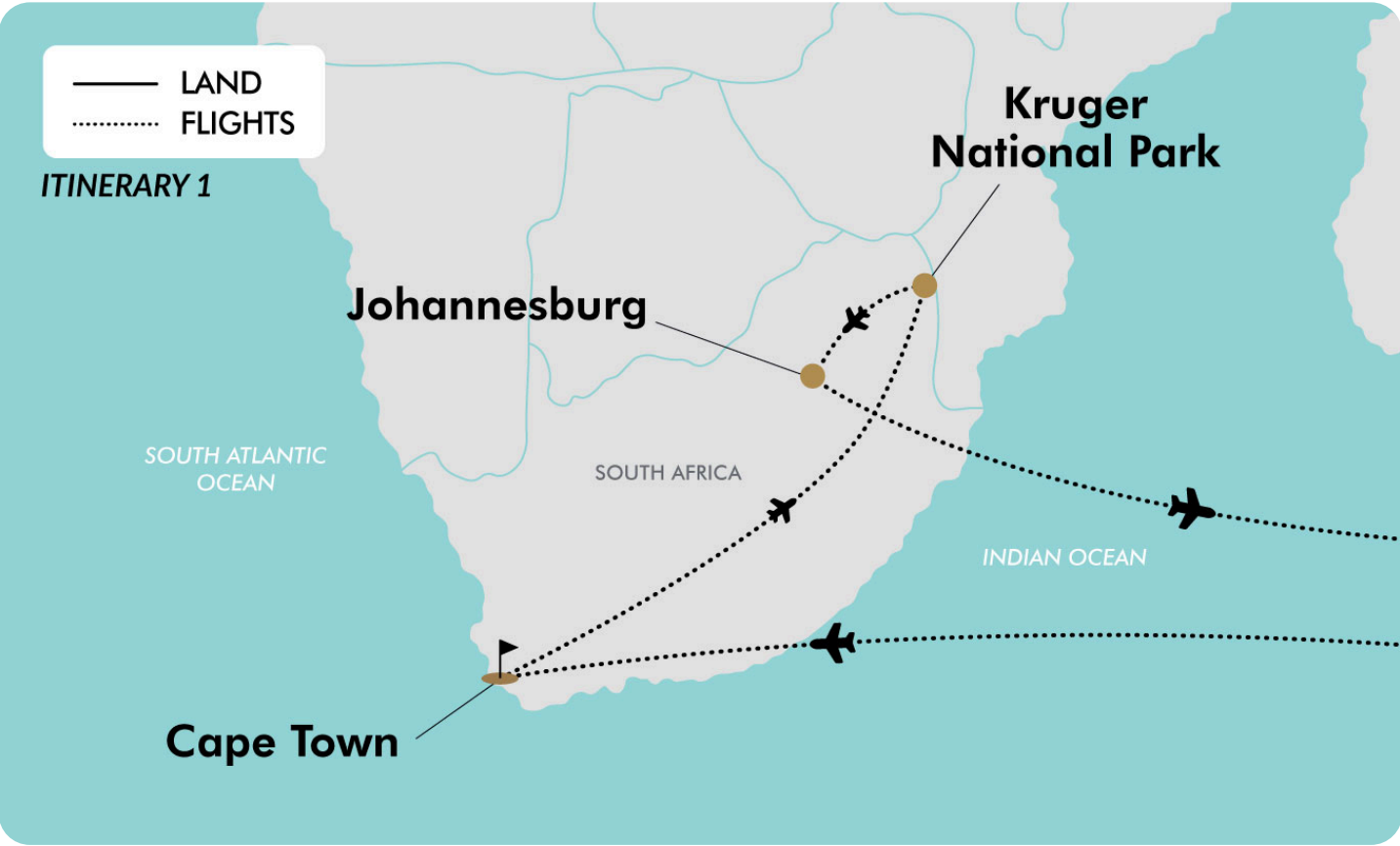

defined by hot, dry summers and cool, wet winters. The city's weather is notoriously changeable.

Zambia

Zambia enjoys a warm, tropical climate year-round, with three distinct seasons. From May to August, temperatures are mild, while September and October are hotter and drier. The wet season, from November to April, transforms the landscape into lush greenery with warm, humid weather and brief afternoon showers. During this time, Victoria Falls is at its most powerful and dramatic, usually creating an unforgettable spectacle of mist and rainbows.

Some countries will refuse entry if you are unable to present your certificate. It's also common for your home country to request a Yellow Fever certificate upon arrival.

You must check with your doctor well before leaving home about the Yellow Fever requirements for the countries you'll be visiting.

Sightseeing:

Wildlife

Visas

South Africa

A tourist visa for South Africa is not required for stays up to 90 days if travelling on an Australian or New Zealand Passport.

Zambia

Australian and New Zealand passport holders do not need a visa to enter Zambia for tourism or short visits.

Botswana

A tourist visa for Botswana is not required for stays up to 90 days if travelling on an Australian or New Zealand Passport.

Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*

- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
- *It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.*
