

Day 8 Crete (Chania), Greece

Arrive: 08:00 - Depart: 18:00

Weaving a tapestry of awe and wonder, Chania is a centuries-old mix of Minoan myths, well-preserved Venetian mansions, a mesmerising Old Town complete with labyrinthine passageways and atmospheric Kastelli Hill, once the site of a Roman acropolis. Chania is the gateway to the breathtaking 4,000 year-old Minoan ruins at Knossos, home of the legendary King Minos and the part-man part-bull creature known as the Minotaur. Around every corner of this idyllic area, you'll find picturesque villages, breathtaking views and architectural wonders that will remain with you for a lifetime.

Day 10 Kusadasi, Türkiye (for Ephesus)

Arrive: 07:00 - Depart: 18:00

From the port of Kusadasi on Türkiye's Anatolian Coast, one travels into the past. Nearby stand the ruins of ancient Ephesus, a primary archeological excavation site (optional shore excursion, charges apply).

The city was once a Roman provincial capital and trading centre; Ephesus is also home to several of Christendom's holiest sites. St Paul preached at the Great Theater, and the ruins of Ephesus' Basilica covered the tomb of Christ's most beloved disciple, St John the Apostle.

In Kusadasi, whitewashed stone houses rise in tiers behind the market district. The palm-lined esplanade is the centre of town life, with thousands of merchants offering wares to rival the Grand Bazaar in Istanbul.

Day 11 Mykonos, Greece

Arrive: 07:00 - Depart: 21:00

Thanks to its proximity to the mainland, Mykonos was one of the first Greek islands to become an international travel destination. During the late 60s and early 70s, Mykonos was famed as a haunt for the rich. The island's nightlife - then and now - was a glittering whirl of coloured lights, music and parties.

There's another side to Mykonos - the neighbouring island of Delos (optional shore excursion, charges apply). In classical mythology, Delos was the birthplace of Apollo and his twin sister Artemis. Travellers to Delos can stroll among the island's vast ruins, which include three temples consecrated to the Sun God and the famed Lions Walk.

Mykonos town features hip boutiques, restaurants, jewellery stores, souvenirs, taverns and cafés. The island's famed windmills are found just south of the waterfront.

Day 12 Athens (Piraeus), Greece
Arrive: 06:00 - Depart: 19:00

Dock in Piraeus where you can enjoy a day at leisure to discover nearby Athens. The past maintains a vibrant presence in the cradle of Western civilisation. Atop the Acropolis, the serene Parthenon sails above the commotion of the modern city. The tragedies of Aeschylus, Sophocles, and Euripides were performed in the Theatre of Dionysus at the foot of the Acropolis.

On Pnyx Hill, citizens of a fledgling democracy gathered to cast their votes on Athens' destiny. Then there is the hustle and bustle of the modern city, a metropolis of 4.5 million that spreads out from the foot of Mt Lycabettus and across the plain. Packed with busy shops and lively tavernas, modern Athens is a colourful counterpoint to classical Greece.

Located approximately 10 kilometres from Athens, Piraeus is a port city and has been Athens' port of entry for over two millennia.

Day 13 Santorini, Greece

Arrive: 07:00 - Depart: 19:00

Did the catastrophic volcanic eruption that ravaged Santorini circa 1600 BC destroy Crete's ancient Minoan civilisation and give birth to the myth of Atlantis? In 1967, archaeologists in Santorini unearthed the remains of a Bronze Age city that may have been home to as many as 30,000 people. Whether the Lost Continent of Atlantis is rooted in myth or reality, an undisputed fact remains. The eruption created a caldera - and one of the most dramatic land and seascapes in the entire Mediterranean.

On Santorini, whitewashed buildings cling to vertiginous cliffs that plunge into a turquoise sea. Part of the Cyclades Archipelago, the three-island group of Santorini, Thirasia and uninhabited Aspronisi present the traveller with unforgettable vistas. The island has had several names throughout history - from Strongyle or "Round" to Thera in honour of an ancient hero. Santorini is more recent and stems from the island church dedicated to St Irene - Santa Rini to foreign sailors.

And those roots are clearly visible in Corfu Town, which boasts fortresses bearing the insignia of the Venetian Republic, an esplanade lavishly planted with palms and eucalyptus by the French during the Napoleonic Wars and an English cricket pitch.

During the Roman Empire, the city was a major port and commercial centre; during the Middle Ages, Messina was the major port of departure for Crusaders. Many historic treasures remain intact after wars and earthquakes, including the 12th-century Annunziata dei Catalani Church. Messina is also your gateway to the rugged beauty of southeast Sicily, from the seaside town of Taormina to Mount Etna.

The island has had several names throughout history - from Strongyle or "Round" to Thera in honour of an ancient hero. Santorini is more recent and stems from the island church dedicated to St Irene - Santa Rini to foreign sailors.

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or

commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Mediterranean

The Mediterranean region transitions from pleasant spring warmth to intense summer heat and back to mild autumn conditions between May and October, with average maximum daytime temperatures ranging from the low 20°C range in the shoulder months to the high 20°C to mid-30°C range during peak summer. In May, temperatures are typically a pleasant 20°C to 25°C, ideal for sightseeing; the weather then heats up dramatically, peaking in July and August where highs commonly exceed 30°C (and can occasionally surpass 35°C in the Eastern Mediterranean and interior areas); by September, the heat eases slightly with averages around 25°C to 27°C, and by October, the weather is generally mild and comfortable, averaging between 20°C and 24°C with increased chances of rain, making the whole period reliably warm and sunny, especially from June through September.

Visas

Europe (Schengen Visa Countries)

A tourist visa is not required for Europe for stays up to 90 days if travelling on an Australian passport.

European Union Entry/Exit System (EES)

From October 12, 2025, a new European Entry System (EES) replaces the current manual passport-stamping process for non-EU travelers. Upon arrival in the Schengen area, Australian and New

Zealand passport holders will have their fingerprints recorded and a photograph taken. Their entry and exit dates will be electronically registered. No previous action is required, but please be aware of longer wait times at border entry. From 10 April 2026, the EES will be fully operational at all external border crossing points of all the European countries (Schengen area) using the system.

European Travel Information & Authorisation System (ETIAS)

As an extension of the EES implementation introduced from 2025, ETIAS travel authorisation is a mandatory entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals travelling to any of these 30 European countries, including Australian and New Zealand citizens, that will be introduced in 2026. We advise you to monitor smartraveller.com.au closer to your departure to ensure you are up to date on the requirements at the time of entry.

Türkiye

According to the Law on Foreigners and International Protection which entered into force on 11th April 2014, those foreigners who arrive at sea ports and intend to visit the seaport city or nearby provinces for touristic purpose are exempt from visa provided that their stay does not exceed 72 hours.

Montenegro

You can stay for up to 90 days in 6 months without a tourist visa from the date of entry into Montenegro if travelling on an Australian passport.

Important:

- Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.
- Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.

- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
- *It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.*
