recorded species, making it a paradise for birdwatchers, especially during the wet season when migratory birds arrive in abundance.

Pause for an authentic African lunch, savoured right in the heart of nature and surrounded by the park's wild beauty. As the afternoon unfolds, switch gears and board a private boat for a serene cruise along the Chobe River. Cruise to Sedudu Island and its lush marshes, offering unparalleled opportunities to spot an abundance of wildlife from a unique watery perspective.

Stretching over 200 kilometres in length and up to 40 kilometres wide, Lake Kariba's flooded forests, hills and plains form a surreal and iconic landscape. Enjoy dinner and spend a peaceful first night on board.

Despite being artificial, Lake Kariba has developed into a thriving ecosystem. Its vast waters are home to abundant fish species, most notably tigerfish and bream. The lake also supports rich birdlife while drawing hippos, crocodiles and elephants to its shores. It's a peaceful yet wild destination, ideal for travellers seeking both relaxation and adventure on the water.

Day 7 Cruising to Spurwing Island, Zimbabwe

At sunrise, journey across the mystical waters of Lake Kariba where the eerie silhouettes of drowned trees rise from the shimmering surface. Board a small private boat to venture into the secluded waterways of Matusadona National Park, gliding through winding channels and untouched inlets. The peaceful stillness and abundant wildlife create a truly magical atmosphere. Keep your eyes peeled for buffalo, lions, elephants and leopards on the lakes shores.

After returning to the ship for lunch, continue sailing toward Palm Bay. As the sun begins to set, head out once more by boat to witness the sky come alive with vibrant colours. Dinner will be served onboard, followed by a peaceful night on the lake.

Day 8 Matusadona National Park, Zimbabwe

This morning, set out on a safari to explore the remarkable wilderness around Matusadona National Park. Nestled between the Sanyati and Ume Rivers, this vast and unspoiled area, spanning 1,400 square kilometres, is rich in wildlife. Keep an eye out for elephants, hippos, buffalo, crocodiles and an impressive array of birdlife. With a bit of luck, you may even spot a big cat roaming the bush.

Matusadona's history is deeply tied to that of Lake Kariba. When the dam was constructed and the waters rose, a massive wildlife rescue mission known as Operation Noah saved over 6,000 animals from the flooding. Many of these were relocated to this protected park where hunting is strictly forbidden.

Return to the ship for lunch and continue sailing. During the afternoon, enjoy a fascinating round-table discussion about the creation of Lake Kariba, the people and animals it affects, and the evolving ecosystem it supports.

Day 9 Disembark Cruise - Kariba Dam - Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

Today, the dam supplies around 70% of Zimbabwe's electricity and stands as a remarkable feat of engineering. Learn about its fascinating history and the local legends surrounding its creation, including the mythical tale of NyamiNyami, the Zambezi River god believed to protect the valley's people.

You'll then board a private plane for a scenic flight to Victoria Falls where an elegant lunch cruise on the Zambezi River awaits. The afternoon is yours to unwind so enjoy relaxing by the hotel pool while taking in views of the surrounding savannah. In the evening, enjoy dinner and settle in for the night at a comfortable hotel in Victoria Falls.

For those seeking more adventure, two optional excursions are available.

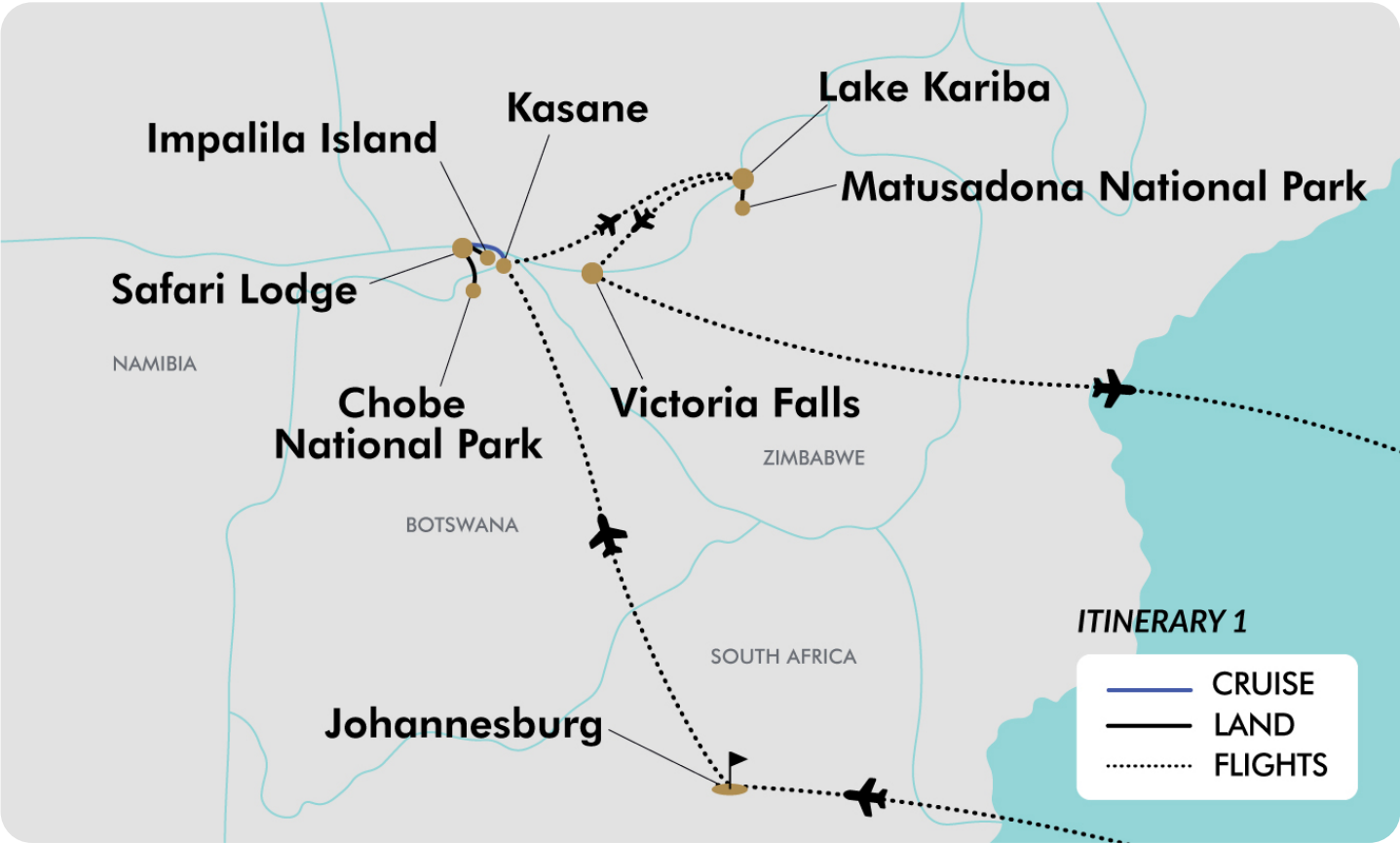

Day 11 Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe - Board Rovos Rail Train

Today, enjoy a day at leisure before making your own way to Victoria Falls Station. You may freshen up in your suite before joining fellow travellers in the lounge car or observation car at the rear of the train. Dinner is served in the dining cars en route to Malindi (formal dress required).

Please note: Ensure the Train Manager or Administration Deputy is in possession of your passport.

Day 12 Rovos Rail - Hwange National Park, Zimbabwe

Today, enjoy a continental breakfast served in the dining cars until departure. Later, enjoy an exciting game drive at The Hide in Hwange National Park.

