### TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

#### Tour Guide

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

#### Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

*Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.*

### CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

#### Hong Kong

In October, Hong Kong's weather is

typically very pleasant as it transitions out of the hot and humid summer. You can expect average daily temperatures around 26°C, with highs of about 28°C and lows around 23°C. It's a significantly drier month, with a notable drop in humidity and an average of only 5 to 8 rainy days. This provides for comfortable conditions with plenty of clear skies and sunshine, making it an excellent time to visit.

#### Vietnam

In November, the weather across Vietnam varies significantly by region. In the north, including Halong Bay, the climate is generally pleasant and cool, with average temperatures around 24.5°C and the end of the wet season, leading to drier conditions and less humidity. In contrast, Central Vietnam, including Da Nang, is at the peak of its rainy season, experiencing heavy rainfall and potential storms. Despite this, temperatures remain warm, ranging from a low of 25°C to a high of 28°C, with showers often being brief and occurring in the afternoon or evening. Meanwhile, in the south, including Ho Chi Minh City, the rainy season begins to decline, with temperatures remaining hot and humid, typically ranging from 24°C to 31°C, though with a promise of less frequent downpours as the month progresses towards its dry season.

#### Thailand

In November, Thailand's weather patterns diverge significantly between its different regions. In Bangkok, the country begins its dry season, with a rapid decrease in rainfall and humidity. The weather becomes much more comfortable for sightseeing and outdoor activities, with average high temperatures around 31°C. In contrast, on the Gulf of Thailand coast, Ko Samui is at the peak of its northeast monsoon season, making it one of the wettest months of the year with frequent and heavy downpours. Despite the rain, the island remains hot and humid, with average temperatures around 27°C.

#### Singapore

In November, Singapore enters its wet

season, marked by a significant increase in rainfall as the northeast monsoon begins. This makes it one of the wettest months of the year, with a high chance of daily showers and thunderstorms. Despite the increased precipitation, temperatures remain consistently hot and humid, with average highs around 31°C and lows of 24°C. Visitors should be prepared for sudden downpours and humid conditions but can still enjoy plenty of indoor attractions, such as shopping malls and museums, which offer a welcome escape from the rain and heat.

#### Indonesia

In November, the weather across the locations in Indonesia you will be visiting is hot, humid, and marks the beginning of the wet season. Both Semarang and Surabaya on the island of Java experience a significant increase in rainfall, with frequent, intense afternoon downpours. Temperatures remain consistently high, with averages around 27-28°C and highs reaching 32°C. Similarly, in Bali, including Celukan Bawang and Benoa, November is the start of the rainy season, bringing more overcast days and tropical showers. Despite the rain, the climate remains very warm and humid, with average daily temperatures around 31°C and lows of 23°C, ensuring the sea is still warm enough for swimming.

#### Darwin

In November, Darwin's weather transitions from the dry season to the wet season, a period locally known as "the build-up." This is characterized by rapidly increasing humidity and temperatures that remain very hot, with average highs of 33°C and lows of around 25°C. The air becomes thick with moisture, and the month sees a significant increase in rainfall, with an average of 140 mm over about 12 days. Spectacular afternoon thunderstorms are common as the atmosphere builds up to the monsoonal rains of the coming months.

## Visas

### Hong Kong

# Important Information

Australian passport holders are visa exempt for a stay of up to 90 days. The traveller must hold a passport valid at least six months on entry with two blank visa pages

## Vietnam

Australian passport holders are eligible to apply online for a single entry electronic visa (e-visa), valid for up to a maximum of 90 days.

Lodge your application online (for a non-refundable fee) with the Vietnamese National Web Portal of Immigration <https://www.xuatnhapcanh.gov.vn/>. You will be given a unique code to track your visa application status. Once your visa is granted, you must print it out and present it at check in. Keep this e-visa print out with you at all times during your travel in Vietnam.

Some private online visa services and travel agents have scammed travellers or been involved in the public disclosure of the personal information of applicants for visas and 'visa issued on arrival' approval letters. To avoid such scams, only use official Government of Vietnam services to arrange your visa. Visa and other entry and exit conditions (such as currency, customs and quarantine regulations) change regularly. Contact the nearest Embassy or Consulate of Vietnam for up-to-date information.

## Thailand

From the 1 May 2025, all Australians will be required to complete the Thailand Digital Arrival Card (TDAC) online prior to arrival. Travellers must register online within 3 days prior to arriving in Thailand. They can do so via this link.

## Singapore

Australian passport holders are Visa exempt for a stay of up to 90 days. The traveller must hold a passport valid at least six months beyond the period of intended stay with one blank visa page

## All Indonesia Arrival Card

As of 1 September 2025 passengers must complete the All Indonesia Arrival Card.

This is free of charge and can be completed online within 72 hours of your departure date. This is in addition to the e-VOA and the Bali Tourism Levy.

## e-VOA

A tourist visa will be issued upon arrival if staying less than 30 days if travelling on an Australian passport. A visa fee of IDR 500,000 (approximately AUD \$50, subject to change) and it is best to have this amount in cash upon arrival to ensure smooth entry. To avoid the queues at the airport, you can apply in advance (no later than 48 hours prior to travelling to Indonesia). You can apply for an e-Visa on Arrival (e-VOA). Check the e-VOA requirements from Indonesian Immigration before applying.

## Bali Tourism Levy

The Bali Provincial Government has introduced a new tourist levy of IDR 150,000 per person to foreign tourists entering Bali. The tourist levy is separate from the e-Visa on Arrival or the Visa on Arrival. Cashless payments can be made online prior to travel or on arrival at designated payment counters at Bali's airport and seaport. Exemption from payment of the levy applies to transit passengers and certain visa holders. See the Bali Provincial Government's official website.

### Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*

- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
- *It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.*
