Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Venice, Italy

Depart today for Venice, Italy!

Day 2 Welcome to Venice

Upon arrival, make your own way to the hotel and spend the remainder of the day at leisure.

You'll also meet your Tour Leader at the hotel today. The Tour Leader will be with the group for the whole duration of the trip, ensuring the smooth operation of the tour as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. They will provide general guidance around the cities while offering information and suggestions on the place visited. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transit between train stations (not included) and more. Your tour leader handles the journey so once there, you're free to explore or join a local guide for an in-depth tour.

Day 3 Venice Free Day

After breakfast this morning, make your own way to Venice's city centre. Admire the beautiful buildings and architecture as you cruise the stunning waters of Venice by water bus (ticket not included). Take some time to wander through the romantic streets of Venice. Some iconic sights include St Mark's Square, regarded as one of the most intricate and beautiful town squares in the world, and the Rialto Bridge, the oldest bridge over the Grand Canal.

Alternatively, choose from the following optional activities.

Optional Activity: Venice Guided Walking Tour

An approximately 2-hour guided tour with headphones included.

Optional Activity: Doge's Palace Reserved Entry Ticket (1-Hour)

A masterpiece of Gothic architecture, the Doge's Palace is an impressive structure composed of layers of building elements and ornamentation. The structure is made up of three large blocks, incorporating previous constructions. The wing towards the St. Mark's Basin is the oldest, rebuilt from 1340 onwards. The wing towards St. Mark's Square was built in its present form from 1424 onwards. The canal-side wing, housing the Doge's apartments and many government offices, dates from the Renaissance and was built between 1483 and 1565.

Optional Activity: Gondola Ride

Enjoy an approximately 30-minute traditional Gondola ride in Venice.

Optional Activity: Mask Painting Workshop

Paint blank Venetian masks, choosing one of over 40 different models that are all handmade from real papier-mâché. You can also select 10 different decorative techniques. The workshop lasts approximately 1-hour.

Optional Activity: Full-Day Murano, Burano and Glass Blowing Tour

Visit the Venetian islands of Murano and Burano, with a focus on experiencing the traditional crafts of glassblowing in Murano and lacemaking in Burano. Take a water bus from Venice train station to Murano and Burano. Includes tour guide and glassblowing factories visit.

Optional Activity: Happy Hour in Venice

Includes professional guide, 2 Cicchetti (Venetian snacks) and 2 Venetian wine tastings. Approximately 1-hour and 45 minutes.

Venice, Italy

It is now mandatory for all tourists who are daytripping or staying less than one night in Venice to pay an entrance tax online prior to arrival. The cost of the tax will change based on the season and the turnout of tourists. Prices will range from €3 up to €10 per person, per day.

- Guests staying more than one night in Venice and Venice area (with proof of stay)
- Children 6 years and under
- Residents, Home owners, Students of Venice
- Tourist bus passengers

Land

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the

group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Italy & West Mediterranean: April to October

Italy is largely characterised by a typical Mediterranean climate made up of warm springs and hot and dry summers, the climate here is very pleasant. Along the coast of Southern Italy in July and August the average temperature is above 25°C. April to June and September to October are the best months to travel through southern Italy. You can expect temperatures of up to 26°C during the warmest part of the day. In the northern areas in October the average daily temperature is 14.5°C but temperatures can still reach highs of 19°C which can feel quite pleasant. Temperatures are starting to drop low during this month though, especially at night. The average minimum temperature in October is 10°C.

Italy: November to March

We recommend dressing in layers as there

can be significant changes in temperature throughout the day. Wear good walking shoes, jeans or heavy cotton pants, a light cotton shirt plus a sweater/jacket and to fit in with the local Italians, a scarf. Expect temperatures ranging from highs of 17°C to lows of 8°C.

Visas

Europe

A tourist visa is not required for Europe for stays up to 90 days if travelling on an Australian or New Zealand passport.

EU Entry/Exit System (EES)

From October 12, 2025, a new European Entry System (EES) replaces the current manual passport-stamping process for non-EU travellers. Upon arrival in the Schengen area, Australian and New Zealand passport holders will have their fingerprints recorded and a photograph taken. Their entry and exit dates will be electronically registered. No previous action is required, but please be aware of longer wait times at border entry. From 10 April 2026, the EES will be fully operational at all external border crossing points of all the European countries (Schengen area) using the system.

European Travel Information & Authorisation System (ETIAS)

As an extension of the EES implementation introduced from 2025, ETIAS travel authorisation is a mandatory entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals travelling to any of [these 30 European countries](#), including Australian and New Zealand citizens, that will be introduced in 2026. We advise you to monitor smartraveller.com.au closer to your departure to ensure you are up to date on

the requirements at the time of entry.

Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
- *It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.*