Hwange National Park, the largest game reserve in Zimbabwe, is one of Africa's top safari destinations, renowned for its incredible diversity and density of wildlife. Covering over 14,600 square kilometres, it lies on the edge of the Kalahari Desert, creating a mix of arid savannah, woodlands and seasonal wetlands that support a vast range of species. The Hide in Hwange National Park is a popular wildlife viewing spot designed to offer visitors close-up, immersive encounters with animals in their natural habitat. Keep your eyes peeled for elephants, buffalo, lions and more!

Lunch will be served when you arrive back onboard as the train travels between Dete and Gwaai along one of the world's longest straight railway stretches (114 kilometres). It passes through Bulawayo, Zimbabwe's second-largest city, the capital of Matabeleland, and its industrial hub.

In the afternoon, tea is served in the lounge and observation cars as the train journeys through baobab country. Dinner will be served in the dining cars en route to the border at Beitbridge (formal dress required).

Day 13 Rovos Rail Free Day Onboard

Breakfast is served in the dining cars until 10:00 as the train crosses the Limpopo River into South Africa at Musina. In the afternoon, enjoy tea in the lounge or observation cars while passing through Warmbaths (Bela-Bela), famed for its natural hot springs, and Nylstroom, a town the Voortrekkers once believed to be the source of the Nile due to its north-flowing river. Later, the train skirts the edge of the escarpment, where the land drops sharply from the Highveld, offering dramatic views of the changing landscape. Dinner is served in the dining cars en route to Pyramid (formal dress required).

