Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Tokyo, Japan

Today depart Australia (or New Zealand) for one of the most captivating cities in the world - Tokyo, Japan. Upon arrival, be transferred to your hotel in Tokyo.

Day 2 Tokyo Sightseeing Tour

After breakfast, discover Tokyo's must-see landmarks on an introductory morning tour.

First up, step into the Meiji Shrine, a breathtaking Shinto sanctuary that was made holy for the Imperial Family in 1920s. Wander along gravel paths lined by towering, ancient trees as your guide explains the history and rituals associated with this sacred shrine. Then, visit the Imperial Palace, built on the site of the former Edo Castle, with a history dating back to the 15th century. The current palace structure completed in 1968.

Immerse yourself in a sprawling oasis of meticulously manicured gardens and tranquil moats, standing as a testament to centuries of imperial traditions nestled within the heart of Chiyoda Ward.

The tour ends at around lunchtime, with time leisure to explore this incredible city at your own pace.

Optional Activity: Tokyo By Night

Experience the electric pulse of Tokyo after dark. Witness the organised chaos of the Shibuya Crossing, explore the neon-soaked streets of Shinjuku's entertainment district, and cap off the night at Tokyo Tower for breathtaking panoramic views of the city lights. From youth culture to sky-high vistas, discover the city's nocturnal magic.

Day 3 Tokyo - Hakone - Shizuoka

Today, enjoy a sightseeing tour of Hakone on your way to Shizuoka.

Hakone is part of the Fuji-Hakone-Izu National Park, less than 100 kilometres from Tokyo. Famous for hot springs, natural beauty and the views across Lake Ashinoko (also known as Lake Ashi) of nearby Mount Fuji, Hakone is one of the most popular destinations for those looking for a break from the busy city of Tokyo.

First stop in Hakone is the viewpoint and area around Owakudani Crater, created during the last eruption of Mount Hakone some 3,000 years ago. View the steaming sulfurous fumes, hot springs and hot rivers in this active volcanic zone. Eggs cooked in Owakudani's hot spring pools with their shells blackened by the sulfur are on sale at shops in the area if you are interested - eating one is said to prolong one's life by 7 years. Additionally, Owakudani has good views of Mount Fuji on clear days.

Afterwards, visit the Hakone Open Air Museum. Located in the mountains of Hakone, the museum spreads across 70,000 square metres and has beautiful views that vary from season to season of the surrounding mountains. Opened in 1969, it was the first outdoor gallery in Japan. The defining feature of the Hakone Open Air Museum is the vast array of 120 sculptures spread across the grounds. Including works by sculptors from both Japan and overseas, the many sculptures of this museum invite you to get up close to appreciate what each piece is trying to convey.

After leaving Hakone, continue onwards to Shizuoka and check into your hotel accommodation for an evening at leisure.

Today's travel is approximately 200 kilometres.

Day 4 Shizuoka - Nagoya - Kyoto

Depart for Nagoya to visit the Toyota Commemorative Museum of Industry and Technology. This hands-on, historical museum in Nagoya, Japan is located within the original 1911 factory buildings of Sakichi Toyoda. It showcases the company's evolution from a textile machinery manufacturer into a global automotive giant, featuring exhibits on weaving, robotics and car assembly.

Afterwards continue to Kyoto. The cultural and historical heart of Japan served as the imperial capital for over 1,000 years (794–1868). It is renowned for preserving traditional Japan

through thousands of Buddhist temples, Shinto shrines, Zen gardens and geisha districts like Gion. Kyoto remains one of the country's best-preserved historical cities.

On arrival check into your hotel for an evening at leisure.

Today's travel is approximately 340 kilometres.

Optional Activity: Maiko Dinner Show

Step into the refined world of Kyoto's Gion district for an evening of exquisite culture and cuisine at a local restaurant. Witness the grace of a 'maiko' (apprentice geisha) performance while savoring a multi-course Kaiseki dinner. Between delicate seasonal dishes and unlimited drinks, you'll have the rare opportunity to gain personal insight into these ancient customs. It is a sensory journey through the heart of Japanese tradition.

Day 6 Kyoto - Nara - Osaka

This morning, depart Kyoto and head to nearby Nara to visit Nara Park, home to more than a thousand deer considered to be the messengers of the gods. These deer have become a symbol of the city and have been designated national treasure status. Deer crackers are for sale around the park and you'll find some deer have learned to bow, asking to be fed.

