

Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Chongqing, China

Today, depart Australia (or New Zealand) for Chongqing, China.

Welcome to Chongqing.

Upon arrival, a tour representative will meet you at the airport and transfer you to the hotel.

Often nicknamed the "Mountain City" due to its hilly terrain, Chongqing's vibrant metropolis is a spectacular blend of hyper-modern innovation and ancient history. The city is famous for its futuristic urban landscape and complex, multi-layered topography. It's a place where you can exit a building on the ground floor and find yourself on the 22nd floor of a different street. The city really comes alive at night, where the skyline lights up its neon-drenched, multi-layered architecture.

- *Some travellers may arrive very early in the morning of Day 2.*
- *Some travellers may have an overnight layover in China with accommodation and transfers provided by the airline.*

Day 2 Chongqing Sightseeing

After breakfast, enjoy a walk outside the Great Hall of the People. This iconic landmark ranks in the top 10 of classical Asian architecture of the 20th century and has been declared the Classic Chinese Centennial Building of the 20th Century.

Head to Liziba Subway Station and watch the Chongqing monorail passing directly through a residential building, an architectural marvel that features heavily on social media. Later, see the giant pandas at the famous Chongqing Zoo. One of the rarest animals in the world and known as "living fossil", China's "National Treasure" is beloved by people around the world.

Enjoy the remainder of the day to explore this amazing city at your own leisure. Tonight there will be additional optional activities available and you are able to participate in both if you wish - see current pricing in Important Information.

Optional Activity - Yangtze Two-Rivers night cruise (Evening)

Sitting at the intersection of the Yangtze and Jialing rivers, Chongqing truly shines at night. On the Two-Rivers night cruise, see the city come alive with a mesmerizing display of lights as you pass major downtown landmarks. Afterwards, you'll be taken to a secret spot for the ultimate view of this amazing city.

Optional Activity - Chongqing Hot Pot dinner (Evening)

Experience Chongqing's most famous dish with a Hot Pot dinner.

Day 3 Chongqing - Emeishan City

Today, you will have time at leisure to explore Chongqing, or maybe participate in an optional activity. Check out at 11:00 and meet the guide at the hotel lobby with your luggage where it may be stored. Enjoy time at leisure in Chongqing or join an optional tour before you meet back at the hotel for a late afternoon transfer and drive onwards to Emeishan City. It is located in the shadow of the 3,099-metre-tall Mount Emei (Emeishan), the highest of the country's four sacred Buddhist mountains.

Optional Activity - Dazu Rock Carvings with transfers and lunch

Approximately 1.5 to 2 hours from Chongqing to this UNESCO World Heritage-listed site, the steep hillsides of the Dazu area contain over 50,000 intricately-carved Buddhist, Confucian, and Taoist statues from the 9th to 13th centuries. They are remarkable for their aesthetic quality, their diverse subject matter, and the light they shine on everyday life in China during those periods.

The carvings provide outstanding evidence of the harmonious synthesis of Buddhism, Taoism and Confucianism. A lunch is included with this optional activity. See current pricing in Important Information.

Optional Activity - Ciqikou Ancient Town & Jiefangbei Tour

This tour starts in Ciqikou Ancient Town, an old town preserved in sprawling modern Chongqing. Built in the Ming and Qing Dynasties, its name, Ciqikou, means porcelain harbour, and the community prospered from the porcelain trade.

Then proceed to Jiefangbei Square. Centred around the six-sided "People's Liberation Monument", the modern shopping precinct has become the heart of the Chongqing CBD.

Last stop is the Kuixing Pavilion, a 200-year-old landmark renowned for its surreal, 3D architectural illusion, where the ground floor is actually the 22nd floor. It features traditional, vividly colored architecture and is a popular spot for photographers.

Please note: You will only be able to participate in one of the optional activities this day. The Ciqikou Ancient Town & Jiefangbei Tour may be offered on Day 2 instead and your tour guide will communicate options accordingly. See current pricing in Important Information.

Day 4 Emeishan Sightseeing

This morning, enjoy some of the most beautiful scenery in China as you walk through the Emeishan area and visit Bao Guo Temple. The largest temple at Emei Mountain, it is the doorway to the mountain as well as the centre of Buddhist activity on Emei Mountain. Visit a local silk factory to see how China's exquisite silk is prepared and then enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure or join an optional tour to visit the Leshan Giant Buddha.

Optional Activity - Leshan Giant Buddha and Emei Kung Fu show with lunch

Your tour takes you to Leshan where you will embark on a cruise to view the famous Leshan Giant Buddha, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The Leshan Giant Buddha is a 71-metre tall stone statue, built between 713 and 803, depicting Maitreya. It is

carved out of a cliff face of Cretaceous red bed sandstone and lies at the confluence of the Min River and Dadu River, in the southern part of Sichuan Province.

