Day 1 Meet us in Barcelona, Spain

Make your own way to Barcelona, Spain to begin your holiday. Check in to the hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Hotel Catalonia La Maquinista, Barcelona, Spain or similar

Meals included: None

Day 2 Barcelona - Walking City Tour

After breakfast, enjoy a half-day guided tour of the city (approximately 4 hours). Travel through the infamous Gothic Quarters, Plaça de Catalunya, Paseo de Gracia and Las Ramblas, Barcelona's most famous street! See Gaudi's inspirational La Sagrada Família (entrance not included).

Afterwards, enjoy the afternoon at leisure to relax or continue exploring on your own.

Please note: If you are interested in visiting the iconic La Sagrada Família, or any of Gaudi's highlights like the Parc Guell, are advised to book tickets online well in advance to secure their place.

Overnight: Hotel Catalonia La Maquinista, Barcelona, Spain or similar

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 3 Barcelona - Zaragoza - Madrid

After breakfast travel to Madrid. On the way stop at Zaragoza, home to historical monuments such as Basilica del Pilar, Cathedral of San Salvador, and Aljafería Palace (entrances not included). Continue your journey to Madrid for the night.

Travelling approximately 600 kilometres.

Overnight: Novotel Madrid City Las Ventas, Madrid, Spain or similar

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 4 Madrid - Half-Day City Tour

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before departing on a half-day guided city tour. Take in sights such as Gran Vía, known as the 'Spanish Broadway' and the street that never sleeps. Discover Plaza España, Puerta del Sol, Paseo de Castellana, Puerta Toledo and the Puerta de Alcalá. You will also see the Royal Palace (entrance not included), the official residence of the Spanish Royal Family and the historic Cathedral de Almudena (entrance not included).

Day 5 Madrid - Badajoz

Continue your Spanish journey as you travel to Badajoz, located on the left bank of the river Guadiana, close to the Portuguese border. Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. Perhaps take a stroll around the historic quarter to reveal Arab walls, interesting monuments and picturesque streets.

Overnight: AC Hotel by Marriott, Badajoz, Spain or similar
Meals included: Breakfast

Day 6 Badajoz - Lisbon, Portugal

After breakfast depart for Lisbon, the capital of Portugal. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure in this beautiful city, that embraces modern culture whilst maintaining its unique heritage and traditions.

Travelling approximately 240 kilometres.

Overnight: Hotel Vila Gale Opera, Lisbon, Portugal or similar
Meals included: Breakfast

Day 7 Lisbon - Half-Day City Tour

Today enjoy a half-day guided tour of Lisbon. Stroll through the maze-like streets to reach the main attractions: Lisbon's Cathedral and Casa dos Bicos, the old city's pastel-coloured buildings, Tagus Estuary, the Ponte 25 de Abril suspension bridge and more. Afterwards, enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Hotel Vila Gale Opera, Lisbon, Portugal or similar
Meals included: Breakfast

Day 8 Lisbon - Faro, Portugal - Seville, Spain

Today continue to Faro, the capital of southern Portugal's Algarve region. The city's neoclassical Arco da Vila is on the site of a gate that was part of the original Moorish wall. The monumental archway leads to the old town, with its cobbled streets. Nearby is Faro Cathedral, built in the 13th century. The Municipal Museum, in a 16th-century convent, displays prehistoric and medieval artifacts, plus religious art. Faro is a fascinating city, which combines an extensive history, interesting tourist attractions and an abundance of Portuguese charm.

Continue your journey to the capital of southern Spain's Andalusia region, Seville. It's famous for flamenco dancing, particularly in its Triana neighbourhood.

Travelling approximately 470 kilometres.

Overnight: Hotel Exe Sevilla Palmera, Seville, Spain
Meals included: Breakfast

Day 9 Seville

Join your tour leader for a morning walking orientation tour of the city and a walk through the imposing Plaza de Espana. See the Gothic Cathedral and the Giralda Tower, a former minaret converted to a bell tower (entrances not included).

The rest of the day is free at leisure or to further explore the city. Tonight you might like to experience a fiery flamenco show (not included).

Day 10 Seville - Granada

Today, depart for Granada, at the foothills of the Sierra Nevada mountains. Granada is a jewel of Hispano-Islamic art featuring striking arches and Byzantine mosaics, a place where serene Islamic architecture and Arab-flavoured street life go hand in hand with monumental churches, old-school tapas bars and counterculture graffiti art. Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Travelling approximately 250 kilometres.

Overnight: Hotel Exe Triunfo Granada, Granada Spain

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 11 Granada - Day at Leisure

Today enjoy the day at leisure to explore on your own. You might like to visit the UNESCO World Heritage Alhambra Palace (not included).

Please note: If you are interested in doing this day trip are advised to book tickets online well in advance in order to secure their place.

Overnight: Hotel Exe Triunfo Granada, Granada Spain

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 12 Granada - Algeciras, Spain - Tangier, Morocco

After breakfast, you will be transferred to the cruise port of Algeciras to board the ferry to Tangier, Morocco (approximately 1 hour).

Tangier is a Moroccan port city on the Strait of Gibraltar, which has been a strategic gateway between Africa and Europe since Phoenician times. Upon arrival, you will enjoy a guided tour of the Medina.

