

Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Denpasar, Bali, Indonesia

Today, make your own way to the airport for the flight to Denpasar, Bali, Indonesia. Upon arrival, an arranged Swan Hellenic transfer is provided to your hotel. Once checked in, enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Day 2 Denpasar, Bali - Jayapura, Papua, Indonesia Departs: 19:00

After check out this morning an arranged Swan Hellenic transfer will take you to the airport for your flight to Jayapura, Indonesia.

Upon arrival, an arranged Swan Hellenic transfer will take you from the airport to the cruise terminal to board the SH Minerva. The remainder of your day is at leisure to explore this luxurious expedition ship.

Day 4 Pulau Padaidori, Papua, Indonesia

Arrives: 13:00 - Departs: 17:00

Pulau Padaidori is one of a cluster of tiny, mostly uninhabited islands and atolls off the northern Papuan coast. This remote stop combines secluded Pacific Rim beaches with a rich, protected marine ecosystem in its calm sapphire waters, where schools of shimmering tropical fish weave amid colourful coral gardens. Mangrove forests shelter snakes and crabs in their twisted root systems, and swaying coconut palms decorate white-sand beaches.

Day 5 Kwatisore, Cenderawasih Bay, Papua

Arrives: 08:00 - Departs: 18:00

Kwatisore, located along the mainland shore of Cenderawasih Bay, is the bay's most renowned spot for whale shark encounters. Here, the gentle giants gather beneath local fishing platforms (bagans), drawn by the catch. This unique interaction site offers rare, up-close experiences with resident whale sharks in calm, clear waters, making it a world-class destination for marine wildlife enthusiasts.

Day 6 Pulau Roon - Auri Islands, Papua

Pulau Roon

Arrives: 08:00 - Departs: 12:00

Pulau Roon in Indonesia's Papua province is an island paradise known for its rich biodiversity. The island's hilly terrain offers pristine beaches and vibrant coral reefs with diverse marine life like dugong, reef sharks, and schools of reef fish. Pulau Roon also boasts a rich cultural heritage, showcasing intricate craftsmanship and traditional music.

Auri Islands

Arrives: 15:00 - Departs: 18:00

The Auri islands, a gateway to Cenderawasih Bay and its marine park, host diverse coral reefs teeming with fish species, butterfly fish, damselfish, clownfish and resident whale sharks. Named after birds of paradise, Cenderawasih is a haven for these brightly

plumed birds, alongside cassowaries, hornbills and crested pigeons. Dense rainforest and tiny fishing villages define the remote charm of these islands in Cenderawasih Bay.

Day 7 Manokwari, Papua

Arrives: 07:00 - Departs: 13:00

Overlooking tranquil Doreri Bay, where palm trees line sheltered coves and ghostly shipwrecks rest on the seabed, Manokwari is West Papua's coastal capital. In town, artists craft carvings and shell handicrafts, while the market and harbour provide immersion in local commerce and culture. Hiking Mount Arfak, the region's highest point, offers stunning mountain vistas and possible sightings of birds of paradise, cuscuses, and rare tree kangaroos.

Day 8 Ayu Atoll, Raja Ampat, Papua

Arrives: 07:00 - Departs: 18:00

Pulau Ayu, the main island in the Ayu Atoll, is a remote jewel of Raja Ampat. Fringed by ivory beaches and lush rainforest, and surrounded by vibrant coral reefs, it's a sanctuary for nesting leatherback turtles. Beneath its clear waters, tropical marine life flourishes, while the villages of Ayu and Imbik Kuan welcome visitors with warm Papuan hospitality. Once a WWII outpost, its isolation made it a key strategic base for Japanese forces.

Day 9 Waigeo Island, Aljui Bay, Raja Ampat

Arrives: 07:00 - Departs: 18:00

Aljui Bay on Waigeo Island in Indonesia's Raja Ampat archipelago is an extensive mangrove-lined inlet filled with pocket coves. Home to a pearl farm, the bay also offers opportunities to sights like saltwater crocodiles, hornbills, cockatoos, and diverse marine life. Inland, the island features orchid-draped cloud forests and waterfalls, rare birds like the Wilson's bird of paradise, and opportunities to experience Papuan culture.

