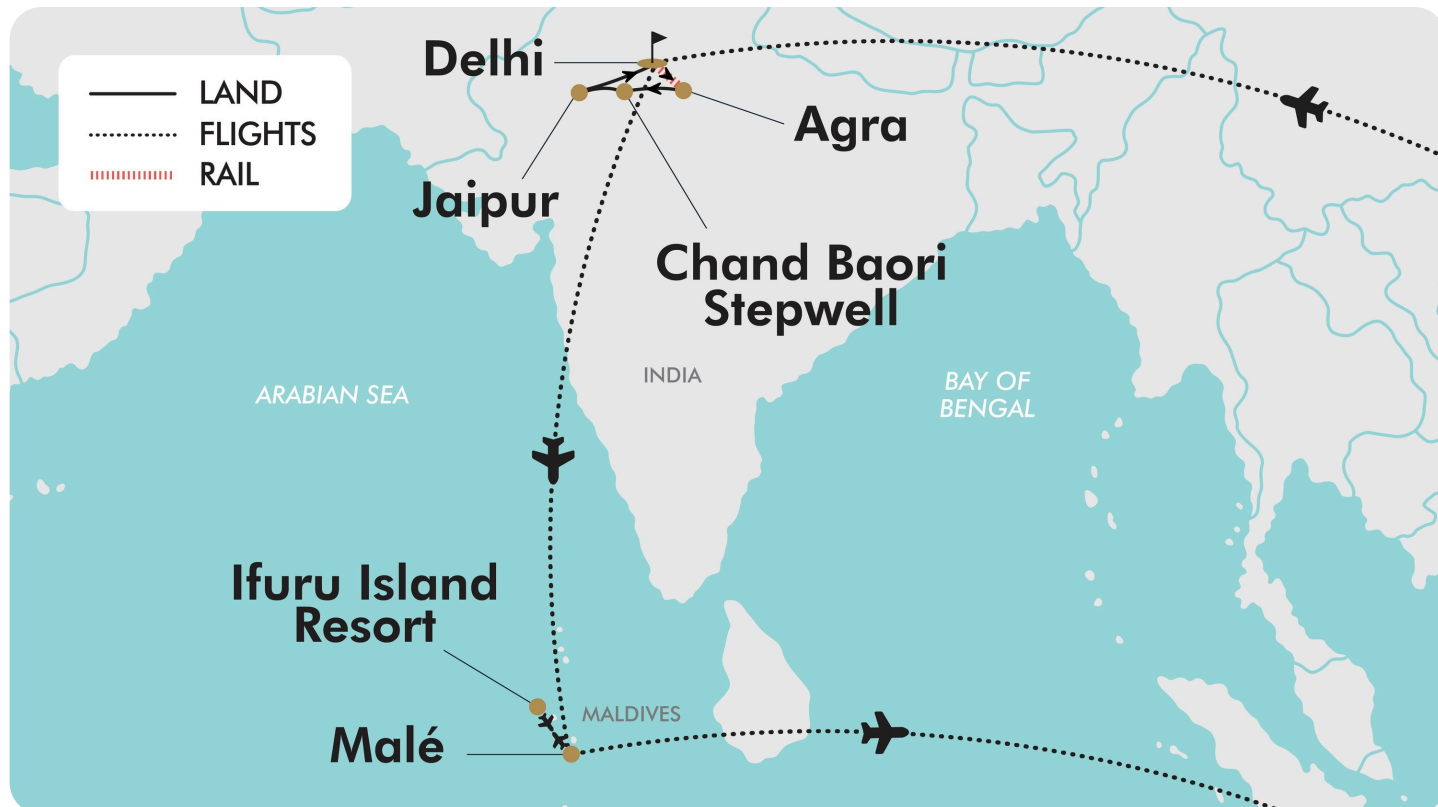

Day 4 Taj Mahal, Agra - Chand Baori - Jaipur

Today, prepare for the crowning jewel of your Indian journey, a visit to the magnificent Taj Mahal.

We recommend an early start (approximately 06:00) for a truly unforgettable sunrise visit. Witness the "epitome of love" as the soft, ethereal morning light washes over the flawless white marble, transforming its perfect symmetry into shades of pink and gold. This is the moment travellers dream of. Alternatively, you may choose a later visit this morning (approximately 09:00) after enjoying a leisurely breakfast at the hotel. Your tour includes entry to the breathtaking central mausoleum.

This UNESCO World Heritage Site is a masterpiece of Mughal architecture, commissioned by Emperor Shah Jahan in 1631 for his beloved wife, Mumtaz Mahal. Marvel at the sheer luminosity of the structure and appreciate the intricate artistry of the 'pietra dura' inlay work, where thousands of semi-precious stones decorate the white marble exterior. After your inspiring visit, return to the hotel.

Later, journey to Jaipur, the vibrant capital of Rajasthan. En route, pause for a captivating stop at the extraordinary Chand Baori Stepwell. Witness this ancient architectural marvel, one of the world's deepest and largest step wells. You'll marvel at its

mesmerising geometric precision, which descends 13 stories into the earth. It is believed to hold deep religious significance and is constructed opposite the revered Harshat Mata Temple.

Upon arrival in Jaipur, the city will greet you with its signature pink-washed buildings, a colour synonymous with traditional Rajput hospitality.
