The Itinerary

Day 1 Australia (or New Zealand) - Kunming, China

Today, depart Australia (or New Zealand) for Kunming, China.

Upon arrival, a tour representative will meet you at the airport and transfer you to the hotel.

Kunming, the capital of Yunnan Province, is known affectionately across China as the 'City of Eternal Spring'. Thanks to its moderate elevation of about 1,890 metres, the city enjoys a perpetually pleasant, mild climate and blooming flowers all year round.

Please note:

- Some travellers may depart on Day 0.
- Some travellers may arrive very early in the morning of Day 2.
- Some travellers may have an overnight layover in China with accommodation and transfers provided by the airline.
- Some travellers may have an overnight layover in an Australian city with airport accommodation provided (excluding transfers).

Day 2 Kunming Sightseeing

This morning, enjoy an introductory tour of Dianchi Lake, the largest freshwater lake in Yunnan Province.

The lake is often called the 'Pearl of the Plateau' because of its vast size, beautiful scenery and important role in the region's ecology and culture. Here you will visit Daguan Park, a lakeside park where many locals come to relax and enjoy the lake.

Daguan Lou is the main attraction of Daguan Park. It is a square, three-storey building originally constructed to give the Kangxi Emperor a better view of the distant Western Hills. Today, it holds a collection of beautiful calligraphy that praises the beauty of the area. The tour will end at around midday, and you're free to explore this amazing city at your own leisure in the afternoon.

Optional Activity: Stone Forest & Yunnan Cultural Show

Stone Forest Scenic Area is a world-famous UNESCO World Heritage site located roughly 1.5 hours southeast of downtown Kunming. This staggering geological marvel features towering, knife-edged karst limestone formations that shot up from the earth over 270 million years ago, creating the illusion of a vast forest made entirely of stone. The area is deeply intertwined with the folklore of the local Sani people, a branch of the Yi minority. Tonight, enjoy a show which will showcase Yunnan's colourful performing arts. Booked and paid on tour.

Overnight: Ramada Encore by Wyndham Kunming West or similar

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 3 Kunming – Chuxiong City

After breakfast visit Golden Temple Park. Built during the late Ming Dynasty, it is the largest bronze temple in the country and among the oldest.

What makes exploring the Golden Temple Park so intriguing is the history and legend behind the construction and usage of the temple, more specifically, the story of Chen Yuanyuan, one of the eight beauties of Chinese history.





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Afterwards, depart Kunming and drive to Chuxiong City, which is positioned perfectly in the geographical centre of Yunnan Province, right between Kunming and Dali.

On arrival in Chuxiong City, visit Yiren Ancient Town, a beautifully designed, sprawling historical and cultural complex. Modelled after traditional Yi architectural styles and featuring distinctively carved timber facades, sweeping eaves and cozy stone courtyards, the town serves as an open-air cultural stage.

By day, Yiren Ancient Town is a peaceful heritage market, that transforms by night into a bustling centre of food, music and celebration.

Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure or take part in an optional activity.

Today's travel distance is approximately 180 kilometres.

Optional Activity: Traditional Hot Pot Dinner & Yi Ethnic Performance

Tonight, enjoy Chuxiong's famous Wild Mushroom Hot Pot. The prefecture's pristine mountain forests yield an incredible variety of prized, edible wild fungi (especially during the rainy summer months), which are simmered together at your table in a rich, flavourful chicken broth. Other flavours of hot pot will be available for those who would prefer something different. Afterwards, enjoy a Yi ethnic performance, featuring vibrant, deeply rooted cultural traditions from Southwest China, celebrated for their elaborate costumes and a bonfire party. Booked and paid on tour.

Overnight: Vienna International Hotel or similar

Day 4 Chuxiong City – Dali

Today, travel onwards to Dali, one of Yunnan's most famous and beloved destinations.

