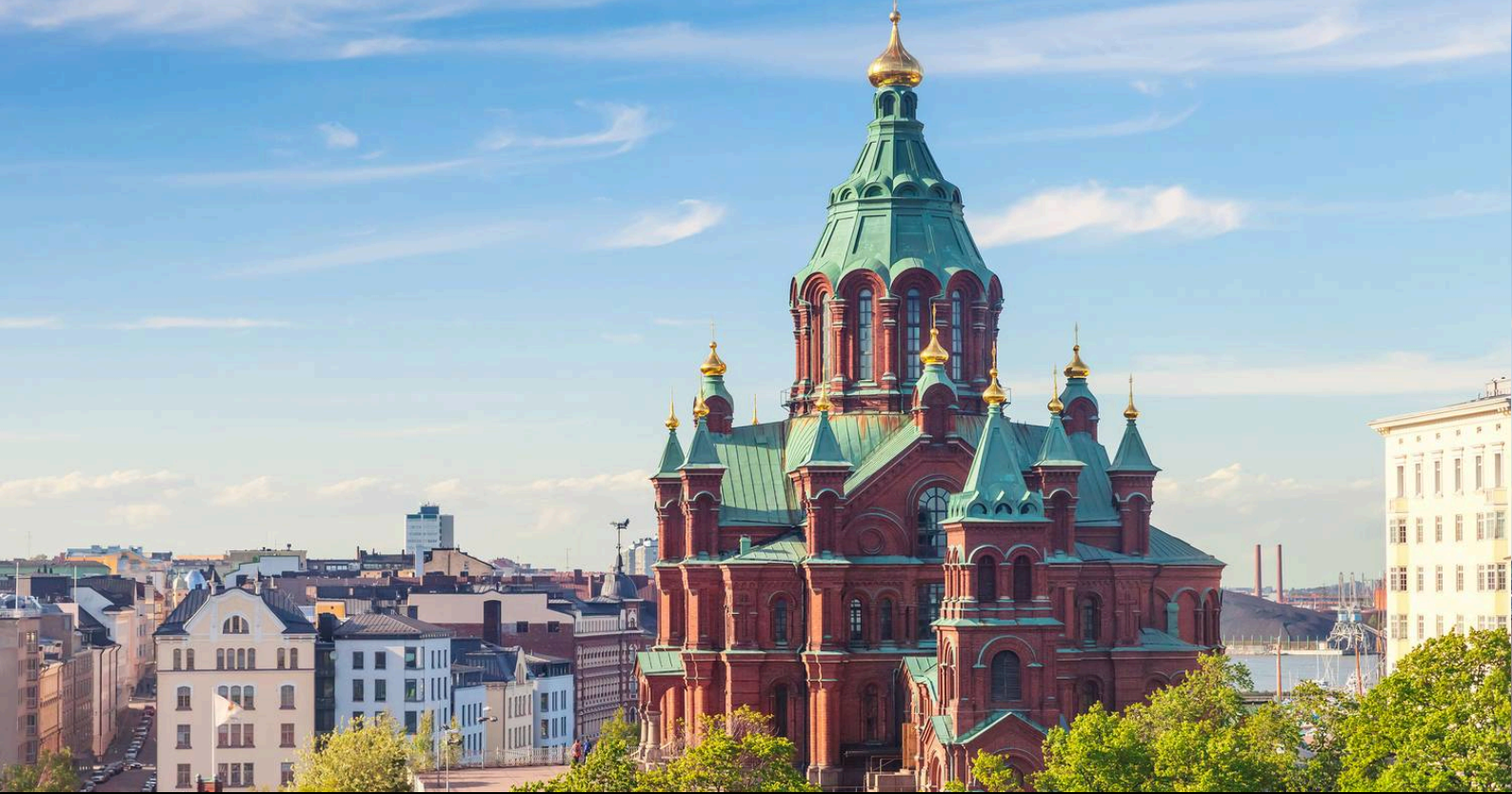

They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with

the group.

#### Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

*Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.*

## CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

### Copenhagen, Denmark

Copenhagen experiences its warmest and most pleasant weather during the summer months of June, July, and August. In June, average daytime high temperatures typically reach around 19°C to 20°C, with comfortable nighttime lows of about 11°C to 13°C. July is generally the warmest month, with average daily highs climbing to 20°C to 21°C and evening lows between 13°C and 16°C. This warmth continues into August, with average daytime highs around 20°C to 21°C and nighttime lows of 12°C to 15°C, though temperatures may start to gradually cool towards the end of the month. All three months feature long daylight hours (especially in June and July with up to 17-18 hours of daylight), plenty of sunshine, and sea temperatures that become suitable for swimming in the harbour baths, usually reaching around 14°C in June and 17°C in July and August. While generally sunny, there's always a moderate chance of brief summer showers

throughout this period, so light rain gear is advisable.

## **Berlin, Germany**

In Berlin, Germany, the summer months from June to August are generally warm and pleasant, offering ideal conditions for exploring the city. In June, average daytime high temperatures typically range from 22°C to 24°C, with comfortable nighttime lows around 12°C to 14°C. Moving into July, it becomes the warmest month, with average daily highs often reaching 24°C to 25°C and evening lows between 15°C and 16°C. This warmth extends into August, with average daytime highs around 24°C to 25°C and nighttime lows of 14°C to 16°C. While summers are usually sunny with long daylight hours, it's worth noting that temperatures can occasionally exceed 30°C, and thunderstorms can occur, especially in the afternoons. Despite being a popular time to visit, some sources note that air-conditioning is not as common in public transport, museums, or restaurants as in some other countries.

## **Gdynia, Poland**

In Gdynia, Poland, the summer months from June to August offer generally mild to warm and comfortable weather, though it's often described as mildly cool and breezy due to its Baltic Sea coastal location. In June, average daytime high temperatures typically range from 19°C to 20°C, with cooler nighttime lows of about 12°C. Moving into July, it's the warmest month, with average daily highs reaching 21°C to 22°C and comfortable evening lows around 15°C. This warmth continues into August, with average daytime highs around 21°C to 22°C and nighttime lows of 15°C, though temperatures may gradually start to cool towards the end of the month. While these months are generally pleasant with good daylight hours, there is a moderate chance of rain, and showers can occur, so bringing layers and a light rain jacket is advisable. The city also experiences a good amount of sunshine during this period, making it ideal for outdoor activities and enjoying the

coastal atmosphere.

## **Klaipeda, Lithuania**

In Klaipeda, Lithuania, the summer months from June to August bring generally mild and often breezy weather, characteristic of its Baltic Sea coastal location. In June, average daytime high temperatures are around 19°C, with nighttime lows around 11°C. The sea temperature averages about 14°C. Moving into July, it becomes the warmest month, with average daily highs reaching approximately 21°C and evening lows around 14°C to 16°C. The sea temperature also warms up significantly, averaging around 18°C. This warmth continues into August, with average daytime highs typically around 21°C and nighttime lows of 14°C to 15°C. While these months offer the most comfortable temperatures for visiting, there is a moderate to significant amount of rainfall, with July often being the wettest month. Despite the chance of rain, there are also good periods of sunshine, and the long daylight hours contribute to a pleasant summer atmosphere.

## **Riga, Latvia**

In Riga, Latvia, the summer months from June to August generally offer warm and pleasant weather, making it a popular time for visitors. In June, average daytime high temperatures are around 20°C to 21°C, with nighttime lows typically falling to about 10°C to 11°C. There are long daylight hours, often around 18 hours, and a good amount of sunshine. July is the warmest month, with average daily highs reaching approximately 22°C to 23°C and comfortable evening lows around 14°C to 15°C. The Baltic Sea water temperature also warms up, potentially reaching around 18°C in July, making it suitable for swimming. This mild warmth continues into August, with average daytime highs typically around 22°C to 23°C and nighttime lows of 13°C to 15°C, though temperatures may begin to slightly decrease towards the end of the month. While summer in Riga is generally sunny and enjoyable for outdoor activities, all three months see a moderate to significant

chance of rainfall, with June often being the wettest month, so it's advisable to be prepared for occasional showers

