Day 1 Meet us in Reykjavik, Iceland

Make your own way to Reykjavik, Iceland to begin your holiday.

Velkomin (Welcome) to Iceland! This 17-day adventure begins in Reykjavik, the capital of Iceland, the world's northernmost capital city!

Known for its colourful houses, clean air and creative scene, it blends small-town charm with a lively arts and nightlife culture. Surrounded by dramatic volcanic landscapes, glaciers and geothermal hot springs, Reykjavik also serves as the main gateway to Iceland's natural wonders.

Make your own way to the hotel for check-in and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Rise early this morning for a Swan Hellenic transfer to the airport for your charter flight to Kangerlussuaq, Greenland. Upon arrival a transfer to the port is provided to board SH Vega.

Situated at the head of the fjord, Kangerlussuaq holds a rich history, having initially served as a crucial WWII airbase. Today, it has been transformed into a hospitable gateway, providing

visitors with an introduction to Inuit culture via its dedicated local museum. It also offers opportunities to explore the icy tundra, populated by diverse Arctic wildlife.

Please note: Restrictions on luggage allowance for this flight are a maximum of 20 kilograms for checked baggage and 5 kilograms for hand luggage.

Day 3 Evigheds Glacier

Evigheds Glacier is a small, picturesque glacier located in the Arctic region, known for its stunning ice formations and remote beauty. It is often characterised by its compact size compared to other glaciers in the area, but remains an important feature in its local ecosystem. The glacier's slow movement and unique landscape make it a subject of interest for researchers studying climate change and glaciology. Despite its modest scale, Evigheds Glacier provides vital insights into the dynamics of Arctic ice systems.

Day 4 Qeqertarsuaq, Disko Bay

Arrive: 08:00 - Depart: 14:00

Qeqertarsuaq is the largest town on Disko Island, Greenland's largest island, where colourful houses pop against dramatic red basalt mountains. Overlooked by striking Lyngemark Glacier, the area is shaped by its volcanic origin, unique terrain featuring dramatic basalt columns, rolling hills and black sand beaches. Thanks to its relatively fertile landscape, it supports unique plant species, such as wild angelica, rarely found elsewhere in Greenland.

Day 5 Itilleq*

Arrive: 08:00 - Depart: 13:00

Cruising at Itilleq, Greenland, offers a unique and scenic experience for travellers seeking to explore the stunning landscapes of the Arctic.

Located along Greenland's rugged west coast, Itilleq provides an opportunity to witness majestic icebergs dramatic fjords, and remote coastal villages. Passengers can enjoy the serene beauty of the region while immersing themselves in the local culture and wildlife. With its unspoiled environment and tranquil atmosphere, Itilleq is a perfect destination for those looking for an authentic Arctic cruising adventure.

*Please note: For departures on 13th September 2027, Itilleq will be replaced by Sisimiut. The second largest town in Greenland, just above the Arctic Circle, Sisimiut remains remarkably ice free

in winter and is known as an adventure sports hub all year round. The area is home to humpback whales and Arctic foxes in their summer coat.

Day 6 Cruising

The native Inuit are an integral part of Iqaluit, a remote community at the head of Frobisher Bay. The bay provides insight into Inuit history and culture including dog-sledding on handmade qamutik sleds led by qimmiq, North America's oldest and rarest purebred canine.

Nunatta Sunakkutaangit Museum displays Inuit artwork while Crystal II, an ancient Thule Inuit settlement, lies outside of Sylvia Grinnell Territorial Park.

Day 8 Lady Franklin Island
Arrive: 08:00 - Depart: 14:00

Most known for its huge vertical cliffs of Archean rocks, reputedly the oldest stones in Canada, Lady Franklin Island is an uninhabited isle off Hall Peninsula on Baffin Island. Black guillemots, ptarmigan and gulls all nest in this ice-filled area of the Davis Strait. Lumbering walrus haul out to the south at Monumental Island, a well-known denning site for polar bears. Nearby, the Cumberland Sound is home to its own species of beluga whale.

Day 9 Cruising Nachvak Fjord, Torngat Mountains National Park

Staffed completely by Inuit, Torngat Mountains National Park takes its name from the Inuktitut word 'tongait', meaning 'place of spirits'. Here, Inuit share their stories of spirits and traditions in their homeland, where for centuries they have been fishing and hunting polar bears and caribou. This magical land made up of dramatically spectacular mountains and deep fjords nudging up to iceberg-filled waters is only accessible by boat.

As the administrative heart of Nunatsiavut and the majestic gateway to the Torngat Mountains National Park, Nain stands as a profound testament to the enduring spirit of the North. Nain serves as a vibrant cultural hub where the echoes of the past meet the breathtaking wilderness of the present.