Tucked between the majestic, emerald-green Cangshan Mountains and the vast, ear-shaped Erhai Lake, Dali sits at an comfortable altitude of about 1,975 meters. Historically, the capital of the ancient Nanzhao and Dali Kingdoms, it is the homeland of the Bai ethnic minority. Today, Dali is famous across China for its distinct, slow-paced lifestyle, attracting an eclectic mix of artists, digital nomads and backpackers looking to escape the frenzy of the country's mega-cities.

On arrival, explore Dali Ancient Town, the historical hub of the area, enveloped by sections of preserved Ming-dynasty stonewalls and massive watchtower gates.

Clear mountain springs flow directly down from Cangshan, trickling alongside the cobblestone streets lined with traditional Bai homes made of gray brick and white wash.

The afternoon is free at leisure to explore, or alternatively you may take part in an optional activity.

Today's travel distance is approximately 180 kilometres.

Optional Activity: Jinsuo Island, Dragon Palace Tour & Dinner

Enjoy an optional tour to visit Jinsuo Island of Erhai Lake. The island is home to a small community of local people, and you can experience their simple and peaceful way of life. Your guide will take you on a walk around the island, introducing the traditional houses, the local crops and the unique customs of the islanders. Whilst on the island, visit The 'Dragon Palace', the natural karst



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cave system known for its stunning limestone formations, colourful lighting and cultural performances depicting local Bai folklore. Booked and paid on tour.

Overnight: Dali Manyue M Garden Hotel or similar
Meals included: Breakfast

Day 5 Dali Sightseeing

This morning, start your exploration of Erhai Lake, a breathtaking, high-altitude alpine lake that stretches over 40 kilometres from north to south. Its turquoise waters are bordered by an extensive eco-corridor trail that has completely banned motor vehicles, making it a peaceful sanctuary for outdoor exploration. Here, you will enjoy a walk along this ecological corridor.

Afterwards, visit nearby Xizhou Town, famous for its well-preserved traditional Bai ethnic houses, known for their grandeur and elaborate architecture. Your guide will take you to visit some of the most representative houses, where you can admire beautiful wood and stone carvings plus painted ceilings. Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Dali Manyue M Garden Hotel or similar
Meals included: Breakfast

Day 6 Dali - Shangri-La City

Today is a big day of travel as you head further into the mountains to Shangri-La City, a mythical and stunning destination located in the Diqing Tibetan Autonomous Prefecture of northwestern Yunnan Province, China.

Officially renamed after the legendary paradise in James Hilton's novel *Lost Horizon*, the city sits on a high-altitude plateau at 3,100 metres, surrounded by majestic snow-capped mountains, deep canyons, sacred Buddhist temples and tranquil lakes. It offers tourists an immersive blend of authentic Tibetan culture, remarkable alpine scenery and rich historical heritage.

On arrival, visit Dukezong Ancient City, which serves as the historical heart of the city and a living window into Tibetan architecture and tradition. With a history stretching back over 1,300 years along the Ancient Tea Horse Road, the old town features a maze of cobbled streets and traditional wooden houses. Although a significant portion of the town was carefully rebuilt following a fire in 2014, it retains its mesmerising highland charm and lively cultural energy, making it an excellent base for travellers.

The remainder of the day is at leisure, or alternatively you may take part in an optional activity.

Today's travel distance is approximately 340 kilometres.

Optional Activity - Songzanlin Temple and local Tibetan Family Dinner

Visit Songzanlin Temple, Yunnan's largest Tibetan Buddhist temple, where you can explore three grand halls, witness Tibetan monks chanting, admire the architecture and learn about Tibetan religious culture. Afterwards visit a local Tibetan family's home to get a sense of how they live and understand their customs and traditions whilst enjoying a local dinner. Booked and paid on tour.



