It's a masterpiece of French Gothic art, renowned for stunning stained glass windows, flying buttresses and intricate statues. Not far from Notre Dame, you will see the Palace of the Conciergerie, formerly a prison but is presently used for practising law. The prison housed as many as 1,200 prisoners in its heyday, including the famous Queen of France Marie Antoinette.

Continue onwards to the Latin Quarter, the literary and intellectual area and home to the former University of Sorbonne. Afterwards, take time to admire the impressive Luxembourg Garden and Saint Germain des Pres (entrances not included). Head through the Les Halles shopping district (formerly a fresh food market in the 19th century) until you reach the cultural centre of 'George Pompidou', built in 1977 by the famous architect Renzo Piano as the Museum of Contemporary Art. Finish the tour on a high by seeing the centrepiece of Paris' cityscape, the Eiffel Tower, before enjoying the remainder of the day at leisure

Tourist Tax (City Taxes)

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the

group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Europe

May is a great season to discover Europe. Temperatures range from lows of 5°C to highs of 19°C. Summer is from June to August and is when the region is at its peak travel time. Generally speaking, Europe's summer temperatures average around 20° Celsius. Average temperatures for September and October at major cities throughout northern Europe average around 15°C.

Scandinavia & Baltics

In spring, the days get longer, and the temperature rises slowly; the first warm days, more likely in the second half of April. By mid-May, the maximum temperatures hover around 15/17 °C. Summer in the Baltics is very pleasant, with the maximum temperatures hovering around 21/22 °C. This is perfect for outdoor activities. Nights are cool, with minimum temperatures around 11/12 °C.

August is one of the hottest months of the year in Oslo. Temperatures average 18°C with highs of 21°C. Baltic countries start to cool down in September, with temperatures ranging from 10°C to 15°C.

Visas

Eu Entry/Exit System (EES)

From October 12, 2025, a new European Entry System (EES) replaces the current manual passport-stamping process for non-EU travelers. Upon arrival in the Schengen area, Australian and New Zealand passport holders will have their fingerprints recorded and a photograph taken. Their entry and exit dates will be electronically registered. No previous action is required, but please be aware of longer wait times at border entry. From 10 April 2026, the EES will be fully operational at all external border crossing points of all the European countries (Schengen area) using the system.

European Travel Information & Authorisation System (ETIAS)

As an extension of the EES implementation introduced from 2025, ETIAS travel authorisation is a mandatory entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals travelling to any of these 30 European countries, including Australian and New Zealand citizens, that will be introduced in 2026. We advise you to monitor smartraveller.com.au closer to your departure to ensure you are up to date on the requirements at the time of entry.

Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*

- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