Later enjoy The Emei Kung Fu show featuring Emei Kung Fu experts, blends ancient Sichuan martial arts with modern, stylish performances. A lunch is provided on this optional activity. See current pricing in Important Information.

Day 5 Emeishan City - Chengdu

This morning first visit a Latex store and learn more about natural latex and its related products. Then drive to Chengdu.

Chengdu is a vibrant and culturally-rich city located in the heart of Sichuan Province. Known as the 'Land of Abundance', Chengdu offers a unique blend of history, cuisine, and natural beauty that makes it a must-visit destination for tourists.

On arrival visit Kuanzhai Alley, one of Chengdu's three historic conservation districts. Constructed in 1718 during the early years of the Qing Dynasty, this charming pedestrian thoroughfare is home to an eclectic mix of classic Sichuan architecture, modern cafes and smart boutiques. As you explore, listen to commentary from your guide about the district's history and design, and witness how some of the city's old establishments — local restaurants, traditional teahouses, Chinese calligraphy demonstrations — sit alongside the new.

Today's driving distance is approximately 180 kilometres.

Overnight: Chunbo Hotel or similar, Chengdu
Meals included: Breakfast

Day 6 Chengdu Sightseeing

After breakfast, visit Heming Teahouse. Nestled in the People's Park, it's a popular destination for both locals and visitors looking for a relaxing cup of tea or a unique cultural experience. The ambiance of Heming Teahouse is peaceful and serene, providing a respite from the hustle and bustle of the city. The teahouse is decorated in a traditional Chinese style, with wooden tables and bamboo chairs adding to the atmosphere.

Afterwards, enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

Day 7 Chengdu - Australia (or New Zealand)

Today, you will be transferred to Chengdu Airport for your return flight back to Australia (or New Zealand).

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the

tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Spring (March - May)

Chongqing

Spring is generally mild and pleasant in Chongqing. The weather warms up quickly, with temperatures typically ranging from about 15°C to 25°C. This season still sees occasional thick fog in the mornings, especially in March, a remnant of the winter humidity. Light showers are common, but overall it's a comfortable transition period before the intense summer heat arrives.

Chengdu

Spring in Chengdu is characterised as pleasant and warming. It's often

considered a very comfortable time to be in the city. Temperatures follow a similar range to Chongqing, usually between 15°C and 25°C. Chengdu experiences less fog than Chongqing and is generally a little drier, making it a popular time for local travel and outdoor activities.

Summer (June - August)

Chongqing

Summer in Chongqing is extremely hot and humid, earning it the moniker of one of China's "Three Furnace Cities."

Temperatures frequently exceed 35°C and can sometimes climb over 40°C in the afternoon. This is the peak rainy season, featuring frequent, heavy thunderstorms that, while intense, do little to break the stifling humidity. The heat often makes midday outdoor activities challenging.

Chengdu

Chengdu's summer is also hot, humid, and rainy, but generally less extreme than in Chongqing. Temperatures typically range from 25°C to 33°C. Like its neighbour, Chengdu receives the bulk of its annual rainfall during this period, with July and August being the wettest months, characterised by high humidity and heavy precipitation.

Autumn (September - November)

Chongqing

Autumn is often considered the best time to visit Chongqing. The weather turns cool and comfortable, providing a welcome relief from the summer heat. Early autumn sees temperatures ranging from 18°C to 28°C, gradually cooling by November. The humidity drops, and the city enjoys clearer skies and less rainfall compared to the summer months.

Chengdu

Autumn in Chengdu is similarly a cool and crisp season. It is another ideal time for tourism due to the comfortable, moderate weather. Temperatures generally range from 14°C to 22°C. While rain is common, it tends to be lighter and less frequent than during the summer, offering many

pleasant, mild days.

Winter (December - February)

Chongqing

Winter in Chongqing is mild, damp, and famously foggy. Compared to northern China, it's short, with temperatures typically ranging from 6°C to 12°C. However, the high humidity makes the cold feel much more penetrating. The season is dominated by frequent and heavy fog, giving the city its nickname "Fog City." Snow is extremely rare.

Chengdu

Chengdu's winter is cold, damp, and predominantly overcast. Temperatures are low, ranging from about 5°C to 10°C. The persistent cloud cover and high humidity contribute to a perpetual feeling of chill. Fog can also occur, and the city receives very little sunshine during this season. As with Chongqing, significant snowfall is highly uncommon.

Weather

We always suggest referring to an online source for the most up-to-date weather information for your destination/s.

FLIGHTS

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points:

We do not arrange seat selection. It is essential to highlight that some airlines do not allow pre-selected seats.
