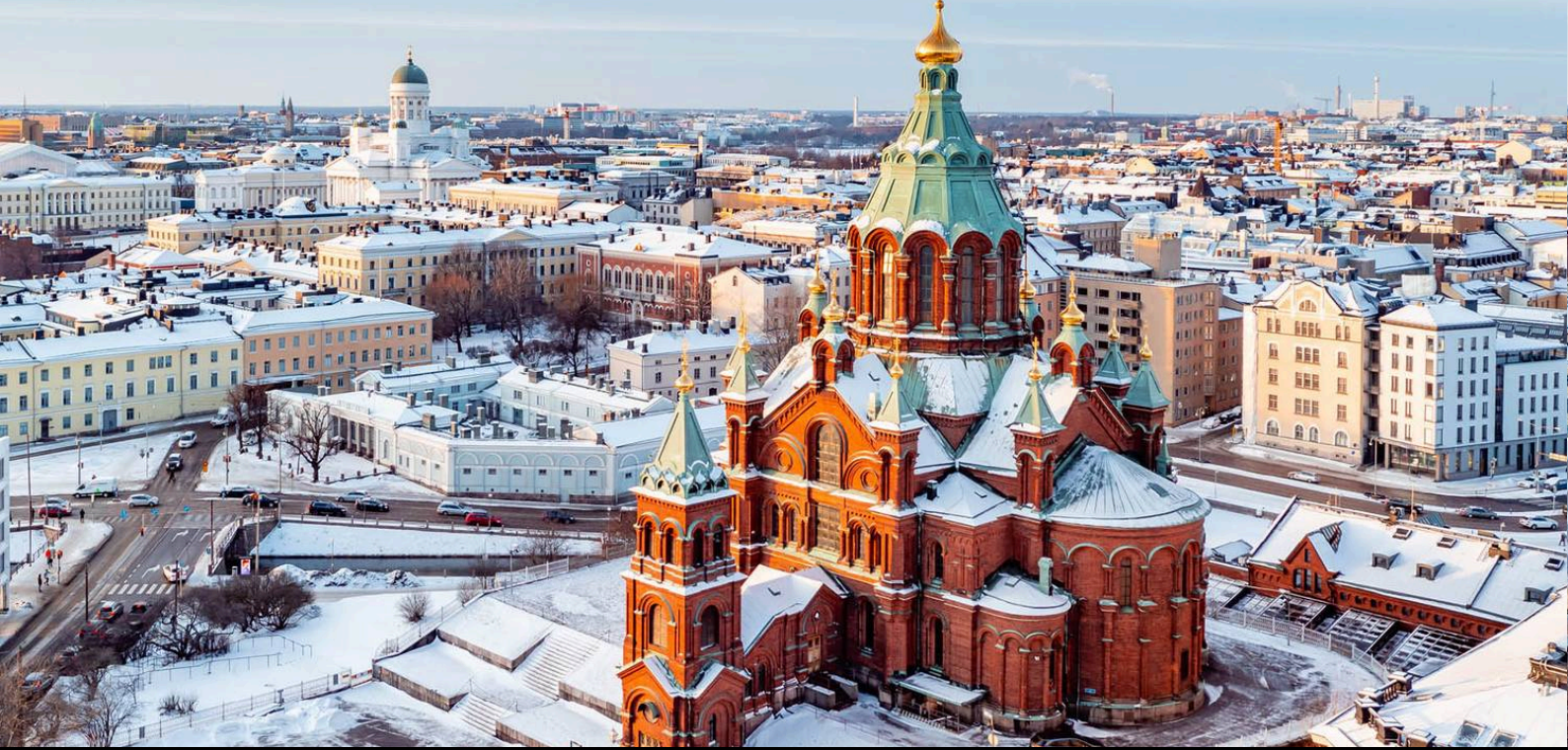
The Map

Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Copenhagen, Denmark

Today, you'll fly from Australia (or New Zealand) to Copenhagen, Denmark.

Please note: Some flights may depart on Day 2 and arrive on Day 2.