Travelling approximately 260 kilometres.

Overnight: Mandarin Palace Hotel, Tangier, Morocco

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

Day 13 Tangier - Chefchaouen - Volubilis - Meknes - Fes

Drive today to Chefchaouen, a hidden gem and one of the most beautiful cities on the planet. Tour Chefchaouen, the blue-washed old town (medina) by foot along with your guide, who will share stories of Chefchaouen's history.

Start the tour with the Kasbah Museum in the medina. The Kasbah of Chefchaouen belongs to the early 18th century, and was built by the legendary ruler Moulay Ismail. It is fairly simple in design without architectural surprises, however, it is surrounded by gardens on the interior and exterior. Inside the Kasbah, visit the ethnographic museum housing antique weapons, musical instruments and photographs of the old town.

After exploring the medina, continue to the ruins of the ancient Roman city of Volubilis. Next head to Meknes, an imperial city under the protection of UNESCO since 1996. Explore the Bab el Khemis and the Jewish neighbourhood of the Medina. Discover the remains of a huge loft of the 17th Century and the mausoleum of Moulay Ismail. In the late afternoon, continue to Fes.

Tonight, enjoy dinner at the hotel.

Travelling approximately 390 kilometres.

Overnight: Les Merinides, Fes, Morocco

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

Day 14 Fes - Full-Day Sightseeing Tour

Today enjoy a sightseeing tour of Fes. See Islamic Architecture, UNESCO World Heritage Sites, historic monuments and Jewish Heritage (Synagogue and Mellah). Begin the day in the oldest working medina in the world that many refer to as a living museum. Visit the 14th Century Palace Gates of the King. The Royal Palace in Fes is one of the oldest (14th Century) and largest in Morocco.

Next visit the Jewish Mellah. Witness the dyers souk of silk, wool and cotton. Cross the carpentry area and enter Attarine Street, filled with scents of spices and oils. Visit the tanneries and the Bou Inania Madrasa. The Bou Inania Madrasa was founded in 1351-56 by Abu Inan Faris, who also founded the Bou Inania Madrasa in Meknes.

Enjoy this evening at leisure.

Overnight: Les Merinides, Fes, Morocco

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

Day 15 Fes - Rabat

This morning, depart for Rabat. Upon arrival enjoy a guided tour of the main monuments of the medina. Visit the Royal Palace (Mechouar), the Kasbah des Oudayas, the Mausoleum of Mohammed V and Hassan Tower (entrances included).

Travelling approximately 207 kilometres.

Overnight: Onomo Hotel, Rabat, Morocco

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

Day 16 Rabat - Marrakech

Following breakfast, travel to Marrakech. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to discover the Medina or visit the vibrant Jemaa El Fna, the famous square and marketplace.

Travelling approximately 320 kilometres.

Overnight: Hotel Essaadi, Marrakech Morocco

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

Day 17 Marrakech - Morning Guided Tour

After breakfast this morning, enjoy a guided tour to discover the spectacular sights of Marrakech. See the Bahia Palace, the 16th century Saadian tombs and the Dar Si Said Museum (entrance not included). Next enjoy time at leisure to visit the largest mosque in Marrakech, Koutoubia, or perhaps venture through the old streets of the medina to the Koranic School and the Museum of Marrakech.

In the evening, enjoy a traditional dinner at a restaurant.

Day 18 Marrakech - Casablanca

Depart Marrakech and journey on to the iconic city of Casablanca. Morocco's economic and financial capital and the second largest port city in Morocco, Casablanca is endowed with a special charm. TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as

well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however, they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

As this deal covers multiple countries, temperatures will range from low to high 20's. The travel period is over the European high season, so expect dry, warm and sunny days – though the evenings may still require an additional layer of clothing.

Fitness Level Required

A moderate level of fitness will be required. Expect a moderate pace of touring with a focus on guided tours that may include full days with extended activity, guided city tours or nature walks. You will require a general level of fitness for unassisted navigation of stairs and inclines, longer distances with possible periods of standing when visiting sites, walking on sloping, uneven ground or elevations. You will be responsible for your own luggage and have the ability to board all modes of transport without assistance.

Visas

Europe

A tourist visa is not required for Europe for stays up to 90 days if travelling on an Australian or New Zealand passport.

European Union Entry/Exit System (EES)

From October 12, 2025, a new European Entry System (EES) replaces the current manual passport-stamping process for non-EU travellers. Upon arrival in the Schengen area, Australian and New Zealand passport holders will have their fingerprints recorded and a photograph taken. Their entry and exit dates will be electronically registered. No previous action is required, but please be aware of longer wait times at border entry. From 10 April 2026, the EES will be fully operational at all external border crossing points of all the European countries (Schengen area) using the system.

European Travel Information & Authorisation System (ETIAS)

As an extension of the EES implementation introduced from 2025, ETIAS travel authorisation is a mandatory entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals

travelling to any of these [30 European countries](#), including Australian and New Zealand citizens, that will be introduced in 2026. We advise you to monitor smartraveller.gov.au closer to your departure to ensure you are up to date on the requirements at the time of entry.

Morocco

A tourist visa for Morocco is not required for stays up to 90 days if travelling on an Australian passport.