Then, visit the Todaiji Temple, one of Japan's most famous and historically significant temples and a landmark of Nara. The temple was constructed in 752 AD as the head temple of all provincial Buddhist temples in Japan.

Travel onward to Osaka, one of Japan's largest cities, known as 'the nations kitchen' and recognised as a vibrant food capital famous for its diverse, delicious and affordable cuisine.

On arrival, visit the well-known Shinsaibashi and Dotonbori shopping/entertainment districts enjoying time at leisure before finishing the day at your hotel. The remainder of the day is at your leisure.

Today's travel is approximately 100 kilometres.

Day 7 Osaka - Day at Leisure

This morning, be transferred to Shin-Osaka train station where your bullet train awaits. Climb aboard and marvel at the train's incredible velocity during an approximately 1.5-hour ride to Hiroshima. On arrival, continue to Miyajimaguchi by coach or train, then board a boat to the majestic Miyajima Island. Disembark and discover the natural and cultural treasures of the UNESCO World Heritage-listed Island for 45 minutes with your guide. See the shimmering Itsukushima Shrine, then revitalise with a delicious lunch in a local eatery (not included).

Re-board the boat and return to Hiroshima to reflect on the region's history. Day 9 Taipei & Surrounds Sightseeing Tour

This morning, depart Taipei and travel to the nearby Pingxi district to enjoy a quick ride along the Pingxi Branch Line. This 8-mile stretch of narrow-gauge railroad runs alongside the Keelung River. Take a step back in time on one of the most popular day trips from Taiwan.

Disembark in the town of Shifen, a popular town for launching sky lanterns. Sky lanterns are a Taiwanese tradition and Pingxi district is one of the only places where you are allowed to launch them. The paper lanterns inscribed with one's hopes for the coming year are launched into the sky and the preferred place to launch them is right on the tracks which makes for some great people watching. Here you will have the opportunity to launch a sky lantern (4 travellers to one sky lantern).

Afterwards, continue to the small mountainous village of Jiufen, made famous largely due to its similarity to the village in *Spirited Away*, arguably Hayao Miyazaki's most popular movie. Enjoy time at leisure to enjoy lunch (not included) and to explore Jiufen. You could explore the picturesque Old Street, a narrow alleyway lined up with small food stalls, tea houses, souvenir shops and pottery stores. The most picturesque tea house in Jiufen is A-Mei Teahouse. This multi-story teahouse is strategically located just a little off the main street, perched on top of a hill. From their balcony, you can admire the picturesque view, Keelung Mountain to the right and the Northern shores of Taiwan to the left.

Return to Taipei and enjoy a quick stop at a duty free shop before continuing to Taipei 101, once the tallest building in the world (from 2004 to 2010). Enjoy time at leisure to explore the modern shopping centre and foodcourt, or alternatively take a trip up to the observatory at the top of the tower (not included, additional cost paid on tour).

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Japan's climate is diverse and seasonal, offering a unique experience depending on when you choose to travel. Generally, the regions of Tokyo, Hakone, Kyoto, and Osaka experience four distinct seasons.

Spring (March to May):

This is one of the most popular times to visit, as the weather is mild and pleasant. Temperatures typically range from 10°C to 20°C. This season is famous for the cherry blossom (sakura) blooms, which usually occur between late March and mid-April.

Summer (June to August):

The summer months are warm and humid. Temperatures range from 23°C to 32°C, though it can often feel hotter in the cities. The rainy season (Tsuyu) typically occurs in June and July, bringing lush green landscapes, followed by a vibrant season of local festivals and fireworks.

Autumn (September to November):

Similar to spring, autumn offers comfortable temperatures ranging from 15°C to 25°C. The humidity of summer

fades, replaced by clear skies and the stunning autumn foliage (Koyo), which transforms the gardens of Kyoto and the mountains of Hakone into shades of brilliant red and orange.

Winter (December to February):

Winters are cold but often clear and sunny. Average temperatures range from 2°C to 12°C. While snow is rare in Tokyo and Osaka, it is more common in the mountains of Hakone, providing a beautiful backdrop for the volcanic scenery and a perfect environment for enjoying the region's famous hot springs.

We recommend you to use the Visit Japan Web to pre-register your details before arrival. Visit Japan Web is a web service to help smooth arrival procedure at the airport in Japan. You can register your information for Immigration and Customs procedures ahead of your trip, including the disembarkation card for visa exemption (for eligible travellers such as Australians). Once you have registered, you can use the QR codes from the service

instead of paper forms as part of the procedures to enter Japan.

Important:

- Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.
- Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.
- It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.
- Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.