Day 2 Copenhagen, Denmark

Welcome to Copenhagen! Upon arrival, transfer from Copenhagen Airport to your centrally located accommodation. In the late afternoon, meet your local tour director for a briefing of the complete tour.

Overnight: Imperial Hotel or similar, Copenhagen

Day 3 Copenhagen & Tivoli Gardens

Copenhagen at Christmas is nothing short of magical. As the seasons change, the city transforms into a winter wonderland filled with twinkling lights, cosy markets and the unmistakable spirit of hygge. The heart of the city glows with Christmas lights and decorations, especially along Strøget, one of Europe's longest pedestrian streets. The picturesque Nyhavn harbour is also lined with festive boats and stalls. The scent of roasted almonds, cinnamon and hot gløgg (Danish mulled wine) fills the air as locals and visitors gather at charming Christmas markets including the famous ones at Tivoli Gardens, Kongens Nytorv and Højbro Plads.

Enjoy a leisurely stroll to the Tivoli gardens with the tour leader (entrance included). The area becomes a fairytale with thousands of lights, snow-dusted trees, themed rides, and traditional

wooden stalls selling gifts and seasonal treats. It's a must-visit for all ages. Despite the cold, the city feels warmer than ever with candles flickering in windows, locals wrapped in scarves sipping warm drinks, and the peaceful calm of snow settling on historic rooftops.

Copenhagen at Christmas time offers a perfect mix of tradition, charm and Scandinavian magic. This makes it one of Europe's most enchanting holiday destinations.

Overnight: Imperial Hotel or similar, Copenhagen

Day 4 Copenhagen - Odense - Kolding

Today, after a delightful breakfast in Copenhagen, you'll journey west to Odense, a city that offers a beautiful and relaxing glimpse into the Danish countryside. This scenic drive spans approximately 165 kilometres (about 2 hours), taking you across the iconic Great Belt Bridge (Storebæltsbroen) and onto the charming island of Funen (Fyn), the birthplace of beloved storyteller Hans Christian Andersen.

The highlight of the drive is undoubtedly crossing the Great Belt Fixed Link. This engineering marvel, one of the longest suspension bridges in the world, stretches nearly 18 kilometres, connecting the islands of Zealand and Funen. As you traverse the bridge, you'll be treated to stunning views of the Baltic Sea which is dotted with wind turbines, a powerful symbol of Denmark's commitment to sustainability.

You'll soon arrive in Odense, Denmark's third-largest city with a peaceful blend of modern life and historic charm. Embark on a captivating walking tour with your tour leader. The journey

begins just outside the H.C. Andersen Museum, stroll across to Kongens Have, one of Denmark's oldest royal gardens. This serene park, with its beautiful fountains and vibrant flower beds, is the perfect starting point for delving into the city's historic heart.

See the striking St. Canute's Cathedral (Skt. Knuds Kirke) which houses the relics of King Canute, Denmark's patron saint. Next door stands Odense City Hall, its design inspired by Italian medieval architecture. The adjacent Flakhaven Square is a lively hub, often hosting open-air markets, music or delightful seasonal events. The tour concludes with a pleasant walk along the Odense River in Munke Mose, a beautiful urban park.

Leaving the cultural heart of Odense, journey to Kolding on an approximately 80-kilometre drive.

Overnight: Comwell Hotel Kolding or similar, Kolding
Meals included: Breakfast

Day 5 Kolding - Aarhus

After breakfast, depart from Kolding for an approximately 100-kilometre drive north to Aarhus. This peaceful route unveils a landscape of rolling fields, tranquil forests, picturesque fjords and charming small towns. Aarhus offers a unique blend of historic charm and youthful dynamism, set against the scenic backdrop of Aarhus Bay. Its medieval roots, cutting-edge architecture, and thriving student population keep the city buzzing year-round.

Upon arrival, immerse yourself in history at Den Gamle By, an extraordinary open-air museum. This unique attraction meticulously recreates Danish life from different historical eras

with full-scale buildings, costumed interpreters and working shops. During the Christmas season, Den Gamle By transforms into a living celebration of 300 years of Danish Christmas traditions, spanning from the 1600s through the 1970s. As you wander its cobbled streets at leisure, the air fills with the delightful scents of roasted almonds, mulled wine (gløgg) and fresh spruce. Candles flicker warmly in windows, old-fashioned lanterns illuminate the paths and period-dressed townsfolk bustle about.

Overnight: Scandic The Mayor or similar, Aarhus
Meals included: Breakfast

Day 6 Aarhus - Frederikshavn, Denmark - Gothenburg, Sweden

Head north approximately 180 kilometres and watch as the urban surroundings give way to a quintessential Danish countryside. You'll see a blend of rolling hills, farmlands, forests and glimpses of inland fjords. As you near Frederikshavn, the air becomes saltier and the trees subtly bend in the sea breeze, signalling the arrival in this coastal town. Frederikshavn serves as a gateway to Læsø Island and northern adventures like Skagen, but it's also a destination worth exploring on its own.

Embark on a Stena Line ferry from Frederikshavn to Gothenburg in Sweden. As your ferry glides into Gothenburg's harbour, the scenery transforms from open sea to a labyrinth of rocky islets and green coastal hills, dotted with summer cottages and lighthouses. The air is crisp and salty as Sweden's second-largest city slowly unfolds before you, a seamless blend of maritime charm, modern design and laid-back energy. Upon disembarking at Stena Line's ferry terminal, you're only minutes from the city

centre. Whether you walk, hop on a tram or catch a taxi, the transition is easy and scenic (charges may apply). Within moments, you're surrounded by broad boulevards, leafy parks and canals.

In Gothenburg, embark on a captivating walking tour with your tour leader. The tour invites you to explore a delightful mix of cosy neighbourhoods, stunning architecture, waterfront views and lush green spaces. Begin at the bustling city square of Kungssportsplatsen, gateway to Gothenburg's main boulevard. You'll find Avenyn lined with shops, cafés and cultural venues.

Walk down to Gustav Adolfs Torg, Gothenburg's historic central square named after the city's founder. Here, you can admire the impressive City Hall, the statue of King Gustav II Adolf and the surrounding classic architecture. Stroll towards the picturesque canal district where narrow waterways wind alongside charming cafés and boutiques. From there, head to Haga, one of Gothenburg's oldest neighbourhoods which is known for its cobblestone streets, quaint wooden houses, and cozs fika spots. No visit is complete without a stop at Feskekôrka, Gothenburg's famed indoor fish market which is housed in a building shaped like a Gothic church.

Starting on Sweden's rugged west coast, the road gently rolls eastward boasting a panorama of dense forests, fertile farmlands and pristine lakes. The scenic journey culminates in the bustling, historic capital, beautifully situated on the Baltic Sea.

Upon arrival in Stockholm, immerse yourself in its unique charm. Enjoy a delightful walking stroll of Gamla Stan (Old Town) with your tour leader. As the seasons change, Stockholm truly transforms into a sparkling festive wonderland. The Gamla Stan Christmas Market at Stortorget Square stands as its magical centrepiece. Nestled among the historic, colourful buildings of the Old Town, this charming market warmly invites locals and visitors alike to experience authentic Swedish holiday traditions in a truly enchanting atmosphere.

Tour Leader

However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

EU Entry/Exit System (EES)

From October 12, 2025, a new European Entry System (EES) replaces the current manual passport-stamping process for non-EU travellers. Upon arrival in the Schengen area, Australian and New Zealand passport holders will have their fingerprints recorded and a photograph taken. Their entry and exit dates will be electronically registered. No previous action is required, but please be aware of longer wait times at border entry. From 10

April 2026, the EES will be fully operational at all external border crossing points of all the European countries (Schengen area) using the system.

European Travel Information & Authorisation System (ETIAS)

As an extension of the EES implementation introduced from 2025, ETIAS travel authorisation is a mandatory entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals travelling to any of these [30 European countries](#), including Australian and New Zealand citizens, that will be introduced in 2026. We advise you to monitor [smartraveller.com.au](#) closer to your departure to ensure you are up to date on the requirements at the time of entry.

Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