For the curious traveller, a visit here is more than a stop, it is an immersion into the soul of the subarctic, providing an authentic look at the community that stewards one of the most remote and awe-inspiring landscapes on Earth.

Day 12 L'Anse-aux-Meadows
Arrive: 08:00 - Depart: 14:00

The thousand-year-old Norse settlement at L'Anse aux Meadows (Meadows Cove), on the northernmost tip of Newfoundland, is the first and only authenticated Viking site in the Americas, believed to have been occupied by Leif Erikson. He was the first European to explore Canada's east coast in around 1021. Some of the 800 original Norse artefacts and eight sod houses are on view during a tour of the recreated village, now a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Reykjavik

In Reykjavik, Iceland, September marks the transition from summer to autumn, bringing cooler temperatures and shorter days. During this time, the weather in Reykjavik can vary, with average temperatures ranging from around 5°C to 11°C. While daylight hours gradually decrease as autumn progresses, visitors can still enjoy several hours of daylight for exploring the city's attractions and surrounding natural landscapes. September in Reykjavik often experiences frequent rainfall and windy conditions, so it's advisable to pack layers and waterproof clothing to stay comfortable while exploring the city and its stunning surroundings.

Greenland

In Greenland, October brings the onset of winter with gradually decreasing temperatures. In coastal areas, temperatures typically range from around -3°C to 2°C. However, in more inland and higher elevation regions, temperatures can drop significantly lower, often reaching below freezing. Additionally, October in Greenland is characterised by shorter daylight hours as the winter solstice approaches, with some areas experiencing polar nights where the sun does not rise above the horizon. Overall, October in Greenland is cold and typically sees the beginning of snowfall, making it an ideal time for winter activities such as skiing and dog sledding.

Halifax

In Halifax, Nova Scotia, October marks the transition to autumn with gradually cooling temperatures and changing weather patterns. Average temperatures in October typically range from around 4°C to 14°C. However, temperatures can vary throughout the month, with occasional colder spells and warmer days. October also sees an increase in rainfall compared

to the summer months, with some days experiencing overcast skies and drizzle. Additionally, as autumn progresses, there is a possibility of early snowfall, particularly towards the end of the month, although significant snow accumulation is less common in October. Overall, October in Halifax is characterised by cool temperatures, increasing rainfall, and the vibrant colours of fall foliage.

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points

country to request a Yellow Fever certificate upon arrival. You must check with your doctor well before leaving home about the Yellow Fever requirements for the countries you'll be visiting.

Visas

Iceland

Australian passport holders are not required to obtain a tourist visa for a stay of less than 90 days.

Greenland

Australian passport holders are not required to obtain a tourist visa for a stay of less than 90 days. Please ensure your passport is valid for at least 3 months from your planned date of departure.

European Union Entry/Exit System (EES)

From October 12, 2025, a new European Entry System (EES) replaces the current manual passport-stamping process for non-EU travellers. Upon arrival in the Schengen area, Australian and New Zealand passport holders will have their fingerprints recorded and a photograph taken. Their entry and exit dates will be electronically registered. No previous action is required, but please be aware of longer wait times at border entry. From 10 April 2026, the EES will be fully operational at all external border crossing points of all the European countries (Schengen area) using the system.

European Travel Information & Authorisation System (ETIAS)

As an extension of the EES implementation introduced from 2025, ETIAS travel authorisation is a mandatory entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals travelling to any of [these 30 European countries](#), including Australian and New Zealand citizens, that will be introduced in 2026. We advise you to monitor smartraveller.com.au closer to your departure to ensure you are up to date on the requirements at the time of entry.

United States of America

Australian passport holders must obtain an ESTA visa waiver in order to enter or transit in the United States.

Please note: You may be required to obtain a visa if you do not meet the eligibility requirements of the ESTA program. Please see <https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov> for full eligibility requirements and applications.

Canada

If transiting via Canada on the way to the USA, Australian and New Zealand passport holders must apply for an electronic travel authorisation (eTA) before travelling to Canada by air. An Electronic Travel Authorisation (eTA) is an entry requirement for visa-exempt foreign nationals travelling to Canada by air. An eTA is electronically linked to a traveller's passport. It is valid for up to five years or until the passport expires, whichever comes first. If you get a

new passport, you need to get a new eTA. If you arrive in Canada by train, bus, or boat, you don't need a visa or eTA, but you do need to bring the right travel documents.

Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- *Visa rules may have changed since Covid-19. Some countries and airlines may require you to obtain an additional visa before arrival. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination you're entering.*

Please note:

- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
- *It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.*
