#### Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Delhi

Today, depart for Delhi, India.

In New Delhi, visit the Laxmi Narayan Temple, dedicated to the goddess of prosperity. Continue to India Gate, a 42-metre-high stone archway commemorating the 85,000 Indian soldiers who lost their lives in World War I. Finally, drive past Rashtrapati Bhawan, the grand official residence of the President of India, featuring a unique blend of Mughal and Western design. Return to the hotel for an afternoon at leisure or take part in an optional activity for the day.

Optional Activity: Explore UNESCO World Heritage Sites

India boasts an astounding 40 UNESCO World Heritage sites, and today you have the opportunity to explore two of Delhi's finest: Visit Humayun's Tomb, the first great example of Mughal architecture in India, featuring a complex of buildings set within manicured lawns and fountains. You will also stop at the Qutub Minar, the world's tallest brick minaret at 72.5 metres. Built in 1193, this red sandstone victory tower features five distinct stories intricately engraved with verses from the Quran. ### Day 3 Delhi - Jaipur

After breakfast, depart by road for Jaipur, the picturesque capital of Rajasthan. Upon arrival, check-in at your hotel.

This is a city where royal grandeur is still a way of life, with majestic palaces and vibrant traditions that have endured for centuries. The city's timeless appeal is reflected in its colourful bazaars, beautifully laid-out gardens, and marvellous heritage monuments. Witness the unique charm of the streets, where ambling camels and locals in multi-hued traditional costumes create a memorable atmosphere.

Once the capital of the Kachhwaha clan, this stunning fortress is crafted from white marble and red sandstone. Perched above the shimmering Maota Lake, the fort's reflection creates a dreamlike illusion that is truly a sight to behold. In the afternoon, continue your exploration of Jaipur's royal heritage at the Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds). This unique five-storey structure was built with intricate latticework to allow royal ladies to observe street festivities without being seen. Visit Jantar Mantar, the largest of five astronomical observatories built by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh, and the beautiful Lakshmi Narayan Temple, dedicated to Lord Vishnu and Goddess Lakshmi.

#### Optional Activity: City Palace, The Former Royal Residence

Visit the former royal residence, a grand complex that showcases a masterful blend of Rajasthani and Mughal architecture. Still home to the Jaipur royal family, the palace houses a museum with rare collections of royal raiment, weapons, and carpets. Please see current pricing in Important Information.

#### Day 5 Jaipur - Agra

After breakfast, depart for Agra, stopping en route to visit the incredible Chand Baori. Located opposite the Harshat Mata Temple, this ancient stepwell is one of the largest and deepest in India, featuring 3,500 narrow steps in a mesmerising symmetrical pattern. It is believed to have a sacred connection to the temple, serving as a site for ritual cleansing.

Continue the drive to Agra, the quintessential Mughal city and home to the world-renowned Taj Mahal. On arrival, check-in to your hotel.

Later, enjoy a visit to the Agra Fort (Red Fort), a UNESCO World Heritage site and a masterpiece of Mughal architecture. This massive sandstone fortress showcases a sophisticated blend of Persian, European, and Indian styles. Once the seat of the Mughal Empire, the fort's intricate artwork and garden designs famously influenced the construction of later monuments in Delhi.

#### Optional Activity: Visit to Baby Taj and Mehtab Bagh

Explore the landmark mausoleum of Itmad-ud-Daulah, affectionately known as the 'Baby Taj'. This intricately carved marble monument predates the Taj Mahal and is often considered the blueprint for its design. Conclude your afternoon at Mehtab Bagh, the 'Moonlight Garden', to enjoy a breathtaking view of the Taj Mahal at sunset from across the Yamuna River. 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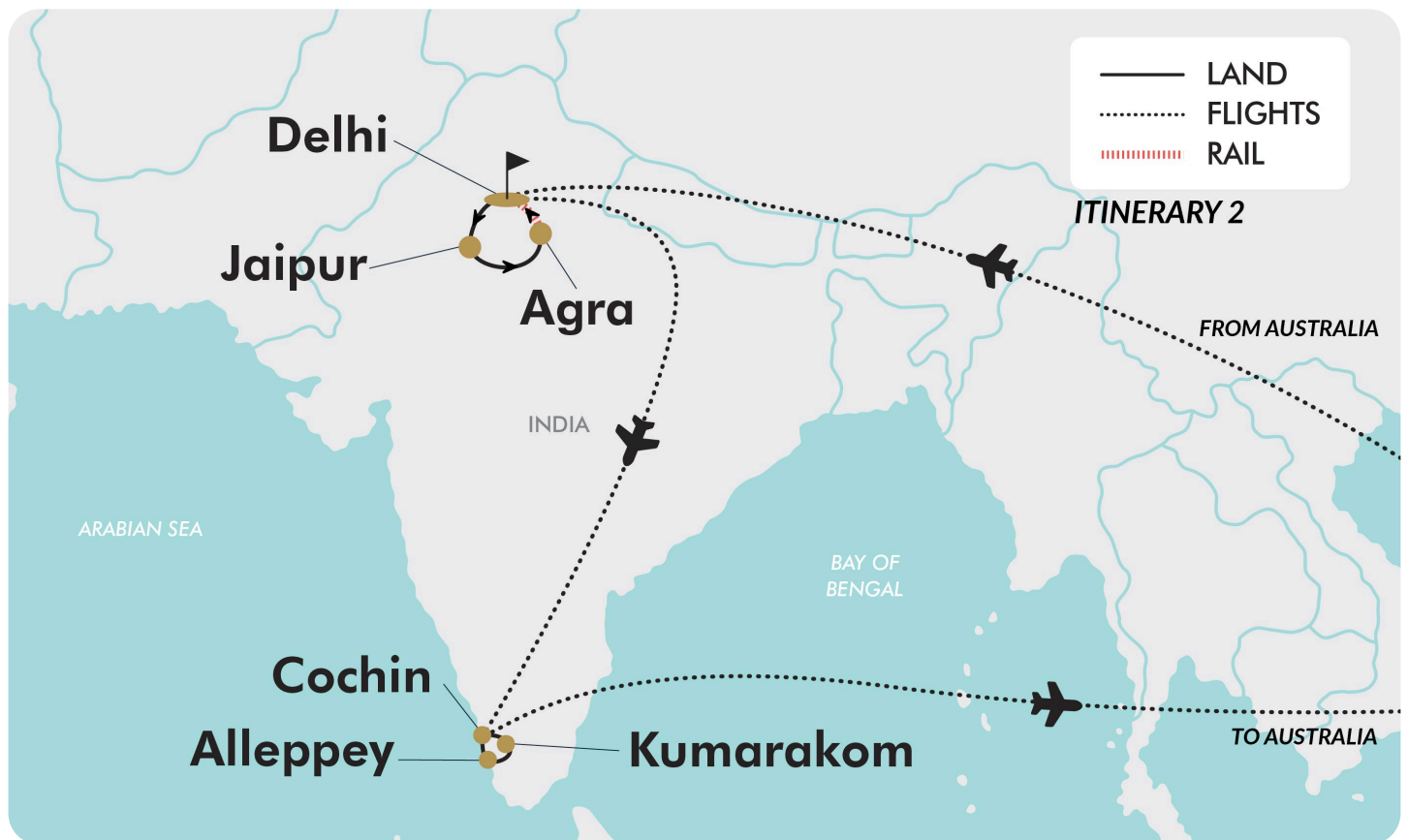

Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.