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Please note: Shangri-La City sits at a high altitude on the Yunnan-Guizhou Plateau, with the main urban area and Dukezong Ancient City, Shangri-La Administration Committee resting at an elevation of approximately 3,160 metres above sea level. High-altitude environments are classified as above 2,500 metres above sea level. Please consult a medical professional if you have any concerns around altitude sickness or to find out what preventative measures are available. Day 7 Shangri-La City- Lijiang

Today, depart Shangri-La for Lijiang. Lijiang City is one of China's premier travel destinations, world-famous for its perfectly preserved UNESCO World Heritage ancient town, vibrant minority culture and breathtaking alpine landscapes. Sitting at an altitude of about 2,400 metres, it serves as a comfortable, scenic middle ground between the lower plains of Dali and the high-altitude plateau of Shangri-La.

On arrival, visit the Black Dragon Pool, which offers one of the most photographed views in all of China: the elegant, multi-tiered Moon Embracing Pavilion and a five-arched marble bridge, silhouetted perfectly against the snow-capped peaks of the mountains beyond. Afterwards, visit nearby Lijiang Old Town which is a mesmerising labyrinth of cobblestone streets, arched stone bridges and traditional timber-framed Naxi houses.

What makes Lijiang completely unique among Chinese old towns is its lack of a city wall; instead, an intricate network of clear alpine canals flows directly through every street, fed by mountain springs.

Tonight will be at leisure or you may enjoy an optional activity.

Today's travel distance is approximately 190 kilometres.

Optional Activity - Lishui Jinsha Show with Dinner

A breathtaking cultural performance that brings the vibrant traditions of Yunnan's ethnic minorities to life! Set in the enchanting ancient town of Lijiang, this spectacular show combines dazzling dance, mesmerising music and stunning costumes to tell the story of Naxi, Yi, Dai and other local cultures. Dinner is included. Booked and paid on tour.

Overnight: Wyndham Garden Lijiang or similar

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 8 Lijiang Sightseeing

This morning, visit Shuhe Ancient Town, one of the earliest habitats of the Naxi people. It is also an important and well-preserved post of the Ancient Tea Horse Route, an international trade route in Southwest China that uses the horse as its main vehicle. Enjoy the remainder of the day to explore Lijiang at your own pace or join an optional activity.

Optional Activity: Jade Dragon Snow Mountain, Blue Moon Valley & Impression Lijiang Show & Dinner

Today is your chance to discover some of China's most wild and beautiful mountain scenery on a full-day tour of Jade Dragon Snow Mountain. You'll drive approximately 40 kilometres to Jade



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Dragon Snow Mountain where you will explore Ganhaizi Meadow and Baishuhe River. You'll take a cable car to Spruce Meadow and visit the Blue Moon Valley which is home to a turquoise river passing over the beautiful terraced valley, forming four large colourful lakes and dozens of miniature whitewater waterfalls. The mountain is the southernmost snow-capped mountain in China and is the ocean glacier nearest to the equator of all the snow mountains in Eurasia. Jade Dragon Snow Mountain has 13 peaks, stretching 35 kilometres from north to south, while Shanzidou, the main peak, is 5,596 metres above sea level. All year round, snow falls on the peaks, which are frequently lost in clouds and fog. Looking from a distance, the mountain resembles a Jade Dragon, which is how it got its name. Afterwards watch the Impression Lijiang show, a massive, open-air cultural performance set against the majestic backdrop of the Jade Dragon Snow Mountain. Booked and paid on tour.

Overnight: Wyndham Garden Lijiang or similar

Day 9 Lijiang - Australia (or New Zealand)

Today, you will be transferred to Lijiang Airport for your return flight back to Australia (or New Zealand).

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are

guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Spring (March - May)

Kunming

Spring is a beautiful and highly comfortable season in Kunming, earning it the famous nickname of the City of Eternal Spring. The weather warms up nicely with crisp mornings and pleasantly mild afternoons, featuring temperatures that typically range from 10°C to 20°C. This season enjoys abundant sunshine and moderate humidity, making it a prime time for blooming flowers across the city. Light showers are possible but infrequent, providing a refreshing transition into the warmer months.