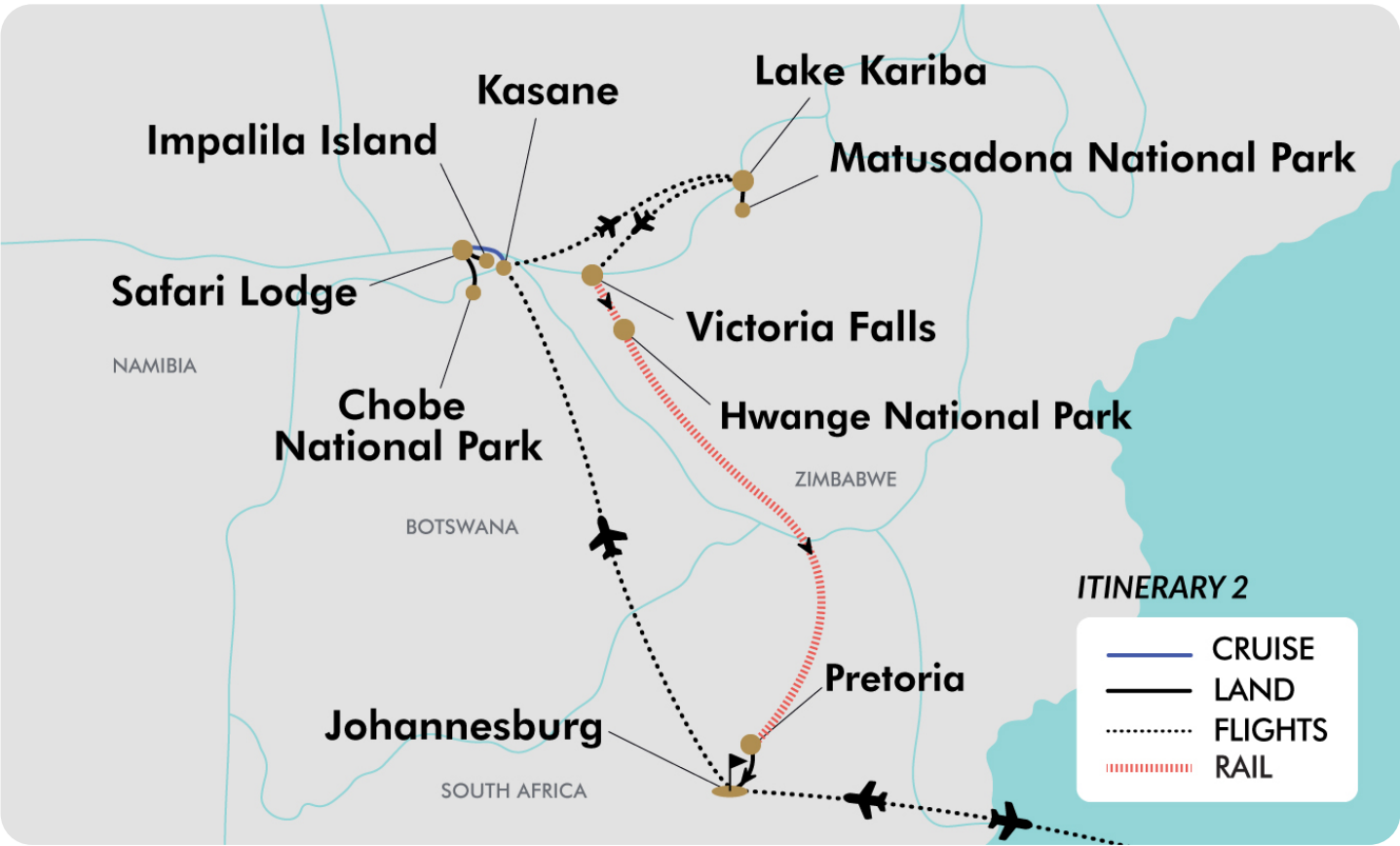

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Johannesburg Area, South Africa

Johannesburg is situated on the highveld plateau, and has a subtropical highland climate. The city enjoys a sunny climate, with the summer months (October to April) characterised by hot days followed by afternoon thunderstorms and cool

evenings.

Botswana

Temperatures in Botswana differ throughout the year. In summer months the climate is warm to hot (November to March) the maximum temperature can reach 30°C with lows of 14°C.

Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

In the area of Victoria Falls, the climate is subtropical, with a mild and dry winter from mid-May to mid-August (during which, however, nights are cold), and a hot, muggy and rainy summer from mid-November to mid-March. Between September and November, before the rainy season, there is a hot period, which is in fact the hottest of the year, with temperatures easily reaching 35°C, and sometimes up to 40°C, even though the humidity is not as high as in summer.

Please note: The amount of water at Victoria Falls (waterfall) will depend on the seasonality.

Namibia, Southern Africa

Summer (November to April): High temperatures are common during the summer months, with daytime temperatures often exceeding 30°C and occasionally reaching higher values, especially in the central and northern regions.

Visas

South Africa

A tourist visa for South Africa is not required for stays up to 90 days if travelling on an Australian or New Zealand Passport.

Botswana

A tourist visa for Botswana is not required for stays up to 90 days if travelling on an Australian or New Zealand Passport. If travelling with children, additional documents may be required. Please stay updated and [check the regulations](#) prior to travel. Botswana has introduced an approximately US\$30 per person tourism levy to be paid on entry in US dollars.

Zimbabwe

Passengers travelling on an Australian or New Zealand passport entering Zimbabwe and Zambia for tourism purposes are required to pay for a multiple entry, 30-day Kaza UniVisa on point of entry into Victoria Falls or Livingstone and costs approximately \$50 USD (approximately \$75 AUD, subject to change). This visa will cover Zimbabwe and can be paid on arrival. Please bring the exact amount in USD cash. Visas can also be purchased prior to travel, if you do pre-purchase your visa please ensure you have a hard copy of the visa ready for immigration.

New Zimbabwe Immigration Requirements

To streamline and speed up the immigration process on arrival, the Zimbabwe Immigration Department has implemented an online immigration declaration form that ideally should be completed by all travellers prior to arriving at any Zimbabwean border post, including Victoria Falls Airport. This new online process will, in time, replace the manual immigration declaration form and is aimed at improving the guest experience at border control.

Namibia

From 1 April 2025, you'll need to apply for a multiple entry visa prior to arrival in Namibia if travelling on an Australian or New Zealand passport. The fee is approximately N\$ 1600 (approximately AUD \$140).

Important:
