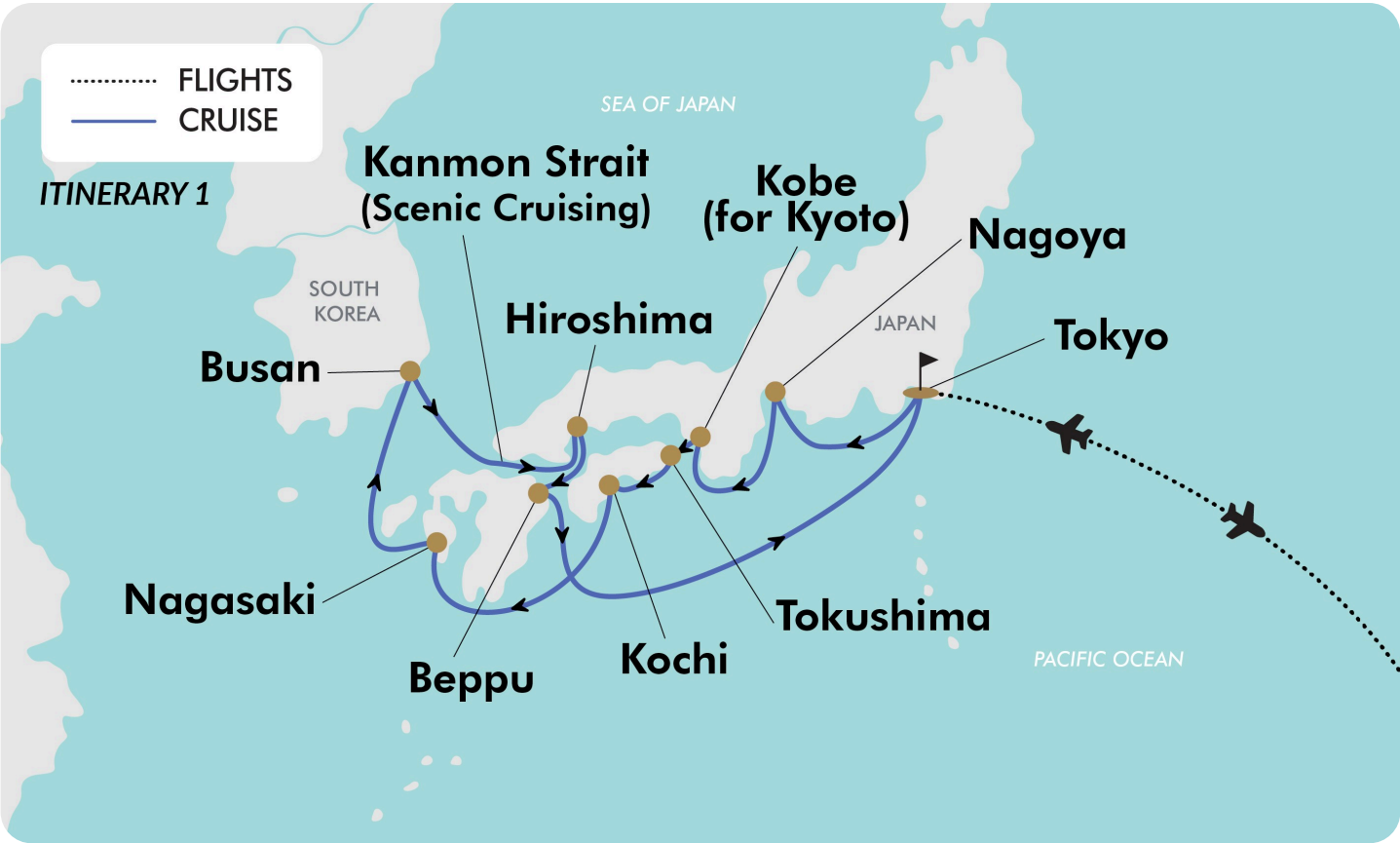

Day 5 Nagoya, Japan

Arrive: 07:00 - Depart: 15:00

Perched on Honshu's central coast, Nagoya is the fourth largest urban centre in Japan. It is also a perfect illustration of the Japanese national story. Japan's colourful history and love for tradition are embodied in the mighty donjon of Nagoya Castle, built by the first Tokugawa shogun. Two celebrated monuments, a Shinto shrine and a Buddhist temple, can be found within the city.

In its own quiet manner Nagoya embodies the Japanese way with its love of modernity and thirst for technological innovation. It embraces Japanese traditions along with change, aesthetics and innovation. The city is home to the very model of a major multinational corporation - Toyota. Toyota's corporate headquarters are located just outside Nagoya in Toyota City (38 kilometres), while the company's excellent museums and factories are scattered about the city and environs. Toyota began life as a manufacturer of industrial looms. Toyota Motor Corporation was spun off from its parent company in 1937.

Day 6 Kobe (for Kyoto), Japan

Arrive: 08:00 - Depart: 23:00

Kobe is the eighth-largest city in Japan and is the capital city of Hyogo Prefecture on the southern side of the main island of Honshu. Its name comes from "kanbe", an archaic title for supporters of the city's Ikuta Shrine. With a population of about 1.5 million, the city is part of the Keihanshin metropolitan area along with Osaka and Kyoto.

The earliest written records regarding the region come from the Nihon Shoki, which describes the founding of the Ikuta Shrine by Empress Jingu in AD 201. For most of its history the area was never a single political entity, even during the Tokugawa Period, when the port was controlled directly by the Tokugawa Shogunate. Kobe did not exist in its current form until its founding in 1889.

