

Kinnvika is a bay situated on the northern side of Murchisonfjorden on the Storsteinhalvøya peninsula in Nordaustlandet, Svalbard. Established during the International Geophysical Year of 1957 to 1958 by Sweden and Finland, it served as a scientific station for geophysical research, including studies on meteorology, aurora borealis (northern lights) and geomagnetism.

Its calm waters and striking surroundings make it a popular spot for Arctic cruises and wildlife observation. Monacobreen is a large and active glacier that flows into Liefdefjorden. The glacier is a key highlight of the area. Visitors often witness ice calving into the fjord, creating a spectacular natural display and offering insight into the dynamic Arctic environment.

Day 7 Heclahamna - Kinnvika, Svalbard

Heclahamna is a natural harbour located on the eastern side of Sørkjorden in Ny-Friesland, Spitsbergen, Svalbard. Named after the British naval vessel Hecla from Parry's 1827 expedition, it was the site of a Swedish-Russian land station during the 1899–1900 Arc-of-Meridian Expedition, marking it as a significant historical location in Arctic exploration.


Kinnvika is a bay situated on the northern side of Murchisonfjorden on the Storsteinhalvøya peninsula in Nordaustlandet, Svalbard. Established during the International Geophysical Year of 1957/1958 by Sweden and Finland, it served as a scientific station for geophysical research, including studies on meteorology, aurora borealis, and geomagnetism.

Day 8 Chermsideøya - Phippsøya - Cruising in search of Ice Pack, Svalbard

Chermsideøya and Phippsøya are remote islands in the Sjuøyane (Seven Islands) group, located at the far northern edge of the Svalbard archipelago. These islands are known for their stark Arctic beauty, frequent polar bear sightings, and their role as stepping stones for explorers heading even farther north. Phippsøya is the largest of the group and often visited by expedition cruises.

Due to its isolation and challenging conditions, human activity on Storøya is minimal, preserving its pristine polar environment.

Day 10 Kvitøya, Svalbard

Kvitøya, meaning "White Island" in Norwegian, is one of the easternmost and most remote islands in the Svalbard archipelago. Almost entirely covered by an ice cap, with only a small rocky outcrop called Andréeneset visible, Kvitøya is both stark and mysterious. It is historically significant as the site where the remains of the ill-fated 1897 Andrée balloon expedition were discovered in 1930. Harsh weather, heavy ice, and its isolation make Kvitøya rarely visited, but its untouched Arctic environment and dramatic history continue to fascinate explorers and historians alike.

Day 11 Sundneset - Villa Disko, Svalbard

Sundneset is a scenic headland located on the eastern side of Barentsøya in the Svalbard archipelago. Known for its tundra landscapes and rich wildlife, the area is a popular landing site for Arctic cruises. Visitors to Sundneset often encounter Arctic foxes and nesting seabirds, all set against a backdrop of sweeping coastal views and rugged terrain.

Villa Disko is a historic trapper's cabin situated at Sundneset. Built in the early 20th century, it was used by Norwegian trappers during overwintering periods. The well-preserved cabin offers a glimpse into the harsh and isolated life of early Arctic hunters, making it both a cultural and historical point of interest for visitors exploring Barentsøya.

Known as one of the world's northernmost towns, it serves as a gateway for Arctic exploration and research. The town features a unique blend of modern facilities and Arctic wilderness, with museums, shops and restaurants alongside stunning landscapes of mountains and glaciers. Longyearbyen is also home to a diverse community of scientists, miners and adventurers, making it a vibrant hub in the High Arctic.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Tromso

In Tromsø, Norway, June and July bring mild temperatures with long daylight hours due to the Midnight Sun. Average temperatures in June range from 7°C to 13°C, while in July, they rise slightly to 10°C to 15°C. However, occasional cold spells can bring temperatures below 5°C, especially in early June. Rain is common, with frequent light showers, and the weather can be unpredictable, shifting between sunshine and overcast skies. Despite the cool temperatures, the near-constant daylight creates a unique and vibrant atmosphere, ideal for outdoor activities like hiking and wildlife spotting.

Copenhagen

Copenhagen in June and July offers pleasant summer weather, making it an ideal time to visit. In June, average daytime high temperatures typically reach around

19-20°C (66-68°F), while nights are cooler, dropping to about 11-13°C (52-55°F). It's one of the sunniest months with ample daylight hours (around 17-18 hours), and while there's a moderate chance of rain, showers are usually brief. The city's beaches and harbor baths become popular as the sea temperature begins to warm up. Moving into July, Copenhagen experiences its warmest period, with average daytime highs often reaching 20-21°C (68-70°F), and comfortable evening lows around 13-16°C (55-61°F). July continues to offer long daylight hours and plenty of sunshine, though it can be slightly wetter than June with a higher chance of scattered showers. Both months are generally considered comfortable and mild, perfect for exploring the city's outdoor attractions and enjoying the vibrant summer atmosphere.

Svalbard

In Svalbard, June and July are the warmest months, but temperatures remain cool, ranging from 1°C to 7°C in June and 3°C to 10°C in July. The archipelago experiences the Midnight Sun, with continuous daylight creating a unique Arctic summer atmosphere. The weather is highly variable, with sudden shifts between sunshine, fog, and occasional rain or snow showers. Winds can be strong, adding to the chill, especially near the coast. Despite the cold, summer is an excellent time for exploring Svalbard's dramatic landscapes, spotting wildlife like polar bears and Arctic foxes, and experiencing the region's glaciers and fjords.

Passport Validity

Visas

Norway

Australian passport holders do not require a visa to travel to Norway for a stay of up to 90 days within a 180-day period.

Denmark

Australian passport holders do not require a visa to travel to Denmark for a stay of up to 90 days within a 180-day period.

EU Entry/Exit System (EES)

From October 12, 2025, a new European Entry System (EES) replaces the current manual passport-stamping process for non-EU travellers. Upon arrival in the Schengen area, Australian and New Zealand passport holders will have their fingerprints recorded and a photograph taken. Their entry and exit dates will be electronically registered. No previous action is required, but please be aware of longer wait times at border entry. From 10 April 2026, the EES will be fully operational at all external border crossing

points of all the European countries (Schengen area) using the system.

European Travel Information & Authorisation System (ETIAS)

As an extension of the EES implementation introduced from 2025, ETIAS travel authorisation is a mandatory entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals travelling to any of [these 30 European countries](#), including Australian and New Zealand citizens, that will be introduced in 2026. We advise you to monitor [smartraveller.com.au](#) closer to your departure to ensure you are up to date on the requirements at the time of entry.

Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
- *It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.*
