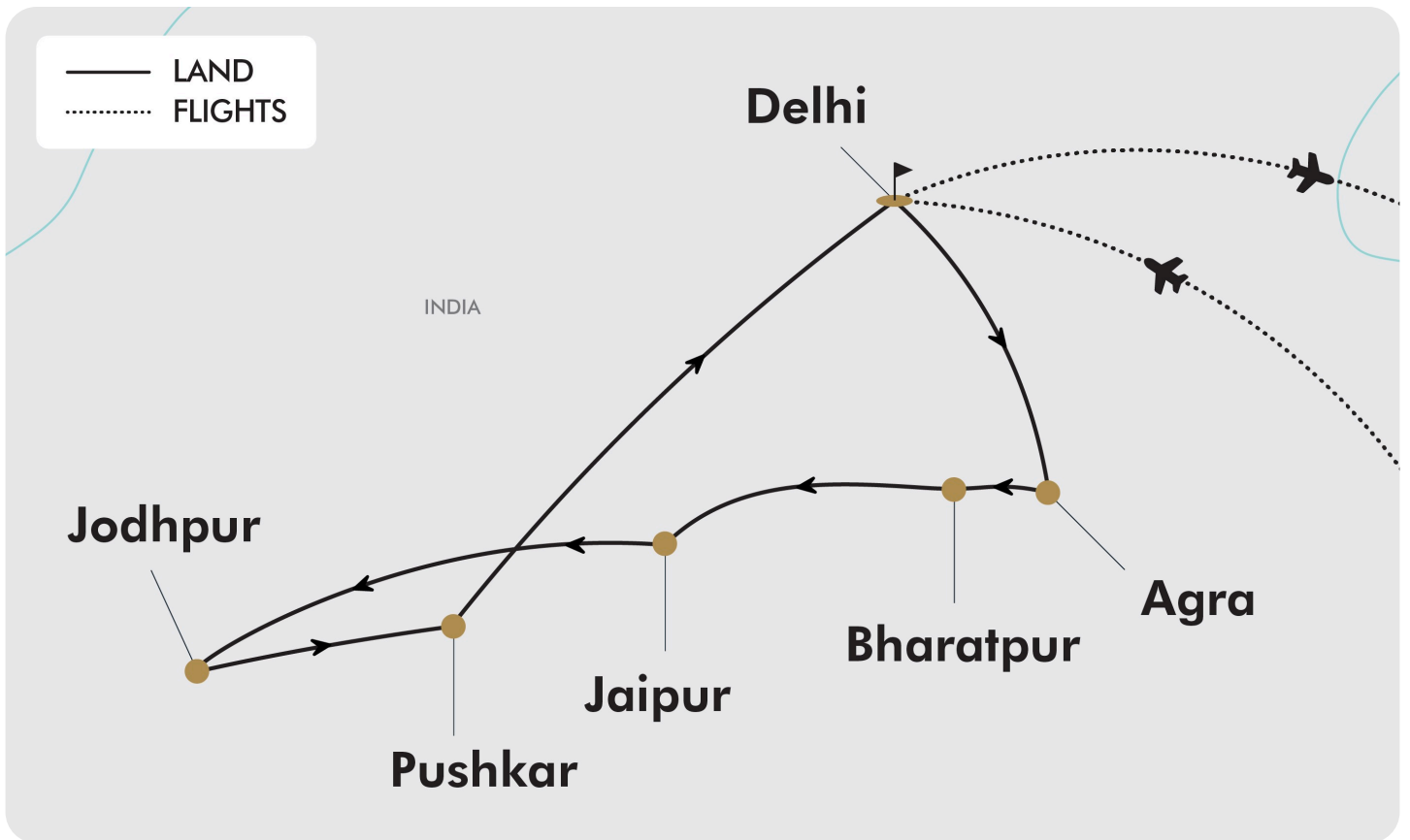

This afternoon visit the City Palace, the former royal residence, built in a blend of the Rajsthani and Mughal styles; Jantar Mantar, the largest of the five observatories built by Sawai Jai Singh; and Hawa Mahal or the Palace of Winds, which was constructed for the royal ladies to watch royal processions without being seen. Afterwards enjoy an Indian costume tying demonstration then a visit to the Lakshmi Narayan Temple.