## **Stockholm, Sweden**

In Stockholm, Sweden, the summer months from June to August offer generally warm and bright weather, making it the most popular time for visitors. In June, average daytime high temperatures typically range from 18°C to 21°C, with comfortable nighttime lows around 11°C to 12°C. This month boasts the most sunshine, with over 18 hours of daylight. Moving into July, it is often the warmest month, with average daily highs climbing to 22°C to 23°C and evening lows between 13°C and 15°C, with sea temperatures potentially reaching around 17°C, making it more appealing for swimming. This pleasant warmth continues into August, with average daytime highs around 20°C to 21°C and nighttime lows of 12°C to 15°C, though temperatures may gradually start to cool towards the end of the month as daylight hours decrease. While summers in Stockholm are generally sunny and ideal for outdoor activities, all three months can experience moderate rainfall, with July and August sometimes being the wettest, so occasional brief, heavy showers or thunderstorms are possible.

## **Tallinn, Estonia**

In Tallinn, Estonia, the summer months from June to August bring generally mild and pleasant weather, though it can still feel moderately cool at times, especially near the coast. In June, average daytime high temperatures range from 17°C to 19°C, with nighttime lows around 11°C to 12°C. Moving into July, it becomes the warmest month, with average daily highs reaching approximately 21°C to 24°C and comfortable evening lows between 15°C and 16°C. The sea temperature also warms up, averaging around 19°C, making it suitable for swimming. This mild warmth continues into August, with average daytime highs around 20°C to 22°C and nighttime lows of 14°C to 15°C, though temperatures will gradually begin to cool

towards the end of the month. Throughout these months, Tallinn experiences long daylight hours and a fair amount of sunshine, but there is also a moderate chance of rainfall, with July and August often being the wettest.

## Helsinki, Finland

In Helsinki, Finland, the summer months from June to August offer generally mild and pleasant conditions, though it's important to note that temperatures are cooler than in many other European capitals. In June, average daytime high temperatures are typically around 19°C, with nights cooling down to about 9°C to 10°C. This month also experiences very long daylight hours, often exceeding 19 hours, leading up to the summer solstice. Moving into July, it is the warmest month, with average daily highs reaching approximately 21°C to 22°C and comfortable evening lows between 14°C to 15°C. The sea temperature around Helsinki also warms up during this time, averaging around 17-18°C in July and August. This pleasant warmth continues into August, with average daytime highs around 19°C to 20°C and nighttime lows of 11°C to 12°C, though temperatures will gradually begin to cool towards the end of the month as autumn approaches. While summer in Helsinki offers plenty of sunshine, all three months typically see a moderate amount of rainfall, with August often being the wettest, so light rain gear is advisable.

## Visas

### Schengen Area (Including Finland, Estonia, Sweden, Latvia, Poland, Germany, Denmark and Lithuania):

Australian passport holders are visa exempt for an accumulative total stay of 90 days per 180 calendar days. The traveller must hold a passport issued within the last 10 years and valid for at least 3 months after the date they intend to leave the EU.

### European Union Entry/Exit System (EES)

From October 12, 2025, a new European Entry System (EES) replaced the manual passport-stamping process for non-EU travellers. Upon arrival in the Schengen area, Australian and New Zealand passport holders will have their fingerprints recorded and a photograph taken. Their entry and exit dates will be electronically registered. No previous action is required, but please be aware of longer wait times at border entry. From 10 April 2026, the EES will be fully operational at all external border crossing points of all the European countries (Schengen area) using the system.

## European Travel Information & Authorisation System (ETIAS)

As an extension of the EES implementation introduced in 2025, ETIAS travel authorisation is a mandatory entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals travelling to any of [these 30 European countries](#), including Australian and New Zealand citizens, that will be introduced in 2026. We advise you to monitor [smartraveller.gov.au](#) closer to your departure to ensure you are up to date on the requirements at the time of entry.

### Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
- *It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.*
