Seattle

In August and September, Seattle enjoys the tail end of its peak summer weather transitioning into a crisp autumn. August is one of the warmest and driest months of the year, with pleasant, sunny days and

temperatures consistently peaking between 20°C and 25°C. As the region shifts into September, the weather begins to cool down, with temperatures averaging between 14°C and 20°C; however, the early part of the month can still feel quite warm and summer-like. Overall, late summer in Seattle is highly comfortable and ideal for travel, characterised by lower humidity, clearer skies, and a gradual shortening of daylight hours as fall approaches.

Alaska

August and September in Alaska mark the transition from the peak of summer into the vibrant, unpredictable onset of autumn. August sees the weather gradually cooling, with average temperatures ranging from 8°C to 18°C, alongside an increase in rain showers as the wettest month of the year. By September, conditions become highly variable and noticeably crisper; temperatures drop back to around 5°C to 15°C, bringing the first signs of fall foliage, shorter days, and a higher likelihood of rainfall or early snow in higher elevations. While coastal areas remain more temperate and damp, interior regions like Fairbanks cool down rapidly, making late summer travel beautifully scenic but requiring preparation for sudden cold fronts and changing conditions.

Visas

Canada

If transiting via Canada on the way to the USA, Australian and New Zealand passport holders must apply for an electronic travel authorisation (eTA) before travelling to Canada by air. An Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) is an entry requirement for visa-exempt foreign nationals travelling to Canada by air. An eTA is electronically linked to a traveller's passport. It is valid for up to five years or until the passport expires, whichever comes first. If you get a new passport, you need to get a new eTA. If you arrive in Canada by train, bus, or boat, you don't need a visa or eTA, but you do need to bring the right travel documents.

United States of America

Australian passport holders must obtain an ESTA visa waiver in order to enter or transit in the United States.

Please note: You may be required to obtain a visa if you do not meet the eligibility requirements of the ESTA program. Please see <https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov> for full eligibility requirements and applications.

Important:

- *Please start arranging your visa three weeks before departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.*
- *Visa rules are subject to change. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination/s you are visiting once you receive your travel documentation to ensure you have the most up to date information.*
- *It is your responsibility to be travel-ready and ensure that you are aware and comply with any destination or travel requirements, including the validity of all required travel documents.*
- *Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.*
- *It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.*

Travel Insurance
