

#### Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not

required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

#### **CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES**

The Andaman Islands are a tropical paradise with a consistent warm climate, with temperatures ranging from 22°C to 31°C. The best time to visit for beach activities, scuba diving, and snorkeling is during the peak season, from October to May. During this time, the weather is dry and sunny with clear skies and calm, clear seas, perfect for exploring the underwater world. The absolute best months are December through February, though this also brings the largest crowds and highest prices. The off-season, from June to September, is the monsoon period, characterised by heavy rain and rough seas. While many water sports are limited or unavailable, this is an excellent time for budget-conscious travelers and nature lovers, as the islands are less crowded, prices are significantly lower, and the landscape is lush and vibrant.