Kobe was one of the cities to open for trade with the West following the end of the policy of seclusion and has since been known as a cosmopolitan port city. While the 1995 Great Hanshin Earthquake diminished much of Kobe's prominence as a port city, it remains Japan's fifth busiest container port. The city is the point of origin and namesake of Kobe beef as well as the site of one of Japan's most famous hot spring resorts, Arima Onsen. Kobe is also your gateway to Kyoto, Japan's ancient imperial capital and the nation's cultural and spiritual centre.

Day 7 Tokushima, Japan

Born as a 16th century castle town whose remains now lie within a park and museum, Tokushima is best known for its colourful summer dance festival, the Awa Odori. But it may be Mother Nature who garners the most attention. Surrounded by 1000 metre-tall mountains that hint at the wonders that lie beyond, the city is the perfect gateway to the mesmerising Naruto whirlpools, the panoramic views from atop Mount Bisan, and the spectacular gorges and vine bridges of Iya Valley. Whether you're entranced with the ways of the warrior, or under the spell of the extraordinary attractions, Tokushima offers exciting new experiences and unforgettable new adventures.

Kochi, a city in Shikoku, takes its name from the great feudal castle that sits at its very heart. Completed in 1611, Kochi Castle was the seat of Yamauchi Kazutoyo, a noted warrior who supported Tokugawa Ieyasu in his successful quest to become Shogun. Tosa Province and Kochi Castle were Yamauchi's reward for faithful service. There is a historical irony here: 250 years later, a Kochi native son - a former low-ranked samurai and now ronin named Sakamoto Ryoma - played a pivotal role in bringing the Tokugawa Shogunate to an end and restoring the Emperor of Japan to political prominence. The prize once awarded for faithful service had become a hotbed of support for the Meiji Restoration.

Kochi sits on the broad alluvial plain facing Urado Bay and is one of the wettest places in Japan, and is a frequent target for cyclonic storms or typhoons. Southeast of the city, warm ocean currents washing against the Muroto Peninsula create a subtropical landscape of hibiscus, palm and ficus at Muroto-Anan Quasi-National Park.

Toba, located at the northeastern end of the Shima-hanto Peninsula in Mie, flourished as the castle town of the Kuki family who ruled this region from the 16th century. It was also a landing spot for visitors on the sea route to Ise-jingu Shrine and belongs to Ise-Shima National Park.

From the 12th century to the Meiji Restoration of 1868, Kagoshima was the chief stronghold of the mighty Shimazu clan. The city lies near the top of the Satsuma Peninsula, a mountainous, geothermal wonderland of hot springs and geysers. The area is also rich in modern Japanese history. Saigo Takamori and the Satsuma samurai were leaders of the Meiji Restoration that toppled the shogun and restored the Emperor to power in 1868. In 1877, dissatisfied with the direction of the new government, Saigo led the Satsuma Rebellion, which ended in his death and the final defeat of the samurai. The symbol of Kagoshima is Sakura Jima - the active volcanic island that sits just offshore.

Yatsushiro city was developed around a beautiful Shinto shrine, built during the Heian era (794–1185). Situated along the delta of the Kuma River, facing Yatsushiro Bay, this castle town and its ruins still showcase the spirit of the city.

A visit to the ruins of Yatsushiro Castle (now part of a Shinto shrine) is a good place to begin your day. Another fun and scenic landmark is the flight of 777 stairs cut into the nearby mountains, to be rewarded with panoramic views from the top – there are benches to rest on along the way!

Yatsushiro is famous for its 17th century pottery designed with a distinctive blue-gray crackled glaze with white inlay. Craft enthusiasts and collectors might like to visit three Kodayaki kilns in the area. Shopping enthusiasts could enjoy the honmachi, a covered arcade that runs the length of several city blocks, and adventurous foodies may partake in some of the city's most exotic local fare, including Basashi, raw horse meat served with soy and garlic, a delicacy of the area. For those with a more traditional palate, the light green Rush ice cream is a treat.

With a population of about 1.5 million, the city is part of the Keihanshin metropolitan area along with Osaka and Kyoto.

The earliest written records regarding the region come from the Nihon Shoki, which describes the founding of the Ikuta Shrine by Empress Jingu in AD 201. For most of its history the area was never a single political entity, even during the Tokugawa Period, when the port was controlled directly by the Tokugawa Shogunate. Kobe did not exist in its current form until its founding in 1889.

Kobe was one of the cities to open for trade with the West following the end of the policy of seclusion and has since been known as a cosmopolitan port city. The city is the point of origin and namesake of Kobe beef as well as the site of one of Japan's most famous hot spring resorts, Arima Onsen. Japan

In March and April, Japan undergoes a beautiful transition from winter to spring, with temperatures varying significantly across its islands. In central hubs like Tokyo, Kyoto, and Osaka, the weather is mild and pleasant, with average highs climbing from 13°C in March to a comfortable 19°C in April. Further south in cities like Fukuoka and Kagoshima, you can expect slightly warmer conditions reaching up to 22°C, while the subtropical islands of Okinawa already feel like summer with temperatures hovering around 24°C. Conversely, northern Hokkaido remains crisp and cool, with March averages sitting at just 4°C before rising to 11°C in April. Because evening temperatures throughout the country can still drop to around 10°C, dressing in versatile layers is the best way to stay comfortable while exploring the blossoming landscapes.

Busan, South Korea

In Busan, South Korea, the spring weather is very similar to that of central Japan, offering a mild and refreshing climate as the cherry blossoms begin to bloom. In March, you can expect daily highs of around 13°C and lows of 5°C, though the coastal breeze can sometimes make it feel slightly crisper. By April, the city warms up

beautifully, with daytime temperatures reaching a comfortable 18°C and evenings averaging around 10°C. Busan during these months is characterised by low humidity and clear skies, though a light-to-medium jacket is recommended for the cooler mornings and the sea air while on deck.

Voluntary Changes

Name Changes Due To Passenger Error

Supplier Fees
