New Zealand

The weather across New Zealand during December and January, which are the peak summer months, is typically warm, sunny, and pleasant, though it can be quite variable depending on the island and region. Average daytime maximum temperatures generally range from 20°C to 28°C across the country. The North Island tends to be warmer, with averages between 20°C and 25°C in December and climbing to 22°C to 28°C in January, with northern areas like Auckland occasionally hitting 30°C or higher. The South Island is slightly cooler, averaging 18°C to 23°C in December and 20°C to 25°C in January, though inland areas like Central Otago can experience hot, dry conditions exceeding 30°C. While summer is generally the driest season, rain showers are still common, especially in the far south and on the West Coast of the South Island, and the intense UV index means sun protection is essential, even on overcast days.