Day 10 Wayag Island, Raja Ampat

Arrives: 07:00 - Departs: 18:00

One of Raja Ampat's most remote islands, Wayag offers spectacular limestone karst formations surrounded by sapphire sea. Steps lead up to the panoramic Wayag Viewpoint overlooking the bullet-shaped stacks erupting from the ocean. Wayag's unusual landscape exists both above and below the surface with deserted white-sand beaches and underwater gardens packed with soft corals, darting tropical fish and blacktipped reef sharks.

Day 11 Balbulal Lagoon, Pulau Misool - Yapap, Pulau Misool

Balbulal Lagoon

With roughly 1,000 coral and over 1,200 reef fish species, the crystalline waters around jungle-woven Raja Ampat, Indonesia's easternmost islands, comprise the most biodiverse marine habitat unparalleled on the planet. Meaning 'four kings,' Raja Ampat refers to Waigeo, Salawati, Batanta and Misool, yet spreads across 1,000 atolls and islets. Originally part of Australia, Raja Ampat is home to tree-dwelling marsupials and 500 bird species.

Pulau Misool, a remote island in Raja Ampat, showcases wild beauty with white-sand beaches and lush hills.

A highlight is Yapap, a secluded lagoon surrounded by towering limestone karsts. Known for its glassy turquoise waters and white-sand seabed, it's ideal for snorkelling, swimming, and photography. Its serene atmosphere makes it a peaceful escape from more crowded spots.

Day 12 Sorong, West Papua - Denpasar, Bali, Indonesia - Australia (or New Zealand)

Arrives: 08:00 - Disembark

The bustling port city of Sorong in West Papua is known as the gateway to the crystalline waters of Raja Ampat, the world's most biodiverse marine habitat, home to over 1,500 species of fish and 75 per cent of the world's known coral species. In town, the Buddhist pagoda of Sapta Ratna stands tall on a hilltop overlooking the harbour. Local fishing boats come in with their catch at the bustling Pasar Jembutan Puri fish market.

After disembarkation, an arranged Swan Hellenic transfer will take you to Sorong Airport for your flight to Denpasar, Bali, Indonesia. Once arrived in Denpasar, at the appropriate time, board your connecting international flight to Australia (or New Zealand).

Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

April is a month of transition for many of these locations in Papua, marking the shift from the wet season to the dry season. In the Raja Ampat area, including Ayu Atoll, Waigeo Island (Aljui Bay), Wayag Island, and Misool Island (Balbulal Lagoon), April signifies the beginning of a more favorable time to visit, with reduced rainfall and improved underwater visibility. However, in other locations like Padaidori Island, Kwatisore in Cenderawasih Bay, the weather remains hot and humid, with a possibility of frequent tropical showers and thunderstorms. Temperatures across all these locations are consistently warm, with daily averages ranging from 27°C to 35°C.

FLIGHTS

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points:

Visas

Indonesia

All Indonesia Arrival Card

As of 1 September 2025 passengers must complete the All Indonesia Arrival Card. This is free of charge and can be completed online within 72 hours of your departure date. This is in addition to the e-VOA and the Bali Tourism Levy.

e-VOA

A tourist visa will be issued upon arrival if staying less than 30 days if travelling on an Australian passport. A visa fee of IDR 500,000 (approximately AUD \$50, subject to change) and it is best to have this amount in cash upon arrival to ensure smooth entry. To avoid the queues at the airport, you can apply in advance (no later than 48 hours prior to travelling to Indonesia). You can apply for an e-Visa on Arrival (e-VOA). Check the e-VOA requirements from Indonesian Immigration before applying.

Bali Tourism Levy

The Bali Provincial Government has introduced a new tourist levy of IDR 150,000 per person to foreign tourists entering Bali. The tourist levy is separate from the e-Visa on Arrival or the Visa on Arrival. Cashless payments can be made online prior to travel or on arrival at designated payment counters at Bali's airport and seaport. Exemption from payment of the levy applies to transit passengers and certain visa holders. See the Bali Provincial Government's official website.

Important:

 Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.

- Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.
- It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.
- Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.
- It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.
