Whether you're savouring a meal or hunting for souvenirs, the city's vibrant neighbourhoods provide endless opportunities to indulge.

Today, after check-out, a transfer is arranged to the airport for your flight to Ushuaia, Argentina.

Upon arrival, a transfer is arranged to your hotel for a two-night city stay. Once checked-in, the remainder of the day is at leisure.

Welcome to Ushuaia, the southernmost city in the world! Ushuaia sits between the snowcapped Andes and the Beagle Channel at the tip of Argentina. This remote yet vibrant city is famed as the gateway to Antarctica and for its dramatic natural beauty—glaciers, forests, and rugged coastline all within easy reach. Visitors can explore Tierra del Fuego National Park, take a cruise along the channel to spot penguins and sea lions, or learn

An unmissable full-day tour in Ushuaia, exploring two key geographical areas.

Your day begins with a historic ride on the Southern Fuegian Railway and a walk along the "Senda de los Presos" (The Inmates Way), followed by an immersive tour of Tierra del Fuego National Park. Highlights within the park include panoramic views at Roca Lake, a visit to the famous "End of the World" post office at Zaratiegui Cove, and a photo opportunity at the Pan-American Highway in Lapataia Bay. After a two-hour lunch break in downtown Ushuaia, you will board a boat to navigate the Beagle Channel, observing local wildlife at Lobos Island, before finishing with the iconic view of the Les Eclaireurs Lighthouse (approximately 10 hours).

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Buenos Aires, Argentina

In January and February, Buenos Aires is at the peak of summer, characterised by hot and humid conditions with an average temperature of approximately 25°C, which is the warmest months of the year; travellers should expect daily high temperatures to typically reach 30°C and nighttime lows to hover around 20°C. Despite receiving plenty of sunshine (around 9 hours daily), this is also one of the rainiest periods, with roughly 100-120mm of precipitation falling across about 8 to 10 days, often in the form of heavy afternoon thunderstorms.

Antarctica

Antarctica in February is considered the late summer season, offering some of the best travel conditions, particularly along the Antarctic Peninsula and coastal regions where most tourism occurs, with average temperatures ranging between 6°C and 4°C; however, the high interior plateau remains frigid. This month is highly desirable as the sea ice has retreated significantly, often allowing expedition ships to reach the Antarctic Circle, and while daylight hours are still very long, they begin to shorten noticeably compared to the peak of summer, yet the sustained relatively mild temperatures and minimal ice coverage make it an ideal time for extensive wildlife viewing, including whale watching and observing penguin chicks.

Falkland Islands

The Falkland Islands in February are experiencing the peak of their austral summer, meaning it's one of the warmest months, but the weather is still marked by cool, temperate, and extremely windy conditions due to its sub-polar oceanic climate. The capital, Stanley, sees average daytime high temperatures around 13°C, with nighttime lows around 7°C, though strong westerly winds often make it feel considerably colder. February features

some of the best sunshine hours of the year (around 6 hours per day) alongside long daylight hours, and while precipitation is moderate, the weather remains very changeable, often shifting rapidly from sun to cloud and rain showers

Uruguay

Uruguay in February is in the middle of its warm and sunny summer season, making it an ideal time to visit its popular beaches like Punta del Este. The weather is generally hot, with average high temperatures across the country around 27°C, while nighttime lows typically settle around 18°C. The sea temperature is also very pleasant for swimming, averaging around 23°C. Although February is one of the sunniest months, it is also one of the wettest, with high rainfall occurring over roughly 10-11 days, usually in the form of heavy, short-lived thunderstorms that quickly clear, leaving behind warm, humid air.

Visas

Uruguay

Australian passport holders are visa exempt for a stay of up to 90 days. The traveller must hold a passport valid at least six months beyond the period of intended stay with one blank visa page

Falkland Islands

Australian passport holders are visa-exempt for a stay of up to 30 days. The traveller must hold a passport valid at least six months beyond the period of intended stay with one blank visa page

Argentina

Australian passport holders are visa-exempt for a stay of up to 3 months.

Please note: Effective immediately, all international travellers to Argentina must hold valid travel insurance with medical coverage. This insurance may be requested and verified upon arrival in the country. Argentina's public healthcare system will no longer provide free medical services to foreign nationals. It is therefore essential that you obtain appropriate insurance before your departure.

Chile (Transiting or Santiago Stopover Selected)

As of 17th September 2025 tourist visas for Chile are not required if travelling on an Australian Passport. You can stay in Chile for up to 90 days without a visa. If you're unsure whether you need a visa, contact the nearest embassy or consulate of Chile.

Important:
