This afternoon, travel approximately 210 kilometres back to Delhi and transfer to the airport for your flight to Varanasi. Upon arrival, a representative will greet you and assist with your transfer to the hotel for check-in.

Varanasi, a city located along the western bank of the Ganges River in Uttar Pradesh, is one of the Hindus' most sacred pilgrimage destinations. Known to the British as Benaras, the city is steeped in history and spiritual significance, with mentions in the ancient epics of the Mahabharata and Ramayana. It was already a thriving trade centre when Buddha delivered his first sermon at Sarnath, approximately 10 kilometres away, around 500 BC.

The author Mark Twain once wrote: "Benaras is older than history, older than tradition, older even than legend and looks twice as old as all of them put together." Varanasi remains a profound symbol of Hindu spirituality, where rituals and traditions have been preserved and revered through the ages. In the evening, witness the mesmerising Aarti ceremony along the banks of the Ganges. This glittering ritual of light and devotion, set against the backdrop of the sacred river, offers a powerful and unforgettable experience.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Rajasthan, India

The best time to visit Rajasthan is from October to March, when the weather is cool and pleasant — perfect for exploring the majestic forts, palaces, and colourful cities. February and March, in particular, offer beautiful weather with clear skies and mild temperatures, making it ideal for sightseeing and outdoor activities. However, it's worth noting that late November to January can sometimes bring heavy smog in certain areas, which may affect visibility.

From April to June, Rajasthan experiences scorching summer heat, with temperatures often soaring above 45 degrees Celsius, especially in cities like Jaipur, Jodhpur, and Jaisalmer. However, the monsoon season from July to September provides some relief, with temperatures dropping slightly and the desert landscape taking on a refreshed, vibrant look. While rains are generally moderate, you may still find pleasant days perfect for sightseeing.