Lijiang

Spring in Lijiang is characterised by clear, sunny skies and a vibrant display of blossoming flowers such as camellias and cherry blossoms. It is a very pleasant time

to explore the region, with average temperatures usually ranging from 10°C to 20°C. While the daytime weather is comfortable and bright, the high altitude means mornings and evenings remain quite chilly. The air is relatively dry, and rainfall is minimal during this period.

Shangri-La City

Spring arrives late and remains relatively short and cold in Shangri-La due to its high plateau elevation. Temperatures during this transition period are low, typically ranging from about -3°C to 16°C. There is a significant temperature difference between day and night, meaning warm layers are essential. Because spring falls within the dry season, rainfall is rare, but the air can feel quite dry and crisp.

Summer (June - August)

Kunming

Summer in Kunming is remarkably mild and pleasant, allowing the city to escape the sweltering heat waves felt across the rest of China. Temperatures are comfortable, typically ranging from 17°C to 25°C and rarely exceeding 30°C. However, this period marks the peak of the rainy season, bringing frequent afternoon thunderstorms and high humidity. While the precipitation is heavy, the rain showers help keep the mountain air fresh and the landscape lush.

Lijiang

Summer in Lijiang is warm and serves as the primary rainy season for the region. Temperatures generally range from 15°C to 25°C, making the climate comfortable despite the strong summer sun. July and August experience the heaviest and most frequent rainfall of the year, which can lead to sudden downpours. Humidity is higher during these months, but the surrounding mountain areas provide a cool retreat from the daytime warmth.

Shangri-La

Summer in Shangri-La is cool and refreshing, making it an ideal destination to escape summer heat. Temperatures are

very mild, usually ranging from 9°C to 19°C, and it never gets hot. This is the wettest time of the year, featuring frequent but typically light to moderate rain showers. The combination of moisture and mild weather transforms the alpine meadows into vast fields of blooming wildflowers.

Autumn (September - November)

Kunming

Autumn is widely considered one of the most ideal times to visit Kunming. The weather turns crisp and cool, with temperatures ranging from 12°C to 22°C before gradually dropping closer to November. The heavy summer monsoons disappear, resulting in beautifully clear skies, lower humidity and reduced rainfall. The moderate and stable conditions make it exceptionally pleasant for outdoor sightseeing.

Lijiang

Autumn in Lijiang is a charming and comfortable season defined by dry weather and clear blue skies. Temperatures generally range from 10° C to 20° C, offering mild and pleasant daytime conditions. The landscape becomes highly scenic as the trees turn vibrant shades of yellow and red. Rainfall becomes rare by mid-October, though the temperature drops sharply after sunset, making the nights feel quite cold.

Shangri-La

Autumn brings dramatic and colourful transformations to Shangri-La, turning the alpine landscape into a brilliant display of red and gold foliage. The weather is cool and crisp, with temperatures averaging between 5°C and 16°C. As the rainy season comes to an end, precipitation drops off significantly, giving way to clear skies that offer magnificent, unobstructed views of the nearby snow mountains.

Weather

FLIGHTS

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points:

Participants must be able to move independently for up to 3 hours a day without assistance, which includes stepping on and off various types of transportation, climbing stairs, and handling occasional steep or uneven ground. Due to the itinerary's nature, we cannot accommodate wheelchairs, mobility scooters, or specialized accessibility needs. Other walking aids are welcome, provided you can maintain the group's pace autonomously. Although some assistance may be available, all participants must be responsible for your own luggage. Because this trip involves extensive walking, please share any health or mobility concerns with us during booking so we can help determine if this adventure is right for you.

High Altitude Illness:

This tour visits high altitude locations, with Shangri-La being the highest at 3,100m above sea level. Altitude illness can occur when there is a lack of oxygen in the air at high altitudes. Altitude illness will affect some travellers, with no apparent regard to age, gender or physical condition. If you have any concerns please consult your healthcare provider prior to purchase/
